### LB, Luke Masterson:

# On what led them to believe they'd be able to get pressure on the quarterback

"We've been working these pressures all camp and all season. The coaches have done a great job every week in dialing stuff up. It was just kind of a matter of time before we brought it home and I'm really glad it worked out today."

# On the impact of the fourth down stop early in the game
