### FOR OPENERS

- Virginia looks to avenge a 70-68 loss at Virginia Tech earlier this season.
- The UVA-VT game is part of the Commonwealth Clash presented by Virginia529, which is a head-to-head, points-based competition between the athletic teams of the Cavaliers and Hokies.
- As of Feb. 8, UVA is third in the ACC at 8-3 and Virginia Tech is 11th at 5-6.
- As of Feb. 8, UVA ranks fifth nationally in scoring defense (60.1 ppg), eighth in field goal percentage (49.5%), 10th in 3-point field goal percentage (41.1%), 15th in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.49) and 28th in free throw percentage (74.5%).

### MORE ON THE COMMONWEALTH CLASH

- The Commonwealth Clash encourages a friendly, statewide rivalry between the two schools across all school-sponsored sports with 21 individual event points on the line.
- The school that accumulates 11 points or more will be crowned the winner and take home the Virginia529 Commonwealth Clash trophy.
- The UVA-VT game is worth a half point in the Clash.
- The score for this year's Clash is Virginia 3.5 and Virginia Tech 3.5.
- UVA claimed the inaugural Commonwealth Clash 15-7 last season.

### HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE SIX-GAME WINNING STREAK

- UVA has allowed 57.0 points during its six-game winning streak.
- UVA has held three opponents (Louisville, Boston College and Pitt) to 50 or fewer points.
- The Cavaliers have limited opponents to 39.1 percent field goal shooting and 33.9 percent 3-point shooting.
- The Cavaliers scored 18 points, including Darius Thompson's game-winning 3-pointer, in the final 1:16 to defeat Wake Forest 72-71.
- UVA limited Louisville to 32.7 percent shooting and 47 points as the Cavaliers handed the Cardinals their worst defeat (63-47) at KFC Yum! Center since the building opened in 2010.
- UVA has shot 50.9 percent from the field and 44.9 percent from 3-point range.
- Malcolm Brogdon has five 20-point games during the streak, averaging 21.7 points, 58.3 percent field goal shooting, 55.2 percent 3-point shooting and 96.8 percent free throw shooting.

### ALL-TIME AGAINST THE HOKIES

- Virginia is 88-54 all-time vs. Virginia Tech in the series that dates back to 1914-15.
- UVA's seven-game winning streak against the Hokies ended with its 70-68 loss at Cassell Coliseum on Jan. 4.
- The Cavaliers are 8-2 in their last 10 meetings against the Hokies, including a three-game winning streak at John Paul Jones Arena.
- The Cavaliers are 36-12 against Virginia Tech in Charlottesville, including a 6-3 mark at JPJ.
- Head coach Tony Bennett is 9-4 all-time vs. Virginia Tech.
- Malcolm Brogdon is Virginia's current career leading scorer against the Hokies, averaging 11.7 points in seven career games.
- Anthony Gill has averaged 10.6 points and 5.6 rebounds in five career games vs. the Hokies, while London Perrantes has averaged 10.8 points and 4.4 assists in five contests.

### LAST TIME VS. VIRGINIA TECH

- Zach LeDay tallied 22 points to lead Virginia Tech to a 70-68 upset win over then-No. 4 Virginia in Blacksburg on Jan. 4.
- London Perrantes had a season-high 22 points, including a career-high seven 3-pointers, in the loss that ended UVA's 11-game winning streak.
- Anthony Gill added 17 points and Malcolm Brogdon chipped in 15 as UVA shot 49 percent (24-49) from the field in the loss.
- Virginia Tech ended its seven-game losing skid against UVA by shooting 52.9 percent (9-17) from 3-point range.
- Justin Bibbs had 16 points and Seth Allen added 13 for the Hokies.
- UVA out-rebounded Virginia Tech 34-22, but had 16 turnovers.

### VIRGINIA RANKED NO. 9 IN LATEST POLLS

- UVA is ranked No. 7 in the latest Associated Press and USA Today Coaches' polls.
- UVA has been ranked in the top 10 in the AP poll on three different occasions this season (10 weeks overall).
- UVA was ranked in the top 10 in 25 consecutive AP polls from March 3, 2014 to Nov. 16, 2015, its longest span since 49 straight from 1980-83.
- The Cavaliers' No. 6 preseason ranking was UVA's best since a No. 1 ranking to start the 1982-83 season.

**LAST TIME OUT**

- Malcolm Brogdon tallied a game-high 21 points and London Perrantes added 14 to send then-No. 9 Virginia to a 64-50 win at Pitt.
- With the scored tied at 31-31, Virginia drained three straight 3-pointers and Devon Hall converted a 3-point play to cap a 12-0 run early in the 2nd half.
- The Cavaliers went 9-16 from 3-point range and limited Pitt to 39.1 percent field goal shooting.
- UVA owned the paint with a 28-14 scoring advantage and scored 20 points off of 11 Pitt turnovers.
- Jamel Artis lead Pitt with 17 points and Michael Young added 12 points and 10 rebounds.
- Anthony Gill was limited to a season-low four points.

**ALL-TIME VS. THE COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA**

- Since the 1999-2000 season, Virginia has a 58-14 record (2-1 in 2015-16) against teams from the Commonwealth of Virginia.
- UVA posted wins over George Mason (83-66) and William & Mary (67-52) and a loss at Virginia Tech (70-68) this season.
- UVA has won 12 of its last 13 games against teams from the Commonwealth of Virginia.

**THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME**

- Virginia is 134-36 (.788) in 10 seasons, including an 11-0 mark in 2015-16, at John Paul Jones Arena.
- As of Feb. 8, UVA owns the nation's 12th longest home-winning streak at 16 games.
- UVA is 96-20 (.828), including a 61-5 (.924) mark the past four seasons, at home under head coach Tony Bennett.
- Virginia is 31-1 in ACC home games over the past four seasons, which marks the third best mark in ACC history with one loss (Duke 33-1 from 1962-64 and Duke 32-1 from 1997-2000).
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for seven straight seasons.
- UVA's 21-game home winning streak from Dec. 21, 2013-Jan. 22, 2015 set a JJP record.

**VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT**

- Head coach Tony Bennett sports a 155-68 mark in seven seasons at Virginia and 224-101 career mark in 10 seasons overall.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett was also named ACC Coach of the Year, NABC District 2 Coach of the Year and USBWA District 3 Coach of the Year for the second consecutive year.
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons for the first time in school history.
- In 2013-14, Bennett guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship (first since 1976) in the same season for the first time in school history.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to four consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014 and 2015, and NIT in 2013).
- Bennett-coached teams are 78-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 10-year coaching career.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense three times (2008-09, 2013-14 & 2014-15), and finished in the top five nationally in six of nine seasons.
- Bennett is one of 26 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- UVA is 79-24 (.767) in non-conference action and 96-20 (.828) at home under Tony Bennett.

**VIRGINIA BASKETBALL GETTING OFFENSIVE**

- UVA is averaging 71.6 points, its most since 76.8 ppg in 2007-08.
- As of Feb. 7, UVA ranks Nos. 3 and 8 in the KenPom.com overall and adjusted offensive efficiency ratings, respectively.
- UVA is shooting 49.5 percent from the field (best since 49.6% in 1986-87), 41.1 percent from 3-point range (best in school history) and 74.5 percent from the free throw line (best since 74.8% in 2009-10).
- UVA has scored 80 or more points in six games, its most since 11 in 2007-08.
- UVA's 86 points against Villanova were its most scored against a top-25 opponent since tallying 87 in a road win at Minnesota in 2010-11.
- UVA has shot 55 percent or better in eight games in 2015-16, its most since accomplishing the feat eight times in 1984-85.

- The Cavaliers scored 82 or more points in three straight games (Nov. 19-22 at Charleston Classic) for the first time since the first three games of the 2001-02 season.
- UVA has shot 50 percent or better from 3-point range in eight games.

**SECONDS ANYONE?**

- Virginia has played its best basketball during the second half of games this season.
- The Cavaliers have scored more points in the second half than the first half in 20 of 23 games.
- UVA is averaging 40.0 points in the second half and 31.1 points in the first stanza.
- UVA is shooting 55.1 percent on its second-half shots, including 49.1 percent from 3-point range, but only 44.4 percent on its first-half shots and 32.5 percent from 3-point range.

**HOO ARE THESE WAHOOS?**

- All-America candidate Malcolm Brogdon leads UVA in scoring for the third consecutive season at a career-best 17.9 points per game, while Anthony Gill is averaging a career-high 14.2 points.
- Brogdon has 12 20-point efforts, including a career-high 28 at George Washington and Wake Forest, marking the most by a UVA player in a season since Sylvan Landesberg had 12 20-point games in 2008-09.
- Gill reached double figures in scoring in 25 consecutive games dating back to last season.
- London Perrantes is averaging career highs in points (11.4), field goal percentage (47.2%) and 3-point field goal percentage (52.9%).
- UVA has shot 50 percent or better from the field in 11 contests.
- UVA is 13-3 when committing nine or fewer turnovers.

**ALL-AMERICAN BROGDON LEADS CAVALIERS INTO ACTION**

- Preseason co-ACC Player of the Year Malcolm Brogdon is aiming to become the first UVA player since Sean Singletary (2006-08) to lead UVA in scoring for three straight seasons.
- Brogdon is also bidding to be UVA's first three-time All-ACC first-team selection since Singletary (2006-08).
- Brogdon's 17.9 scoring average is the highest for UVA since Mike Scott's 18.0 ppg in 2011-12.
- Brogdon's 19.8 scoring average in ACC action is the highest for UVA since Sean Singletary's 21.5 ppg in 2007-08.
- Brogdon was named a preseason All-American by The Sporting News (1st team), Blue Ribbon Yearbook (1st team), CBSsports.com (2nd team), NBCsports.com (2nd team), Bleacher Report (2nd team), USA Today (3rd team) and CollegeInsider.com.
- Brogdon and Gonzaga's Kyle Wiltjer are the first consensus All-Americans to return as fifth-year seniors since Vanderbilt's Billy McCaffrey in 1993-94.
- In 2014-15, Brogdon averaged 14.0 points and 3.9 rebounds en route to All-America second-team and All-ACC first-team accolades.
- The two-time All-ACC performer is tied for 15th on UVA's all-time scoring list with 1,546 points in 122 career games (12.7 career ppg).
- Brogdon ranks second on UVA's career free-throw percentage list at 86.6% (368-for-425).
- Brogdon is a Wooden Award and West Award finalist for the second straight season, and candidate for the 2016 Senior CLASS Award and Wooden Citizen Cup Award.
- Brogdon helped Team USA to a bronze medal at the 2015 Pan American Games in Toronto.
- He earned a degree in history and is pursuing a master's degree from the Frank Batten School of Leadership and Public Policy.

- Preseason All-ACC second-team selection Anthony Gill is averaging a career-high 14.2 points.
- Gill leads UVA in rebounding (6.1 rpg) and field goal percentage (58.6%) and has led UVA in scoring in seven games.
- Gill was the first UVA player to score in double figures in the first 22 games of a season since Sean Singletary scored 10 or more points in all 33 games during 2007-08.
- Gill earned ACC Player of the Week honors after tallying 20 points and 12 rebounds vs. West Virginia for his fourth career double-double.
- Gill averaged 11.6 points and 6.5 rebounds en route to All-ACC third-team (media) honors in 2014-15.
- Gill was named to the coaches' All-ACC Defensive Team in 2014-15.
- Gill, who has led UVA in field goal percentage in each of the past two seasons, is shooting 58.5 percent during his UVA career.
- Gill has amassed 1,275 career points in three seasons at UVA and one at South Carolina (1,039 at UVA).

## LONDON CALLING THE SHOTS

- Guard London Perrantes is enjoying a breakout season in 2015-16.
- Perrantes has hit double figures in scoring in 12 games, including a season-high 22 points (career-best seven 3-pointers) at Virginia Tech.
- Perrantes leads the ACC in 3-point shooting at a career-best 52.9 percent and has a career 3.0 assist-to-turnover ratio (379 assists, 127 turnovers) in 88 games.
- He tallied his second career double-double with 16 points and a career-high 11 assists against George Mason en route to MVP honors at the Charleston Classic.
- Perrantes also tallied 19 points against Villanova and Florida State.
- He missed the Ohio State and William & Mary contests due to an appendectomy.
- Perrantes averaged 6.4 points and 4.6 assists en route to honorable mention All-ACC honors last season.
- He had a career-high 26 points, including five 3-pointers, at Miami (1/3/15).
- Perrantes earned All-ACC Freshman Team honors in 2013-14.

## HALL OF A SPARK

- Devon Hall has played in all 23 games this season and is averaging 19.7 minutes after averaging 10.6 minutes in 23 contests last season.
- Hall has averaged 5.7 points in seven consecutive starts.
- Hall has just four turnovers in his last 189 minutes (eight games).
- Hall scored an ACC-high 11 points against Clemson.
- Hall netted a career-high 13 points vs. Morgan State and drained a

- career-best four 3-pointers for 12 points vs. Long Beach State.
- Hall had five points, four assists and three rebounds in a solid all-around outing against Notre Dame.
- Hall made his first start of the season at Florida State, scoring six points and matching a season high with 26 minutes.

- Darius Thompson has averaged 5.4 points, 1.7 rebounds, 1.8 assists and 0.9 steals in his first season at UVA.
- Thompson is shooting 35.5 percent (11-31) from 3-point range after shooting 19.5 percent (8-41) from downtown at Tennessee in 2013-14.
- Thompson banked in the game-winning 3-pointer at Wake Forest.
- He had a five-game double figure scoring streak from Nov. 25-Dec. 19, and tallied 12 points in four games.
- Thompson sat out as a transfer last season after averaging 2.6 points and 2.4 assists in 37 games at Tennessee in 2013-14.
- Thompson had 12 points, six rebounds, four assists and three steals in his UVA debut as a starter vs. Morgan State.

- Malcolm Brogdon is third in scoring (17.9 ppg), tied for third in free throw shooting (86.9%), tied for seventh in 3-point shooting (40.7%) and 10th in minutes (33.4 mpg).
