#### **FOR OPENERS**

- No. 15 Virginia meets Saint Francis (Pa.) for the first time.
- The Cavaliers have won 23 straight home-opening games, including last season's 65-34 win over JMU.
- UVA is 79-7 in nonconference action under head coach Tony Bennett at John Paul Jones Arena.

#### LAST TIME OUT

- · Justin McKoy tallied career highs in points (11) and rebounds (6), but then-No. 4 Virginia dropped a 61-60 decision to San Francisco at Bubbleville at Mohegan Sun Arena on Nov. 27.
- Rookie Reece Beekman added a season-high 11 points and Sam Hauser chipped in 10 in the loss.
- $\,$  UVA sank 15 3-pointers its season-opening win vs. Towson, but went 3 of 12 from distance in the 61-60 loss to San Francisco.
- UVA allowed 13 3-pointers, but outrebounded the Dons 36-32.
   Jamaree Bouyea tallied a game-high 19 points and six assists and Khalil Shabazz added 14 points and five rebounds.

#### THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- $\cdot$  Virginia is 195-45 (.813), including a 14-3 mark in 2019-20, in 14 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- · South Carolina ended UVA's 22-game home nonconference winning streak on Dec. 22, 2019.
- · UVA was 15-1 at JPJ last year and is 156-29 (.843), including a 122-14 (.897) mark the past eight seasons, under Bennett. · Virginia is an ACC-leading 65-8 (.890) in league home games over the past eight seasons. Duke is second at 64-9 (.877).
- · UVA has won 11 or more home games for 11 straight seasons.

#### **UVA VS. THE NORTHEAST CONFERENCE**

- · Virginia is 9-0 all-time vs. current Northeast Conference opponents (3-0 vs. LIU Brooklyn, 3-0 vs. Wagner, 1-0 vs. Farleigh Dickinson, 1-0 vs. Mount St. Mary's and 1-0 vs. St. Francis Brooklyn).
- The Cavaliers meet their first Northeast Conference foe since defeating St. Francis Brooklyn 72-32 at John Paul Jones Arena on Nov. 15, 2016.
- ·Tony Bennett is 2-0 all-time vs. current Northeast Conference opponents as a head coach (1-0 vs. St. Francis Brooklyn at UVA and Fairleigh Dickinson at Washington State).

#### **GETTING OFFENSIVE IN SEASON OPENER**

- · Virginia's 89 points against Towson were its most since scoring 100 against Marshall during the 2018-19 season.
- The Cavaliers scored 70 or more points twice last season (78 vs. Boston College and 73 vs. Louisville).
- $\cdot$  UVA scored 80 or more points in nine games in its championship season in 2018-19 and is 35-1 when scoring 80 or more points under Tony Bennett.

#### **UVA RANKED NO. 15 IN LATEST AP POLL**

- · Virginia is ranked No. 15 in the latest Associated Press poll.
- · UVA was ranked No. 4 in both preseason polls, marking its third AP preseason top-5 ranking in school history (No. 1 in 1982-83 and No. 5 in 2018-19).
- •The Cavaliers were ranked in the AP preseason top-10 for the eighth time in school history (No. 8 in 1980-81, No. 7 in 1981-82, No. 1 in 1982-83, No. 9 in 2014-15, No. 6 in 2015-16, No. 8 in 2016-17, No. 5 in 2018-19 and No. 4 in 2020-21.)
- $\cdot$  UVA has been ranked in the top 25 in the preseason rankings in nine of the past 10 seasons.

#### **HOO ARE THESE CAVALIERS?**

- · Sam Hauser, Kihei Clark and Jay Huff lead the Cavaliers into action in 2020-21.
- · Hauser leads the team in scoring (14.5) and rebounding (7.0) and is shooting 60 percent from the field (12 of 20), 50 percent from 3-point range (3 of 6) and 100 percent from the charity strip (2 of 2).
- $\cdot$  Clark has chipped in 8.0 points per game and leads the team with five assists.
- · Huff is averaging 9.0 points, 5.5 rebounds and a team-leading 2.5 blocks per game.
- ·Trey Murphy III and Reece Beekman have sparked the Cavaliers off the bench.
- · Murphy III went for game-high 21 points against Towson, while Beekman had a team-high 11 points in the loss vs. San Francisco.
- Casey Morsell, Tomas Woldetensae and Kody Stattmann have shared minutes on the perimeter, while Kadin Shedrick has averaged nine minutes off the bench in the frontcourt.

#### VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Three-time National and four-time ACC Coach of the Year Tony Bennett has a 278-97 (.741) mark in 12 seasons at Virginia and 347-130 (.727) career mark in 15 seasons.
- · Bennett led the Cavaliers to their eighth straight season with 23 or more wins in 2019-20.
- $\cdot$  Bennett also led UVA to a 15-5 mark and second-place ACC finish.
- · In 2018-19, Bennett led the Cavaliers to their first NCAA national championship, a share of their ninth ACC regular-season title and school-record 35 wins.
- · Bennett became the 80th active Division I head coach to win his 300th career game against Marshall on Dec. 31, 2018.
- · Bennett was named the USBWA Henry Iba National Coach of the Year for the third time in 2018 to rank second all-time behind legendary John Wooden, who captured the award six times.
- · He has led UVA to outright ACC regular-season and tournament championships in the same season two times (2014 and 2018).
- · Bennett guided UVA to six straight NCAA Tournament appearances from 2014-19 for the first time in school history and has led UVA to 29 or more wins in five of the past seven seasons.
- · Bennett is the sixth coach in ACC history to win at least three outright ACC regular-season titles (Frank McGuire, Vic Bubas, Dean Smith, Mike Krzyzewski and Roy Williams).
- · Bennett has led UVA to a school-best 16 or more ACC wins in four of the last six seasons and a school-record eight straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- · He has led UVA to a school-best nine straight 20-win seasons. · Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons two times (2014-16, 2017-19 & 2018-20).
- Bennett led UVA to nine consecutive postseason appearances (2012-19) and six consecutive NCAA tournaments (2014-19).
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons two times (2014-2015 and 2018-19).
- · UVA is 136-58 (.701) in ACC play (77-20 at home & 59-38 away), 157-29 (.844) at home and 142-39 (.785) in non-conference action (79-7 at JPJ) under Bennett.
- · Bennett ranks fifth all-time in winning percentage at .701, among ACC head coaches with 100 or more ACC regular-season wine.

#### **DAZZLING DEBUTS FOR HAUSER AND MURPHY III**

- · Sam Hauser and Trey Murphy III shined in their UVA debuts against Towson.
- · Hauser, who played three seasons at Marquette, drilled 7 of 9 shots (3 of 3 from 3) en route to his 19 points.
- · Hauser also tallied a game-high eight rebounds and tied for team lead with three assists.
- · Murphy III transferred to Virginia after the 2019-20 season and received his NCAA waiver on Nov. 24.
- · Murphy III recorded his eighth career 20-point effort and tied a career-high with six 3-pointers in 17+ minutes off the bench.

#### **VIRGINIA PICKED FIRST IN THE ACC**

- · Virginia was selected first in the ACC Operation Basketball 2020-21 Preseason Poll.
- The Cavaliers were named the Preseason ACC favorite for the first time since 1982-83 and second time in the 52-year history of the league poll.
- · Virginia was followed Duke, Florida State, North Carolina and Louisville in the top five.
- · ACC preseason voters selected Syracuse sixth, followed by Miami, NC State, Georgia Tech and Clemson. Virginia Tech was picked 11th, while Notre Dame, Pitt, Boston College and Wake Forest rounded out the voting.
- The Cavaliers have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in 11 of the last 12 seasons.

#### HAUSER AND CLARK EARN PRESEASON ALL-ACC HONORS

- $\cdot$  Sam Hauser was named to the preseason All-ACC first team, while Kihei Clark was named to the second team.
- · Hauser was joined on the first team by preseason ACC Player of the Year Garrison Brooks (North Carolina), Scottie Barnes (Florida State), Jalen Johnson (Duke), Aamir Simms (Clemson) and Chris Lykes (Miami).
- · Clark was joined on the preseason All-ACC second team by

#### **OUR DEFENSE NEVER RESTS**

- $\cdot$  UVA has limited its first two opponents to 60 or fewer points in 2020-21.
- •The Cavaliers are limiting their foes to 57.5 points and 38.3 percent field goal shooting and a pair of shot clock violations.
- In 2019-20, UVA captured its sixth NCAA scoring defense title after limiting opponents to 52.4 points per game.
- · UVA limited 12 opponents to fewer than 50 points, one opponent (Duke) to 50 points and four foes to fewer than 40 points.
- •The Cavaliers limited five opponents (Syracuse, JMU, Columbia, Maine and Virginia Tech) to fewer than 50 points, 29 percent or less field goal shooting and 29 percent or less 3-point shooting.
- · UVA held 23 opponents below 41 percent from the field.
- •The Cavaliers forced 27 shot clock violations and outrebounded 22 opponents.
- · Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense seven times and finished in the top-five nationally in 11 of 14 seasons.

#### WATCH ME NOW

- · Kihei Clark (Bob Cousy Award), Sam Hauser (Julius Erving Award) and Jay Huff (Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Award) were named to Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame preseason award top-20 watch lists.
- The Cousy Award honors the nation's top point guard, while the Erving Award honors the top small forward and Abdul-Jabbar the top center.
- · Clark was named to the Cousy Award top-20 watch list last
- · Hauser was one of 50 players named to the preseason watch list for the 2021 Jersey Mike's Naismith Trophy Watch List for Men's Player of the Year.
- · Hauser was one of 20 players named to the preseason watch list for the 2021 NABC Division I Player of the Year.

- $\cdot$  Virginia finished the season with a 23-7 overall record and tied for second in the ACC with a 15-5 record.
- $\cdot \text{The 2020 ACC}$  and NCAA tournaments were canceled due to the coronavirus.
- ·The Cavaliers won 23 or more games for the eighth consecutive
- · UVA won 15 or more league games for the third straight season and fifth overall.
- · UVA finished the season on an eight-game winning streak.
- •The Cavaliers captured the Air Force Reserve Tip-Off Tournament title with a 48-45 win over Arizona State on Nov. 24 and have captured seven straight November tournament championships (Emerald Coast Classic, Charleston Classic, Barclays Center Classic, Corpus Christi Challenge, NIT Season Tip-Off, Battle 4 Atlantis and Air Force Reserve Tip Off Tournament).
