Virginia Cavaliers (0-5, 0-2 ACC) at RV/ No. 25 Virginia Tech Hokies (6-1, 1-1 ACC)

Sunday, Dec. 20, 12 p.m., Cassell Coliseum, Blacksburg, Va.

- Virginia is coming off a 69-51 loss at Florida State last Sunday
- The game was tied at halftime, but the Seminoles went on a 26-3 run against the short-handed Cavaliers in the second half
- In its previous three games, UVA chipped away at a big deficit but came up short of victory. The Tigers led by 18 points in the second period, a deficit UVA got down to seven in the fourth quarter. Against JMU (Dec. 3), the Dukes led by 17 in the third period and 13 in the fourth with the Cavaliers making it a three-point game late in the fourth quarter. Against ECU (Nov. 29), the Cavaliers were in a 21-point hole in the second quarter, coming back to tie the game before losing on a three-pointer in the final seconds of the game
- Redshirt sophomore guard Amandine Toi has led the team in scoring in each of the last four games. After scoring zero points in the opener Toi was one point shy of her previous career high with 12 against ECU and then had 17 and 23 point performances against JMU and Clemson followed by 18 points at Florida State
- She ranks fifth in the ACC in scoring in conference games at 20.5 points per game
- Toi is averaging 3.0 three-pointers per game (ranking fourth in the ACC) and is shooting 45.5 percent from beyond the arc (ranking sixth)
- Toi is 10-of-18 (55.6 percent) from three-point range in the last two games. She missed her first six attempts of the season but since making her first three in the 3rd quarter of the ECU game, Toi is 15-of-27 (55.5 percent) from long range
- Toi (38.6) and Carole Miller (36.7) are ranked No. 1 and No. 2 in the ACC in minutes per game
- Freshman guard Kaydan Lawson made her first collegiate start at Florida State. Virginia has had 10 student-athletes appear in games this season, nine of whom have now made at least one start
- Lawson leads the team in free throw attempts (18) and free throw percentage (14-of-18, 77.8 percent)
- Meg Jefferson, whose status is still day-to-day, had led the ACC and was ranked as high as seventh in the NCAA in shooting percentage with a 73.3 percent efficiency (17-of-22), but no longer has enough attempts to qualify in the rankings. She has been sidelined with an injury since after the JMU game

Players' individual phone numbers will not be given to the media at any time. Game day interviews will not be granted until the postgame press conference opportunity. Please give a minimum of 24 hours notice for all interview requests.

- The Cavaliers had to cancel the Dec. 6 contest at George Washington due to a depleted roster. Freshman Nycerra Minnis is out for the season with a leg injury. Junior Dani Lawson has been sidelined since the pre-season with a leg injury and will be out for an extended period of time. Tihana Stojasavljevic suffered a leg injury in the season-opener at UCF and will miss the remainder of the season. Meg Jefferson and Deja Bristol both sustained injuries in the game against James Madison. Additionally, Dylan Horton has opted out of playing the remainder of the season, reducing UVA's available player pool to just six student-athletes
- Bristol returned to the court for the game against Clemson without technically missing a game. She also returned to the starting lineup, making her second start of the season
- London Clarkson, a transfer from Florida State who was supposed to be sitting out the season, received waivers for immediate eligibility from the NCAA and ACC. Her first game will be at Virginia Tech on Dec. 20

- Virginia Tech is receiving votes in the AP poll and is tied for 25th in the USA Today Coaches Poll
- The Hokies are coming off an 84-78 loss at Notre Dame on Thursday. Point guard Georgia Amooore had a career-best 23 points in the game and center Elizabeth Kitley registered a game-high 25 points and pulled down seven rebounds
- Virginia Tech leads the ACC in blocked shots (35) and is fourth in per game average (5.8)
- The Hokies lead the ACC in all offensive three-point shooting categories, ranking fifth in the NCAA in made-threes-per game (11.4)
- Virginia Tech has made 80 three-pointers in seven games. UVA has made 22 in five games with Amandine Toi accounting for 15 of those
- UVA leads the all-time series 51-14
- Virginia has won six of the last eight meetings, including last year's 86-76 victory in Blacksburg in which UVA The Cavaliers jumped out to a 13-point lead in the first quarter, but the Hokies came back to take a one-point lead at the beginning of the fourth quarter. Virginia shot over seventy percent from the field in the final 10 minutes to outscore Virginia Tech 22-13 and log the 10-point victory

- Virginia will have an almost entire new look this season with the return of just two starters from last year's lineup: Carole Miller, who started 26 of 30 games and Amandine Toi who started 28
- Miller averaged 6.0 points per game with 3.6 rebounds per game in her rookie season with five double-digit scoring performances, including a 19-point game against Clemson
- Toi is a fourth-year student at the University, on track to receive her B.A. in French in May, but athletically is a redshirt sophomore after being sidelined in 2017-18 with a knee injury and 2018-19 after suffering an injury to her other knee
- In her delayed rookie campaign last season, Toi averaged 4.3 points and 1.0 rebounds per game, hitting 26 three-pointers while shooting 32.1 percent from long range
- There is not a single member of the current team who played for the Cavaliers any time before last season. Toi and Dani Lawson were both on the roster in 2018-19 (and Toi in 2017-18), but neither played
- The team also has an influx of new faces, led by freshman guard Kaydan Lawson, Dani's younger sister. She averaged 18.0 points, 8.0 rebounds and 3.1 steals per game her senior season of high school playing in the greater Cleveland metro area
- Guard Aaliyah Pitts was the 2018-19 Virginia 6A State Player of the Year at Woodbridge High before playing her senior season at Bishop McNamara in Maryland just outside of Washington, D.C. Pitts was ranked No. 29 at her position by ESPNW in the site's recruiting rankings



HEAD COACH TINA THOMPSON QUICK FACTS

- Third season at Virginia; third season as a head coach
- Previously spent three seasons on coaching staff at Texas, elevated to associate head coach in her final season
- Inducted into the Naismith Hall of Fame on Sept. 7, 2018
- Enshrined in the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame on June 9, 2018
- Olympic Gold Medalist in Athens in 2004 and 2008 in Beijing. Also won a gold at the 1998 World Cup in Germany and a bronze in 2006 in Brazil
- 4× WNBA champion (1997–2000)
- 9× WNBA All-Star (1999–2003, 2006, 2007, 2009, 2013)
- WNBA All-Star Game MVP (2000)
- 3× All-WNBA First Team (1997, 1998, 2004)
- 4× All-WNBA Second Team (1999–2002)
- First player selected in the first WNBA Draft (1997) by the Houston Comets
- First WNBA player to have 7,000 points and 3,000 rebounds
- Was the WNBA's all-time leading scorer at the time of her retirement (2013) with 7,488 points in 496 games played (15.1 ppg)
- She finished her collegiate career ranked fifth on Southern California's career lists in scoring (2,248 points) and (1,168 rebounds)

2020-21 VIRGINIA CAVALIERS (CONTINUED)

- Forward Deja Bristol was a member of the 2019 GEICO National Champion New Hope team and helped lead the squad to a runner-up finish at the NACA National Championships her senior season when she averaged 12 points and 10 rebounds per game
- Forward London Clarkson was supposed to sit the season out after transferring from FSU, but has been granted a waiver of immediate eligibility. Last season, Clarkson appeared in 25 of FSU's 32 games, averaging 1.2 points, 1.4 rebounds, shooting 43.8 percent (7-of-16) from the floor in 7.5 minutes per game. As a senior at Pflugerville High School, she averaged 17.3 points, 10.0 rebounds, 2.9 steals and 2.1 assists per game, leading her team to the Class 5A regional quarterfinals while earning All-Central Texas First Team honors. She was ranked 68th nationally and eighth in the state of Texas by Prospects Nation, while earning a No. 93 overall rank by Max Preps
- Guard Zaria Johnson, from Houston, Texas, averaged 13.0 points and 5.9 rebounds per game during her senior season, and was ranked No. 37 at her position by ESPNW in the site's recruiting rankings
- The Cavaliers also added a walk-on grad transfer in Charlottesville native Emily Maupin. She played two seasons at Elon (2017-19) before transferring to Liberty, but sat out the 2019-20 season at Liberty and never played for the Flames. She graduated as The Covenant School's all-time leading scorer with 2,256 points and also grabbed 1,778 rebounds
- As a sophomore at Elon, Maupin was named to the All-CAA third team after pacing the Phoenix in both points (11.7 ppg) and rebounds (6.0 rpg), while shooting 47.3 percent from the field with three double-doubles
- UVA graduated four players; Jocelyn Willoughby, Dominique Toussaint, Lisa Jablonowski and Felicia Aiyeotan (though Aiyeotan did not play at all last season due to a medical condition)
- A pair of freshmen from 2019-20, Shemera Williams and Kylie Kornegay-Lucas, are no longer members of the team

WHERE ARE THEY NOW - CLASS OF 2020

- Jocelyn Willoughby was a first-round draft pick in the WNBA, playing this season for the New York Liberty. She played in all 22 games, with five starts, in about 17 minutes per game, she averaged 5.7 points and 2.4 rebounds. She shot 40.5 percent from 3-point range and had season highs of 21 points (against Los Angeles), nine rebounds (against Phoenix), three assists (against Chicago), and three steals (against Atlanta)
- Willoughby began playing for Hapoel Petah-Tikva in the Israeli DI League at the end of November
- Lisa Jablonowski is playing for Costa Masnaga in the Italian Serie A1 League. She is averaging 9.3 points, 5.3 rebounds and 2.2 assists per game
- Dominique Toussaint signed to play for Tindastoll in Iceland's DI League, but has since moved on to play for Eisvogel USC Freiburg (DBBL) in Germany
- Felicia Aiyeotan, who had her playing career come to an end because of a

medical issue, is a graduate assistant at Evansville

WNBA TIES

- The Virginia coaching staff has quite the WNBA flair. In addition to Tina Thompson, associate head coach Karleen Thompson (no relation) is a coaching veteran in the WNBA with the Houston Comets, Los Angeles Sparks and most recently with the Atlanta Dream. Assistant coach Monica Wright played for the Minnesota Lynx and the Seattle Storm. In her final season, she was the WNBA Player Association Secretary-Treasurer. Strength & Conditioning coach Jeremy Golden was the head strength coach for the LA Sparks
- WNBA Titles: Tina Thompson, 4 (Houston Comets, 1997-00), Monica Wright, 2 (Minnesota 2011, 2013), Karleen Thompson, 2 (LA Sparks 2001-02)
- Karleen Thompson joined the coaching staff of the Houston Comets in 2005, serving as an assistant coach for two seasons before being promoted to head coach and acting general manager from 2007-08. Before coaching with the Comets, Karleen Thompson spent eight years in the Los Angeles Sparks organization. She joined the Sparks in 1997. In 2004, she served as interim co-head coach following the mid-season departure of Michael Cooper to join the staff of the Denver Nuggets of the NBA. Karleen Thompson helped the Sparks to WNBA titles in 2001 and 2002

LOOKING BACK AT THE 2019-20 SEASON

- Virginia (13-17) finished the regular-season in a tie with Notre Dame for ninth place in the ACC at 8-10. By virtue of a tiebreaker (UVA's victory over the Irish in the regular season), the Cavaliers were the No. 9 seed in the tournament, earning a first-round bye, before falling to Syracuse in the 8/9 game
- The Cavaliers had an exciting 66-63 home victory over Duke. Virginia went on a 14-0 run between the first and second quarters and converted 11 consecutive field goal attempts to build up a 14-point lead in the first half. Duke outscored the Cavaliers 24-13 in the third quarter to take a five-point advantage into the fourth quarter. Virginia trailed by eight with 3:31 remaining when it mounted a 13-1 run to build up a four-point lead with seven seconds remaining and held on for its first conference win.
- The Cavaliers followed up their Duke win with a 17-point road win at Boston College, holding the high-scoring Eagles to 26.5 points below their season average
- Virginia's biggest victory of the year was a 90-60 domination of Notre Dame. It was the most points the Cavaliers scored last season and was the largest margin of victory over an ACC team since topping Virginia Tech by 49, 76-27, on Jan. 26, 2017
- UVA had back-to-back double-digit victories over Syracuse and Clemson, including holding the Orange to 41 points, its fewest scored in a game since falling to Rutgers, 68-40 on Feb. 14, 2007. The 41 points was the fewest points allowed by the Virginia defense this season
- The Cavaliers erased a 22-point deficit to come back and defeat Miami, 69-64, thanks to the second-half heroics of Jocelyn Willoughby (25 points, 19 in the second half) and Dominique Toussaint (16 points, 14 in the second half). It was the Cavaliers' fourth-consecutive victory on the home court
- The Cavaliers played the toughest schedule in the nation during non-conference play. Virginia also had an RPI of 20 heading into ACC play. Virginia continued to hold the top spot on the strength of schedule chart until Feb. 10 when the Cavaliers were finally edged by Oklahoma
- The Cavaliers were led by two of the most prolific scorers in program history. Jocely Willoughby ended her career ranked No. 9 on the career scoring list with 1,677 points and sixth in rebounding with 868. Dominique Toussaint finished her career ranked No. 20 on the career scoring list with 1,321 points, while also ranking in the top-10 in career assists (T-9th, 390) and made three-pointers (T-10th, 131)
- Willoughby led the ACC in scoring last season, averaging 19.2 points per game. She is the second player in program history to finish the season as the conference's scoring leader, joining Monica Wright who did so in both her junior (2009) and senior (2010) seasons
- Willoughby was named to the CoSIDA Academic All-America Division I women's basketball third team. She was one of 15 players nationally to be named an academic All-American. She is the seventh player in program history to earn the honor and the first to do so since Jenny Boucek in 1996
- Willoughby was last year's Kay Yow Award winner, honoring the ACC Women's Basketball Scholar-Athlete of the Year. She was the first player in program history to win this award

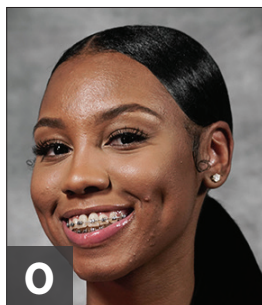

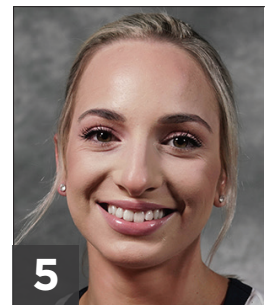
