FOR OPENERS

- UVA is 1-28 all-time vs. top-ranked foes, posting an 86-73 win against then-No. 1 North Carolina in Charlottesville on Jan. 30, 1986.
- The Cavaliers are 2-2 vs. ranked opponents in 2016-17, defeating then-No. 6 Louisville and No. 14 Notre Dame and losing to then-No. 25 West Virginia and then-No. 20 Florida State.
- UVA has the toughest remaining schedule according to ESPN's College Basketball Power Index.
- Virginia is 6-1 in true road games and has an ACC-leading 23-9 road record in the 15-team ACC era (since 2013-14).
- UVA's six true road wins ranks first among ACC, Big Ten, Big 12, Pac-12, BIG EAST and SEC schools.
- UVA has a five-game winning streak, including ACC road wins at Clemson. Boston College and Notre Dame.
- The Cavaliers rank first nationally in scoring defense (53.3 ppg) and second in turnovers per game (9.7).
- London Perrantes leads UVA in scoring at 12.3 points per game, marking the lowest scoring average to lead any UVA team in a single season (Malcolm Brogdon 12.7 ppg in 2013-14).
- UVA is playing back-to-back top 25 opponents (No. 14 Notre Dame and No. 1 Villanova) on the road for the first time since 2009 (No. 3 North Carolina and No. 25 Florida State).

A WIN AT VILLANOVA WOULD GIVE UVA ITS:

- First road win against a top-ranked opponent in school history.
- Second win against a top-ranked opponent in school history.
- First back-to-back road wins against ranked opponents since 1981-1982 (74-56 win at No. 17 Louisville on Jan. 24 and 69-66 win at No. 18 Wake Forest on Jan. 27)
- Second straight win vs. Villanova and a 6-2 mark in the series.
- Third win against a ranked opponent in 2016-17.
- Fifth straight win against a BIG EAST opponent.
- Sixth consecutive win overall.
- Seventh road win and fourth consecutive road win in 2016-17.

SUITS AND SNEAKERS WEEK

- The UVA-Villanova game is part of the Coaches vs. Cancer Suits And Sneakers Week, celebrated Jan. 23-29.
- The UVA and Villanova coaching staffs will wear sneakers with their suits as a visible reminder about the importance of nutrition and physical activity in reducing cancer risk.

IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

- As of Jan. 27, UVA ranks first nationally in scoring defense (53.3 ppg), second in turnovers per game (9.7), fifth in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.56), ninth in scoring margin (+16.4), 12th in field goal percentage defense (38.5%),13th in 3-point field goal percentage (40.4%), 14th in field goal percentage (49.6%), 16th in turnover margin (+3.9) and 20th in fouls per game (15.9).
- UVA has held four opponents to fewer than 40 points and was the first team in Division I to hold three straight opponents (St. Francis Brooklyn, Yale and Grambling State) to fewer than 40 points in the last 20 years.
- UVA was also the first team in ACC history (1953-present) to hold three straight opponents to fewer than 40 points.
- The Cavaliers have held 13 of their opponents to 54 or fewer points and six opponents to 50 or fewer points.

UVA RANKED NO. 12/13 IN LATEST POLLS

- UVA is ranked No. 12 in the latest AP poll and No. 13 in USA Today Coaches' poll.
- UVA has ranked in the top 15 in 55 of the last 57 AP polls.
- UVA was ranked in top 10 in the preseason rankings (No. 8/7) for the third straight season, matching a school-best from 1981-83.
- UVA has been ranked in 58 consecutive AP polls since Feb. 3, 2014.
- UVA has finished in the top 10 (No. 3 in 2014 & No. 6 in 2015 and No. 4 in 2016) in the final AP rankings in three consecutive seasons for the first time since 1981-83.

ALL-TIME VS. VILLANOVA

- The Cavaliers own a 5-2 advantage over the Wildcats in the all-time series that dates back to 1981.
- UVA topped the eventual national champion Villanova 86-75 in Charlottesville last season on Dec. 19, 2015.
- The Cavaliers are 1-2 against the Wildcats in Pennsylvania, including a 73-63 loss in the 2004 NIT at The Pavilion in Villanova, Pa.
- UVA posted its lone win (83-80) against Villanova on the road in the first round of the 1992 NIT at The Pavilion.
- UVA and Villanova meet for the first time at Wells Fargo Center, which also serves as the home of the NBA's Philadelphia 76ers and NHL's Philadelphia Flyers.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett has a 181-75 (.707) mark in eight seasons at Virginia and 250-108 (.698) career mark in 11 seasons overall.
- Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons from 2014-16, eclipsing 88 wins from 1981-83.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense three times (2008-09, 2013-14 & 2014-15), and finished in the top-five nationally in seven of 10 seasons.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to five consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015 and 2016, and NIT in 2013).
- In 2015-16, Bennett led UVA to its third consecutive NCAA Tournament and first NCAA Elite Eight appearance since 1995 with 29 wins.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year and ACC Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons (2014-2015) for the first time in school history.
- In 2013-14, Bennett guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship (first since 1976) in the same season.
- Bennett-coached teams are 86-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 11-year coaching career.
- Bennett is one of 28 current Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.

LAST TIME AGAINST THE WILDCATS

- Anthony Gill tallied 22 points and Malcolm Brogdon had 20 to lead then-No. 8/9 Virginia to an 86-75 win over then-No. 12/13 Villanova on Dec. 19, 2015.
- London Perrantes added 19 points as Virginia posted its second straight win against a ranked opponent.
- UVA shot 55.6 percent from the field and 66.7 percent from 3-point range, and out-rebounded the Wildcats 31-19.
- Kris Jenkins led Villanova with 23 points and Josh Hart added 12.

LAST TIME OUT

- No. 12 Virginia posted a 71-54 win at No. 14 Notre Dame on Jan. 24.
- London Perrantes bagged a game-high 22 points and Isaiah Wilkins added 13 points, including a 9-10 effort from the free throw line.
- Devon Hall added 11 points and nine rebounds as UVA owned a 38-22 rebounding advantage.
- Bonzie Colson led Notre Dame with 20 points.
- UVA led 27-26 at the half, but outscored the Irish 44-28 in the second half behind Ty Jerome's career-high eight points.

UVA IN KEN POM EFFICIENCY RATINGS

- As of Jan. 27, UVA ranks Nos. 3, 4 and 17 in the KenPom.com adjusted defense, overall and adjusted offense efficiency ratings, respectively.
- UVA is shooting 49.6 percent from the field (best since 50.1% in 1985-86), 40.4 percent from 3-point range (school record) and 70.3 percent from the free throw line.
- UVA scored a Tony Bennett era high 90 points vs. Grambling State.
- UVA has shot 50 percent or better in eight games.

UVA VS. THE BIG EAST

- Virginia meets its second BIG EAST opponent of the season, defeating Providence 63-52 to capture the Emerald Coast Classic on Nov. 25.
- UVA is 26-32 all-time against current BIG EAST Conference members (1-0 vs. Butler, 0-2 vs. DePaul, 11-12 vs. Georgetown, 3-1 vs. Marquette, 4-3 vs. Providence, 0-3 vs. Seton Hall, 1-7 vs. St. John's, 5-2 vs. Villanova and 1-2 vs. Xavier).

UVA VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

- Virginia is 2-2 vs. ranked opponents, losing to then-No. 25 West Virginia and then-No. 20 Florida State, and defeating then-No. 6 Louisville and No. 14 Notre Dame.
- UVA's 61-53 road win at then-No. 6 Louisville marked the Cavaliers' first top-10 road win since the 2002-03 season (86-78 vs. then-No. 8 Maryland).
- UVA is 24-25 against ranked opponents in the Tony Bennett era.
- UVA is 139-321 vs. ranked opponents, including a 25-119 mark against top-5 foes, since 1953-54.
- UVA is 1–28 vs. No. 1-ranked opponents (86-73 vs. No. 1 North Carolina on Jan. 30, 1986).
- UVA tied a school mark with eight wins against ranked foes in 2015–16.

- UVA is led by senior point guard London Perrantes, who is averaging team highs in points (12.3 ppg) and assists (3.7 apg).
- Isaiah Wilkins (6.8 ppg & 5.7 rpg) leads the team in rebounding, blocked shots (24) and steals (24).
- Devon Hall is averaging 8.2 points and 4.2 rebounds, while Darius Thompson has added 7.2 points per game.
- Marial Shayok is averaging 10 points and Kyle Guy is averaging 8.2 points on 46.4 percent 3-point shooting.
- Jack Salt is averaging 4.2 points and 3.8 rebounds in 19.6 minutes per game after averaging 1.6 points and 1.1 rebounds in 6.6 minutes per game last season.
- Mamadi Diakite, Jarred Reuter and Ty Jerome are role players off the bench.

• Seven of UVA's opponents are ranked in the lastest AP poll (Villanova, Florida State, North Carolina, Louisville, Notre Dame, Duke and West Virginia), while one opponent (Virginia Tech) received votes.

• The Cavaliers will play 13 games against 2016 NCAA Tournament teams: home games against Duke, North Carolina, West Virginia, Miami, Pitt and Yale; road contests at Villanova, North Carolina, Syracuse, California, Pitt and Notre Dame; and a neutral-site tilt against lowa in the Emerald Coast Classic in Niceville, Fla.

HOLDING FOES UNDER 50

- Virginia is 61-2 when holding opponents under 50 points in the Tony Bennett era.
- Bennett-coached teams are 86-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points (25-1 in three years at Washington State).
- UVA has held four opponents (St. Francis Brooklyn, Yale, Grambling State and Robert Morris) under 40 points this season and is 18-0 under Bennett when limiting foes to 40 or fewer points.

• Virginia is 90-5 when scoring at least 70 points under Tony Bennett and 91-70 when scoring under 70 points.

60 IS THE NEW 70

• UVA is 157-33 when scoring at least 60 points under Tony Bennett and 24-42 when scoring fewer than 60 points.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Virginia is 146-38 (.793), including an 8-2 mark in 2016-17, in 11 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- West Virginia ended UVA's JPJ-record, 24-game home winning streak on Dec. 3.
- The Cavaliers finished undefeated at home (15-0) in 2015-16 for the first time since 1981-82 (12-0).
- UVA is 108-22 (.831), including a 73-7 (.913) mark the past five seasons, at home under head coach Tony Bennett.
- Virginia is 37-2 in ACC home games over the past five seasons.
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for seven straight seasons.

LEAVING ITS BENCH(MARK)

- UVA has outscored its opponents 559-255 off the bench this season.
- The Cavaliers are averaging 29.4 points off the bench, while opponents are averaging 13.4 bench points.
- UVA scored a season-high 61 points off the bench against Grambling and had a 20-0 advantage over Providence off the bench.
- West Virginia (27–20) and Clemson (26–16) are the lone opponents to outscore UVA off the bench in 2016–17.

LONDON CALLING

- Preseason All-ACC first-team selection and ACC Player of the Year candidate London Perrantes leads UVA into action this season.
- Perrantes is averaging 12.3 points, 3.7 assists and 3.2 rebounds in 2016-17.
- Perrantes had a season-high 25 points at Clemson (1/14/17), 24 points against Wake Forest (1/8/17) and 22 at Notre Dame (1/24/17).
- He enjoyed a breakout season in 2015-16, averaging career highs in points (11), field goal percentage (43.9%) and ACC-leading 3-point field goal percentage (48.8%).
- Perrantes has led UVA in assists in each of the last three seasons and has a career 2.7 assist-to-turnover ratio (512 assists, 188 turnovers) in 123 games (119 starts).
- Perrantes needs eight wins to become UVA's all-time winningest player (112 by Mike Tobey, Evan Nolte, Caid Kirven).
- He was named All-ACC Honorable Mention in each of the past two seasons and earned All-ACC Freshman Team honors in 2013-14.
- Perrantes ranks first all-time at UVA in 3-point percentage (42.7%), fifth in assists (512), seventh in 3-pointers (185), eighth in starts (119) and 44th in points (1,027).

HALL OF A YEAR SO FAR

- Redshirt junior Devon Hall is enjoying his best season at UVA, averaging career highs in points (8.2), rebounds (4.2), field goal percentage (44.9%), 3-point percentage (41.9%), free throw percentage (82.8%) and minutes (25.5).
- Hall, who has started 39 consecutive games dating back to last season, tallied career highs in points (15) and rebounds (9) at Pitt (1/4/17).
- Hall is averaging 11.5 points and 5.4 rebounds during ACC play.
- Hall has scored 10+ points in eight of the last 10 games.

ZAY PAVES THE WAY

- Junior Isaiah Wilkins is UVA's top returning frontcourt player after leading the Cavaliers with 31 blocked shots and adding 28 steals in 2015-16.
- Wilkins, who has started all 19 games, had a season-high 13 points at Notre Dame (1/24/17) and tallied 11 points in wins against Iowa (11/25/16) and Boston College (1/18/17).
- He had a career-high five blocked shots vs. Wake Forest (1/8/17) and matched a career best with 13 rebounds at Clemson (1/14/17).
- Wilkins leads the team in rebounding (5.7 rpg), blocked shots (24) and steals (24).

- Brogdon earned consensus first-team All-America and NABC Defensive Player of the Year honors in 2016 after becoming the first player to be named ACC Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year in the same season. The three-time All-ACC first-team performer earned consensus second-team All-America honors in 2015.
- He helped Virginia to 111 wins, four NCAA tournaments, two ACC regular-season titles and one ACC Tournament championship during his career.
- The other former Virginia men's basketball players whose numbers have been retired are Jeff Lamp (3), Barry Parkhill (40), Ralph Sampson (50), Sean Singletary (44), Bryant Stith (20), Wally Walker (41), and Buzzy Wilkinson (14).
- Brogdon, who is averaging 9.2 points and 4.2 assists for the NBA's Milwaukee Bucks, will compete in the BBVA Compass Rising Stars Challenge at All-Star Weekend on Feb. 17 in New Orleans.
