OPENING DRAW

GAME OVERVIEW

- Virginia opens up the 2021 men's lacrosse season on Saturday against the Towson Tigers at Klöckner Stadium. Faceoff is set for 4 p.m.
- Virginia is ranked No. 5 in the preseason USILA coaches poll and No. 6 in the preseason Inside Lacrosse media poll.

THE SERIES VS. TOWSON

- Virginia leads the all-time series by an 13-3 margin.
- The Cavaliers have won the last 10 match-ups, their third-longest active winning streak against a Division I opponent (VMI 25, Drexel 11, UMass 8). A win on Saturday will put UVA's active win streak over Towson into a tie for second with Drexel (11).
- The schools met on an annual basis from 1972-77, but did not meet again until the 1991 NCAA Tournament, a game Towson won 14-13 in Charlottesville.
- Ten years passed before the annual series resumed in 2001 with a 12-8 Cavalier victory in what proved to be the biggest defeat the Tigers suffered in a season when they advanced to Championship Weekend.

VIRGINIA IN SEASON OPENERS

- UVA is 52-34-1 (.603) all-time in season openers.
- When the season opener is at home, the Cavaliers have compiled a 30-17-1 (.635) record throughout the years.
- This is the 14th time in the last 22 seasons the Cavaliers have opened the season at home. The Cavaliers are 17-17 (.500) when the season opener is on the road.
- UVA has won 11 of its last 13 season openers.



Jared Connors is a preseason first-team All-American at LSM. He enters 2021 with 25 career points on 16 goals and nine assists.

COVERING THE CAVALIERS

UNIQUELY UVA

The University of Virginia is an institution rich with history and tradition. Here is some of the terminology that contributes to UVA's culture.

Grounds: The term used by students, faculty and alumni to refer to the University dating as far back as Thomas Jefferson. "Campus" is never used.

First Year, Second Year, Third Year, Fourth Year: Instead of freshman, sophomore, junior, senior. Why you may ask? To be a "senior" implies that a person has reached the final phase of learning, a feat that Thomas Jefferson believed to be impossible, arguing instead that education is a life-long process.

Commonwealth: Virginia is one of four constituent states of the United States of America that officially uses the name "Commonwealth" instead of the word state in all references. The other three commonwealths are Kentucky, Massachusetts and Pennsylvania.

UNIVERSITY NICKNAMES

Virginia's athletics teams have been accompanied by a somewhat confusing array of nicknames. The most prominent and widely accepted of these monikers are "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos."

Although the terms "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are used almost interchangeably to refer to University teams and players, "Cavaliers" is more often used by the media, while "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are frequently used by Virginia students and fans.

Legend has it that Washington & Lee baseball fans dubbed the Virginia players "Wahoos" during the fiercely contested rivalry that existed between the two in-state schools in the 1890s. By 1940, "Wahoos"

was in general use around Grounds to denote University students or events relating to them. The abbreviated "Hoos" sprang up later in student newspapers and has gained growing popularity in recent years.

THE CAVALIER MASCOT

The costumed Cavalier with a large character head debuted during Virginia's 1984 football season and has remained the official mascot of the University.

UNIVERSITY COLORS

Orange and blue were adopted as the University of Virginia's official athletic colors at a mass student meeting in 1888. UVA athletic teams had previously worn silver gray and cardinal red, but those colors did not stand out on muddy football fields, prompting a student movement to change them.

One of the students attending the mass meeting was Allen Potts, a star athlete who played on Virginia's first football team in 1888. Potts showed up at the meeting wearing a navy blue-and-orange scarf that he had acquired during a summer boating expedition at Oxford University. Orange and blue were chosen as the official athletic colors after one of Potts' fellow students pulled the scarf off Potts' neck and, waving it to the crowd, yelled, "How will this do?" UVA later served as the inspiration for schools like Auburn and Florida when they selected school colors.

WAH-HOO-WAH

The origin of "Wah-hoo-wah" is uncertain. The cheer was used to root on Virginia teams as early as 1890 and may have been borrowed from Dartmouth College, whose athletics teams were once known as the Indians.

Legend attributes the yell to Natalie Floyd Otey, who sang the ballad "Where'er You Are, There Shall My Love Be" at Charlottesville's Levy Opera House in 1893. The predominantly student audience noticed that Otey warbled the first three words of the song between each of the stanzas and decided to join in the refrain. By evening's end, goes the legend, the crowd had corrupted "Where'er You Are" into "Wah-hoo-wah."

The Levy Opera House stands at the corner of High Street and Park Street and has since been renovated into an office building.

MORE ON THE TOWSON SERIES

- UVA played every year from 2001-10 before the series went on hiatus following UVA's 15-9 win at Towson in 2010.
- Two of Towson's three victories have been by one-goal (1977, '91). The Tigers' three wins have been by an average of 2.0 goals.

HOLDING THE LEAD

- During Virginia's current 10-game winning streak over Towson, the Cavaliers have outscored the Tigers 129-50.
- One of the characteristics of UVA's winning streak has been an ability to get and maintain a lead.
- In the last 10 meetings Towson has only had four brief leads (2002, '04, '07, '10).
- The Tigers have also had the added whammy of several long scoring droughts.
- In the last 10 meetings they have had 20 scoring droughts of 10+ minutes (ranging from 10:00 to 43:22).
- Towson's lead of 33:29 in the 2004 game is by far its longest lead time in the last 10 games.

LAST MEETING: 2010 (UNITAS STADIUM)

- The then-No. 1 Virginia Cavaliers overcame a first quarter deficit and rode four goals from Chris Bocklet and four points from Brian Carroll to handily defeat the Towson Tigers, 15-10, the last time these teams met (March 21, 2010).
- Trailing, 4-2, after one quarter of play, the Cavaliers stormed out to a 7-4 advantage after scoring four goals in the first 3:33 of the second quarter enroute to five straight scores.
- Chris Bocklet led the way with four goals for the Cavaliers, while Brian Carroll scored two goals and dished out two assists. Steele Stanwick and Chris LaPierre each scored two goals and dished an assist in the winning cause.

UVA ON THE GREEN GRASS OF KLÖCKNER

- Virginia owns a 151-40 (.7906) all-time record at Klöckner Stadium, including a 4-1 mark in 2020 and are winners of 13 of last 15 played in the historic edifice. UVA also is 12-3 all-time at Klöckner Stadium in the NCAA Tournament.
- UVA is 24-8 all-time at Klöckner Stadium under head coach Lars Tiffany.
- Klöckner Stadium first hosted lacrosse in 1993.

CAVALIERS WELCOME THREE SENIORS USING THE NCAA'S COVID YEAR

- Virginia welcomes two seniors back and one graduate transfer that are utilizing the NCAA's extra year due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- M Dox Aitken and LSM Jared Conners, both first-team USILA All-Americans in 2019, return for their fifth year on Grounds.
- UVA welcomes grad transfer Charlie Bertrand from Merrimack College. Bertrand was the 2018 and 2019 DII National Player of the Year after leading Merrimack to back-to-back NCAA titles.
- Bertrand appeared in 58 career games for Merrimack, scoring 210 goals, dishing out 64 assists and notching 274 points for a career. Merrimack made the jump to DI in 2020 and Bertrand scored 18 goals and dished five assists for 23 points in just six games in 2020 before the season was canceled due to the pandemic.

AITKEN RETURNS TO UVA AFTER FOOTBALL STINT AT VILLANOVA

- Aitken, who graduated from UVA last May with a degree in foreign affairs, enrolled last fall at Villanova to play football.
- With uncertainty of being able to play a full FCS schedule this spring, Aitken was able to transfer back for the men's lacrosse season.

BERTRAND HAS A POINT IN 58-STRAIGHT GAMES

- Charlie Bertrand has a point in all 58 games of his career, which ranks No. 1 among active DI players.

BERTRAND WAS A GOAL-SCORING MACHINE AT MERRIMACK

- Charlie Bertrand scored 210 goals over 58 career games at Merrimack from 2017-20, which includes at least one in all 58 career games.
- In 53 of his 58 career games (91.4) he scored at least two goals, while in 42 of his 58 career games (72.4) he scored at least three goals.

CONNERS AND FOX REPEAT AS TEAM CAPTAINS IN 2021

- Virginia men's lacrosse head coach Lars Tiffany announced that long-stick midfielder Jared Conners and midfielder John Fox have been selected as captains for the 2021 season, as voted on by their peers.
- Conners and Fox repeat as captains. It makes just the fourth time that UVA has had at least two repeat captains. In 1971 and 1972 it was Jay Connor and Bob Proutt, while in 1985 and 1986 it was Roddy Marino and Jeff Nicklas. Most recently, it was Conor Gill and Mark Koontz in 2001 and 2002.

UVA'S BIG FOUR ON OFFENSE

- Virginia has four players with an active point streak of 20+ games, making the Cavaliers the only team with at least three players on its roster with active streaks of 20+ games with at least one point.
- Charlie Bertrand ranks No. 1 in the nation at 58 games, while Ian Laviano ranks No. 7 with a streak of 36 games. Matt Moore is No. 9 in the nation with a streak of 33 games and Dox Aitken is No. 19 in the nation with a streak of 28 games with at least one point.

CAVALIER ROSTER BOASTS STUDENT-ATHLETES FROM ALL OVER USA

- UVA's roster of 48 players hail from 13 different states and also Canada.
- UVA has five players from the state of California, which is the same amount from the traditional hotbed of Maryland. The five from California is the most on a single team in program history from the "Sunshine State."
- UVA's roster by state: New York (10), Pennsylvania (7), California (5), Maryland (5), Virginia (5), Connecticut (3), New Jersey (3), Georgia (2), Texas (2), Florida (1), Massachusetts (1), Minnesota (1), North Carolina (1) and Ontario, Canada (1).

UVA'S RIDING GAME

- In 2020 Virginia was No. 2 in the nation in riding, limiting its opponents to .737 clearing. Bucknell as No. 1 in the nation at .690.
- UVA was No. 2 in the nation in 2019 at .711, trailing only Cleveland State (.707).

BERTRAND AND MOORE GOAL-SCORING STREAKS

- Grad transfer Charlie Bertrand has scored at least one goal in all 58 of his career collegiate games. It is the longest active streak of all DI players entering 2021.
- Matt Moore has a goal in 27-straight games, which ranks No. 7 among active players.
- Moore's streak started at Loyola in the first round of the 2018 NCAA Tournament.
