FOR OPENERS

- Virginia meets West Virginia for the second straight season and first time in Charlottesville since Jan. 29, 1975, when the Cavaliers posted an 87-79 win over the Mountaineers.
- UVA owns the nation's sixth longest current home-winning streak at 24 games.
- The Cavaliers rank first in the nation in scoring defense at 44.1 points per game and have held six of their seven opponents to 52 or fewer points.
- Virginia meets its first ranked opponent of the season and is 22-23 against ranked foes in the Tony Bennett era.
- UVA has started 7-0 for the second time (started a school-record tying 23-0 in 2014-15) under head coach Tony Bennett.

ALL-TIME VS. WEST VIRGINIA

- Virginia is 9-8 all-time vs. West Virginia in the series that dates back to the 1915-16 season.
- The Cavaliers posted a 70-54 win over the Mountaineers last season during the Jimmy V Classic at Madison Square Garden in New York.
- UVA has a two-game winning streak in the series and is 4-3 against West Virginia in Charlottesville.
- UVA is 3-2 in its last five games vs. West Virginia and 6-4 in its last 10.

LAST TIME VS. THE MOUNTAINEERS

- Anthony Gill posted season highs of 20 points and 12 rebounds for his fourth career double-double in then-No. 10 Virginia's 70-54 win over then-No. 14 West Virginia in the 2015 Jimmy V Classic at Madison Square Garden.
- Malcolm Brogdon added 14 points and London Perrantes added 13 points in his return from an appendectomy.
- UVA overcame a six-point halftime deficit by shooting 73.7 percent (14-19) in the second half and 62.8 percent for the game (27-43).
- Gill finished 9 of 11 from the field while Perrantes was 5 of 6.
- The Cavaliers committed a season-high 19 turnovers in the game and West Virginia had 18 turnovers.

AGAINST THE BIG 12 CONFERENCE

- West Virginia is the lone Big 12 Conference opponent on Virginia's 2016-17 schedule.
- UVA went 2-0 against the Big 12 Conference last season, including an 84-71 win over Iowa State in the NCAA Sweet 16 at the United Center in Chicago, III.
- UVA is 14-16 all-time against current Big 12 Conference members (0-1 vs. Baylor, 2-2 vs. Iowa State, 1-2 vs. Kansas, 2-1 vs. Oklahoma, 0-1 vs. Oklahoma State, 0-1 vs. TCU and 9-8 vs. West Virginia).

LAST TIME OUT

- Virginia rallied from a 16-point deficit to top Ohio State 63-61 in an ACC/Big Ten Challenge game on Wednesday, Nov. 30.
- London Perrantes scored 15 of his game-high 19 points as UVA started the second half with an 11-0 run after trailing 32-16 late in the first half.
- The 16-point deficit was UVA's largest since the Cavaliers trailed by 37 points in the second half during an 87-52 loss at Tennessee on Dec. 30, 2013
- Devon Hall added a season-high 12 points for UVA and the Cavaliers went 7-of-16 from 3-point range in the win.
- Jae'Sean Tate led Ohio State with 14 points.
- UVA shot a season-low 37.5 percent from the field, but forced 20 Ohio State turnovers, including eight from JaQuan Lyle (12 points).
- UVA improved to 11-6 all-time in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Virginia is 142-36 (.798) in 11 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- UVA owns the nation's sixth-longest current home-winning streak at a JPJ-record 24 games.
- The Cavaliers finished undefeated at home (15-0) in 2015-16 for the first time since 1981-82 (12-0).
- UVA is 104-20 (.839), including a 69-5 (.932) mark the past five seasons, at home under head coach Tony Bennett.
- Virginia is 35-1 in ACC home games over the past four seasons.
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for seven straight seasons.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett has a 172-72 (.705) mark in eight seasons at Virginia and 241-105 (.697) career mark in 11 seasons overall.
- Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons from 2014-16, eclipsing 88 wins from 1981-83.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense three times (2008-09, 2013-14 & 2014-15), and finished in the top-five nationally in seven of 10 seasons.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to five consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015 and 2016, and NIT in 2013).
- In 2015-16, Bennett led UVA to its third consecutive NCAA Tournament and first NCAA Elite Eight appearance since 1995 with 29 wins.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year and ACC Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons (2014-2015) for the first time in school history.
- In 2013-14, Bennett guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship (first since 1976) in the same season.
- Bennett-coached teams are 84-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 11-year coaching career.
- Bennett is one of 28 current Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- UVA is 104-20 (.839) in eight seasons at JPJ under Bennett.

HOO ARE THESE WAHOOS?

- Virginia is led by senior point guard London Perrantes, who is a Wooden and Naismith Player of the Year and ACC Player of the Year candidate
- Perrantes is averaging team highs in points (10.6 ppg) and assists (4.0 apq).
- Isaiah Wilkins (6.7 ppg & 4.7 rpg) leads the team with 13 steals and is second with 10 blocked shots.
- Marial Shayok is averaging 9.2 points off the bench, while Darius Thompson has chipped in 9.1 point per game.
- Newcomer Kyle Guy is averaging 7.6 points, while Jarred Reuter leads UVA in rebounding at 5.0 per game.
- Mamadi Diakite is averaging 6.0 points, 3.5 rebounds and 2.2 blocked shots in 14.7 minutes per game.

UVA RANKED NO. 6 IN LATEST POLLS

- UVA is ranked No. 6 in the latest Associated Press and USA Today Coaches' polls.
- UVA has been ranked in the top 10 in 11 consecutive AP polls and 12 consecutive coaches' polls dating back to last season.
- The Cavaliers were ranked in top 10 in the preseason rankings (No. 8/7) for the third straight season, matching a school-best from 1981-83.
- UVA has been ranked in the top 10 in 41 of the last 45 AP polls.
- UVA has finished in the top 10 (No. 3 in 2014 & No. 6 in 2015 and No. 4 in 2016) in the final AP rankings in three consecutive seasons for the first time since 1981-83.

UVA IN KEN POM EFFICIENCY RATINGS

- As of Dec. 1, UVA ranks Nos. 2, 3 and 10 in the KenPom.com adjusted defense, overall and adjusted offense efficiency ratings, respectively.
- UVA is averaging 71.4 points and allowing 44.1 points per game.
- UVA is shooting 49.7 percent from the field, 39 percent from 3-point range and 69.8 percent from the free throw line.
- UVA scored a Tony Bennett era high 90 points vs. Grambling State.

IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

- As of Dec. 1, UVA ranks first nationally in scoring defense (44.1 ppg), fourth in field goal percentage defense (33.1%), fourth in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.85), fifth in scoring margin (+27.3), eighth in turnover margin (+6.9) and 20th in rebounding margin (+9.6).
- UVA was the first team in Division I to hold three straight opponents (St. Francis Brooklyn, Yale and Grambling State) to fewer than 40 points in the last 20 years.
- UVA was also the first team in ACC history (1953-present) to hold three straight opponents to fewer than 40 points.

GOING ON A RUN

- Virginia has had scoring runs of 11 or more consecutive points in six of its seven games this season.
- UVA went on a 26-0 run to close the first half against Grambling State, tallied a 22-0 run at UNCG spanning halftime, posted a 20-0 first-half run against St. Francis and added a 16-0 run vs. Yale.
- UVA's 13-0 run against Ohio State helped erase a 16-point defecit in the 63-61 win over the Buckeyes.

ABOUT THE 2016-17 SCHEDULE

- Six of Virginia's opponents are ranked in the lastest AP poll (Villanova, North Carolina, Duke, Louisville, Syracuse and West Virginia), while five (Notre Dame, Ohio State, Florida State, California and Virginia Tech) received votes.
- The Cavaliers will play 13 games against 2016 NCAA Tournament teams: home games against Duke, North Carolina, West Virginia, Miami, Pitt and Yale; road contests at Villanova, North Carolina, Syracuse, California, Pitt and Notre Dame; and a neutral-site tilt against lowa in the Emerald Coast Classic in Niceville, Fla.
- Four opponents (Florida State, Georgia Tech, Ohio State and Virginia Tech) participated in the 2016 National Invitation Tournament.

UVA VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

- Virginia is 22-23 against ranked opponents, including a 2-6 mark vs. top-5 foes, in the Tony Bennett era.
- UVA is 137-319 vs. ranked opponents, including a 25-119 mark against top-5 foes, since 1953-54.
- The Cavaliers are 1-26 vs. No. 1-ranked opponents (86-73 vs. No. 1 North Carolina on Jan. 30, 1986).
- UVA was 8-2 vs. ranked opponents in 2015-16, tying a school record for most ranked wins in a season set in 1980-81.

HOOS WATCHING ME?

- London Perrantes is one of 50 players named to the watch list for the 2017 John R. Wooden Award for national player of the year.
- Perrantes is also one of 50 players named to the 2017 Naismith Men's College Player of the Year watch list.
- Perrantes was one of 20 players named to the watch list for the 2017 Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year Award.
- Perrantes led the ACC in 3-point shooting at a career-best 48.8 percent and averaged 11 points and 4.4 assists in 2015-16.

LONDON CALLING

- Preseason All-ACC first-team selection and ACC Player of the Year candidate London Perrantes leads UVA into action this season.
- \bullet Perrantes is averaging 10.6 points, 4.0 assists and 3.4 rebounds in 2016-17.
- He enjoyed a breakout season in 2015-16, averaging career highs in points (11), field goal percentage (43.9%) and ACC-leading 3-point field goal percentage (48.8%).
- Perrantes has led UVA in assists in each of the last three seasons and

- has a career 2.9 assist-to-turnover ratio (469 assists, 163 turnovers) in 111 games (107 starts).
- Perrantes needs 17 wins to become UVA's all-time winningest player (112 by Mike Tobey, Evan Nolte, Caid Kirven).
- He was named All-ACC Honorable Mention in each of the past two seasons and earned All-ACC Freshman Team honors in 2013-14.
- Perrantes ranks first all-time at UVA in 3-point percentage (42.4%), sixth in assists (467) and 10th in 3-pointers (160).

SUPER MARIAL HOT OFF THE BENCH

- Sixth man Marial Shayok ranks second on the team in scoring at a career-best 9.3 points per game.
- Shayok led UVA in scoring in two games, tallying 15 points against UNCG and Yale.
- Shayok is shooting 46.6 percent from the field and 10-for-13 (76.9%) from the charity stripe.

ZAY PAVES THE WAY

- Junior Isaiah Wilkins is UVA's top returning frontcourt player after leading the Cavaliers with 31 blocked shots and adding 28 steals in 2015-16.
- Wilkins tallied 10 points and a game-high nine rebounds in the season opener at UNCG (11/11/16).
- Wilkins is averaging 6.7 points and 4.7 rebounds with a teamleading 13 steals and 10 blocked shots in 2016-17.

'HOO ARE THE NEW GUY(S)?

- Virginia welcomes freshmen Kyle Guy, Ty Jerome, Jay Huff and De'Andre Hunter to this year's team.
- Guy averaged 23.5 points, 5.6 rebounds and 3.7 assists en route to Mr. Basketball for Indiana and McDonald's All-America honors in 2015-16
- Jerome talled 24.7 points, 8 rebounds and 5 assists per game before season-ending hip surgery last season.
- Huff averaged 16.3 points, 10.1 rebounds and 5.5 assists in 2015-16, while Hunter recorded 23.5 points and 9.8 rebounds per game last season.
- \bullet UVA head coach Tony Bennett announced on Nov. 11 he plans to redshirt Huff and Hunter.
