FOR OPENERS

- No. 21 Virginia (15-6) hosts Miami (7-15) during Senior Day on Monday, March 1.
- Seniors Jay Huff, Sam Hauser, Tomas Woldetensae and Austin Katstra, and managers Matt Palumbo and Carter Furr will be honored prior to the game.
- UVA is second in the ACC at 11-4, while Miami is 15th at 3-14.
- UVA aims for its fourth consecutive win in the series.
- As of Feb. 28, Virginia ranks third nationally in personal fouls per game (13.1) and turnovers per game (9.6), fifth in free throw percentage (80.1%), seventh in scoring defense (60.6), eighth in 3-point field goal percentage (39.3%), 16th in assist/turnover ratio (1.47) and 28th in field goal percentage (48.4%).
- Tomas Woldetensae returns to action after missing two games due to contact tracing.

ALL-TIME VS. MIAMI

- Virginia is 12-12 all-time vs. Miami in the series that began in 1965-66.
- The Cavaliers are 7-4 against the Hurricanes in Charlottesville, including a 56-46 win at JPJ in 2018-19.
- Eleven of the last 12 meetings between the teams have been decided by 10 points or less.
- Virginia has limited Miami to 54 or fewer points in the last four meetings.
- Head coach Tony Bennett is 9-6 all-time against Miami.

LAST TIME VS. THE HURRICANES

- Jay Huff scored then-No. 22 Virginia's first 17 points in a 46-44 win at Miami on March 4, 2020.
- Mamadi Diakite added 14 points and 10 rebounds for his third double-double as the Cavaliers improved to 22-7, 14-5 ACC.
- Chris Lykes led Miami (14-15, 6-13 ACC) with 16 points before leaving the second half with an injury.
- Huff made seven of his first nine shots, and added nine boards.
- Kihei Clark's (7 points, 4 assists) two free throws with 8.6 seconds left gave UVA the win.
- UVA outrebounded Miami 33-30.

A WIN VS. MIAMI WOULD GIVE UVA:

- Twelve or more ACC wins for the fourth straight year.
- A four-game winning streak vs. the Hurricanes.
- Its eighth win in Charlottesville vs. Miami and 13th win in the series.
- Head coach Tony Bennett a 10-6 record vs. Miami.
- A 10-1 home record (7-1 ACC).

HOW ARE THESE CAVALIERS?

- Kihei Clark, Sam Hauser and Jay Huff lead the Cavaliers into action against Miami.
- Clark, who has handed out six or more assists in seven contests, has averaged 10.2 points and team-high 4.5 assists.
- Hauser leads the team in scoring (15.1 ppg) and rebounding (7.0 rpg), and is shooting 51.4 percent from the field, 44.4 percent from 3-point range and 85.3 percent from the foul line.
- Huff leads the team in blocked shots (2.4 bpg) and is second in scoring (13.3 ppg) and rebounding (6.8 rpg).
- Trey Murphy III (11.3 ppg) leads UVA in free throw shooting (90.3%) and 3-point shooting (48.3%), and is second with 42 3-pointers.
- Reece Beekman has a team-high 26 steals.
- Tomas Woldetensae (44.4 3FG%) provides bench scoring, while Casey Morsell (5.1 ppg) is UVA's top perimeter defender.
- Justin McKoy (3.3 ppg and 2.7 rpg) and Kadin Shedrick (2.5 ppg & 2.2 rpg) have added depth.

GETTING OFFENSIVE IN 2020

- Virginia has scored 70 or more points in 10 games (9-1) and is averaging 69.2 points per game.
- UVA is shooting 49 percent from the field, best since 49.1 percent in 2015-16.
- UVA's 89 points against Towson were its most since scoring 100 against Marshall during the 2018-19 season.
- UVA ranks fifth nationally in 3-point field goal percentage (40%), 11th in free throw percentage (78.9%) and 20th in field goal percentage (49%).
- UVA's 78.9 percent free throw shooting is its best in school history, while its 40 percent 3-point shooting ranks second.

LAST TIME OUT

- Cam Hayes tallied 16 points and DJ Funderburk added 14 as NC State defeated then-No. 15 Virginia 68-61 on Wednesday, Feb. 24 at John Paul Jones Arena.
- Sam Hauser led Virginia (15-6, 11-4 ACC) with 21 points, while Jay Huff added 19 points, 11 rebounds and five blocked shots.
- NC State raced to a 17-4 lead, but the Cavaliers pulled ahead 35-33 before the Wolfpack pulled away for the win.
- NC State outrebounded Virginia, 31-30, and made 23 of 28 free throws in the win.
- UVA shot 37 percent from the field, but was 14 of 14 from the foul line.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Dean and Markel Families Head Men's Basketball Coach Tony Bennett has a 292-102 (.741) mark in 12 seasons at Virginia and 361-135 (.728) career mark in 15 seasons.
- With the Feb. 13 win over North Carolina, Bennett became just the third coach in ACC men's basketball history to lead his program to 10-straight winning conference seasons, joining Dean Smith and Mike Krzyzewski.
- In 2018-19, Bennett led the Cavaliers to their first NCAA national championship, a share of their ninth ACC regular-season title and school-record 35 wins.
- The three-time National and four-time ACC Coach of the Year led the Cavaliers to their eighth straight season with 23 or more wins in 2019-20.
- Bennett became the 80th active Division I head coach to win his 300th career game against Marshall on Dec. 31, 2018.
- Bennett was named the USBWA Henry Iba National Coach of the Year for the third time in 2018 to rank second all-time behind legendary John Wooden, who captured the award six times.
- He has led UVA to outright ACC regular-season and tournament championships in the same season two times (2014 and 2018).
- Bennett guided UVA to six straight NCAA Tournament appearances from 2014-19 for the first time in school history and has led UVA to 29 or more wins in five of the past seven seasons.
- Bennett is the sixth coach in ACC history to win at least three outright ACC regular-season titles (Frank McGuire, Vic Bubas, Dean Smith, Mike Krzyzewski and Roy Williams).
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-best 16 or more ACC wins in four of the last six seasons and a school-record nine straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- He has led UVA to a school-best nine straight 20-win seasons.
- Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons two times (2014-16, 2017-19 & 2018-20).
- Bennett led UVA to nine consecutive postseason appearances (2012-19) and six consecutive NCAA tournaments (2014-19).
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons two times (2014-2015 and 2018-19).
- UVA is 147-62 (.703) in ACC play (83-21 at home & 64-41 away), 163-29 (.849) at home and 145-40 (.784) in non-conference action (82-7 at JPJ) under Bennett.
- Bennett ranks third all-time in winning percentage (.703) among ACC head coaches with 100 or more ACC regular-season wins.

TRANSFERS MAKING IMMEDIATE IMPACT

- Transfers Sam Hauser and Trey Murphy III have made immediate impacts for the Cavaliers in 2020-21.
- Hauser, who played three seasons at Marquette, leads UVA in scoring (15.3 ppg) and 3-pointers (53), and second in rebounding (6.8 rpg).
- Hauser has reached double figures in 19 games, including a season-high 23 points vs. Pitt, 22 points vs. Georgia Tech, 21 vs. NC State and Syracuse, and 19 points against Towson and Duke.
- Hauser registered three straight double-doubles (13 points & 10 rebounds at Notre Dame, 16 points & 11 rebounds vs. Wake Forest and 17 points and 10 rebounds at Boston College).
- Hauser leads the ACC in 3-point percentage (44.4%) and has made 36 of his last 68 3-point attempts (52.9%), including a career-high tying seven against the Orange.
- Murphy III transferred to Virginia from Rice after the 2019-20 season and received his NCAA waiver on Nov. 24.
- Murphy III had a game-high 21 points in his UVA debut, recording his eighth career 20-point effort and tying a career-high with six 3-pointers off the bench.
- Murphy III, who has reached double figures in 13 games, led the Cavaliers with 18 points at Georgia Tech and tied for team high with 18 at NC State.
- Murphy leads UVA in free throw shooting (90.3%) and 3-point shooting (46.2%), and is second with 42 3-pointers.

OUR DEFENSE NEVER RESTS

- UVA has limited 14 opponents to 64 or fewer points and four foes to fewer than 50.
- The Cavaliers are limiting their opponents to 60.6 points per game, which ranks seventh nationally.
- UVA has forced 16 shot clock violations.
- UVA has limited 11 opponents to 40 percent or less field goal shooting and outrebounded 11 opponents.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense seven times and finished in the top-five nationally 11 times.

UVA RANKED NO. 21 IN LATEST AP POLL

- Virginia is ranked No. 21 in the latest Associated Press poll.
- UVA has been ranked in the top 25 of the AP poll for 17 straight weeks over the past two seasons.
- UVA was ranked No. 4 in both preseason polls, marking its third AP preseason top-5 ranking in school history (No. 1 in 1982-83 and No. 5 in 2018-19).
- UVA has been ranked in the top 25 in the preseason rankings in nine of the past 10 seasons.

FOUR CAVALIERS AMONG ACC LEADERS

- As of Feb. 28, Jay Huff ranks first in the ACC in field goal percentage (.605), second in blocked shots (2.5), 13th in rebounding (7.0) and 19th in scoring (13.6).
- Sam Hauser ranks first in 3-point percentage (.445) and made 3-pointers (2.52), sixth in field goal percentage (.509), ninth in scoring (15.3) and 14th in rebounding (6.8).
- Kihei Clark ranks third in assists (4.6) and fourth in assist/turnover ratio (2.0).
- Trey Murphy III ranks 10th in made 3-pointers (2.0).

RECORDS WATCH

- Jay Huff ranks third at UVA with 153 career blocked shots.
- Huff needs four blocked shots to pass Mamadi Diakite (156 blocked shots from 2017-20) for second on the list.
- Huff leads the Cavaliers with 53 blocked shots and his 61 blocked shots in 2019-20 led the team and rank seventh on UVA's all-time single-season list.
- Huff has 43 career multi-block games, including 16 last season and 16 this season.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Virginia is 204-46 (.816), including a 9-1 mark in 2020-21, in 15 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- NC State ended UVA's 15-game winning streak with a 68-61 decision at JPJ on Feb. 24, 2021.
- UVA was 14-3 at JPJ in 2019-20 and is 163-30 (.845), including a 129-15 (.896) mark the past nine seasons, under Bennett.
- Virginia is an ACC-leading 71-9 (.888) in league home games over the past nine seasons. Duke is second at 70-11 (.864).
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for 11 straight seasons.

UVA VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

- UVA is 1-3 vs. ranked opponents, dropping a 98-75 decision to top-ranked Gonzaga, defeating then-No. 12 Clemson, losing at then-No. 20 Virginia Tech and then-No. 16 Florida State.
- The Cavaliers were 4-2 against ranked opponents in 2019-20.
- UVA is 47-38 against ranked opponents in the Tony Bennett era.
- UVA's 11 ranked wins in 2018-19 marked a school record.
- UVA is 160-333 vs. ranked opponents since 1953-54.
- UVA is 1-31 all-time vs. No. 1-ranked opponents (86-73 win vs. No. 1 North Carolina on Jan. 30, 1986).

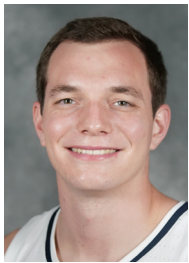
