VIRGINIA-VIRGINIA TECH SERIES

- THE BASICS After sweeping Virginia Tech last year in a three-game series in Blacksburg, Sites
- Virginia holds an 89-75 advantage in the all-time series with the Hokies.

- UVa won all three games decisively last year (18-3, 9-3, 10-2).
- Virginia has won 16 of the 19 meetings with VT since 2004.

VIRGINIA STRONG IN RECENT YEARS VS. IN-STATE FOES

- After going 10-0 last season against in-state opponents, UVa is 2-1-1 in 2012 versus foes from the commonwealth of Virginia.
- Under the current coaching staff (since 2004), the Cavaliers have a 74-11-1 record against in-state opponents.

RARE HOME START TO ACC SEASON

 This series marks UVa's first ACC-opening series at home since the Cavaliers took on Florida State in the first ACC games ever played at the then-new Davenport Field in 2002 (March 15-16).

- UVa started ACC play on the road each of the last nine seasons.
- Since the ACC went to the 3-game series format in 1990, UVa has opened ACC play home just twice – 2002 and 2012 (on road 22 of the last 24 years).

HOME COOKIN'

- The Cavaliers are 102-21 at home since 2009 (4-3 in 2012).
- · Virginia won a school-record 35 home games last season, which was fourth

most nationally behind North Carolina, South Carolina and Texas (36 each). In going 35-5 at Davenport Field last year, UVa broke the previous singleseason record for home wins, 34, which was set in 2010.

TAYLOR HEATS UP

 After starting the season slowly at the plate, Chris Taylor got it going last weekend with six hits in 11 at bats and then went 2-for-6 with a triple and solo home run Tuesdav at JMU.

• He also reached base safely in 10 of his 15 plate appearances last weekend. • Taylor was batting .071 (1-for-14) following the opening weekend, but has hits in eight of his last nine games to raise his average to .269.

• After getting hit by a season-high six pitches at JMU, Virginia batters have been plunked by an ACC-high 30 pitches this year (2.5 HBP per game).

• Coming into the week UVa ranked ninth nationally with 24 HBP; Delaware State and UC Davis led the nation with 29 HBP as of the Monday rankings.

UNEARNED RUNS PLAGUE CAVALIERS

- Virginia's mistakes have proven costly this year, resulting in 17 unearned runs in 11 games.
- The Cavaliers allowed 30 unearned runs all of last season (68 games).

• In addition to 14 errors, the UVa has been charged with six passed balls this year (seven in 2011).

JEKYLL AND HYDE ON DEFENSE

• Virginia has committed 14 errors this year, but 13 of those errors have come in four games (4 vs. W&M, Liberty; 3 vs. JMU, 2 vs. Seton Hall-Sunday).

- UVa is 1-2-1 in those contests and trailed in the seventh inning in all three.
- Virginia is 6-2 when failing to commit a miscue.
- UVa owns a .968 fielding percentage overall.

NEW ROTATION OFF TO GOOD START

• After losing its top four starting pitchers to professional baseball, Virginia has plugged the holes nicely thus far.

• UVa's weekend rotation of Branden Kline (2-1, 2.76 ERA), Scott Silverstein (1-1, 1.50) and Whit Mayberry (2-0, 2.50) has combined for a 5-2 record and 2.24 ERA through three weeks.

• They have pitched through the fifth inning in eight of nine starts.

HOT TICKET AT DAVENPORT FIELD

• Davenport Field has become a popular spring destination in Charlottesville, with more than 125,000 fans flocking to the stadium each of the last two years.

• UVa averaged a school-record 3,298 fans per game in 2011.

• Virginia is well on its way to matching that figure in 2012 and shattered the program record for season ticket sales prior to the start of the season.

• UVA has averaged 2,677 fans per game through eight home dates in 2012.

• UVa ranked 14th nationally in total attendance (125,355) and 19th in average attendance (3,298) last year.

CAVALIERS SLOW OPPONENTS' RUNNING GAME

• Virginia historically does a good job of holding baserunners and limiting stolen bases.

• Since the current coaching staff arrived in 2004, UVa has allowed the lowest stolen base percentage (60.2) as well as the fewest stolen bases (315) and stolen base attempts (523), in the ACC.

• This year opponents are 9-for-15 in stolen base tries against the Cavaliers (60 percent).

LOTS OF NEW FACES

O'CONNOR REACHES 350 WINS IN FEWEST GAMES IN ACC HISTORY

• In his ninth season as Virginia's head coach, Brian O'Connor stands at 378 career wins (379-132-2); he reached 350 on April 15, 2011.

• He posted 350 wins in the fewest number of games in ACC history (472).

• Mike Martin of Florida State was the fastest in ACC history to reach 350 wins (while a member of the ACC). He needed 478 games (in seven seasons from 1992 to 1998) to reach the mark.
