TONIGHT'S GAME

- Virginia opens a two-game homestand as it hosts Maryland-Eastern Shore
- The Cavaliers look to start a season 11-1 for the first time since 2000-01
- UVa seeks its first nine-game win streak since 2001-02

SERIES HISTORY

- Virginia leads 1-0 (1-0 at John Paul Jones Arena)
- The only previous meeting was a 104-63 Cavalier win in 2006-07

WINNING STREAKS

- The Cavaliers enter the game on an eight-game winning streak, their longest since the 2009-10 season
- Virginia hasn't won nine consecutive games since the 2001-02 season
- Dating back to last season, UVa has won seven consecutive home games, its longest home win streak since 2009-10 (Cavaliers haven't had an eight-game home win streak since a 12-game streak from the end of 2006-07 to the start of 2007-08)

LAST TIME OUT

- Virginia defeated Seattle 83-77 on Dec. 21 at KeyArena
- It was the Cavaliers' fourth consecutive win in true road games
- Mike Scott led Virginia with a career-high 33 pts along with 14 rebs (5th double-double this season)
- Joe Harris added 14 points in his return to his home state of Washington

SCOTT REPEATS AS ACC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Mike Scott was named ACC Player of the Week on Dec. 26 after having 33 pts and 14 rebs in the Cavaliers' 83-77 win at Seattle
- He was also honored on Dec. 19 and becomes the first Cavalier to win the award in consecutive weeks since Sean Singletary in January 2007

2011-12 Opponents in Bold

HOOS RANKED

- Virginia is ranked No. 23 in this week's Associated Press Top 25
- This week marks the first time Virginia has been in the AP poll in consecutive weeks since December 2004
- UVa entered the ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll this week at No. 24
- It is the first time Virginia has been ranked in both polls since February 19, 2007

AGAINST THE MEAC

- UMES is the second of two MEAC teams on UVa's 2011-12 schedule
- Virginia defeated South Carolina State 75-38 in the season opener on Nov. 13
- The Cavaliers have a 17-0 all-time record against current members of the MEAC (1-0 vs. Bethune-Cookman, 1-0 vs. Coppin State, 6-0 vs. Hampton, 4-0 vs. Howard, 1-0 vs. Maryland-Eastern Shore, 1-0 vs. Morgan State, 1-0 vs. Norfolk State, 1-0 vs. North Carolina A&T, 1-0 vs. South Carolina State)

CAVALIERS GET DEFENSIVE

- Virginia is third in the nation in scoring defense at 51.1 ppg (as of 12/26)
- UVa ranks third nationally in points allowed per possession (0.82) and 31st nationally in field goal percentage defense (38.3%)
- The Cavaliers held each of their first 10 opponents under 60 points, their longest streak since 17 straight games from the end of the 1947-48 season (last eight games) to the start of the 1948-49 season (first nine games)
- It is the third-longest streak in ACC history (longest in the shot clock era)
- UVa has held five opponents to under 50 points, a feat it has done 12 times in the Tony Bennett era
- Virginia held Drexel to 35 points, the second lowest scoring total by a UVa opponent in the shot clock era
- South Carolina State's 25.5% shooting (13-51) was the lowest percentage allowed by UVa since Liberty shot 22.6% percent (12-53) against UVa in the 2005-06 season opener
- Virginia has held two opponents under 30% shooting this season (only accomplished the feat twice in the previous three seasons combined)
- It is the first time UVa has held multiple opponents under 30% shooting in the same season since 2005-06 (three times)

ONE AND DONE...

- Virginia ranks third nationally in defensive rebounding percentage at 77.0%
- The Cavaliers have allowed points on just 41.5 percent of their opponents' possessions this season (third nationally)
- Opponents are averaging 6.5 second chance points a game this season
- UVa has held 9 of 11 opponents to single digit second chance points

FREE THROW PRODUCTION

- Virginia leads the ACC and ranks 30th nationally with a 74.3 free throw percentage
- UVa has scored 26.5 percent of its points this season from the free throw line
- The Cavaliers are going to the line 7.8 more times a game this season and scoring 6.6 more points from the line per game this season

THEY CALL THEM FREE THROWS FOR A REASON

- UVa set a school record by going 19-for-19 from the free throw line against Winthrop
- The previous school record was 16-for-16 against South Carolina on Jan. 8, 1965
- It was the best free throw performance by an ACC team since Wake Forest shot an ACC-record 32-for-32 against North Carolina in 2005

70 IS A MAGIC NUMBER

- Under Tony Bennett, Virginia is 22-2 when scoring at least 70 points
- The Cavaliers are 19-30 over the past three seasons when scoring under 70 points

MIKE SCOTT DOMINATES IN SEATTLE

- Mike Scott had a career-high 33 points (12-14 FG), along with 14 rebounds, in Virginia's 83-77 win at Seattle University on Dec. 21
- Scott's 33 points were the most by a Cavalier since Sean Singletary scored 41 points at Miami on Mar. 1, 2008
- Scott's 33 points are the most by an ACC player this season
- Scott was the first ACC player with at least 33 pts and at least 14 rebs in a game since Florida State's Al Thornton (37 pts, 15 rebs) at Duke on Feb. 4, 2006
- Scott's 19 points in the first half were the most in a half by a Cavalier since Sylvan Landesberg had 26 second half points vs. Boston College (Feb. 4, 2009) and the most in a first half since Sean Singletary had 23 first half points vs. Virginia Tech (Jan. 26, 2008)

SCOTT NAMED PRESEASON ALL-ACC

- Senior forward Mike Scott was one of six players named to the preseason All-ACC team at ACC Operation Basketball
- He is the first Cavalier selected as preseason All-ACC since Sean Singletary in 2007-08

SCOTT DOUBLING IT UP

- Mike Scott enters the game with 29 career double-doubles (T-3rd in UVa history)
- He has five double-doubles this season
- His 29 career double-doubles leads all active ACC players
- Scott has two "20-10" games this season (six in his career)

SCOTT LEADS THE ACC

- Mike Scott is the ACC active leader in points (1,151), rebounds (788) and double-doubles (29)

SCOTT JOINS 1,000 POINT CLUB

- Mike Scott became the 43rd Cavalier to score 1,000 career points, reaching the milestone against TCU in the Virgin Islands
- He enters the game with 1,151 career points, T-35th in Virginia history

RETURN TO SENE-DER

- Assane Sene ranks seventh in school history with 105 career blocks
- He led the Cavaliers last season with 39 blocks

ZEGLINSKI FROM LONG RANGE

- Sammy Zeglinski enters the game with 161 career 3-pointers, which ranks T-6th in school history

EVANS SHINES AGAINST WINTHROP

- Jontel Evans scored a career-high 17 points against Winthrop
- He was 5-6 from the field, made a career-high two 3-pointers, and went 5-5 from the free throw line
- His previous career high was 11 points

ACC LEADERS

- Mike Scott is second the ACC in field goal percentage (.633)
- Scott ranks third in rebounding (9.9) and fourth in scoring (17.1)
- Joe Harris ranks second in free throw percentage (.897) and 14th in scoring (12.8)
- Sammy Zeglinski ranks fourth in 3-point percentage (.426) and T-3rd in steals (1.8)
- Jontel Evans ranks eighth in assists (3.1) and eighth in steals (1.5)

COMEBACK CAVS

- Virginia rallied from halftime deficits to win at both Oregon and Seattle
- It marked the first time the Cavaliers won consecutive games when trailing at the half since 2009-10 (at NC State, vs. Georgia Tech)
- It marked the first time Virginia won consecutive games (both on the road) when trailing at the half since 1990-91 (at Minnesota, at Marquette)

AT JOHN PAUL JONES ARENA

- Virginia is 66-28 all-time at John Paul Jones Arena
- The Cavaliers went 11-6 at home last season
- Virginia is 6-0 at home this season

ROAD WARRIORS

- Dating back to last season, Virginia has won four consecutive true road games
- It is the Cavaliers' longest road winning streak since winning four straight road games during the 1994-95 season
- When Virginia plays at LSU on Jan. 2, it will look for its first five-game road win streak since a five game streak from the end of 1991-92 to the start of 1992-93

CAVALIERS TOP MICHIGAN

- UVA's 70-58 win over No. 14 Michigan was its highest ranked win of the Bennett era
- It was the Cavaliers' first double-digit win over a top-15 opponent since a 72-58 win over No. 11 Boston College on Feb. 21, 2006 at University Hall

VIRGINIA PICKED FOURTH IN ACC

- Virginia was selected fourth in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball
- It was the highest the Cavaliers were picked in the poll since 2001-02, when they were picked to finish third
- UVA has finished higher than its place in the preseason poll in each of the last three seasons
- North Carolina was the preseason favorite, followed by Duke, Florida State, Virginia, Miami, Virginia Tech, Clemson, NC State, Maryland, Georgia Tech, Wake Forest and Boston College

HARRELL AND JOHNSON DECIDE TO TRANSFER

- Sophomore guard KT Harrell (Dec. 23) and redshirt freshman forward James Johnson (Dec. 24) announced they were transferring
- Harrell appeared in 11 games (starting five) and averaged 4.7 ppg this season
- Johnson appeared in six games and averaged 1.5 ppg this season

FOUR SIGN WITH VIRGINIA

- UVA signed four players to National Letters of Intent for the 2012 recruiting class
- The four players are 6-6 wing Justin Anderson of Spotsylvania, Va.; 6-0 guard Teven Jones of Kannapolis, N.C.; 6-8 forward Evan Nolte of Alpharetta, Ga.; and 6-11 post player Mike Tobey of Monroe, N.Y.

ON THE AIR

- Virginia will have almost every game this season broadcast either on television or online
- All 16 ACC games and all 16 home games will be broadcast
- 13 games will be televised nationally by ESPN, ESPN2, ESPNU or FSN

McKAY PARTICIPATING IN "SHOTS FROM THE HEART"

- Associate Head Coach Ritchie McKay is participating in "Shots from the Heart", a project designed to raise awareness for the growing problem of heart disease
- College basketball coaches are competing against one another in a free throw shooting tournament, which benefits the American Heart Association
- The event also pays tribute to the late Skip Prosser who passed away on July 26, 2007 of a heart attack
- Last year, McKay reached the quarterfinals of the assistant coach bracket in the inaugural event
- McKay defeated Ricky Yahn of Longwood in the first round of this year's tournament and will play Adam Caporn of St. Mary's in the round of 32

- Virginia concludes its home non-conference schedule on Dec. 30 as it hosts Towson
- Game time at John Paul Jones Arena is 7 p.m., and the game will be carried on ESPN3
