TODAY'S GAME

- Virginia hosts South Carolina State in its season-opener
- It is the 13th consecutive year the Cavaliers have opened the season at home

SERIES HISTORY

- First all-time meeting between UVa and SCSU
- South Carolina State is one of at least three first-time opponents on Virginia's schedule (SC State, TCU, Green Bay; possibly Drake in the Paradise Jam)

SEASON OPENERS

- Virginia has won its last 13 season openers and its last 14 home openers
- Overall, the Cavaliers are 86-20 in season openers
- Last season, Virginia opened the season with a 76-52 win over William & Mary
- Head Coach Tony Bennett is 5-0 in season openers (2-0 at UVa, 3-0 at WSU)
- It is the 13th consecutive season the Cavaliers have opened at home

AGAINST THE MEAC

- South Carolina St. is the first of at least two MEAC teams on UVa's 2011-12 schedule
- UVa will play UM-Eastern Shore and could play Norfolk State at Paradise Jam
- Virginia has a 16-0 all-time record against current members of the MEAC (1-0 vs. Bethune Cookman, 1-0 vs. Coppin State, 6-0 vs. Hampton, 4-0 vs. Howard, 1-0 vs. Maryland-Eastern Shore, 1-0 vs. Morgan State, 1-0 vs. Norfolk State, 1-0 vs. North Carolina A&T)

AT JOHN PAUL JONES ARENA

- Virginia is 60-28 all-time at John Paul Jones Arena
- The Cavaliers went 11-6 at home last season

VIRGINIA PICKED FOURTH IN ACC

- Virginia was selected fourth in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball
- It was highest the Cavaliers were picked in the poll since 2001-02, when they were picked to finish third
- UVa has finished higher than its place in the preseason poll in each of the last three seasons
- North Carolina was the preseason favorite, followed by Duke, Florida State, Virginia, Miami, Virginia Tech, Clemson, NC State, Maryland, Georgia Tech, Wake Forest and Boston College

SCOTT NAMED PRESEASON ALL-ACC

- Senior forward Mike Scott was one of six players named to the preseason All-ACC team at ACC Operation Basketball
- He is the first Cavalier selected as preseason All-ACC since Sean Singletary in 2007-08

GETTING VOTES

- Virginia received votes in the preseason ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll
- It is the first time the Cavaliers received votes in either the AP or ESPN/USA Today preseason poll since the 2007-08 season

EXPERIENCE COUNTS

- Virginia opens the season with the roster having 256 career starts, which is the most among ACC schools
- The Cavaliers have seven players who have made a start in their career (Mike Scott-74, Sammy Zeglinski-55, Assane Sene-48, Jontel Evans-38, Joe Harris-25, KT Harrell-15, Akil Mitchell-1)

ABOUT THE SCHEDULE

- Three of Virginia's opponents are ranked in the preseason polls (North Carolina, Duke, Michigan), while another three are receiving votes (Florida State, George Mason, Miami)
- The Cavaliers could play another ranked team (Marquette) and another team receiving votes (Drexel) in the Paradise Jam
- Virginia will play at least nine games against teams that participated in the 2011 NCAA Tournament, at least four games against teams that participated in the 2011 National Invitation Tournament and will play 2011 College Basketball Invitational Tournament Champion Oregon

70 IS A MAGIC NUMBER

- Under Tony Bennett, Virginia is 18-2 when scoring at least 70 points
- The Cavaliers are 13-29 over the past two seasons when scoring under 70 points

ON THE AIR

- Virginia will have almost every game this season broadcast either on television or online
- All 16 ACC games and all 16 home games will be broadcast
- 13 games will be televised nationally by ESPN, ESPN2, ESPNU or FSN

'HOOS BACK

- 10 players return from last season's team that went 16-15 (7-9 ACC)
- The Cavaliers return 69.0% of scoring and 79.4% of rebounding from last season

SCOTT DOUBLING IT UP

- Mike Scott enters the game with 24 career double-doubles (T-8th in UVa history)
- He had six double-doubles in his 10 games last season before suffering a season-ending injury
- His 24 career doubles leads all active ACC players

SCOTT LEADS THE ACC

- Mike Scott is the ACC active leader in points (963), rebounds (679) and double-doubles (24)

RETURN TO SENE-DER

- Assane Sene ranks 10th in school history with 93 career blocks
- He led the Cavaliers last season with 39 blocks

ZEGLINSKI FROM LONG RANGE

- Sammy Zeglinski enters the game with 141 career 3-pointers, which ranks 11th in school history
- He will tie Cory Alexander for 10th place in UVa history with his first 3-pointer of the season

FOUR SIGN WITH VIRGINIA

- UVa signed four players to National Letters of Intent for the 2012 recruiting class
- The four players are 6-6 wing Justin Anderson of Spotsylvania, Va.; 6-0 guard Teven Jones of Kannapolis, N.C.; 6-8 forward Evan Nolte of Alpharetta, Ga.; and 6-11 post player Mike Tobey of Monroe, N.Y.

HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Tony Bennett is in his third season at Virginia
- Bennett has a 31-31 record at Virginia and a 100-64 career record
- He is one of 19 active Division I head coaches to have played in the NBA

McKAY PARTICIPATING IN "SHOTS FROM THE HEART"

- Associate Head Coach Ritchie McKay is participating in "Shots from the Heart", a project designed to raise awareness for the growing problem of heart disease
- College basketball coaches are competing against one another in a free throw shooting tournament, which benefits the American Heart Association
- The event also pays tribute to the late Skip Prosser who passed away on July 26, 2007 of a heart attack
- Last year, McKay reached the quarterfinals of the assistant coach bracket in the inaugural event
- McKay faces Ricky Yahn of Longwood in the round of 64 of this year's event

UP NEXT

- Virginia will host Winthrop on Tuesday at John Paul Jones Arena
- Game time is 7 p.m. and the game will be broadcast by the Regional Sports Networks (Comcast SportsNet in Virginia)
- The Cavaliers won both previous meetings with Winthrop, both at University Hall in the early 1990s
