TONIGHT'S GAME

- Virginia begins a two-game road stretch with a visit to Duke
- The Cavaliers look to win their ACC road opener for the fourth consecutive year
- UVa seeks its first top-10 win since a 68-66 overtime win over No. 8 Duke on Feb. 1, 2007 at John Paul Jones Arena

SERIES HISTORY

- Duke leads 114-48 (Duke leads 49-8 at Cameron Indoor Stadium)
- Virginia has lost 14 consecutive games at Cameron Indoor Stadium, since a 91-88 2OT win over the Blue Devils on Jan. 14, 1995
- Duke has won the last seven overall meetings (UVa's last win in the series was a 68-66 OT win in Charlottesville on Feb. 1, 2007)
- First meeting with both teams ranked since 2001-02
- Duke's two lowest-scoring games of the past three seasons have come against UVa

WINNING STREAKS

- The Cavaliers enter the game on a 12-game winning streak, their longest since a 15-game win streak during the 1981-82 season
- Dating back to last season, Virginia has won five consecutive true road games, its longest road winning streak since winning five straight road games from the end of 1991-92 to the start of 1992-93
- The Cavaliers haven't had a six-game road win streak since 1981-82 (seven games)
- UVa has won its last 10 home games, the second-longest streak at JPJA

STRONG START TO THE SEASON

- The Cavaliers' 14-1 record is their best start to a season since going 27-1 to open the 1981-82 season
- Virginia won 13 non-conference regular-season games this season, its most since winning 14 non-conference regular-season games in 1990-91

2011-12 Opponents in Bold

LAST TIME OUT

- Virginia opened ACC play with a 52-51 win over Miami on Jan. 7 at JPJA
- It is the fourth consecutive year the Cavaliers won their ACC opener (only Duke has a longer active streak - five)
- Mike Scott led Virginia with 23 points and eight rebounds

'HOOS RANKED

- Virginia is ranked No. 16 in The Associated Press Top 25, its highest AP ranking since February 11, 2002 (No. 15)
- It marks the first time Virginia has been in the AP poll in four consecutive weeks since December 2004
- UVa is ranked No. 17 in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches poll, its highest coaches poll ranking since February 18, 2002 (No. 15)

RANKED MATCHUP

- Virginia is playing a game in which both teams are ranked in the AP poll for the first time since Jan. 2, 2005 (No. 25 Virginia lost 89-70 to No. 5 Wake Forest at U-Hall)
- UVa is playing a game in which both teams are ranked in the AP top-20 for the first time since Feb. 17, 2002 (No. 15 Virginia lost 92-70 at No. 19 Wake Forest)
- Virginia and Duke are playing with both teams ranked for the first time since Jan. 27, 2002 (No. 1 Duke defeated No. 7 Virginia 94-81 at Cameron Indoor Stadium)

AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS

- Virginia is playing its second ranked opponent of the season
- The Cavaliers defeated No. 14 Michigan 70-58 on Nov. 29 in Charlottesville
- UVa is 5-6 against teams ranked in the AP poll in the Tony Bennett era
- Virginia last won at a ranked opponent on Nov. 29, 2010, defeating No. 15 Minnesota 87-79
- UVa seeks its first top-10 win since a 68-66 overtime win over No. 8 Duke on Feb. 1, 2007 at John Paul Jones Arena
- The Cavaliers' last road win at a top-10 opponent was on Feb. 6, 2003, an 86-78 win at No. 8 Maryland

CAVALIERS GET DEFENSIVE

- Virginia is second in the nation in scoring defense at 50.5 ppg (as of 1/10)
- UVa ranks second nationally in points allowed per possession (0.82) and 18th nationally in field goal percentage defense (38.0%)
- Virginia leads the nation in fewest assists/game allowed (6.7) and ranks second nationally in opponents' assist-to-turnover ratio (0.48)
- The Cavaliers held each of their first 10 opponents under 60 points, their longest streak since 17 straight games from the end of the 1947-48 season (last eight games) to the start of the 1948-49 season (first nine games)
- It is the third-longest streak in ACC history (longest in the shot clock era)
- UVa has held six opponents to under 50 points, a feat it has done 13 times in the Tony Bennett era
- Virginia held Drexel to 35 points, the second lowest scoring total by a UVa opponent in the shot clock era
- South Carolina State's 25.5% shooting (13-51) was the lowest percentage allowed by UVa since Liberty shot 22.6% (12-53) against UVa in the 2005-06 season opener
- Virginia has held three opponents under 30% shooting this season (only accomplished the feat twice in the previous three seasons combined)
- It is the first time UVa has held multiple opponents under 30% shooting in the same season since 2005-06 (three times)

70 IS A MAGIC NUMBER

- Under Tony Bennett, Virginia is 22-2 when scoring at least 70 points
- The Cavaliers are 23-30 over the past three seasons when scoring under 70 points

ROAD WARRIORS

- Dating back to last season, Virginia has won five consecutive true road games
- It is the Cavaliers' longest road winning streak since winning five straight road games from the end of 1991-92 to the start of 1992-93
- The Cavaliers haven't had a six-game road win streak since 1981-82 (seven games)
- Virginia won three non-conference road games in a season for the first time since 2000-01

ONE AND DONE...

- Virginia ranks fourth nationally in defensive rebounding percentage at 75.9%
- The Cavaliers have allowed points on just 42.0 percent of their opponents' possessions this season (third nationally)
- Opponents are averaging 6.7 second chance points a game this season
- UVa has held 13 of 15 opponents to single digit second chance points

SCOTT NAMED ACC PLAYER OF THE WEEK THREE TIMES

- Mike Scott leads the league with three ACC Player of the Week awards this season
- He joins Barry Parkhill (1971-72), Ralph Sampson (1982-83), Bryant Stith (1989-90) and Norman Nolan (1997-98) as the only Cavaliers to be named ACC Player of the Week three times in a season
- Scott was named ACC Player of the Week on Dec. 19, Dec. 26 and Jan. 9
- With his awards on Dec. 19 and Dec. 26 he became the first Cavalier to be honored in consecutive weeks since Sean Singletary in January 2007

MIKE SCOTT DOMINATES IN SEATTLE

- Mike Scott had a career-high 33 points (12-14 FG), along with 14 rebounds, in Virginia's 83-77 win at Seattle University on Dec. 21
- Scott's 33 points were the most by a Cavalier since Sean Singletary scored 41 points at Miami on Mar. 1, 2008
- Scott's 33 points are the most by an ACC player this season
- Scott is the first ACC player with at least 33 pts and at least 14 rebs in a game since Florida State's Al Thornton (37 pts, 15 rebs) at Duke on Feb. 4, 2006
- Scott's 19 points in the first half were the most in a half by a Cavalier since Sylven Landesberg had 26 second half points vs. Boston College (Feb. 4, 2009) and the most in a first half since Sean Singletary had 23 first half points vs. Virginia Tech (Jan. 26, 2008)

SCOTT NAMED PRESEASON ALL-ACC

- Senior forward Mike Scott was one of six players named to the preseason All-ACC team at ACC Operation Basketball
- He is the first Cavalier selected as preseason All-ACC since Sean Singletary in 2007-08

SCOTT DOUBLING IT UP

- Mike Scott enters the game with 29 career double-doubles (T-3rd in UVa history)
- He has five double-doubles this season
- His 29 career double-doubles lead all active ACC players
- Scott has two "20-10" games this season (six in his career)

SCOTT LEADS THE ACC

- Mike Scott is the ACC active leader in points (1,210), rebounds (813) and double-doubles (29)

SCOTT JOINS 1,000 POINT CLUB

- Mike Scott became the 43rd Cavalier to score 1,000 career points, reaching the milestone against TCU in the Virgin Islands
- He enters the game with 1,210 career points, 32nd in Virginia history

RETURN TO SENE-DER

- Assane Sene ranks seventh in school history with 107 career blocks
- He led the Cavaliers last season with 39 blocks

ZEGLINSKI FROM LONG RANGE

- Sammy Zeglinski enters the game with 172 career 3-pointers, which ranks sixth in school history
- He has made at least three 3-pointers in seven of 13 games this season, including four games with four 3-pointers
- Zeglinski is third in the ACC in 3-point percentage at 41.9%

EVANS SHINES AGAINST WINTHROP

- Jontel Evans scored a career-high 17 points against Winthrop
- He was 5-6 from the field, made a career-high two 3-pointers, and went 5-5 from the free throw line
- His previous career high was 11 points

ACC LEADERS

- Mike Scott leads the ACC in field goal percentage (.596)
- Scott ranks fifth in rebounding (8.9) and fifth in scoring (16.5)
- Scott is the only player to rank in the top five in the ACC in both scoring and rebounding
- Joe Harris ranks seventh in free throw percentage (.824) and 20th in scoring (12.3)
- Sammy Zeglinski ranks third in 3-point percentage (.419) and sixth in steals (1.7)
- Jontel Evans ranks T-5th in assists (3.5) and T-3rd in steals (1.7)

THEY CALL THEM FREE THROWS FOR A REASON

- UVa set a school record by going 19-for-19 from the free throw line against Winthrop
- The previous school record was 16-for-16 against South Carolina on Jan. 8, 1965
- It was the best free throw performance by an ACC team since Wake Forest shot an ACC-record 32-for-32 against North Carolina in 2005

CONSISTENT LINEUP

- Virginia has had the same starting lineup (Scott, Sene, Evans, Harris, Zeglinski) the past 10 games and has used just two different starting lineups this season
- If the Cavaliers use the same lineup tonight, it will mark the first time since 1993-94 that they have used just two lineups through the first 16 games of a season

COMEBACK CAVS

- Virginia rallied from halftime deficits to win at both Oregon and Seattle
- It marked the first time the Cavaliers won consecutive games when trailing at the half since 2009-10 (at NC State, vs. Georgia Tech)
- It marked the first time Virginia won consecutive games (both on the road) when trailing at the half since 1990-91 (at Minnesota, at Marquette)

AT JOHN PAUL JONES ARENA

- Virginia is 69-28 all-time at John Paul Jones Arena
- The Cavaliers went 11-6 at home last season
- Virginia is 9-0 at home this season
- UVa has won its last 10 home games, the second-longest streak at JPJA
- This season the Cavaliers went undefeated at home in non-conference regular-season games (8-0) for the first time since the 2004-05 season

CAVALIERS TOP MICHIGAN

- UVa's 70-58 win over No. 14 Michigan was its highest ranked win of the Bennett era
- It was the Cavaliers' first double-digit win over a top-15 opponent since a 72-58 win over No. 11 Boston College on Feb. 21, 2006 at University Hall

VIRGINIA PICKED FOURTH IN ACC

- Virginia was selected fourth in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball
- It was the highest the Cavaliers were picked in the poll since 2001-02, when they were picked to finish third
- UVa has finished higher than its place in the preseason poll in each of the last three seasons
- North Carolina was the preseason favorite, followed by Duke, Florida State, Virginia, Miami, Virginia Tech, Clemson, NC State, Maryland, Georgia Tech, Wake Forest and Boston College

HARRELL AND JOHNSON DECIDE TO TRANSFER

- Sophomore guard KT Harrell (Dec. 23) and redshirt freshman forward James Johnson (Dec. 24) announced they were transferring
- Harrell appeared in 11 games (starting five) and averaged 4.7 ppg this season
- Johnson appeared in six games and averaged 1.5 ppg this season

FOUR SIGN WITH VIRGINIA

- UVa signed four players to National Letters of Intent for the 2012 recruiting class
- The four players are 6-6 wing Justin Anderson of Spotsylvania, Va.; 6-0 guard Teven Jones of Kannapolis, N.C.; 6-8 forward Evan Nolte of Alpharetta, Ga.; and 6-11 post player Mike Tobey of Monroe, N.Y.

- Virginia has a week off before visiting Georgia Tech on Feb. 19
- Game time at Philips Arena is 8 p.m., and the game will be broadcast on the ACC Network (split telecast)


