- In the 78th minute she connected with Alexa Spaanstra off a corner for what proved to tbe the game-winning goal
- · She then got in the scoring column in the 83rd minute when she took a pass from Cam Lexow and buried it for the 3-0 lead

HOOS PICKED TO FINISH THIRD IN ACC PRESEASON POLL

• The Cavaliers were picked to finish third in the ACC in a presasson vote of league coaches this season

- · Virginia received two first place votes and tallied 113 points picked behind North Carolina and Florida State
- · North Carolina was picked to repeat as regular-season champions, while Florida State was picked to finish second
- The Cavaliers finished third in the ACC regular-season standings a year ago and advanced to the finals at the ACC Tournament

PRESEASON ALL-ACC HONOREES

· UVA had sophomore forward Diana Ordoñez and junior forward Alexa Spaanstra named to the preseason All-ACC team

- · Both players were All-ACC second team selections a year ago and named to the ACC Championships All-Tournament Team
- · Ordoñez tied for the ACC lead in goals scored last season (15) while Spaanstra was second in the ACC in assists (12)
- The preseason All-ACC team was made up of 11 players and featured players from five different teams
- · North Carolina and Florida State each had three players selected, UVA and Louisville had two and Duke had one player

CAVALIERS SET TO PLAY ABBREVIATED SCHEDULE IN THE FALL

- · Virginia is set to play an abbreviated schedule this fall made up of 11 contests which all come against ACC teams
- The Cavaliers will play an eight-game conference schedule with three matches designated as non-conference contests
- · UVA's two matches against Virginia Tech and a road trip to North Carolina will not count in the ACC standings this season
- · The eight-game ACC schedule will feature four home games and four road games
- · Virginia will play seven matches against teams that went to the NCAA Tournament in the 2019 season in this schedule
- · Of those seven contests, four come on the road at Clemson, Duke, North Carolina and Virginia Tech- the home opponents in that group are FSU, Louisville and Virginia Tech

UNITED SOCCER COACHES RELEASE INITIAL RANKINGS FOR WEEK THREE

The United Soccer Coaches released its initial rankings for the fall of 2020 on Sept. 22 and the Hoos came in at No. 11

- The organization is only ranking teams competing in the fall season in the limited poll that sees 15 teams ranked
- The Atlantic Coast Conference has a strong presence with six teams in the poll all in the top 12 and all of the top three

NCAA COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS STRUCTURE FOR CHAMPIONSHIPS AND SPRING SEASON

- The current recommendation is for brackets to be filled at 75 percent (48 teams) instead of the usual 64 teams
- · Fall contests are to be counted toward selection for the championships in the spring when resumes are considered
- The spring season will be played Feb. 3 April 17 with NCAA Tournament selections to be made on April 18
- •The College Cup is set to be conducted May 13-17 and the tournament field will have 31 automatic bids and 17 at-large

IVORY CLIMBING THE RANKS IN THE RECORD BOOK

- · In her third season, goalkeeper Laurel lvory is already working her way into the history books at UVA
- · Currently, Ivory is fourth all-time in shutouts with 28 solo shutouts in her career
- ·With 45 wins, lvory is fourth all-time in victories as a keeper she has a 45-13-9 record for her career

CAVALIERS RESPOND WELL AFTER A LOSS UNDER SWANSON

- · Responding after a loss has been a trend for the Cavaliers throughout Steve Swanson's tenure at UVA
- •Throughout the 20 seasons under Swanson, Virginia holds a 58-8-12 record in matches following a loss
- The number does not include season-ending losses where the next match would be part of a new season

THE HOOS IN OVERTIME IN THE SWANSON ERA

- The Cavaliers are no stranger to overtime having gone past regulation three times this season with a 2-0-1 mark
- Virginia has gone to extra time in 84 matches during the Steve Swanson era with a 23-12-49 record in those matches In those 49 draws, 14 have come in the postseason with the Cavaliers surviving shootouts in five of those 14 matches

2020 CAVALIER WOMEN'S SOCCER

PENALTY KICKS PROVED COSTLY FOR THE CAVALIER DEFENSE EARLY IN 2020

- · Penalty kicks have been costly for the Cavaliers through six matches in the 2020 season
- · For the most part, the UVA defense has done its job by limiting opponents to 32 shots this season
- ·Virginia has also allowed 10 goals through the first eight games, but three of them have come on penalty kicks
- The Hoos have surrendered a goal from a PK in matches with Virginia Tech (9/12), at Clemson (9/20) and Pitt (10/1)

CAVALIER OFFENSE APPLYING PRESSURE BUT LOOKING TO CONVERT MORE CHANCES

- The Virginia offense has kept the pressure on its opponents in 2020, managing a 168-to-57 edge in shots so far
- · Of the 168 shots managed so far this season, the Cavaliers have put 76 on frame with 60 of them saved
- · UVA has taken at least 20 shots in four contests vs Virginia Tech (21), at Virginia Tech (27), Pitt (30) and Louisville (24)

The University of Virginia is an institution rich with history and tradition. Here is some of the terminology that contributes to UVA's culture.

- · Grounds: The term used by students, faculty and alumni to refer to the University dating as far back as Thomas Jefferson. "Campus" is never used.
- First Year, Second Year, Third Year, Fourth Year: Instead of freshman, sophomore, junior, senior. Why you may ask? To be a "senior" implies that a person has reached the final phase of learning, a feat that Thomas Jefferson believed to be impossible, arguing instead that education is a life-long process. This tends to be used less in athletic eligibility references.
- Commonwealth: Virginia is one of four constituent states of the United States of America that officially uses the name "Commonwealth" instead of the word state in all references. The other three commonwealths are Kentucky, Massachusetts and Pennsylvania.

UNIVERSITY NICKNAMES

- Virginia's athletics teams have been accompanied by a somewhat confusing array of nicknames. The most prominent and widely accepted of these monikers are "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos."
- Although the terms "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are used almost interchangeably to refer to University teams and players, "Cavaliers" is more often used by the media, while "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are frequently used by Virginia students and fans.
- Legend has it that Washington & Lee baseball fans dubbed the Virginia players "Wahoos" during the fiercely
 contested rivalry that existed between the two in-state schools in the 1890s. By 1940, "Wahoos" was in
 general use around Grounds to denote University students or events relating to them. The abbreviated "Hoos"
 sprang up later in student newspapers and has gained growing popularity in recent years.

THE CAVALIER MASCOT

•The costumed Cavalier with a large character head debuted during Virginia's 1984 football season and has remained the official mascot of the University.

UNIVERSITY COLORS: ORANGE AND BLUE

- Orange and blue were adopted as the University of Virginia's official athletic colors at a mass student meeting in 1888. UVA athletic teams had previously worn silver gray and cardinal red, but those colors did not stand out on muddy football fields, prompting a student movement to change them.
- One of the students attending the mass meeting was Allen Potts, a star athlete who played on Virginia's first football team in 1888. Potts showed up at the meeting wearing a navy blue-and-orange scarf that he had acquired during a summer boating expedition at Oxford University. Orange and blue were chosen as the official athletic colors after one of Potts' fellow students pulled the scarf off Potts' neck and, waving it to the crowd, yelled, "How will this do?" UVA later served as the inspiration for schools like Auburn and Florida when they selected school colors.

WAHOOWA

- •The origin of "Wah-hoo-wah" is uncertain. The cheer was used to root on Virginia teams as early as 1890 and may have been borrowed from Dartmouth College, whose athletics teams were once known as the Indians.
- Legend attributes the yell to Natalie Floyd Otey, who sang the ballad "Where'er You Are, There Shall My Love Be" at Charlottesville's Levy Opera House in 1893. The predominantly student audience noticed that Otey warbled the first three words of the song between each of the stanzas and decided to join in the refrain. By evening's end, goes the legend, the crowd had corrupted "Where'er You Are" into "Wah-hoo-wah."




