On breaking out of a slow start to the game

"Yeah, I think in the first half I was trying to push the tempo and in my mind I was pushing it, I was just moving a little too fast, wasn't when things slow down wasn't reading too much just kind of trying to push. Yeah, once we got to the second half, I wasn't pleased with what happened in the first half, so I just started to slow things down like Coach Mendenhall mentioned before. That last drive felt the best. I felt like I was looking over, reading through my reads, seeing everything I needed to see. But yeah, just the first game, figured we'd come out a little bit faster, but we didn't. That's not something we got to fix this coming week against Illinois."

On the defense stepping up when the offense was feeling slow

"Yeah, it turns into a shootout and I'm happy our defense did that, I mean that's what their goal is. They said they're gonna try to get a shout out every week, and they did that. That takes a lot of stress off us, especially when we weren't clicking in the first half, you know, we weren't scoring, they had us, the defense kept us, you know twice, and like on our 30 and we didn't score there, two times. So that was frustrating, but they kept battling, they kept doing their part, and yet so we finally kicked it on and got some points to make it a little bit easier for them to relax and start playing."

On looking towards the Illinois matchup

"Yeah, it was a good little icebreaker this week. Now we start getting to a Power Five, Big 10 conference with Illinois. I'm excited just to go and continue to get better this next week; figure out what we need to work on. Obviously start faster. I'm excited to see what our guys do next week."

WR Demick Starling

On his touchdown scored

"I think that play is also something that we practice a lot. I just read the defense and when I saw the ball was in the air, all I could think was touchdown. I just wanted to take my opportunity and make the best of it."

On offensive performance tonight

"Our offense has a lot of weapons. You know, like I said, in practice we get into our rhythm a lot. After coming in from half time and seeing us making plays, that's what we do naturally.
