FOR OPENERS

- · No. 16 Virginia (4-1) aims for its second win against a top-ranked opponent in school history.
- The Cavaliers return to the Lone Star state for the first time since posting wins over SMU (76-73) and Missouri State (83-63) at the 2013 Corpus Christi Challenge.
- · UVA is 145-39 against nonconference foes under Tony Bennett.

ALL-TIME VS. TOP-RANKED OPPONENTS

- · Virginia is 1-30 all-time vs. top ranked opponents.
- •The Cavaliers posted an 86-73 against then-No. 1 North Carolina on Jan. 30, 1986, at University Hall in Charlottesville.
- · UVA is meeting its first top-ranked opponent since dropping a 72-70 decision at then-No. 1 Duke on Jan. 19, 2019.
- ·Tony Bennett is 0-3 vs. top-ranked foes at Virginia with losses coming to then-No. 1 Duke (76-60 in 2011), Villanova (61-59 in 2017) and Duke (72-70 in 2019).
- · Bennett was 0-2 against top-ranked opponents at Washington State, dropping a 55-52 decision to then-No. 1 UCLA in 2006 and 68-47 loss top-ranked North Carolina in the 2008 NCAA Sweet 16.

ALL-TIME VS. GONZAGA

- \cdot Virginia is 1-2 all-time in the series that dates back to the 2000-01 season.
- The Cavaliers defeated the Bulldogs 108-87 in the last meeting on Jan. 3, 2007, in Charlottesville.
- · Gonzaga earned an 86-85 first-round victory in the 2001 NCAA Tournament and an 80-69 win on Dec. 17, 2005, in Spokane, Wash
- Tony Bennett was 2-1 all-time vs. Gonzaga as head coach at Washington State, including wins in 2006 (77-67) and 2007 (51-47) and a loss in 2008 (74-52).

LAST TIME VS. THE BULLDOGS

- · Sean Singletary scored 37 points as Virginia topped Gonzaga 108-87 at John Paul Jones Arena on Jan. 3, 2007.
- · Mamadi Diane added 22 points and J.R. Reynolds added 15 and Jamil Tucker chipped in 12.
- $\cdot \text{The Cavaliers}$ drilled 12 of 20 3-pointers en route to a 60-26 halftime lead.
- · UVA forced 19 turnovers and finished with a school-record 18 3-pointers.
- · Derek Raivio led the Bulldogs with 26 points and Sean Mallon added 16.

HOO ARE THESE CAVALIERS?

- Sam Hauser leads the team in scoring (13.0), second in rebounding (6.0) and is shooting 56.3 percent from the field and 43.5 percent from 3-point range (10 of 23).
- · Kihei Clark has chipped in 7.2 points per game and a teamleading 3.0 assists.
- · Jay Huff is averaging 11.6 points, a team-high 6.2 rebounds and team-best 2.6 blocks per game.
- · Trey Murphy III has reached double figures in scoring in three games and is third on the team in scoring at 11.6 points per game.
- Reece Beekman has 10 assists and team-high eight steals.
- · Justin McKoy has started four games and is averaging 4.6 points and 3.2 rebounds.
- · Casey Morsell (5.2 ppg), Tomas Woldetensae (37.5% 3FG) and Kody Stattmann (4.7 ppg, 2.3 rpg) have shared minutes on the perimeter, while Kadin Shedrick (4.9 ppg & 3.6 rpg) has averaged 11.6 minutes off the bench in the frontcourt.

LAST TIME OUT

- •Trey Murphy III scored 15 points and Kadin Shedrick added 10 as No. 16 Virginia rolled to a 76-40 win over William & Mary on Dec. 22 at John Paul Jones Arena.
- · Sam Hauser and Jay Huff each added nine points in the win.
- The Cavaliers jumped to a 36-14 halftime lead on 55.6 percent shooting.
- · UVA limited William & Mary to 28 percent shooting, including 3 of 17 from 3-point range.
- · Yuri Covington led the Tribe (2-3) with 12 points.

UVA RANKED NO. 16 IN LATEST AP POLL

- \cdot Virginia is ranked No. 16 in the latest Associated Press poll and No. 15 in the USA Today Coaches' poll.
- · UVA was ranked No. 4 in both preseason polls, marking its third AP preseason top-5 ranking in school history (No. 1 in 1982-83 and No. 5 in 2018-19).
- \cdot UVA has been ranked in the top 25 in the preseason rankings in nine of the past 10 seasons.
- · UVA has been ranked in the top 25 of the AP poll for the eighth straight week over the past two seasons.

GETTING OFFENSIVE IN 2020

- · UVA has scored 70 or more points in four of its five games.
- $\ \, \cdot \text{The Cavaliers scored 70 or more points twice last season (78 vs. Boston College and 73 vs. Louisville). }$
- · UVA's 89 points against Towson were its most since scoring 100 against Marshall during the 2018-19 season.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Three-time National and four-time ACC Coach of the Year Tony Bennett has a 281-97 (.743) mark in 12 seasons at Virginia and 350-130 (.729) career mark in 15 seasons.
- \cdot Bennett led the Cavaliers to their eighth straight season with 23 or more wins in 2019-20.
- · In 2018-19, Bennett led the Cavaliers to their first NCAA national championship, a share of their ninth ACC regular-season title and school-record 35 wins.
- · Bennett became the 80th active Division I head coach to win his 300th career game against Marshall on Dec. 31, 2018.
- Bennett was named the USBWA Henry Iba National Coach of the Year for the third time in 2018 to rank second all-time behind legendary John Wooden, who captured the award six times.
- He has led UVA to outright ACC regular-season and tournament championships in the same season two times (2014 and 2018).
 Bennett guided UVA to six straight NCAA Tournament appear-
- ances from 2014-19 for the first time in school history and has led UVA to 29 or more wins in five of the past seven seasons.
- · Bennett is the sixth coach in ACC history to win at least three outright ACC regular-season titles (Frank McGuire, Vic Bubas, Dean Smith, Mike Krzyzewski and Roy Williams).
- · Bennett has led UVA to a school-best 16 or more ACC wins in four of the last six seasons and a school-record eight straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- · He has led UVA to a school-best nine straight 20-win seasons.
- · Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons two times (2014-16, 2017-19 & 2018-20).
- Bennett led UVA to nine consecutive postseason appearances (2012-19) and six consecutive NCAA tournaments (2014-19).
 Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back to back seasons.
- · Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons two times (2014-2015 and 2018-19).
- · UVA is 136-58 (.701) in ACC play (77-20 at home & 59-38 away), 159-29 (.846) at home and 145-39 (.788) in non-conference action (82-7 at JPJ) under Bennett.
- · Bennett ranks fifth all-time in winning percentage at .701, among ACC head coaches with 100 or more ACC regular-season wins

UVA VS. THE WEST COAST CONFERENCE

- · UVA meets its second foe from the West Coast Conference, dropping a 61-60 decision to San Francisco.
- •The Cavaliers are 6-5 all-time vs. current WCC members (3-1 vs. BYU, 2-0 vs. LMU, 0-1 vs. San Francisco and 1-2 vs. Gonzaga).
- Tony Bennett was 3-2 all-time vs. the WCC as head coach at Washington State (2-1 vs. Gonzaga, 1-0 vs. Portland and 0-1 vs. St. Mary's).

TRIO OF CAVALIERS MAKING IMMEDIATE IMPACT

- · Sam Hauser, Reece Beekman and Trey Murphy III have made immediate impacts for the Cavaliers in 2020-21.
- · Hauser, who played three seasons at Marquette, has reached double figures in four games, shooting 56.3 percent from the field and 43.5 percent from 3-point range.
- · Beekman, who made his first career start vs. Saint Francis (Pa.), tallied 11 points against San Francisco and is tied for third on the team in minutes (22.2).
- · Murphy III transferred to Virginia after the 2019-20 season and received his NCAA waiver on Nov. 24.
- · Murphy III had a game-high 21 points in his UVA debut, recording his eighth career 20-point effort and tying a career-high with six 3-pointers off the bench.
- · Murphy III led the Cavaliers with 15 points vs. William & Mary.
- · Murphy leads UVA in 3-point shooting at 53.3 percent (11 of 21).

OUR DEFENSE NEVER RESTS

- · UVA has limited each of its five opponents to 64 or fewer points in 2020-21.
- ·The Cavaliers are limiting their foes to 54 points (4th nationally) and 36.3 percent field goal shooting (15th nationally) and seven shot clock violations.
- · In 2019-20, UVA captured its sixth NCAA scoring defense title after limiting opponents to 52.4 points per game.
- · UVA limited 12 opponents to fewer than 50 points, one opponent (Duke) to 50 points and four foes to fewer than 40 points.
- •The Cavaliers limited five opponents (Syracuse, JMU, Columbia, Maine and Virginia Tech) to fewer than 50 points, 29 percent or less field goal shooting and 29 percent or less 3-point shooting.
- · UVA held 23 opponents below 41 percent from the field.
- ·The Cavaliers forced 27 shot clock violations and outrebounded

VIRGINIA PICKED FIRST IN THE ACC

- · Virginia was selected first in the ACC Operation Basketball 2020-21 Preseason Poll.
- The Cavaliers were named the Preseason ACC favorite for the first time since 1982-83 and second time in the 52-year history of the league poll.
- · Virginia was followed Duke, Florida State, North Carolina and Louisville in the top five.
- · ACC preseason voters selected Syracuse sixth, followed by Miami, NC State, Georgia Tech and Clemson. Virginia Tech was picked 11th, while Notre Dame, Pitt, Boston College and Wake Forest rounded out the voting.
- •The Cavaliers have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in 11 of the last 12 seasons.

HAUSER AND CLARK EARN PRESEASON ALL-ACC HONORS

- · Sam Hauser was named to the preseason All-ACC first team, while Kihei Clark was named to the second team.
- · Hauser was joined on the first team by preseason ACC Player of the Year Garrison Brooks (North Carolina), Scottie Barnes (Florida State), Jalen Johnson (Duke), Aamir Simms (Clemson) and Chris Lykes (Miami).
- · Clark was joined on the preseason All-ACC second team by David Johnson (Louisville), Jose Alvarado (Georgia Tech), M.J. Walker (Florida State) and Wendell Moore Jr. (Duke).

WATCH ME NOW

- · Kihei Clark (Bob Cousy Award), Sam Hauser (Julius Erving Award) and Jay Huff (Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Award) were named to Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame preseason award top-20 watch lists
- · The Cousy Award honors the nation's top point guard, while the Erving Award honors the top small forward and Abdul-Jabbar the top center.
- · Clark was named to the Cousy Award top-20 watch list last season.
- \cdot Hauser was one of 50 players named to the preseason watch list for the 2021 Jersey Mike's Naismith Trophy Watch List for Men's Player of the Year.
- · Hauser was one of 20 players named to the preseason watch list for the 2021 NABC Division I Player of the Year.
- · Hauser was one of 50 players named to the preseason watch list for the 2021 Wooden Award, honoring the nation's top player.

- \cdot Virginia is 198-45 (.815), including a 3-0 mark in 2020-21, in 15 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- · UVA was 14-3 at JPJ in 2019-20 and is 159-29 (.846), including a 125-14 (.899) mark the past nine seasons, under Bennett.
- · Virginia is an ACC-leading 65-8 (.890) in league home games over the past eight seasons. Duke is second at 64-9 (.877).
- \cdot UVA has won 11 or more home games for 11 straight seasons.
