- She played 23 minutes as a substitute on Oct. 24 in the $3-0$ semifinal win over Mexico in Philadelphia as the team clinched a Women's World Cup berth - She started the championship game, a 6-0 win over Costa Rica, playing 50 minutes and assisting on Abby Wambach's goal in the fourth minute - Brian has 16 appearances for the USWNT and three international goals since her debut in June 2013
- She was the only collegian on the 20-player USWNT qualifying roster
