

## LEADING OFF

· Virginia enters the midweek matchup with the Hokies after splitting the weekend series with NC State at home last weekend - taking games one and three of the weekend series. •The meeting between the two teams on Wednesday is designated as a non-conference

contest as the squads won't meet as part of the ACC schedule. It's the first in a home-and home non-conference series set up between the two teams.

· Aly Rayle made her first start of the season in game one of the series with NC State after returning to the lineup against Clemson in relief. She struck out nine and picked up the win in a complete-game outing in her return in game one against the Wolfpack.

· Virginia Tech leads the all-time series 46-22 and lead the series 20-8 in games played in Blacksburg. UVA last won in the middle game of the 2017 series with a 9-8 victory at home.

## HOO TO WATCH

## **KATIE GOLDBERG • SO • IF**

· Katie Goldberg enters the weekend as one of the top offensive producers for the Hoos with a .329 batting average to date.

· Goldberg leads the team with seven multiplehit games and is tied for the team lead with four multiple-RBI games.

• The sophomore has a nine-game hit streak entering game three of the series vs. NC State. · She leads the squad in runs (12) and RBI (12) and is tied for second in home runs (3). · She hit .429 for the series at Duke and this past weekend with NC State hit her first career triple - a three-RBI hit.



## PALMER PARK

• Virginia opened its new stadium, Palmer Park, on March 3, 2020 against JMU. Palmer Park is named after former Cavalier pitcher Lisa Palmer and her mother Fran. The Palmers were the lead contributors to the stadium project.

 The Cavaliers hosted a dedication ceremony for Palmer Park prior to Virginia's matchup against Virginia Tech on Friday, March 6, 2020.

 Palmer Park is a state-of-the-art facility which houses all of the Cavaliers' needs. Within the confines of Palmer Park is the team locker room and lounge, athletic training room, meeting rooms and a brand new indoor facility.

• Lisa Palmer pitched for the Cavaliers from 1986-89, establishing school records in wins (74), innings pitched (861.2), complete games (102) and games started (112). She still holds the UVA single-season records for wins (27), shutouts (14) and assists (221).



## NOTING THE HOOS

#### TRIO LEAD UVA IN OPENING WEEKEND

· Kate Covington, Donna Friedman and Katie Goldberg led the Hoos at the plate in the opening weeked as the trio hit for power and average.

•The three players all hit over .400 and combined for two doubles, three home runs, four runs scored and eight RBI.

· In all, the three players provided eight of the 11 hits on the weekend and eight of the nine RBI.

#### **HOOS BACK**

·Virginia returns 18 players from a year ago and nine position players who made at least 18 starts through the 22 games played.

· At the plate, Virginia's returning players accounted for all 14 home runs and 77-of-78 RBI. The returning crew scored all 89 runs last season for the Cavaliers. • In the circle, Virginia's returning staff accounted for

136.2 innings of work out of 151.1 last season. •That group of four returning hurlers amassed 140-of-148 strikeouts.

#### **NEW FACES IN THE CROWD**

·Virginia welcomed five signees to Grounds for the 2021 campaign that comprised a top-30 recruiting class. • Among the signees were three players ranked among the top 100 recruits with Leah Boggs (No. 55), Madison Harris (No. 91) and Lauren VanAssche (No. 95). · Virginia also added a transfer prior to the start of the 2021 campaign with Gabby Baylog from Coastal Carolina.

#### **HOOS NEW IN THE CIRCLE**

· Virginia welcomes a pair of new faces to the circle this season with the addition of Madison Harris and Mikayla Houge.

· Harris was the No. 91 overall recruit in the 2020 class and was a member of the inaugural Team USA U17 squad in the 2019 Pan-American Games - striking out 22 batters in 11 innings as the US won gold.

· Houge was the 2019 Iowa Gatorade HS Player of the Year and the Ames Tribune Female Athlete of the Year. She was also a four-time All-State selection with 103 career wins and 1,102 career strikeouts.

· Hogue also earned NFCA High School All-America honors as she was selected to the first team.

## **SCHEDULE CHANGES FOR 2021**

•The schedule will look a little different for the 2021 season as programs and leagues around the country work to mitigate the COVID-19 pandemic and protect student-athlete welfare.

• The ACC announced it will play a 38 game schedule with teams playing four-game series throughout the year that includes single games on Friday and Sunday along with Saturday doubleheaders.

· In addition to the four-game series format, the second weekend of the season will feature competition in pod format to bring teams to one area.

·As part of the pod format, the Cavaliers will face Louisville and Pittsburgh in ACC contests at Duke and

NC State. The games will count in the ACC standings despite being played a a neutral site. • The Hoos do not see Florida State or Virginia Tech as

part of the ACC schedule this season.

## **COVINGTON COMES THROUGH AT UGA**

· Kate Covington came up with perhaps the biggest hit of her career in the 6th inning against South Alabama on Saturday (2/13)

· Covington broke open a 4-4 game with the Jaguars when she hit her first career grand slam to vault the Cavaliers to an 8-4 lead.

• The grand slam was part of a six-run inning for the Cavaliers who trailed 4-3 after 5.5 innings of play. Virginia would go on to win the game 9-4.

#### ...AND AGAIN AGAINST PITTSBURGH

· Covington again came through with a powerful shot in the arm for the Hoos in the finale against Pitt with a three-run home run.

· Covington's three-run shot snapped a 3-3 tie and vaulted the Hoos into the lead as Virginia would go on to clinch the series with a 12-3 win last Sunday. · Both of Covington's home runs have come in tie games and launched the Cavaliers on to victory so far this seaosn.

#### **HOGUE'S 12 STRIKEOUT OUTING**

· Mikayla Houge's 12 strikeout performance agianst Pitt helped the right-hander pick up her first win. · It was the most strikeouts against an ACC foe since Melanie Mitchell fanned 13 vs. BC on March 30, 2013. · Houge retired the first 13 batters faced and struck out eight batters in that time against Pitt.

#### **SWIPING BAGS**

• With 28 steals in 2020, the Cavaliers swiped the most bags since 2016 when UVA tallied 56 steals.

· Virginia was 28-for-32 on stolen base attempts in 2020 · Bailey Winscott (Clinton, Miss.) was a perfect 7-for-7 in stolen base attempts to lead Virginia.

- · Tori Gilbert was a perfect 5-for-5 in steal attempts. • Ten different Cavaliers recorded a stolen base in 2020.

• This season, the Cavaliers are already 20-for-24 in steal attempts with Goldberg 4-4 and Gilbert 3-3.

· Winscott has continued to be efficient in steal attempts this year, going 5-for-7 and is a 16-of-18 for her career.

#### WEAVER MAKES MOST OF STARTS

· Freshman Abby Weaver broke into the starting lineup at 3B in the final two games of the Duke series and made the most of her chances.

·Weaver went 2-for-5 with a run scored in game two on Saturday, a 10-9 loss in nine innings to the Blue Devils. · She continued her streak at the plate in the finale, going 2-for-2 with two runs scored and an RBI off her first collegiate home run.

· Against NC State last weekend, she hit. 375 as she went 3-for-8 with two runs scored and an RBI. She also added three walks, was hit by a pitch and went 1-1 in steal attempts vs. the Wolfpack.

#### FRIEDMAN PROVIDES POP FOR HOOS

· Junior Donna Friedman has provided pop for the Cavaliers as she has played catcher and DP.

Friedman led the squad with a .324 batting average a year ago and a team-leading 13 RBI through 22 games.
Her 23 hits last year was one off her freshman total in 20 fewer games - though she did drive in 19 runs on 24 hits in that freshman campaign.

• Friedman also tied for the team lead in home runs with three in that time.

• She picked up right where she left off in 2021, notching a first-pitch home run in the first inning of

UVA's season-opener at No. 14 Georgia.

•The sophomore has three home runs this season and is tied for second on the team with 11 RBI.

#### **RAYLE RACKED UP K'S IN 2020**

• Aly Rayle got off to a hot start in the circle as a sophomore, amassing 74 strikeouts in a shortened 2020.

• Averaging 9.0 strikeouts per seven innings, Rayle was second among ACC hurlers and 50th nationally in the category.

• Rayle was just six strikeouts away from matching her 2019 season total when the season was canceled.

• Rayle also ranked among ACC leaders by holding opponents to just a .188 average a year ago.

• She saw her first action of the 2021 season when she came to the circle in relief in game one against Clemson last weekend and twice in relief at Duke.

#### UVA SIGNS NO. 31 CLASS FOR 2021

• Virginia head coach Joanna Hardin followed up on the recruiting success for the 2020 class with another strong class for 2021.

• The Cavaliers signed six players for 2021, including four players ranked among the top 50 nationally which tied Virginia for the most top-50 recruits in the ACC for the 2021 signing class.

• Kailyn Jones (OF) is the No. 22 recruit overall and a top-10 outfielder. She hit .495 at Grayson High School this past season and has been an All-State selection. • Shelby Barbee (Util.) is the No. 28 player and helped lead her high school to the North Carolina state championship and twice earned All-State honors. • Reece Holbrook (IF) is the No. 45 player and has been an All-State selection as she helped lead Wesleyan High School to a pair of Georgia state championships. • Sydney Hartgove (C) is the No. 48 player and is also a two-time All-State selection who hit above .400 as both a freshman and a sophomore.

#### **MURPHY COMES UP BIG VS. GW**

 $\cdot$  Morgan Murphy made an immediate impact in the weekend of the Cavalier Classic.

• The sophomore picked up her first win in the circle in game one against the Colonials, working 6.2 innings and striking out six in the 3-2 win.

In game two against George Washington, Murphy went
 3-for-5 at the plate and drove in the game-winning run with a walk-off double to score Donna Friedman in the ninth inning.

#### **CHALLENGING SCHEDULE AWAITS UVA**

 $\cdot Virginia \ will face a challenging slate as part of its 50-game schedule this season.$ 

• The Cavaliers open up the year with No. 14 Georgia and will face the Bulldogs twice in the opening weekend. • As part of the 50-game slate, the Cavaliers are set to play 19 games against teams ranked or receiving votes in the preseason NFCA coaches poll.

#### HOOS AND HOKIES GO NON-CON

Virginia will play limited non-conference action this season with only 12 games outside of league competition and only four in the midweek.
With the Hoos and Hokies not meeting as part of the ACC schedule this season, the squads will meet twice in non-conference matchups with one game at each stadium.
