### SERIES INFORMATION VS. CINCINNATI, WISCONSIN

- Virginia boasts a 1-0 series edge against both Cincinnati and Wisconsin.
- The Cavaliers topped Cincinnati, 1-0, on Sept. 10, 2004, at the Saint Louis Nike Classic
- UVa will play Wisconsin for the first time in the regular season; the Cavaliers downed the Badgers, 3-0, on Nov. 28, 1993, in the NCAA quarterfinals in Charlottesville en route to their third of four straight NCAA titles.
- UVa has not played a team from the Big Ten Conference since dropping a 4-2 decision to Penn State on Sept. 8, 2002, in the FILA/Maryland Classic.

## FRESHMEN MAKE BIG IMPACT IN FIRST TWO GAMES

- Eleven true freshmen have earned playing time in the first two games nearly twice as many as any other ACC program this year.
- Six of these freshmen have started at least one of the games, also the most among ACC programs this year. (Spencer LaCivita, Chris Somerville, Ryan Zinkhan, Kyler Sullivan, Eric Bird, Grant Silvester).
- UVa's freshmen have accounted for 848 minutes this year nearly half of the total minutes available.
- UVa had five UVa freshmen in the starting lineup Monday, with 11 freshmen earning 10 or minutes of action.

### VIRGINIA REBOUNDS TO POUND RICHMOND

- Virginia scored four goals in a nine-minute span in the first half to break open a scoreless match and roll to a 7-1 win over Richmond Monday night. UVa also scored three goals in a 12-minute period of the second half.
- Will Bates scored a pair of goals and dished out two assists for Virginia as he tied a career high with his six-point effort. UVa received goals from six others in rolling to the win.
- Virginia held a dominating 28-8 edge in shots, including a 16-5 advantage in shots on goal. Both teams attempted five corner kicks.
- True freshman Spencer LaCivita earned his first career win in goal after stopping four shots.

## VIRGINIA PICKED THIRD IN PRESEASON ACC COACHES POLL

- Virginia was picked to finish third in the Atlantic Coast Conference this season, according to a vote of the league's nine head coaches.
- UVa finished sixth in the ACC last season.
- North Carolina is the preseason favorite to win the ACC; the Tar Heels received seven first-place votes. Maryland was picked second.

- UVa has not lost in Blacksburg since Oct. 29, 2005, a 2-1 overtime loss to Virginia Tech.
- Will Bates has led Virginia in goals each of the last two seasons (12 goals in 2009, 8 in 2010) and is the team leader this year with a pair of scores.
- Spencer LaCivita was the first true freshman to start in goal for a UVa season opener in Gelnovatch's 16 seasons as head coach.
- UVa has eight players on its roster who have played in at least 40 matches each during their college careers.

## **VETERANS MAN LAST LINE OF DEFENSE**

- Virginia is particularly experienced in the back of its defense, with seniors Hunter Jumper, Greg Monaco and Mike Volk manning three-fourths of the defender positions
- The trio have combined to start 161 games and play in 171 in their careers.
- Jumper has started all 63 games in his career.
- All three were starters on Virginia's national championship team in 2009.

## JUMPER NAMED CANDIDATE FOR LOWE'S SENIOR CLASS AWARD

- Virginia senior defender Hunter Jumper has been named one of 30 candidates for the 2011 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award for Men's Soccer.
- To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence - community, classroom, character and competition.
- Jumper has started 62 games during his three seasons with the Cavaliers. He has three goals and nine assists for 15 points.
- A three-time All-ACC Academic Team honoree, Jumper also has been named to each of the last two ACC All-Tournament teams. He was selected to the CoSIDA/ESPN Academic All-District second team in 2010.

#### **HOOS BACK?**

• Virginia returns eight starters and 19 letterwinners from the 2010 squad, which finished with an 11-6-3

record, including a 2-4-2 mark in the ACC.

- 2010 First-Team All-ACC honoree Brian Ownby highlights the returning group of players, while Brian Span was named to the 2010 ACC All-Freshman Team.
- The Cavaliers' leading scorer in 2010, F Will Bates (8-4-20) also is back in the mix.
- UVa's returning core features five players who started in the 2009 national championship game against Akron (D Greg Monaco, D Mike Volk, D Hunter Jumper, M Ari Dimas and F Will Bates); Brian Ownby also played in that match.

### **HOOS GONE**

- UVa lost three starters from the 2010 team, including GK Diego Restrepo, MF Jimmy Simpson and D Sean Murnane.
- Restrepo started every game in goal for the Cavaliers last season and was third in the ACC with a 0.77 GAA.
- Simpson was fourth on the team in scoring with nine points (4-1-9), while Murnane started all 20 games for UVa.
- Senior MF/D TJ Cyrus also graduated after playing in all 20 matches in 2010.

#### **BIG GROUP OF NEWBIES**

- Virginia boasts a large and talented group of 12 freshmen this season many of whom are expected to contribute and push for playing time immediately.
- This marks one of the largest freshman classes in the George Gelnovatch coaching era, and it also features quality players at every position on the field.
