## LEADING OFF

- When Virginia opens the 2021 season against No. 14 Georgia it will be the first time for UVA to open with a ranked opponent since 2016 vs. No. 9 Oregon (L, 11-6) in Arizona.
- Virginia and Georgia have faced off one time at the FAU First Pitch Classic in 2019. The Bulldogs were ranked No. 6 at the time and won that meeting in Florida.
- The Cavaliers have never faced the South Alabama Jaguars on the softball diamond.
- Both UGA games at the Red & Black Showcase will be streamed on SEC Network+ online.
- Virginia has opened the season on the road every year since 1995 when the Cavaliers hosted Charlotte, Ohio and UConn in the North/South Classic.
- The Cavaliers return nine position players from last season who started at least 18 games.
- Virginia also returns four pitchers who accounted for 136.2 of 151.1 innings pitched.

## HOO TO WATCH

### DONNA FRIEDMAN • JR • C/1B

- Led the Cavaliers in batting average last season, hitting at a .324 clip in 22 games.
- The top returner in RBI heading into the 2020 season, she led the team in RBI last season with 13 through her 22 games.
- Turned in a .991 fielding percentage as a sophomore with only one error in 2020.
- Tied for the team lead a year ago with three home runs in the shortened season.
- Tallied a .507 slugging percentage as she notched seven extra-bases in her 23 hits with four doubles and the trio of home runs.



## PALMER PARK

- Virginia opened its new stadium, Palmer Park, on March 3, 2020 against JMU. Palmer Park is named after former Cavalier pitcher Lisa Palmer and her mother Fran. The Palmers were the lead contributors to the stadium project.
- The Cavaliers hosted a dedication ceremony for Palmer Park prior to Virginia's matchup against Virginia Tech on Friday, March 6, 2020.
- Palmer Park is a state-of-the-art facility which houses all of the Cavaliers' needs. Within the confines of Palmer Park is the team locker room and lounge, athletic training room, meeting rooms and a brand new indoor facility.
- Lisa Palmer pitched for the Cavaliers from 1986-89, establishing school records in wins (74), innings pitched (861.2), complete games (102) and games started (112). She still holds the UVA single-season records for wins (27), shutouts (14) and assists (221).

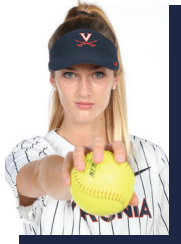

## NOTING THE HOOS

**HOOS BACK**

- Virginia returns 18 players from a year ago and nine position players who made at least 18 starts through the 22 games played.
- At the plate, Virginia's returning players accounted for all 14 home runs and 77-of-78 RBI. The returning crew scored all 89 runs last season for the Cavaliers.
- In the circle, Virginia's returning staff accounted for 136.2 innings of work out of 151.1 last season.
- That group of four returning hurlers amassed 140-of-148 strikeouts.

**NEW FACES IN THE CROWD**

- Virginia welcomed five signees to Grounds for the 2021 campaign that comprised a top-30 recruiting class.
- Among the signees were three players ranked among the top 100 recruits with Leah Boggs (No. 55), Madison Harris (No. 91) and Lauren VanAssche (No. 95).
- Virginia also added a transfer prior to the start of the 2021 campaign with Gabby Baylog from Coastal Carolina.

**HOOS NEW IN THE CIRCLE**

- Virginia welcomes a pair of new faces to the circle this season with the addition of Madison Harris and Mikayla Houge.
- Harris was the No. 91 overall recruit in the 2020 class and was a member of the inaugural Team USA U17 squad in the 2019 Pan-American Games - striking out 22 batters in 11 innings as the US won gold.
- Houge was the 2019 Iowa Gatorade HS Player of the Year and the Ames Tribune Female Athlete of the Year. She was also a four-time All-State selection with 103 career wins and 1,102 career strikeouts.
- Hogue also earned NFCA High School All-America honors as she was selected to the first team.

**A NEW FOE IN OPENING WEEKEND**

- Virginia and South Alabama face off for the first time when they meet in game two of the Red & Black Showcase on Saturday.
- Virginia has faced five teams from the Sun Belt in program history and is 19-17 all-time against teams from the league.
- The Cavaliers have faced five current members of the Sun Belt with at least six games against four of those opponents: App State, Coastal Carolina, Georgia State and Louisiana.

**SCHEDULE CHANGES FOR 2021**

- The schedule will look a little different for the 2021 season as programs and leagues around the country work to mitigate the COVID-19 pandemic and protect student-athlete welfare.
- The ACC announced it will play a 38 game schedule with teams playing four-game series throughout the year that includes single games on Friday and Sunday along with Saturday doubleheaders.
- In addition to the four-game series format, the second weekend of the season will feature competition in pod format to bring teams to one area.

- As part of the pod format, the Cavaliers will face Louisville and Pittsburgh in ACC contests at Duke and NC State. The games will count in the ACC standings despite being played at a neutral site.
- The Hoos do not see Florida State or Virginia Tech as part of the ACC schedule this season.

**CHALLENGING SCHEDULE AWAITS UVA**

- Virginia will face a challenging slate as part of its 50-game schedule this season.
- The Cavaliers open up the year with No. 14 Georgia and will face the Bulldogs twice in the opening weekend.
- As part of the 50-game slate, the Cavaliers are set to play 19 games against teams ranked or receiving votes in the preseason NFCA coaches poll.

**HOOS AND HOKIES GO NON-CON**

- Virginia will play limited non-conference action this season with only 12 games outside of league competition and only four in the midweek.
- With the Hoos and Hokies not meeting as part of the ACC schedule this season, the squads will meet twice in non-conference matchups with one game at each stadium.

**SWIPING BAGS IN 2020**

- With 28 stolen bases, the Cavaliers have already swiped the most bags since 2016 when the Hoos tallied 56 steals.
- Virginia was 28-for-32 on stolen base attempts.
- Bailey Winscott (Clinton, Miss.) was a perfect 7-for-7 in stolen base attempts to lead Virginia.
- Tori Gilbert was a perfect 5-for-5 in steal attempts.
- Ten different Cavaliers recorded a stolen base last season.

**AVILLA AT THE PLATE**

- After playing sparingly in her first two seasons on Grounds, junior outfielder Savana Avilla found a home at the top of the Virginia order in 2020.
- Avilla had a career-best 11-game streak to open the season a year ago.
- Avilla's nine RBI were more than her first two seasons combined as were her 20 hits.
- She helped pace the Hoos with five multi-hit games.
- Avilla hit her first career home run against Georgetown on Feb. 15.

**FRIEDMAN PROVIDES POP FOR HOOS**

- Junior Donna Friedman has provided pop for the Cavaliers as she has played catcher and DP.
- Friedman led the squad with a .324 batting average a year ago and a team-leading 13 RBI through 22 games.
- Her 23 hits last year was one off her freshman total in 20 fewer games - though she did drive in 19 runs on 24 hits in that freshman campaign.
- Friedman also tied for the team lead in home runs with three in that time.

**RAYLE RACKED UP K'S IN 2020**

- Sophomore Aly Rayle got off to a hot start in the circle, amassing 74 strikeouts in a shortened 2020.
- Averaging 9.0 strikeouts per seven innings, Rayle was second among ACC hurlers and 50th nationally in the category.
- Rayle was just six strikeouts away from matching her 2019 season total when the season was canceled.
- Rayle also ranked among ACC leaders by holding opponents to just a .188 average a year ago.

**UVA SIGNS NO. 31 CLASS FOR 2021**

- Virginia head coach Joanna Hardin followed up on the recruiting success for the 2020 class with another strong class for 2021.
- The Cavaliers signed six players for 2021, including four players ranked among the top 50 nationally which tied Virginia for the most top-50 recruits in the ACC for the 2021 signing class.
- Kailyn Jones (OF) is the No. 22 recruit overall and a top-10 outfielder. She hit .495 at Grayson High School this past season and has been an All-State selection.
- Shelby Barbee (Util.) is the No. 28 player and helped lead her high school to the North Carolina state championship and twice earned All-State honors.
- Reece Holbrook (IF) is the No. 45 player and has been an All-State selection as she helped lead Wesleyan High School to a pair of Georgia state championships.
- Sydney Hartgove (C) is the No. 48 player and is also a two-time All-State selection who hit above .400 as both a freshman and a sophomore.

**FAREWELL TO THE PARK**

- Since 1995, Virginia softball called The Park its picturesque home. The Cavaliers played their final games ever at the facility on April 30, 2019.
- Virginia played 478 games at The Park finishing 260-218 (.544) all-time at The Park.
- The Cavaliers closed The Park in ceremonious fashion, no-hitting Hampton in final game.
- Virginia moved to its new home at Palmer Park in the 2020 season right before the season was canceled, playing six games there through eight days in March.
- There were 718 fans on hand at Palmer Park for the first game played there against James Madison on March 3, 2020.

**WHAT A SEND-OFF**

- In its final game ever at The Park, Virginia closed the facility in style by no-hitting Hampton.
- Ally Frei tossed the first no-hitter in her career and the first solo no-hitter by a Virginia pitcher since 2009.
- In over 480 games at The Park over 25 years, the facility saw just three Cavalier no-hitters.
