#### FOR OPENERS

- Virginia and Wisconsin meet for the first time during the 14th annual ACC/Big Ten Challenge and third overall.
- Virginia head coach Tony Bennett (Green Bay) and sophomore guard Paul Jespersion (Merrill) are Wisconsin natives.
- Bennett starred at Green Bay (1988-92) and coached at Wisconsin for four seasons (1999-2000) under his father, Dick Bennett, Brad Soderberg and current Wisconsin head coach Bo Ryan.
- Virginia is 7-5 all-time in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge.
- The Cavaliers are on a three-game winning streak.

#### LAST TIME OUT

- Virginia beat North Texas, 80-64, in NIT Season Tip-Off consolation action on Nov. 20.
- The Cavaliers landed five players in double figures - Justin Anderson (14), Evan Nolte (13), Teven Jones (13), Joe Harris (12) and Darion Atkins (10).
- Virginia shot season-bests from the floor (58.7%) and three-point line (72.7%) in the win.

#### ALL-TIME IN THE ACC/BIG TEN CHALLENGE

- Virginia has a two-game winning streak in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge.
- UVa is 2-4 on the road during the challenge.
- The ACC won the Commissioner's Cup the first 10 years of the ACC/Big Ten Challenge, but the Big Ten has won the cup the last three years.
- Virginia beat Michigan, 70-58, in the 2011-12 ACC/Big Ten Challenge.

#### ALL-TIME VS. WISCONSIN

- UVa is 1-1 all-time vs. Wisconsin.
- The Cavaliers are playing the Badgers for the first time since the 1999 Top of the

### 2012-13 Opponents in Bold

- Virginia defeated Wisconsin, 86-78, at the Milwaukee Classic during the 1974-75 season in Milwaukee, Wis.

### MORE WISCONSIN TIES

- Virginia graduate manager Mark Vershaw played collegiately at Wisconsin from 1997-2001 for head coaches Dick Bennett and Brad Soderberg.
- Vershaw was the leading scorer on the Badgers' 2000 Final Four squad.
- Brad Soderberg is the older brother of Kurt Soderberg, who was Paul Jespersen's coach at Merrill High School in Merrill, Wis.
- Freshman forward Evan Nolte was born in Milwaukee, Wis.

### SHOOTING TO A THREE-GAME WINNING STREAK

- UVa is shooting 52.3 percent from the floor, 48.8 percent from the three-point line and 84.7 percent from the free throw line during its three-game winning streak.
- UVa is averaging 73.3 points per game and allowing 50.3 points per game during the streak.
- The Cavaliers are limiting opponents to 31.3 percent shooting from the floor and 25 percent from the three-point line during the streak.

### ON THE ROAD

- UVa is 0-1 on the road this season and 13-19 on the road in four years under head coach Tony Bennett.
- UVa went 7-4 on the road last season and the seven road wins were the most since 1986-87.

### HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett has posted a 57-43 mark in four seasons at UVa.
- Bennett is 36-16 vs. nonconference opponents at Virginia.
- Bennett has a 126-76 career record, including a 69-33 record at Washington State, in seven seasons of collegiate coaching.
- Bennett guided the Cavaliers to their first NCAA Tournament since 2007 last season with a 22-10 record, and UVa's 22 wins were the most since 25 in 1994-95.
- UVa's nine ACC wins in 2011-12 were its most since 11 in 2006-07.
- Bennett is one of 18 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.

### NO ORDINARY JOE

- Joe Harris is averaging a career-high 15 points, 4.5 rebounds and 1.8 assists per game this season.
- Harris led UVa with 19 points at George Mason, 15 points vs. Fairfield, 20 vs. Delaware and 17 vs. Lamar.
- Harris has led the team in scoring 16 times and scored in double figures 42 times in 69 career games at Virginia.
- Harris is also shooting a career-high 51.9 percent (14-27) from three-point range.
- He ranks 12th in the ACC in scoring.

### AKIL HAS A FEEL

- Akil Mitchell is averaging career highs in points (11.7) and rebounds (9.3).
- Mitchell posted back-to-back double-doubles vs. Delaware (11/13) and Seattle (11/17) for the first time in his career.
- He had 15 points and 13 rebounds vs. Delaware (11/13) and 14 points and 16 rebounds vs. Seattle (11/17).
- Mitchell established a new career high in scoring in each of the first three games.
- Mitchell has led UVa in rebounds in four games.

**YOUTH MOVEMENT**

- Five Virginia freshmen (Justin Anderson, Taylor Barnette, Teven Jones, Evan Nolte and Mike Tobey) have started at least one game this season.
- Jones leads the newcomers in scoring at 7.7 points per game, followed by Nolte (7.5), Anderson (6.8), Tobey (6.5) and Barnette (2.5).
- Anderson leads the team in assists at 3.1 per game, while Nolte leads the team in steals at 1.8 per game.
- UVa started three freshmen (Anderson, Tobey and Barnette) in its season-opening game vs. George Mason for the first time in school history.
- Nolte and Jones have started the past two games.

**EVANS AND BROGDON HAVE BEEN MISSED**

- Senior guard Jontel Evans, an ACC All-Defensive Team member last season, has missed five of Virginia's first six games due to a foot injury.
- Sophomore Malcolm Brogdon has missed all six games with a foot injury.
- Evans tallied 7.3 points and 3.9 assists per game last season, while Brogdon averaged 6.7 points and 2.8 rebounds per game.

**CLEANING THE GLASS**

- Virginia, who is averaging 32.8 rebounds per game, has outrebounded its opponents in five of six games.
- The Cavaliers have grabbed nine or more offensive rebounds in five of six games.
- Akil Mitchell leads Virginia in offensive rebounds (20), defensive rebounds (36) and total rebounds (56).
- Mitchell ranks fourth in the ACC in rebounding at 9.3 per game.

**LONG RANGE BOMBERS**

- The Cavaliers set a John Paul Jones Arena team record for three-point shooting percentage in a game by drilling 8-of-11 shots beyond the arc vs. North Texas (11/20/12).
- Virginia has made six or more three-pointers in four of six games.
- Joe Harris ranks third in the ACC in 3-point field goal percentage at 51.9 percent (14-27), while Evan Nolte is shooting 47.4 percent (9-19).

**PERRANTES AND HALL SIGN WITH VIRGINIA**

- Virginia signed standout guards London Perrantes (Woodland Hills, Calif.) and Devon Hall (Virginia Beach, Va.) to National Letters of Intent on Nov. 14.
- Perrantes is ranked No. 86 on ESPN's Top 100 recruiting list for 2013, while Hall is ranked No. 77 on Rivals.com's Prospect Ranking list.

**THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME AT JPJ**

- Virginia is 76-32 (.704) in seven seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- The Cavs are 4-1 this season at JPJ after posting a 13-3 record last season.
- Virginia is 39-16 (.710) at home under head coach Tony Bennett.

**NOTE WORTHY**

- The Cavs rank 13th in the nation in scoring defense at 53 points per games.
- UVa has used five starting lineups this season.
- Joe Harris and Akil Mitchell have started every game.
- UVa is 4-0 when shooting 70 percent or better from the free throw line.
- The Cavs are 4-0 when limiting opponents to less than 50 percent shooting from the field.

**HOLDING FOES UNDER 50**

- Virginia is 3-0 this season when holding opponents under 50 points.
- Virginia is 20-1 when holding opponents under 50 points in the Tony Bennett era.
- Last season, Virginia set an ACC record during the shot clock era by holding 11

Credentials that can't be mailed will be held for pickup at the will call window at John Paul Jones Arena. You must have a press pass to be admitted to the media area and the press room.

**PHOTO CREDENTIALS**

All photographers and camera operators must wear a visible credential issued by the Virginia athletics media relations office. Photographers work from the baselines at both ends of the court at John Paul Jones Arena. Live television is given top priority for courtside space.

**PRESS PARKING**

Press parking passes are provided upon request on a limited basis. If you need a parking pass, please be sure to inform the UVa athletics media relations office when making your press or photo credential request.

**INTERVIEWS**

All requests for interviews with Virginia basketball coaches and players should be made through Erich Bacher in the athletics media relations office. It is requested you allow the athletics media relations staff at least one day, preferably longer, to arrange an interview.

**POSTGAME INTERVIEWS**

Virginia head coach Tony Bennett and the visiting head coach will meet with media representatives in the press room after each game at John Paul Jones Arena. The first coach will be available in the press room approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the game and the second coach will be in the press room approximately 20 minutes after the game. Virginia players will be available in the team meeting room adjacent to the men's basketball locker room after home games.

**RADIO**

Each visiting school is allowed one free radio broadcast from John Paul Jones Arena. The Virginia athletics media relations office provides two ISDN lines and three business touchtone lines for use by the visiting broadcast crew. Radio network crews work from a courtside location at the scorer's table. Three seats are available at the table and one seat behind the visitor's broadcast location.

**GAME SERVICES**

Information packets are available before each game at John Paul Jones Arena, and a full statistical summary and play-by-play sheets are distributed at halftime and after the game. Quotes from both coaches and two or three players from each team will be available at the conclusion of the game. A pregame meal is served for working members of the media in the press room on the event level of John Paul Jones Arena.

**TELEPHONES/WIRELESS**

The Virginia athletics media relations office will have a limited number of telephones available for postgame reporting. Should you require your own telephone for game coverage, please contact Darlene Craig or Jim Daves in the Virginia athletics media relations office. A wireless network is available at John Paul Jones Arena for visiting media. A UVa media relations representative will provide login directions.

- The 11 games of holding opponents under 50 points were the most for the Cavaliers in a season since holding 16 opponents under 50 points in 1945-46.

### **70 IS A MAGIC NUMBER**

- Virginia is 27-2 when scoring at least 70 points under Tony Bennett.
- The Cavaliers are 30-41 over the past four seasons when scoring under 70 points.

### **60 IS THE NEW 70**

- UVa is 3-0 when scoring at least 60 points and 1-2 when scoring under 60 points.
- Last season, Virginia was 18-2 when scoring at least 60 points and 4-8 when scoring under 60 points.

### **VIRGINIA PICKED 7TH IN THE ACC**

- Virginia was selected seventh in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball.
- The Cavaliers, who were picked fourth and finished fourth last season, have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in each of the last four seasons.
- NC State is the preseason favorite, followed by Duke, North Carolina, Florida State, Miami, Maryland, Virginia, Clemson, Georgia Tech, Virginia Tech, Wake Forest and Boston College.

### **ABOUT THE 2012-13 SCHEDULE**

- Five of Virginia's opponents were ranked in the preseason polls (NC State, Duke, North Carolina, Wisconsin and Florida State), while another two received votes (Tennessee and Miami, Fla.).
- Six opponents earned 2012 NCAA Tournament berths, while three participated in the College Basketball Invitational and two in the National Invitation Tournament.

### **EUROPEAN TOUR RECAP**

- The Cavaliers posted a 2-3 mark during their five-game European Tour this past August.
- UVa competed against teams from the Netherlands, Belgium and France. Joe Harris led Virginia in scoring in Europe, averaging 15.6 points per game, while Akil Mitchell averaged 13.4 ppg, Mike Tobey 11.2 ppg and Jontel Evans 9.6 ppg. • Evans averaged 7.8 assists per games, while Mitchell was UVa's top rebounder, pulling down 50 boards in the five games.

### **SCOTT WILL BE TOUGH TO REPLACE**

- UVa will miss the 2011-12 third-team All-American Mike Scott, who is now a member of the NBA's Atlanta Hawks.
- Scott, who led Virginia in scoring and rebounding last season, was the first Cavalier to earn All-America honors since Ralph Sampson in 1983.
- Scott totaled 1,538 points and 944 rebounds in 130 career games at UVa.

### **ON THE AIR THIS SEASON**

- Most all of Virginia's games this season will be broadcast either on television or online this season. The only games that will not be broadcast are the NIT Season Tip-Off consolation games on Nov. 19-20.
- All games will be broadcast on the Virginia Sports Radio Network with David Koehn (play-by-play) and Ted Jeffries (analyst) calling the action.

### **RECORDS WATCH**

- Jontel Evans needs 25 assists and 25 steals to rank 10th on the UVa career lists. Joe Harris needs 27 three-pointers to rank 10th on the all-time career list.

### **ON THE HORIZON**

Virginia hosts Green Bay in nonconference action on Saturday, Dec. 1. Tipoff is set for 4 p.m. at John Paul Jones Arena.
