### FOR OPENERS

- Virginia meets Wisconsin for the third time in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge.
- UVA head coach Tony Bennett (Green Bay) is a Wisconsin native, who starred at Green Bay (1988-92) and coached at Wisconsin for four seasons (1999-2003) under his father, Dick Bennett, current UVA assistant coach Brad Soderberg and former Wisconsin head coach Bo Ryan.
- Bennett and Wisconsin head coach Greg Gard served as assistant coaches under Ryan at Wisconsin from 2001-03.
- UVA has started 6-0 for the second straight season and is 106-33 (.763) in non-conference action under Tony Bennett.
- UVA has captured championships in each of its last five Thanksgiving holiday tournaments (NIT Season Tip-Off, Emerald Coast Classic, Charleston Classic, Barclays Center Classic and Corpus Christi Challenge).

### LAST TIME VS. THE BADGERS

- Virginia dropped a 48-38 decision to then-No. 8 Wisconsin during the Big Ten/ACC Challenge on Dec. 4, 2013 at John Paul Jones Arena.
- The Cavaliers shot 23.4 percent (11-of-47) from the field, marking the fourth lowest percentage in school history.
- Virginia's 38 points were its lowest during the Tony Bennett era and second fewest during the shot clock era (since 1986).
- London Perrantes led Virginia with eight points, while Josh Gasser had a game-high 11 points for Wisconsin.
- The Cavaliers shot 78.9 percent (15-of-19) from the free throw line.

### LAST TIME OUT

- Tournament MVP Isaiah Wilkins scored a career-high 19 points to lead Virginia to a 70-55 win over Rhode Island in the NIT Season Tip-Off championship game on Friday, Nov. 24 in Brooklyn, N.Y.
- Devon Hall added 18 points and Nigel Johnson chipped in a season-high 12 points as UVA shot 50 percent (23-46) in the win.
- Wilkins was 7 of 9 from the field and 5 of 6 from the free throw line, topping his career best of 15 points vs. Virginia Tech last season.
- Jack Salt added a game-high eight rebounds as UVA owned a 33-22 advantage on the glass.

### AGAINST THE BIG TEN CONFERENCE

- UVA is 102-129 all-time vs. current Big Ten Conference opponents.
- The Cavaliers meet their lone Big Ten opponent this season and first since battling Ohio State in last year's Challenge.
- UVA defeated Iowa (74-41) and Ohio State (63-61) last year.
- The Cavaliers are 8-5 against Big Ten opponents under head coach Tony Bennett, including wins against Iowa, Maryland, Minnesota, Michigan, Ohio State (2), Rutgers and Wisconsin.

### UVA RANKED NO. 25 IN USA TODAY COACHES' POLL

- UVA received votes in the latest Associated Press regular-season poll and is ranked No. 25 in the USA Today Coaches' poll.
- The Cavaliers received votes in the preseason rankings in both polls, snapping a streak of 64 consecutive weeks in the AP rankings since Feb. 3, 2014.
- UVA was ranked in the top 10 in the preseason rankings in each of the past three seasons (2014-16).

### UVA ALL-TIME IN THE BIG TEN/ACC CHALLENGE

- The Cavaliers have an 11-6 record, including a 6-2 home mark, in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge.
- Virginia has a three-game winning streak in the Challenge, defeating Maryland (2014) and Ohio State (2015 and 2016).
- UVA defeated Ohio State 63-61 in last year's Challenge.
- The ACC leads the Big Ten in the Challenge 11-5-2 in 19 years of competition between the two conferences.
- The ACC captured the Commissioner's Cup last season, winning nine of the 14 matchups.
- The ACC won 10 straight challenges from 1999-2008.

### ALL-TIME VS. WISCONSIN

- UVA is 2-2 all-time vs. Wisconsin, including a 1-1 mark in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge.
- Wisconsin defeated Virginia 48-38 during the 2013 Big Ten/ACC Challenge in the lone meeting between the teams in Charlottesville.
- UVA beat Wisconsin 60-54 during the 2012 Challenge in Madison.
- Wisconsin defeated Virginia 66-56 at the 1999 Top of the World Classic in Fairbanks, Alaska.
- Virginia defeated Wisconsin, 86-78, at the Milwaukee Classic during the 1974-75 season in Milwaukee, Wis.

**VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT**

- Head coach Tony Bennett has a 194-83 (.700) mark in nine seasons at Virginia and 263-116 (.694) career mark in 12 seasons overall.
- Bennett has guided UVA to four straight NCAA Tournament appearances and has led UVA to a school-record five straight seasons with 23 or more wins.
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-record five straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons from 2014-16, eclipsing 88 wins from 1981-83.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to six consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and NIT in 2013).
- In 2015-16, Bennett led UVA to its third consecutive NCAA Tournament and first NCAA Elite Eight appearance since 1995 with 29 wins.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year and ACC Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons (2014-2015) for the first time in school history.
- In 2013-14, Bennett guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship (first since 1976) in the same season.
- Bennett is one of 28 current Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- UVA is 106-33 (.763) in non-conference action, 88-50 (.638) in ACC play and 115-24 (.827) at home under Tony Bennett.

**GETTING DEFENSIVE**

- UVA is allowing 52.3 points per game and has held three of its 2017-18 opponents to fewer than 50 points (UNCG, Austin Peay and Vanderbilt).
- The 52.3 points allowed are the lowest for UVA since it allowed 51.5 ppg in 2014-15.
- The Cavaliers are 67-2 when limiting their opponents to fewer than 50 points under head coach Tony Bennett.
- UVA has held each of its six opponents to less than 50 percent shooting.
- In 2016-17, Virginia led the nation in scoring defense (56.4 ppg) for the third time under Bennett.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense four times (2008-09, 2013-14, 2014-15, 2016-17) and finished in the top-five nationally in eight of 11 seasons.
- Bennett-coached teams are 92-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 12-year coaching career.

**ABOUT THE CAVALIERS**

- UVA is led by tri-captains Devon Hall, Isaiah Wilkins and Jack Salt.
- The announcement of Hall, Wilkins and Salt marked the first time in Bennett's 12-year head coaching career where he officially named team captains.
- UVA has averaged 73.3 points per game (most under Bennett) on offense, while yielding 52.3 ppg (second lowest in school history) on defense.
- UVA has started Ty Jerome, Kyle Guy, Hall, Wilkins and Salt in each of its first six games.
- Guy leads the team in scoring at 15.8 points per game. Guy has scored 13 or more points in five of six games, including a career-high 29 points at VCU (11/17/17).
- Hall has averaged 11.2 points on 50 percent field goal shooting and a team-leading 95.2 percent (20 of 21) from the charity stripe.
- Wilkins, who has averaged 8.8 points and a team-high 6.3 rebounds, leads UVA in field goal percentage (67.7%) and has a team-high eight blocked shots.
- Jerome, who is averaging 8.3 points, leads the team in assists (16) and has a 2.29 assist-to-turnover ratio.
- Salt is averaging 2.8 points and 5.0 rebounds, while graduate transfer Nigel Johnson is averaging 7.3 points after averaging 11.3 points for Rutgers last season.
- Mamadi Diakite (6.7 ppg & 3.7 rpg) and redshirt freshmen De'Andre Hunter (7.0 ppg) and Jay Huff (5.0 ppg) are key contributors off the bench.
- Marco Anthony provides depth and fellow rookie Francesco Badocchi is expected to redshirt the 2017-18 season.

**ZAY PAVES THE WAY**

- Senior forward Isaiah Wilkins is one of the top utility players in college basketball.
- Wilkins has averaged 8.8 points, 6.3 rebounds, 2.0 assists, 1.3 blocked shots and 1.1 steals in 2017-18.
- Wilkins was named the MVP of the NIT Season Tip-Off after scoring a career-high 19 points against Rhode Island (11/24/17) and blocking four shots and scoring eight points against Vanderbilt (11/23/17).
- He tallied eight points, eight rebounds, two assists, one steal and took a team-high three charges at VCU (11/17/17).
- In 2016-17, the All-ACC Defensive team honoree led the team in rebounding (6.0 rpg), blocked shots (43) and steals (33), becoming the first Cavalier since Travis Watson in 2002-03 to lead the team in those three categories.
- Wilkins recorded a pair of double-doubles in 2016-17 (13 points, 11 rebounds and career-high tying five blocks vs. Louisville and 10 points, 10 rebounds and four steals vs. Miami).

**HALL OF A PLAYER**

- Redshirt senior Devon Hall is averaging 11.2 points, 4.3 rebounds and 2.2 assists in 26.8 minutes per game.
- Hall is shooting 50 percent from the floor, 46.7 percent from 3-point range and 95.2 percent (20 of 21) from the free throw line.
- He scored a career-high 19 points against UNCG (11/10/17) and added 18 against Rhode Island (11/24/17).
- In 2016-17, Hall averaged career highs in points (8.4), rebounds (4.4), 3-point percentage (37.2%), free throw percentage (77.6%) and minutes (27.4).
- Hall, who has started 60 consecutive games dating back to last season, has scored in double figures in 23 career games including three games this season.
- He was named to the 2016-17 All-ACC Academic Team after earning his degree in media studies and is currently enrolled in the Professional Development Program at the Curry School of Education.

**THIS GUY GETS BUCKETS**

- Sophomore Kyle Guy is having a breakout season for UVA.
- Guy leads Virginia in scoring (15.8 ppg), steals (1.7 spg) and 3-point percentage (48.3%) and is second in free throw percentage (88.2%).
- Guy's career-high 29 points at VCU (11/17/17) were the most for a Virginia player since Joe Harris' 36 points vs. Duke in 2012-13.
- Guy has scored 13 or more points in five of six games this season.
- Guy is shooting 49.2 percent (65-of-132) from 3-point range during his two-year career and has made five 3-pointers in four games.
- Guy's 7.5 points per game average in his rookie season under head coach Tony Bennett ranked higher than former UVA standouts Malcolm Brogdon (6.7 ppg) and London Perrantes (5.5 ppg).
- Guy has scored 10+ points in 16 games, including a pair of 20-point efforts last season against Pitt (3/8/17) and Grambling State (11/22/16).
- Guy shot a team-high 49.5 percent from 3-point range in 2016-17.

**THE ELECTRIC 70s**

- Virginia is 99-6 when scoring at least 70 points under Tony Bennett and 95-77 when scoring under 70 points.

- Virginia is 67-2 when holding opponents under 50 points in the Tony Bennett era (3-0 in 2017-18).
- Bennett-coached teams are 192-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points (25-1 in three years at Washington State).
- UVA held four opponents (St. Francis Brooklyn, Yale, Grambling State and Robert Morris) under 40 points in 2016-17 and is 18-0 under Bennett when limiting foes to 40 or fewer points.

### ABOUT THE 2017-18 SCHEDULE

- Seven of Virginia's opponents are ranked in the AP Top-25 preseason poll (Duke, North Carolina, Miami, Notre Dame, Louisville, Seton Hall and West Virginia), while Rhode Island received votes.
- The Cavaliers will play 17 games against 2017 NCAA Tournament teams: home games against North Carolina, Notre Dame, Louisville, Virginia Tech and Wisconsin; road contests at Duke, North Carolina, West Virginia, Louisville, Florida State, Wake Forest and VCU; and neutral-site tilts against Vanderbilt and either Seton Hall or Rhode Island in the NIT Season Tip-Off in Brooklyn, N.Y.
- Four opponents (Clemson, Georgia Tech, Monmouth, UNC Greensboro and Syracuse) participated in the 2017 National Invitation Tournament.

### VIRGINIA PICKED 6TH IN THE ACC

- Virginia was picked to finish sixth in the ACC preseason poll.
- The Cavaliers, who were picked third and finished tied for fifth last season, have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in eight seasons of the last nine seasons.
- Duke is the preseason favorite, followed by North Carolina, Notre Dame, Miami, Louisville, Virginia, Virginia Tech, Florida State, Georgia Tech, Syracuse, Wake Forest, NC State, Clemson, Boston College and Pittsburgh.

### UVA VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

- In 2016-17, Virginia was 4-6 vs. ranked opponents, including wins against then-No. 6 Louisville, then-No. 14 Notre Dame, then-No. 4 Louisville and then-No. 5 North Carolina.
- In 2016-17, UVA defeated multiple top-5 opponents in a season for the first time since 2000-01 (No. 4 Tennessee, No. 3 Duke, No. 2 UNC).
- UVA's 61-53 road win at then-No. 6 Louisville marked the Cavaliers' first top-10 road win since 2002-03 (86-78 vs. No. 8 Maryland).
- UVA is 26-30 against ranked opponents in the Tony Bennett era.
- UVA is 141-326 vs. ranked opponents since 1953-54.
- UVA is 1-29 all-time vs. No. 1-ranked opponents (86-73 win vs. No. 1 North Carolina on Jan. 30, 1986).
