TONIGHT'S GAME

- Virginia hosts Winthrop to conclude a two-game homestand to open the season
- After tonight, UVa travels to the Virgin Islands for three games in the Paradise Jam

SERIES HISTORY

- Virginia leads the series 2-0 (both previous meetings at University Hall)
- The Cavaliers defeated the Eagles 93-47 in 1990-91 and 92-68 in 1992-93
- In the last meeting against Winthrop (1/2/93), current UVa radio analyst Ted Jeffries had one of his 10 career double-doubles (14 pts, 12 rebs)
- Tony Bennett is 1-0 against the Eagles, leading Washington State to a 71-40 win over Winthrop in the first round of the 2008 NCAA Tournament in Denver

AGAINST THE BIG SOUTH

- Tonight's game is the only regular season game for UVa against a Big South team
- Virginia has an all-time record of 121-17 against current members of the Big South (1-0 vs. Charleston Southern, 2-0 vs. Coastal Carolina, 1-0 vs. Gardner-Webb, 1-0 vs. High Point, 6-2 vs. Liberty, 1-0 vs. UNC Asheville, 6-0 vs. Radford, 101-15 vs. VMI, 2-0 vs. Winthrop)
- UVa played one Big South team last season, a 54-44 win over Radford at JPJA

LAST TIME OUT

- Virginia opened the season with a 75-38 win over South Carolina State on Sunday
- Joe Harris and KT Harrell led the Cavaliers with 13 points each
- Mike Scott had eight points and 15 rebounds
- UVa had a 24-0 run early in the second half, shooting 59.1% (13-22) after halftime
- The 37-point victory is the largest margin of victory in the Tony Bennett era

CAVALIERS GET DEFENSIVE AGAINST SC STATE

- Virginia held South Carolina State to 38 points in the season opener, the eighth time in the Tony Bennett era that UVa has held a team below 50 points
- It was the fourth lowest scoring total by a UVa opponent in the shot clock era
- SCSU's 25.5% shooting (13-51) was the lowest percentage allowed by the Cavaliers since Liberty shot 22.6% percent (12-53) against UVa in the 2005-06 season opener
- Fewest points allowed by Virginia in a season opener since 1949-50 (W 63-37 vs. Richmond Royals)

VIRGINIA PICKED FOURTH IN ACC

- Virginia was selected fourth in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball
- It was highest the Cavaliers were picked in the poll since 2001-02, when they were picked to finish third
- UVa has finished higher than its place in the preseason poll in each of the last three seasons
- North Carolina was the preseason favorite, followed by Duke, Florida State, Virginia, Miami, Virginia Tech, Clemson, NC State, Maryland, Georgia Tech, Wake Forest and Boston College

SCOTT NAMED PRESEASON ALL-ACC

- Senior forward Mike Scott was one of six players named to the preseason All-ACC team at ACC Operation Basketball
- He is the first Cavalier selected as preseason All-ACC since Sean Singletary in 2007-08

EXPERIENCE COUNTS

- Virginia opened the season with the roster having 256 career starts, which is the most among ACC schools
- The Cavaliers had seven players who made a start in their career prior to this season (Mike Scott-74, Sammy Zeglinski-55, Assane Sene-48, Jontel Evans-38, Joe Harris-25, KT Harrell-15, Akil Mitchell-1)

ABOUT THE SCHEDULE

- Four of Virginia's opponents are currently ranked in the national polls (North Carolina, Duke, Michigan, Florida State), while one other is receiving votes (George Mason)
- The Cavaliers could play another ranked team (Marquette) and another team receiving votes (Drexel) in the Paradise Jam
- Virginia will play at least nine games against teams that participated in the 2011 NCAA Tournament, at least four games against teams that participated in the 2011 National Invitation Tournament and will play 2011 College Basketball Invitational Tournament Champion Oregon

70 IS A MAGIC NUMBER

- Under Tony Bennett, Virginia is 19-2 when scoring at least 70 points
- The Cavaliers are 13-29 over the past two seasons when scoring under 70 points

'HOOS BACK

- 10 players return from last season's team that went 16-15 (7-9 ACC)
- The Cavaliers return 69.0% of scoring and 79.4% of rebounding from last season

CAVALIER DEBUTS

- Malcolm Brogdon and James Johnson, along with walk-ons Rob Vozenilek and Angus Mitchell made their collegiate debuts in the season opener vs. SC State
- Brogdon had nine points, four assists and two rebounds in his debut
- Johnson had six points (6-8 FT) and three rebounds in his debut

SCOTT DOUBLING IT UP

- Mike Scott enters the game with 24 career double-doubles (T-8th in UVa history)
- He had six double-doubles in his 10 games last season before suffering a season-ending injury
- His 24 career doubles leads all active ACC players

SCOTT LEADS THE ACC

- Mike Scott is the ACC active leader in points (971), rebounds (694) and double-doubles (24)

RETURN TO SENE-DER

- Assane Sene ranks 10th in school history with 93 career blocks
- He led the Cavaliers last season with 39 blocks

ZEGLINSKI FROM LONG RANGE

- Sammy Zeglinski enters the game with 141 career 3-pointers, which ranks 11th in school history
- He will tie Cory Alexander for 10th place in UVa history with his first 3-pointer of the season

JESPERSON TO REDSHIRT

- Freshman guard Paul Jespersen is expected to redshirt this season
- Virginia head coach Tony Bennett indicated that after Virginia's game with South Carolina State on Nov. 13

FOUR SIGN WITH VIRGINIA

- UVa signed four players to National Letters of Intent for the 2012 recruiting class
- The four players are 6-6 wing Justin Anderson of Spotsylvania, Va.; 6-0 guard Teven Jones of Kannapolis, N.C.; 6-8 forward Evan Nolte of Alpharetta, Ga.; and 6-11 post player Mike Tobey of Monroe, N.Y.

McKAY PARTICIPATING IN "SHOTS FROM THE HEART"

- Associate Head Coach Ritchie McKay is participating in "Shots from the Heart", a project designed to raise awareness for the growing problem of heart disease
- College basketball coaches are competing against one another in a free throw shooting tournament, which benefits the American Heart Association
- The event also pays tribute to the late Skip Prosser who passed away on July 26, 2007 of a heart attack
- Last year, McKay reached the quarterfinals of the assistant coach bracket in the inaugural event
- McKay faces Ricky Yahn of Longwood in the round of 64 of this year's event

AT JOHN PAUL JONES ARENA

- Virginia is 61-28 all-time at John Paul Jones Arena
- The Cavaliers went 11-6 at home last season

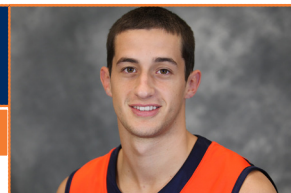
