#### **Game Notes**

- UVA recorded its eighth win of the regular season. Last UVA won eight games in the regular season was 2011. UVA has reached eight wins for the 27th time in program history.
- UVA has scored 30+ points for the seventh time this season. It is the most games in a season with at least 30 points since the 2004 team did so eight times.
- Virginia finished with 227 rushing yards. It is the first time since the 2018 Belk Bowl (205 vs South Carolina) that UVA surpassed 200 rushing yards. It was the most rushing yards in a game since the 2018 opener when UVA rushed for 301 yards against Richmond.
- UVA scored on its opening offensive drive of the game for the seventh time this season and for the fourth game in a row.
- With 229 yards of total offense, QB Bryce Perkins passed 3,000 yards of total offense for the season for the second year in a row. He is the first Cavalier to notch multiple seasons of 3,000 yards of total offense. The plateau has only been reached four times in Virginia history (Bryce Perkins, 2018-19; Kurt Benkert, 2017; Matt Schaub, 2002), including three seasons in a row from 2017-19.
- Perkins won his 16th game as a UVA quarterback, trying him for No. 3 all-time in career wins at Virginia with Aaron Brooks, Marques Hagans and Jameel Sewell. Perkins is 16-8 all-time as UVA's starting quarterback.
- DB DeVante Cross notched his first interception of the season (second of his career) in the second quarter, returning it 52 yards. The interception of LU's Buckshot Calvert snapped the nation's longest active streak of pass attempts without an interception (295). Cross' only other career interception happened last season against Calvert and Liberty.
- Cross had his second interception of the game (third of his career) in the fourth quarter, returning it 35 yards. It is the first time in his career with two interceptions in one game.
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$  WR Dontayvion Wicks caught his first career touchdown pass for 44 yards in the fourth quarter.

#### **Game Notes**

- UVA finished 9-3 in the regular season, marking the eighth time the Cavaliers have had nine or more wins in the regular season (1895, 1989, 1994, 1995, 1998, 2002, 2007, 2019).
- · Virginia is the 2019 ACC Coastal Division Champions, the first time in program history
- $\cdot$  UVA is the first ACC Coastal team to be in first place from day one of the season and finish as division champions since Virginia Tech in 2005.
- UVA is now the seventh different team to be Coastal Champions in seven years.
- UVA scored on its first possession of the game for seventh time this season. The touchdown snapped nine-straight quarters the Virginia Tech defense had held its opponents scoreless.
- QB Bryce Perkins finished with 311 passing yards and 164 rushing yards. It is the third time this season and fifth time in his career he has accomplished this. His five games of 200 passing and 100 rushing yards is tied for the most in the nation since the start of the 2018 season. Caleb Evans of ULM also has five. Perkins has five of UVA's six all-time such games by a quarterback.
- Perkins finished with 164 rushing yards, a career high and extended his program record for career 100-yard rushing games by a quarterback to seven.
- Perkins added two rushing touchdowns to extend his season mark to 11, passing Bob Davis (10, 1964) and Shawn Moore (10, 1988) for No. 2 all-time in UVA history with single-season rushing touchdowns by a quarterback.
- Perkins 164 rushing yards ranks No. 3 all-time on UVA's single-game rushing list by a quarterback.
- · Perkins notched a career-long 67-yard rush in the first quarter for a touchdown.
- Perkins' 164 rushing yards, long rush of 67 yards and two rushing touchdowns are all season highs allowed by the Hokies in 2019.
- With 21 kick return yards, WR Joe Reed became the 10th player in FBS history to pass 3,000 career kick return yards. He is the only player in FBS history to have 3,000+ yards and a career return average of 28+ yards.
- OLB Noah Taylor recorded the first interception of his career on the final play of the first half.
- $\cdot$  TB Wayne Taulapapa rushed for one touchdown, extending his season total to 13. It is the most rushing touchdowns by a UVA running back since Keith Payne notched 14 in 2010.
- WR Hasise Dubois finished with 139 receiving yards, marking the second 100-yard receiving game of his season (and career).
