TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Virginia continues its three-game road trip by visiting Duke
- The Cavaliers can clinch a spot in the ACC Tournament with a victory

SERIES HISTORY:

- UVa leads 19-12-7 overall (UVa leads 8-4-4 in Durham)
- Virginia won last year's game at Koskinen, 3-2, rallying from a 2-0 halftime deficit with goals from Makenzy Doniak, Morgan Brian and Gloria Douglas
- The Cavaliers are unbeaten (8-0-2) in the regular season vs. Duke since 2004, including a 4-0-1 record in Durham, but Duke has won all three postseason games during that span (all in NCAA Tournament)

HIGH SCORING HOOS:

- The Cavaliers lead the ACC and rank second nationally in scoring offense at 3.47 goals per game
- Virginia led the nation in scoring in 2013 at 3.00 goals per game
- UVa has 14 different goal scorers this season, including 11 players with multiple goals, and 15 different players with a point
- Virginia has scored at least two goals in 14 of 15 games this season
- Ten different Cavaliers have scored a game-winning goal this season

SCORING FROM THE BACK:

• Virginia has 11 goals from defenders this season (Cox-4, Sonnett-3, McNabb-2, Reid, Iordanou), breaking the school record of nine set last year

STREAKS ON THE LINE TODAY:

· Virginia has won 44 straight games and is unbeaten in its last 58 games (57-0-1) against unranked opponents

BRIAN SCORES IN CONCACAF QUALIFYING DEBUT:

- Morgan Brian is currently with the United States Women's National Team as the team competes in CONCACAF World Cup Qualifying
- Brian made her first appearance in qualifying on Monday, entering as a substitute in the 63rd minute and scoring a goal in the 82nd minute in the 6-0 win over Haiti at RFK Stadium in Washington
- It was her 14th appearance for the USWNT and her third international goal since her debut in June 2013
- She is the only collegian on the 20-player USWNT qualifying roster
- The USWNT will play Mexico in the semis on Friday in Philadelphia and would clinch a spot in next year's FIFA Women's World Cup in Canada with a win

SWANSON ASSISTING USWNT:

- Head Coach Steve Swanson is also assisting the United States Women's National Team as it competes in CONCACAF World Cup Qualifying
- He is working with both teams this fall, but his schedule will minimize the number of Virginia games he will miss

GOALS GALORE:

- Virginia found the back of the net 12 times in wins over BC & NCSU
- First time since 2008 a team scored at least six goals in consecutive ACC games
- UVa was the first Power 5 Conference team (ACC, Big 12, Big Ten, Pac-12, SEC) to score at least six goals in consecutive games since 2011

TRIO OF WEEKLY HONORS:

- Virginia had three players earn weekly honors on Oct. 14 after the victories over Boston College and NC State
- Danielle Colaprico was named ACC Player of the Week after posting a goal and two assists in each victory
- Kaili Torres was named the TopDrawerSoccer.com Player of the Week after an assist vs. BC and a goal and three assists vs. NC State
- Makenzy Doniak was the College Soccer Madness ACC Player of the Week after two goals and an assist vs. BC and a goal and an assist vs. NC State

RATCLIFFE'S LATE WINNER SINKS IRISH:

- Virginia won 2-1 at Notre Dame on Brittany Ratcliffe's goal in the 90th min.
- The goal was scored with 20 seconds left as she tapped in a rebound of a saved shot by Makenzy Doniak
- It was the latest GWG in regulation by a Cavalier since Nikki Krzysik scored with 14 seconds left to defeat William & Mary 1-0 in the second round of the 2007 NCAA Tournament
- Ratcliffe was named ACC Player of the Week on Oct. 7

PRESEASON ACC HONORS:

- Virginia was selected second in the preseason ACC coaches' poll, behind reigning champion Florida State
- UVa led all schools with three selections on the preseason All-ACC team, with Brian, Colaprico and Doniak on the 11-player squad



THREE HOOS ON PRESEASON HERMANN LIST:

- Virginia had three players named to the preseason watch list for the MAC Hermann Trophy
- Morgan Brian, who became Virginia first women's MAC Hermann Trophy winner, was joined by 2013 semifinalist Makenzy Doniak and Danielle Colaprico
- All three were also named preseason All-Americans by Soccer America and Top Drawer Soccer

BRIAN JOINS 30-30 CLUB:

- Morgan Brian became the second Cavalier to join the 30-30 club, currently having 35 goals and 34 assists in her career
- Andrea Rubio (1989-92) is UVa's other member (36G, 30A)
- Rachel Tejada of Illinois State and Daphne Corboz of Georgetown are the only other active members of the club

CAVALIERS HAVE TWO IN 30-20 CLUB:

- Only 12 active players nationally have posted at least 30 goals and at least 20 assists in their career, and Virginia has two of them
- Morgan Brian (35G, 34A) and Makenzy Doniak (40G, 22A) are both members of the club
- Doniak is the only member of the club who is not a senior

BRIAN AND DONIAK REACH 100 POINT MARK:

- Morgan Brian became the fifth player in school history to record 100 career points (35G, 34A 104pts) on Sept. 25
- Makenzy Doniak became the sixth player in school history to record 100 career points (40G, 22A 102pts) on Oct. 12
- Virginia is the first ACC team to have two active 100-point scorers since North Carolina had three in 2005 (Lindsay Tarpley, Heather O'Reilly and Kacey White)

DONIAK RISING UP THE UVA RECORD BOOK:

- Makenzy Doniak has already entered several UVa career top 10 lists
- She ranks 4th in goals (40), T-5th in points (102) and T-7th in GWG (12)

COLAPRICO CLIMBS ASSISTS CHART:

- Danielle Colaprico leads the ACC with 11 assists this season, already setting the school record for assists by a senior
- Her 36 career assists ranks T-2nd in school history
- She had a point in seven straight games earlier this season, the longest streak of her career and tied for the fourth-longest streak in Cavalier history
