FOR OPENERS

- Virginia (7-2) meets Green Bay (4-2) for the third time in the series that started in 2011-12.
- The Cavaliers aim for their straight win against Green Bay and play their first true road game of 2013-14.
- Cavalier head coach Tony Bennett starred for his father, Dick Bennett, at Green Bay from 1988-92 and finished his four-year career as the Mid-Continent Conference's all-time leader in career points (2,285) and assists (601).
- Tony Bennett is a member of the Green Bay Athletics Hall of Fame and his No. 25 jersey was retired by the school on Feb. 18, 1995.
- Bennett is 4-1 vs. teams from the state of Wisconsin as a head coach (1-1 vs. Wisconsin, 2-0 vs. Green Bay, 1-0 vs. Milwaukee)
- UVa is 50-20 against non-conference opponents during Bennett's five seasons.
- The Cavaliers rank second in the nation in scoring defense at 52.9 points per game.
- Virginia is outscoring opponents 262-143 in bench points, averaging 29.1 per game.

ALL-TIME VS. GREEN BAY

- UVa is 2-0 all-time vs. Green Bay, posting home victories in each of the last two seasons.
- Virginia defeated Green Bay, 67-51, last season behind 20 points each from Joe Harris and Akil Mitchell.
- The Cavaliers defeated the Phoenix, 68-42, on Nov. 25, 2011 as Mike Scott tallied 15 points and 10 rebounds to lead UVa.

VIRGINIA RECEIVING VOTES IN LATEST NATIONAL POLLS

- UVa received votes in the latest Associated Press and USA Today Coaches polls.
- Virginia's No. 24 preseason AP ranking marked its first since being ranked No. 11 to start the 2001-02 season.
- The Cavaliers, who were ranked for first two weeks, returned to the rankings this season for the first time since Feb. 27, 2012, when they were No. 24 in the AP poll.

AGAINST THE HORIZON LEAGUE

- Virginia is 3-0 all-time vs. current Horizon League opponents (1-0 vs. Cleveland State and 2-0 vs. Green Bay).

LAST TIME OUT

- Virginia dropped a 48-38 decision to No. 8 Wisconsin at John Paul Jones Arena on Dec. 4.
- The Cavaliers shot 23.4 percent (11-of-47) from the field, marking the fourth lowest percentage in school history.
- Virginia's 38 points were its lowest during the Tony Bennett era and second fewest during the shot clock era (since 1986).
- London Perrantes led Virginia with eight points, while Josh Gasser had a game-high 11 points for Wisconsin.
- The Cavaliers shot a season-best 78.9 percent (15-of-19) from the free throw line.

NOTEWORTHY

- Virginia has nine players averaging 11.1 minutes or more per game.
- Virginia has made eight or more 3-pointers in four of its last five games, shooting 45.7% (37-of-81) from downtown during that span.

- Virginia has shot 70 percent or better from the free throw line in three of nine games.
- The Cavaliers' average margin of victory is 18.9 points.

HARRIS AND MITCHELL LEAD CAVALIERS INTO ACTION

- Returning All-ACC members Joe Harris and Akil Mitchell lead the Cavaliers into action this season.
- Last season, Harris averaged a career-high 16.3 points and Mitchell added career bests with 13.1 points and 8.9 rebounds per game.
- Harris is tied for 23rd on UVA's all-time scoring list with 1,356 points and Mitchell has grabbed 564 career rebounds.
- In 2013-14, Harris is averaging 11.2 points and 3.6 rebounds per game, while Mitchell is averaging 5.9 points and 4.8 rebounds.
- Harris is shooting 48.5 percent (16-of-33) from 3-point range this season, including 11-of-16 in the last four games.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett has an 83-55 mark in five seasons at UVA and 152-88 record in eight seasons of coaching.
- Bennett guided the Cavaliers to the NCAA Tournament in 2012 and NIT in 2013.
- Bennett has increased UVA's win total in each of the last four seasons (15 in 2009-10, 16 in 2010-11, 22 in 2011-12 and 23 in 2013-13).
- UVA's 11 ACC wins in 2012-13 were its most since 11 in 2006-07.
- Bennett is one of 23 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- He guided Washington State to a pair of NCAA Tournaments and the NIT in three seasons and was the National Coach of the Year in 2007.

EMBRACE THE PACE

- As of Dec. 5, the Cavaliers rank in the top nine nationally in eight defensive categories: points per game (2nd), rebounds per game (3rd), offensive rebound percentage (4th), points per possession (5th), offensive rebounds per game (5th), possessions per 40 minutes (6th), shooting percentage (8th) and rebound percentage (9th).
- Virginia has held all nine of its opponents below 50 percent shooting from the floor and opponents are shooting 36.2 percent (8th nationally) from the floor and 32.2 percent (58-for-180) from 3-point range overall.
- Virginia has limited JMU (2), VCU (3), Davidson (2), Navy (5) and Liberty (2), Hampton (0), SMU (2), Missouri State (2) and Wisconsin (2) to a combined 20 fast break points.

CLEANING THE GLASS

- Virginia has outrebounded its opponents in seven of nine games.
- The Cavaliers rank ninth nationally in rebound percentage at 57.2 percent and are enjoying a +10.8 average rebound margin per game.
- Malcolm Brogdon (5.1), Mike Tobey (5.0), Akil Mitchell (4.8), Darion Atkins (4.6), Justin Anderson (4.6) and Anthony Gill (4.3) are each averaging four or more rebounds per game.

PAINT IT ORANGE AND BLUE

- UVA has outscored its opponents in the paint in seven of nine games and 266-164 overall.
- Virginia has scored 44.7 percent of its points in the paint.
- A post player has led UVA in scoring in five of nine games (Gill 13 vs. JMU, 18 vs. Navy, 13 vs. Liberty and 19 vs. SMU and Tobey 18 vs. Davidson).

MALCOLM BACK IN THE MIDDLE OF THE ACTION

- Redshirt sophomore guard Malcolm Brogdon returned to action against JMU (11/8/13) after missing the 2012-13 season and last four games of 2011-12 with a foot injury.
- Brogdon is averaging 10.1 points and a team-leading 1.3 steals per game.
- Brogdon is shooting 47 percent (31-of-66) from the floor, 40 percent (10-of-25) from 3-point range and a team-leading 86.4 percent (19-of-22) from the free throw line.
- Brogdon tallied a career-high 17 points vs. Davidson (11/16/13) and matched his career high with three 3-pointers against JMU (11/8/13).
- Brogdon tallied a career-best four consecutive games of double figures scoring from Nov. 12-23.
- He averaged 6.7 points in 28 games as a freshman in 2011-12.

TOBEY, TOBEY, TOBEY... DOES IT AGAIN

- Mike Tobey is becoming Virginia's go-to man, averaging career bests in points (8.4), rebounds (5.0) and blocks (1.1) this season.
- Tobey is also displaying his scoring touch, shooting 50.8 percent (31-of-61) from the floor.
- He tallied a season-high 18 points vs. Davidson (11/16/13) and had a career-high nine rebounds vs. VCU (11/12/13).
- Tobey, who has started four games, has scored in double figures in four games.

AG MAKING SUCCESSFUL TRANSFER

- Redshirt sophomore Anthony Gill made his UVA debut against JMU (11/8/13) after sitting out last season as a transfer from South Carolina.
- Gill has led UVA in scoring in four games, including 13 vs. JMU (11/8/13), 18 points on 8-of-9 shooting against Navy (11/19/13), 13 vs. Liberty (11/23/13) and a career-high 19 vs. SMU (11/29/13).
- Gill, who earned Corpus Christi Challenge All-Tournament honors, is shooting a sizzling 66.7 percent from the floor (34-of-51) and averaging 9.9 points and 4.3 rebounds per game this season.
- Gill averaged 7.6 points and 4.7 rebounds per game as a freshman for South Carolina in 2011-12.

ANDERSON GIVES VIRGINIA A LIFT OFF THE BENCH

- Sophomore Justin Anderson was one of two players in NCAA Division I to record 20 points, five rebounds, five blocked shots and five 3-pointers in a game last season, joining South Alabama's Mychal Ammons who also accomplished the rare feat.
- Anderson tallied 24 points, six rebounds, five blocked shots and five 3-pointers in Virginia's season-ending 75-64 loss to Iowa (3/27/13), while Ammons had 21 points, five rebounds, five blocked shots and five 3-pointers vs. FIU.
- Anderson, who started the first two games, is averaging 8.9 points per game in seven games off the bench.
- He had a season-high 23 points (10-of-13 shooting) vs. Missouri State and added 12-point efforts vs. Davidson (11/16/13) and Hampton (11/26/13).
- Anderson earned Corpus Christi Challenge all-tournament honors.

LONDON CALLING

- Freshman London Perrantes joined the UVa starting lineup vs. Davidson (11/16/13).
- Perrantes is averaging 3.3 points, 2.1 rebounds and a team-leading 3.1 assists in 26.2 minutes per game.
- Perrantes had a season-high nine points on 3-of-3 shooting from 3-point range vs. SMU (11/29/13).
- Perrantes, who has a 3.1 assists to turnover ratio, added a season-high six assists against Liberty (11/23/13) and Missouri State (11/30/13).

ABOUT THE 2013-14 SCHEDULE

- Six of Virginia's opponents were ranked in the preseason polls (Duke, Syracuse, North Carolina, VCU, Wisconsin and Notre Dame), while three (Tennessee, Pittsburgh and Boston College) received votes.
- Twelve opponents (JMU, VCU, Davidson, Liberty, Wisconsin, NC State, Duke, North Carolina, Pittsburgh, Notre Dame, Miami and Syracuse) earned 2013 NCAA Tournament berths, while four (Norfolk State, Tennessee, Florida State and Maryland) participated in the National Invitation Tournament and two (Northern Iowa and Green Bay) in the CollegiateInsider.com Tournament.

VIRGINIA PICKED 4TH IN THE ACC

- Virginia was selected fourth in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball.
- UVa, who was picked seventh and tied for fourth last season, has finished at or higher than its predicted finish in each of the last four seasons.
- Duke is the preseason favorite, followed by Syracuse, North Carolina, UVa, Notre Dame, Pitt, Maryland, Boston College, Florida State, NC State, Georgia Tech, Miami, Wake Forest, Clemson and Virginia Tech.

HARRIS NAMED PRESEASON ALL-ACC

- Joe Harris is one of five players named Preseason All-ACC.
- Joining Harris on the preseason All-ACC team were C.J. Fair (Syracuse), Rodney Hood (Duke), Jabari Parker (Duke) and Jerian Grant (Notre Dame). Fair was the pick for Preseason ACC Player of the Year and Parker was named Preseason ACC Rookie of the Year.

HARRIS ONE OF 15 ON ROBERTSON WATCH LIST

- Joe Harris is one of 15 players on the preseason Oscar Robertson Watch List, honoring the nation's NCAA Division I Player of the Year.
- Joining Harris on the watch list were Jahii Carson (Arizona State), Aaron Craft (Ohio State), C. J. Fair (Syracuse), Aaron Gordon (Arizona), Gary Harris (Michigan State), Doug McDermott (Creighton), Mitch McGary (Michigan), Shabazz Napier (Connecticut), Jabari Parker (Duke), Adreian Payne (Michigan State), Julius Randle (Kentucky), Marcus Smart (Oklahoma State), Russ Smith (Louisville) and Andrew Wiggins (Kansas).

We would like to receive credential requests no later than seven (7) days prior to the game. Credentials that can't be mailed will be held for pickup at the will call window at John Paul Jones Arena. You must have a press pass to be admitted to the media area and the press room.

PHOTO CREDENTIALS

All photographers and camera operators must wear a visible credential issued by the Virginia athletics media relations office. Photographers work from the baselines at both ends of the court at John Paul Jones Arena. Live television is given top priority for courtside space.

PRESS PARKING

Press parking passes are provided upon request on a limited basis. If you need a parking pass, please be sure to inform the UVa athletics media relations office when making your press or photo credential request.

INTERVIEWS

All requests for interviews with Virginia basketball coaches and players should be made through Erich Bacher in the athletics media relations office. It is requested you allow the athletics media relations staff at least one day to arrange an interview.

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

Virginia head coach Tony Bennett and the visiting head coach will meet with media representatives in the press room after each game at John Paul Jones Arena. Coach Bennett will be available in the press room approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the game and the visiting coach will be in the press room approximately 20 minutes after the game. Virginia players will be available in the team meeting room adjacent to the men's basketball locker room after Coach Bennett is done with his postgame press conference.

RADIO

Each visiting school is allowed one free radio broadcast from John Paul Jones Arena. The Virginia athletics media relations office provides two ISDN lines and three business touchtone lines for use by the visiting broadcast crew. Radio network crews work from a courtside location at the scorer's table. Three seats are available at the table and one seat behind the visitor's broadcast location.
