### FOR OPENERS

- Virginia meets Florida State for the lone regular-season meeting between the teams in 2015-16.
- UVA has a five-game winning streak against the Seminoles, including a 62-50 win in Tallahassee to open the 2013-14 ACC season.
- As of Jan. 15, UVA is tied for 8th in the ACC at 2-2 and FSU is tied for 10th at 1-3.
- As of Jan. 14, UVA ranks 10th nationally in scoring defense (60.7 ppg), 11th in field goal percentage (49.8%), 13th in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.62), 21st in free throw percentage (75.1%) and 23rd in 3-point field goal percentage (39.7%).

### ALL-TIME AGAINST FLORIDA STATE

- Virginia is 23-22 all-time vs. Florida State, including a pair of wins last season, in the series that dates back to 1991-92.
- In 2014-15, UVA defeated Florida State 51-41 in Charlottesville and 58-44 in the quarterfinals of the ACC Tournament.
- Virginia has won six of the last seven meetings between the teams, including a three-game winning streak at John Paul Jones Arena.
- Head coach Tony Bennett is 6-5 all-time vs. Florida State.
- Malcolm Brogdon is Virginia's current career leading scorer against Florida State, averaging 10.5 points in six career games.
- Anthony Gill is averaging 9.6 points and 5.8 rebounds in five career games against the Seminoles.

### SECONDS ANYONE?

- Virginia has played its best basketball during the second half of games this season.
- The Cavaliers have scored more points in the second half than the first half in 14 of 16 games.
- UVA is averaging 41.4 points in the second half and 31.8 points in the first stanza.
- UVA is shooting 56.6 percent on its second-half shots, including 50 percent from 3-point range, but only 43.4 percent on its first-half shots and 28.4 percent from 3-point range.

### LAST TIME VS. FLORIDA STATE

- Evan Nolte scored 11 points, including a trio of 3-pointers, as No. 1 seed Virginia topped No. 9 seed Florida State 58-44 in ACC Tournament quarterfinal action on March 12, 2015.
- Mike Tobey added 11 points and six rebounds, and Malcolm Brogdon added 10 points and a 6-6 effort from the charity stripe.
- Xavier Rathan-Mayes led the Seminoles with 13 points on 6-18 shooting from the floor.
- The Cavaliers started 6-6 from the floor en route to a 34-17 halftime lead.
- Florida State cut the margin to 44-39 in the second half, but Virginia outscored the Seminoles 14-5 in the last 7:06 to secure the win.

### LAST TIME OUT

- Malcolm Brogdon led four players in double figures with 20 points as No. 13 Virginia beat No. 8 Miami 66-58 on Jan. 12.
- Anthony Gill added 15 points, London Perrantes had 12 and Mike Tobey added 12 as Virginia snapped a two-game losing streak.
- Angel Rodriguez scored 17 points to lead Miami and Sheldon McClellan added 13.
- UVA shot 61.1 percent from the field and 82 percent (15-17) from the charity stripe in the second half.
- Gill had a game-high eight rebounds as UVA enjoyed a 35-27 rebounding advantage.
- Miami was 6-22 (27.3%) from 3-point range and 10-17 (58.8%) from the free throw line in the loss.

### VIRGINIA WARMING UP TO SUNSHINE STATE

- UVA has a two-game winning streak in the state of Florida after suffering a 17-game losing streak in the Sunshine State.
- UVA followed up its 62-50 win at Florida State in 2014 with an 89-80 double overtime win at Miami in 2015.
- UVA is 2-17 in its last 19 games in the state of Florida (1-10 at Florida State, 1-5 at Miami, 0-1 at South Florida and 0-1 in the ACC Tournament in Tampa).

**VIRGINIA RANKED NOS. 13 AND 11 IN LATEST POLLS**

- UVA is ranked No. 13 in the latest Associated Press poll and No. 11 in the USA Today Coaches' poll.
- UVA had been ranked in the top 10 in six consecutive polls.
- UVA was ranked in the top 10 in 25 consecutive AP polls from March 3, 2014 to Nov. 16, 2015, its longest span since 49 straight from 1980-83.
- The Cavaliers' No. 6 preseason ranking was UVA's best since a No. 1 ranking to start the 1982-83 season.
- Virginia has been ranked in the preseason top-10 in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 1981-82 and 1982-83.

**VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT**

- Head coach Tony Bennett sports a 149-67 mark in seven seasons at Virginia and 218-100 career mark in 10 seasons.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett was also named ACC Coach of the Year, NABC District 2 Coach of the Year and USBWA District 3 Coach of the Year for the second consecutive year.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons for the first time in school history.
- In 2013-14, Bennett guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship (first since 1976) in the same season for the first time in school history.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to four consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014 and 2015, and NIT in 2013).
- Bennett-coached teams are 76-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 10-year coaching career.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense three times (2008-09, 2013-14 & 2014-15), and finished in the top five nationally in six of nine seasons.
- Bennett is one of 26 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- UVA is 79-24 (.767) in non-conference action and 93-20 (.823) at home under Tony Bennett.

**VIRGINIA BASKETBALL GETTING OFFENSIVE**

- Virginia is averaging 73.9 points per game, its most since 76.8 ppg in 2007-08.
- As of Jan. 14, UVA ranks No. 6 in the KenPom.com overall and adjusted offensive efficiency ratings.
- UVA is shooting 49.8 percent from the field (best since 50.1% in 1985-86), 39.7 percent from 3-point range (best in school history) and 75.1 percent from the free throw line (best since 76.2% in 1978-79).
- Virginia has scored 80 or more points in six games, its most since 11 in 2007-08.
- UVA's 86 points against Villanova were its most scored against a top-25 opponent since tallying 87 in a road win at Minnesota in 2010-11.
- UVA has shot 55 percent or better in six games in 2015-16 after achieving the feat three times in 34 games in 2014-15 and four times in 37 games in 2013-14.
- The Cavaliers scored 82 or more points in three straight games (Nov. 19-22 at Charleston Classic) for the first time since the first three games of the 2001-02 season.
- UVA has shot 50 percent or better from 3-point range in five games.

**'HOO ARE THESE WAHOOS?**

- All-America candidate Malcolm Brogdon leads UVA in scoring for the third consecutive season at a career-best 17 points per game, while Anthony Gill is averaging a career high 15.1 points.
- Brogdon has seven 20-point efforts, including a career-high 28 at George Washington, marking the most by a UVA player in a season since Joe Harris had nine 20-point games in 2012-13.
- Gill has reached double figures in scoring in all 16 games in 2015-16 and 19 straight dating back to 2014-15.
- London Perrantes is averaging career highs in points (11.6), field goal percentage (50.5%) and 3-point field goal percentage (56.4%).
- UVA has out-rebounded its opponents in 10 of its 13 wins.
- Eight players have each scored 11 or more points in a game.

**ALL-AMERICAN BROGDON LEADS CAVALIERS INTO ACTION**

- Preseason co-ACC Player of the Year Malcolm Brogdon is aiming to become the first UVA player since Sean Singletary (2006-08) to lead UVA in scoring for three straight seasons.
- Brogdon's 17.0 scoring average is the highest for UVA since Mike Scott's 18.0 ppg in 2011-12.
- Brogdon was named a preseason All-American by The Sporting News (1st team), Blue Ribbon Yearbook (1st team), CBSsports.com (2nd team), NBCsports.com (2nd team), Bleacher Report (2nd team), USA Today (3rd team) and Collegensider.com.
- Brogdon and Gonzaga's Kyle Wiltjer are the first consensus All-Americans to return as fifth-year seniors since Vanderbilt's Billy McCaffrey in 1993-94.
- In 2014-15, Brogdon averaged 14.0 points and 3.9 rebounds en route to All-America second-team and All-ACC first-team accolades.
- The two-time All-ACC performer, who was a John Wooden Award finalist last season, ranks 24th on UVA's all-time scoring list with 1,406 points in 115 career games (12.2 career ppg).
- Brogdon ranks second on UVA's career free-throw percentage list at 85.8% (338-for-394).
- Brogdon is a candidate for the 2016 Senior CLASS Award and Wooden Citizen Cup Award.
- Brogdon helped Team USA to a bronze medal at the 2015 Pan American Games in Toronto.
- The redshirt senior earned a degree in history and is pursuing a master's degree in public policy from the Frank Batten School of Leadership and Public Policy.

**LONDON CALLING THE SHOTS**

- Guard London Perrantes is enjoying a breakout season in 2015-16.
- Perrantes has hit double figures in scoring in nine games, including a season-high 22 points (career-best seven 3-pointers) at Virginia Tech.
- Perrantes leads the ACC in 3-point shooting at a career-best 56.4 percent (31-55) and has a career 3.0 assist-to-turnover ratio (347 assists, 114 turnovers) in 82 career games.
- He tallied his second career double-double with 16 points and a career-high 11 assists against George Mason en route to MVP honors at the Charleston Classic.
- Perrantes also tallied 19 points in UVA's win over Villanova.
- He missed the Ohio State and William & Mary contests due to an appendectomy.
- Perrantes averaged 6.4 points and 4.6 assists en route to honorable mention All-ACC honors last season.
- He had a career-high 26 points, including five 3-pointers, at Miami (1/3/15).
- Perrantes earned All-ACC Freshman Team honors in 2013-14.

**GILL THRILLS**

- Preseason All-ACC second-team selection Anthony Gill is averaging career highs in points (15.1), field goal percentage (60.8%).
- Gill leads UVA in rebounding (6.3 rpg) and field goal percentage (60.8%), and has led UVA in scoring in six games.
- Gill is the first UVA player to score in double figures in the first 16 games of a season since Sean Singletary scored 10 or more points in all 33 games during 2007-08.
- Gill earned ACC Player of the Week honors after tallying 20 points and 12 rebounds vs. West Virginia for his fourth career double-double.

## 2015-16 Opponents in Bold

- Gill averaged 11.6 points and 6.5 rebounds en route to All-ACC third-team (media) honors in 2014-15.
- Gill was named to the coaches' All-ACC Defensive Team in 2014-15.
- Gill, who has led UVA in field goal percentage in each of the past two seasons, is shooting 59 percent during his UVA career.
- Gill has amassed 1,190 career points in three seasons at UVA and one at South Carolina (954 at UVA).

## DARIUS SHOWING VARIOUS SKILLS

- Darius Thompson has averaged 7.0 points, 2.1 rebounds, 1.9 assists and a team-leading 1.2 steals in his first season at UVA.
- Thompson is shooting 37 percent (10-27) from 3-point range after shooting 19.5 percent (8-41) from downtown at Tennessee in 2013-14.
- He had a five-game double figure scoring streak from Nov. 25-Dec. 19, and tallied 12 points in four games.
- Thompson sat out as a transfer last season after averaging 2.6 points and 2.4 assists in 37 games at Tennessee in 2013-14.
- Thompson had 12 points, six rebounds, four assists and three steals in his UVA debut as a starter vs. Morgan State.

## HALL OF A SPARK OFF THE BENCH

- Redshirt sophomore guard Devon Hall has earned increased playing time this season for UVA.
- Hall has played in all 16 games this season and is averaging 17.6 minutes after averaging 10.6 minutes in 23 contests last season.
- Hall netted a career-high 13 points vs. Morgan State and drained a career-best four 3-pointers for 12 points vs. Long Beach State.
- Hall had five points, four assists and three rebounds in a solid all-around outing against Notre Dame.

## PERRANTES, GILL AND BROGDON LEAD UVA IN ACC RANKINGS

- As of Jan. 15, London Perrantes ranks first in the ACC in 3-point shooting (56.4%) eighth in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.36), and ninth in assists (4.2 apg) and 3-pointers per game (2.2).
- Malcolm Brogdon ranks seventh in scoring (17 ppg), eighth in free throw shooting (82.1%) and ninth in minutes (32.9 mpg).
- Anthony Gill ranks second in the ACC in field goal shooting (60.8%), 17th rebounding (6.3 rpg) and 18th in scoring (15.1 ppg).

## THE ELECTRIC 70's

- Virginia is 71-4 when scoring at least 70 points under Tony Bennett and 78-63 when scoring under 70 points.

## IN THE 60's

- UVA is 100-14 when scoring at least 60 points and 18-22 when scoring fewer than 60 points over the past five seasons.

## HOLDING FOES UNDER 50

- Virginia is 51-2 when holding opponents under 50 points in the Tony Bennett era.
- UVA is 35-1 over the past four seasons when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points.

## ABOUT THE TWO-GAME LOSING STREAK

- Virginia dropped back-to-back ACC games (Virginia Tech & Georgia Tech) for the first time since March 3-7, 2013 (Boston College and Florida State).
- The two-game losing streak was UVA's first since Dec. 4-7, 2013 (Wisconsin and Green Bay).
- UVA allowed 69 points per game during its two-game losing streak.
- The Cavaliers allowed Virginia Tech and Georgia Tech to shoot 53.1 percent (17-32) from 3-point range.
- UVA was outscored 36-26 in bench points during the streak.

## UVA VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

- UVA is 3-0 vs. ranked opponents, including back-to-back wins over then-No. 14 West Virginia (70-54) and then-No. 12/13 Villanova (86-75).
- UVA added a win over No. 8 Miami (66-58), marking the second straight season the Cavaliers have defeated a trio of top 15 opponents (Notre Dame, North Carolina and Louisville in 2014-15).
- UVA last defeated consecutive top-15 teams in non-league play on Dec. 11 and 16, 1982 – vs. No. 3 Georgetown (68-63) and No. 14 Houston (72-63). The Georgetown game was played at the Capital Centre in Landover, Md., and the Houston game was played in Tokyo, Japan. NBA Hall of Famers Hakeem Olajuwon and Patrick Ewing were the featured opponents in those contests.
- UVA went 4-4 vs. ranked foes in 2014-15, defeating Maryland, Notre Dame, North Carolina and Louisville.
- Virginia is 17-21 against ranked opponents, including a 2-6 mark vs. top-5 foes, in the Tony Bennett era.
- Virginia is 132-316 vs. ranked opponents, including a 25-119 mark against top-5 foes, since 1953-54.
- The Cavaliers are 1-26 vs. No. 1-ranked opponents (86-73 vs. No. 1 North Carolina on Jan. 30, 1986).

- Huff is ranked No. 87 on Scout's 2016 Prospect Ranking list.
- Hunter is a 6-7, 195-pound guard, who averaged 21.6 points, 11.0 rebounds and 5.0 assists during his junior season at Friends' Central.
- Hunter is ranked No. 66 on Rivals' 2016 Prospect Ranking list and No. 77 on ESPN's 2016 Prospect Ranking list.
