#### **FOR OPENERS**

- The Virginia-Virginia Tech game is part of the Commonwealth Clash presented by Virginia529, which is a head-to-head, points-based competition between the athletic teams of the Cavaliers and Hokies.
- Virginia is 5-3 in ACC road openers under head coach Tony Bennett.
- Bennett became the third fastest Virginia head coach to achieve 200 wins (284 games) after UVA's 59-58 victory over Boston College.
- · As of Jan. 2, the Cavaliers rank first nationally in scoring defense (52.8 ppg), second in turnovers per game (9.2), third in field goal percentage defense (36.4%), eighth in fouls per game (14.8), 12th in scoring margin (18.3), 16th in turnover margin (4.7), 17th in assistto-turnover ratio (1.5) and 29th in free throw percentage (76.1%).

#### **MORE ON THE COMMONWEALTH CLASH**

- The Commonwealth Clash encourages a friendly, statewide rivalry between the two schools across all school-sponsored sports with 21 individual event points on the line.
- The school that accumulates 11 points or more will be crowned the winner and take home the Virginia529 Commonwealth Clash trophy.
- The UVA-VT game is worth a half point in the Clash and the Hokies lead this year's Clash 4-1.
- UVA captured the Clash in 2015 and 2016.

#### **ALL-TIME VS. VIRGINIA TECH**

- Virginia is 90-55 all-time vs. Virginia Tech, including a 20-30 mark in Blacksburg, in the series that dates back to 1914-15.
- The Cavaliers are 5-2 in their last seven games against the Hokies at Cassell Coliseum and 8-2 in its last 10 meetings vs. the Hokies overall. • Head coach Tony Bennett is 11-5 all-time vs. Virginia Tech.

#### LAST TIME AGAINST THE HOKIES

- Seth Allen hit a short jumper with three seconds left in double overtime to send Virginia Tech to an 80-78 win over then-No. 12 Virginia on Feb. 12, 2017.
- London Perrantes led four Cavaliers in double figures with a gamehigh 22 points.
- Kyle Guy added 12 points, Marial Shayok added 11 and Devon Hall had 10 in the Commonwealth Clash.
- Virginia Tech erased a 14-point UVA halftime advantage and sent the game to overtime on a Ty Outlaw tip-in at the buzzer.
- · Isaiah Wilkins had a game-high nine rebounds.

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

- Ty Jerome hit 6 of 9 3-point tries and scored a career-high 31 points, including two free throws with 53 seconds left, as the Cavaliers held off Boston College 59-58 on Dec. 30.
- Kyle Guy added 11 points and Isaiah Wilkins had eight with 14 rebounds and four blocks for the Cavaliers, who ended BC's five-game winning streak.
- Jerome Robinson led the Eagles (10-4, 1-1) with 29 points and Jordan Chatman had 18. Boston College scoring leader Ky Bowman (16.8 ppg) didn't score until just 11:03 remained and finished with five points on 2-for-10 shooting.

#### **UVA IN KEN POM EFFICIENCY RATINGS**

- As of Jan. 2, UVA ranks Nos. 1, 5 and 41 in the KenPom.com adjusted defense, overall and adjusted offense efficiency ratings.
- UVA is shooting 47.7 percent, 39.2 percent from 3-point range (2nd best in school history) and 76.1 percent from the free throw line (2nd best in school history).
- UVA has shot 50 percent or better in seven games and limited its opponents to less than 50 percent shooting in all 13 games.

#### **GETTING DEFENSIVE**

- UVA has limited its foes to 52.8 points per game (2nd best in school history) and has held six opponents to fewer than 50 points (UNCG, Austin Peay, Vanderbilt, Wisconsin, Savannah State and Hampton).
- UVA has held nine foes to less than 43 percent shooting.
- The Cavaliers are 70-2 when limiting their opponents to fewer than 50 points under head coach Tony Bennett.
- In 2016-17, Virginia led the nation in scoring defense (56.4 ppg) for the third time under Bennett.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense four times (2008-09, 2013-14, 2014-15, 2016-17) and finished in the top-five nationally in eight of 11 seasons.
- Bennett-coached teams are 95-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 12-year coaching career.

#### **UVA VS. THE COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA**

- UVA has a 64-14 record against teams from the Commonwealth of Virginia since 1999-2000.
- UVA is 2-0 vs. teams from Virginia this season (VCU and Hampton).
- UVA has won 17 of its last 19 games against teams from Virginia.

#### VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett has a 200-84 (.704) mark in nine seasons at Virginia and 268-117 (.696) career mark in 12 seasons overall.
- Bennett has guided UVA to four straight NCAA Tournament appearances and has led UVA to a school-record five straight seasons with 23 or more wins.
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-record five straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons from 2014–16, eclipsing 88 wins from 1981–83.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to six consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and NIT in 2013).
- In 2015-16, Bennett led UVA to its third consecutive NCAA Tournament and first NCAA Elite Eight appearance since 1995 with 29 wins.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year and ACC Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons (2014-2015) for the first time in school history.
- In 2013-14, Bennett guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship (first since 1976) in the same season.
- Bennett is one of 28 current Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- UVA is 111-34 (.765) in non-conference action, 89-50 (.640) in ACC play and 121-24 (.834) at home under Tony Bennett.

#### **ABOUT THE CAVALIERS**

- UVA is led by tri-captains Devon Hall, Isaiah Wilkins and Jack Salt.
- The announcement of Hall, Wilkins and Salt marked the first time in Bennett's 12-year head coaching career where he officially named team captains.
- UVA has averaged 71.1 points per game (most under Bennett) on offense, while yielding a nation-leading 52.8 ppg (second lowest in school history) on defense.
- UVA has started Ty Jerome, Kyle Guy, Hall, Wilkins and Salt in each of its 13 games.
- Guy leads the team in scoring at 15.7 points per game and has reached double figures in 11 games, including a career-high 29 points at VCU (11/17/17) and 21 vs. Lehigh (12/2/17).
- Hall has averaged 11.5 points and is shooting 88.1 percent (30 of 34) from the charity stripe and 43.9 percent (18 of 41) from 3-point range.
- Wilkins is averaging 7.3 points and team-highs in rebounds (7.5), blocked shots (1.4) and steals (1.3).
- Jerome is averaging 9.7 points and Salt has chipped in 4.3 rebounds per game.
- Graduate transfer Nigel Johnson is averaging 6.5 points after averaging 11.3 points for Rutgers last season.
- Mamadi Diakite (6.1 ppg & 3.8 rpg) and redshirt freshmen De'Andre Hunter (6 ppg) and Jay Huff (4.6 ppg) are key role players.
- Marco Anthony provides depth and fellow rookie Francesco Badocchi is expected to redshirt the 2017-18 season.

#### **UVA RANKED NO. 8 IN LATEST NATIONAL POLLS**

- UVA is ranked a season-high No. 8 in the latest AP and USA Today Coaches' polls.
- UVA has been ranked in the AP poll for six straight weeks and has been ranked in the top 10 in the past two polls.
- The Cavaliers received votes in the first three AP polls, snapping a streak of 64 consecutive weeks in the AP rankings since Feb. 3, 2014.
- UVA was ranked in the top 10 in the preseason polls from 2014-16.

#### THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Virginia is 159-40 (.799), including a 9-0 mark in 2017-18, in 12 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- UVA has an 11-game home win streak dating back to last year.
- The Cavaliers finished undefeated at home (15-0) in 2015-16.
- UVA is 121-24 (.834), including an 85-9 (.904) mark the past six seasons, at home under head coach Tony Bennett.
- Virginia is 42-4 in ACC home games over the past six seasons.
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for eight straight seasons.

#### **ZAY PAVES THE WAY**

- Senior forward Isaiah Wilkins is one of the top utility players in college basketball.
- Wilkins has averaged 7.3 points, 7.5 rebounds, 1.9 assists, 1.4 blocked shots and 1.3 steals in 2017-18.
- Wilkins was named the MVP of the NIT Season Tip-Off after scoring a career-high 19 points against Rhode Island (11/24/17) and blocking four shots and scoring eight points against Vanderbilt (11/23/17).
- He tallied eight points, eight rebounds, two assists, one steal and took a team-high three charges at VCU (11/17/17).
- Wilkins added 14 points, six rebounds and three steals vs. Lehigh (12/2/17).
- Wilkins ranks sixth at UVA with 110 career blocked shots.
- In 2016-17, the All-ACC Defensive team honoree led the team in rebounding (6.0 rpg), blocked shots (43) and steals (33), becoming the first Cavalier since Travis Watson in 2002-03 to lead the team in those three categories.

#### **HALL OF A PLAYER**

- Redshirt senior Devon Hall is averaging a career-best 11.5 points, 3.9 rebounds and 2.8 assists.
- Hall is shooting 46.4 percent from the floor, 43.9 percent from 3-point range and 88.2 percent from the free throw line.
- He scored a career-high 20 points vs. Davidson and 19 points against UNCG (11/10/17) and West Virginia (12/5/17).
- Hall, who has started 67 consecutive games dating back to 2015-16, has scored in double figures in 26 career games.
- In 2016-17, Hall averaged 8.4 points and 4.4 rebounds.
- He was named to the 2016-17 All-ACC Academic Team after earning his degree in media studies and is currently enrolled in the Professional Development Program at the Curry School of Education.

#### **THIS GUY GETS BUCKETS**

- Sophomore Kyle Guy is having a breakout season for Virginia.
- Guy leads Virginia in scoring (15.7 ppg) and made 3-pointers per game (2.85).
- Guy's scored a career-high 29 points at VCU (11/17/17) and has led the Cavaliers in scoring in seven contests.
- Guy has scored 11 or more points in 11 games this season.
- Guy is shooting 47.8 percent (88 of 184) from 3-point range during his two-year career and has made five or more 3-pointers in six games.
- Guy needs 12 more 3-pointers to qualify for UVA's career 3-point percentage record set at 42.1 percent set by Keith Freel (107 3 pointers from 2000-01).
- Guy has scored 10+ points in 21 career games, including a pair of 20-point efforts last season against Pitt and Grambling State .

#### THE ELECTRIC 70s AND AWESOME 80s

- Virginia has scored 70 or more points in eight games and is 103-6 when scoring at least 70 points under Tony Bennett and is 97-78 when scoring under 70 points under Bennett.
- UVA has scored 80 or more points in three games and is 26-1 under Bennett when scoring 80 or more. UVA's lone loss under Bennett when scoring 80 or more was a 93-81 loss at UNC in 2012-13.

#### **HOLDING FOES UNDER 50**

- Virginia is 70-2 when holding opponents under 50 points in the Tony Bennett era (6-0 in 2017-18).
- Bennett-coached teams are 95-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points (25-1 in three years at Washington State).
- UVA held Wisconsin under 40 points and is 19-0 under Bennett when limiting foes to 40 or fewer points.

#### **RECORDS WATCH**

- Senior forward Isaiah Wilkins ranks sixth on UVA's career blocked shots list with 110.
- Wilkins needs three blocked shots to pass Jason Clark (112 blocks, 2002-05) for fifth on the list.

#### **GUY AND WILKINS AMONG ACC LEADERS**

- As of Jan. 2, Kyle Guy ranks third in the ACC in 3-pointers per game (2.85) and 3-point percentage (45.7%) and 11th in scoring (15.7
- Isaiah Wilkins ranks 12th in the ACC in rebounding (7.5 rpg).

#### **ABOUT THE 2017-18 SCHEDULE**

- Six of Virginia's opponents are ranked in the latest AP Top-25 poll (Duke, West Virginia, North Carolina, Miami, Florida State and Clemson), while Notre Dame, Syracuse, Rhode Island and NC State) received votes.
- The Cavaliers will play 17 games against 2017 NCAA Tournament teams: home games against North Carolina, Notre Dame, Louisville, Virginia Tech and Wisconsin; road contests at Duke, North Carolina, West Virginia, Louisville, Florida State, Wake Forest and VCU; and neutral-site tilts against Vanderbilt and either Seton Hall or Rhode Island in the NIT Season Tip-Off in Brooklyn, N.Y.
- Four opponents (Clemson, Georgia Tech, Monmouth, UNC Greensboro and Syracuse) participated in the 2017 National Invitation Tournament.

#### **CAVALIERS INK CLARK AND STATTMANN**

- Virginia signed guards Kihei Clark (Woodland Hills, Calif./Taft Charter High School) and Kody Stattmann (Bentley Park, Queensland, Australia/St. Augustine's College) to National Letters of Intent.
- The 5-9, 155-pound Clark averaged 18.9 points, 7.1 assists and 4.2 rebounds for Taft Charter High School as a junior in 2016-17.
- The 6-7, 178-pound Stattmann averaged 31 points to lead the Australian U17 Emus Men's Basketball Team to a gold medal at the FIBA Oceania Championships in Guam.

#### **UVA VS. RANKED OPPONENTS**

- UVA is 26-31 against ranked opponents in the Tony Bennett era, including an 0-1 record this season (West Virginia).
- The Cavaliers are 141-327 vs. ranked opponents since 1953-54.
- UVA will face current ranked foes Duke, Miami, North Carolina and Florida State later this season.
- UVA is 1-29 all-time vs. No. 1-ranked opponents (86-73 win vs. No. 1 North Carolina on Jan. 30, 1986).

#### **VIRGINIA PICKED 6TH IN THE ACC**

- Virginia was picked to finish sixth in the ACC preseason poll.
- The Cavaliers, who were picked third and finished tied for fifth last season, have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in eight of the last nine seasons.
- Duke is the preseason favorite, followed by North Carolina, Notre Dame, Miami, Louisville, Virginia, Virginia Tech, Florida State, Georgia Tech, Syracuse, Wake Forest, NC State, Clemson, Boston College and Pittsburgh.

#### **CAVALIERS IN THE NBA**

- Justin Anderson (Philadelphia), Malcolm Brogdon (Milwaukee), Joe Harris (Brooklyn), Mike Scott (Washington) and London Perrantes (Cleveland) are former Cavaliers playing in the NBA this season.
- Brodgon earned 2017 NBA Rookie of the Year honors .
- Scott is in his sixth season (first with Washington) and Harris is in his fourth NBA season (second with Brooklyn), while Anderson is in his third season (second with Philadelphia).
- Perrantes signed a two-way contract with Cleveland and made his NBA debut vs. Atlanta on Dec. 12.
- In addition, Dallas head coach Rick Carlisle is a Virginia alum who helped the Cavaliers to their last NCAA Final Four in 1984. Carlisle gained his 700th NBA victory on Dec. 2.
