OUICK KICKS

UVA remained No. 2 in the rankings for the fourth consecutive week after win over #17 Notre Dame The match with Notre Dame was the sixth against a top-20 team this season. UVA is 4-1-1 in the six games against top-20 teams this season and has one left at top-ranked FSU next week.

Diana Ordoñez leads UVA in goals (11) and points (24). She has 87 points - 10th all-time at UVA. **Ordoñez** is sixth at UVA in career goals (38) after her goal against Louisville on Thursday night. **Ordoñez** entered the week ranked fifth in active D1 players in points per game for her career (1.57) and tied for fourth in goals per game (0.69). She has a goal or assist in eight of the last 11 games. Haley Hopkins tied a career high with five points (2G, 1A) at Syracuse - including the game winner and hit the game winner vs. the Irish. She has three goals and two assists in the last four games. Alexa Spaanstra came up big for the Hoos in the last four games with a brace at BC, an assist at Syracuse, a goal and an assist in the 2-1 vs. No. 17 Notre Dame and an asisst vs. Louisville. **Spaanstra** is 9th all-time at UVA in assists and now has 27 assists for her career after Louisville. She was named the ACC Co-Offensive Player of the Week following the Notre Dame win. Laurel Ivory entered the week tied as the NCAA active leader in career shutouts in all divisions (40). **Ivory** has 64 career wins and is five shy of tying the UVA record set by Morgan Stearns (2013-16).

Lia Godfrey leads UVA in assists (11) passing her ACC-leading total from 2020. She has a goal or an assist in 10 of the last 13 matches and has a goal and five assists in the last four games. Godfrey and Ordoñez are among the ACC leaders with Godfrey tied for first in assists (11) and second in assists/game (0.69). Ordoñez is tied for first in goals (11) and third in goals/game (0.69). **Spaanstra** is tied for eighth in points (19) and fourth in assists (7) in the ACC.

WHO'S BACK FOR THE HOOS?

- · UVA returns 17 letterwinners and seven starters from last year's squad that advanced to a 26th straight NCAA Tournament
- Back are five players who earned post-season honors from the ACC forward Alexa Spaanstra earned first team honors, while forwards Rebecca Jarrett and Diana Ordoñez, and midfielder Lia Godfrey were second team honorees. Samar Guidry earned All-Freshman team honors along with Godfrey.
- · Godfrey also earned All-America honors to lead a group of players to earn honors from the United Soccer Coaches
- · In addition to Godfrey, Ordoñez and Spaanstra were both All-Region selections by the United Soccer Coaches last season
- · UVA returners contributed 38-of-40 goals scored (95%) a year ago and 31-of-34 assists (91%)
- -Among those are the top five goal scorers Ordoñez (12), Spaanstra (10), Jarrett (4), Godfrey (4) and **Claire Constant** (3) and the top assist leaders Godfrey (9), Ordoñez (5), Lizzy Sieracki (4) and Jarrett (3).

HOOS WELCOME SIX FRESHMEN FOR 2021

- ·The Cavaliers brought in six freshmen as part of the 2021 newcomer class to Grounds this fall
- · Among those players were three ranked in the top 200 nationally by Top Drawer Soccer midfielder Madeline Simpson (No. 49), defender Kiki Maki (No. 170) and midfielder Charlotte McClure (No. 186)
- · Also part of the class is forward Degen Miller who was named the Colorado Gatorade Player of the Year after tallying 43 goals and 16 assists as a senior
- · A pair of goalkeepers round out the freshman crop with Camryn Miller who earned Regional Player of the Year honors and Ally Reynolds who earned Top Drawer Soccer DA Playoff standout recognition

ALL-AMERICAN TRANSFER JOINS CAVALIER PROGRAM

- · In addition to the six freshmen, the Cavaliers also added a grad transfer with two-time All-American forward Haley Hopkins
- · Hopkins comes to the Virginia program with two years of eligibility remaining after graduating from Vanderbilt
- · She finished her career with 34 goals second all-time on the career goal scoring list for in Commodore program history
- · Of her 34 goals, 14 were game-winning goal and she added 12 assists for a total of 80 points in her career
- · Hopkins was named the Southeastern Conference Freshman of the Year in 2018 and earned All-America honors in 2018 and this past season.

IVORY AND CAVALIERS' EXTENDED SHUTOUT STREAK SNAPPED AGAINST GEORGE WASHINGTON

- ·The Hoos entered the 2021 season riding a shutout streak after posting four clean sheets on a run to the NCAA semifinal
- · Laurel Ivory and UVA posted 459:35 scoreless minutes dating back to the NCAA opener against SIUE to close the year
- · After shut outs in the first three games, the Hoos went 776:41 minutes between goals surrendered
- •That stretch of 776:41 was the third longest in program history and passed the last stretch of 775:01 set in 2019
- · Ivory's streak of 665:06 shutout minutes is fourth all-time at UVA Ivory has four of the top eight performances
- ·The fifth-year keeper also holds the second longest shutout streak with 775:01 minutes set in the 2019 season

- ·Thursday's contest will be the regular-season finale and is set for broadcast on ACC Network at 7 p.m.

HOOS PICKED TO FINISH THIRD IN ACC PRESEASON POLL

- ·The Cavaliers were picked to finish third in the ACC in a presasson vote of league coaches this season
- · Virginia received one first place vote and tallied 148 points picked behind Florida State and North Carolina
- · Florida State was picked to claim the league title, while North Carolina was picked to finish second
- ·The Cavaliers finished third in the ACC regular-season standings a year ago and advanced to the College Cup

PRESEASON ALL-ACC HONOREES

- · UVA had sophomore midfielder Lia Godfrey and senior forward Alexa Spaanstra named to the preseason All-ACC team
- · Spaanstra was a first team All-ACC selection a year ago and was named an All-Region selection
- · Godfrey earned All-America honors and was the ACC Freshman of the Year last season after leading the league in assists (9)
- ·The preseason All-ACC team was made up of 11 players and featured players from five different teams

IVORY CLIMBING THE RANKS IN THE RECORD BOOK

- · In her fifth season, goalkeeper Laurel Ivory is closing in on the top spots in the history books at UVA
- · Currently, Ivory is second all-time at UVA in shutouts with 40 solo shutouts in her career
- · With 64 wins, Ivory is second all-time in victories as a keeper at UVA she has a 64-16-12 record for her career

- · Responding after a loss has been a trend for the Cavaliers throughout Steve Swanson's tenure at UVA

- · UVA head coach Steve Swanson hit a rare milestone vs. NC State (10/25/18), hitting the 400 career win mark
- ·As a head coach, Swanson holds a 447-162-63 record through stops at Dartmouth, Stanford and Virginia
- · Currently only a handful of D1 coaches have hit the 400 win milestone with seven of them currently active
- · Swanson is one of only nine coaches who has recorded 400 wins all at a D1 institution
- \cdot In his coaching career, he has taken all three teams to league titles and the NCAA Tournament

SWANSON GRABS HIS 300TH WIN AS UVA HEAD COACH

- · Head Coach Steve Swanson picked up his 300th wins as the head coach of the Cavaliers vs. Liberty (8/25/19)
- · Currently, Swanson holds a 341-99-52 record as UVA head coach and is 137-48-21 in ACC matches
- · He has 21 consecutive winning seasons at Virginia and 29 overall as a head coach

- · Midfielder Sydney Zandi and defender Talia Staude got involved in the offensive production for the Hoos at NC State
- · Sydney Zandi scored the opening goal for the Hoos marking her first goal since the 2019 NCAA Tournament opener vs. Radford
- · Staude then secured the win for the Hoos when she hit the game-winning goal in the 90th minute of play
- · It was Staude's second career goal and the first game-winning goal of her Virginia career
- · With the duo getting in on the action, UVA now has 11 players who have tallied goals and 11 players who have assists

CAVALIERS EXPLODE FOR BURST OF GOALS AT SYRACUSE

- •The Virginia offense exploded for a burst of goals at Syracuse scoring five goals in under 12 minutes
- · Haley Hopkins started the scoring off a service from Lia Godfrey in the 55th minute
- · Hopkins would notch two goals and an assist in a seven minutes stretch as part of the flurry for goals
- · Godfrey would also add a goal in that stretch when Hopkins found her in the 61st minute to put UVA up 3-0
- · Four different players scored goals in that flurry of offensive output while a different player assisted on each of the five goals

- · Alexa Spaanstra was named ACC Co-Offensive Player of the Week after a goal and assist in a win over No. 17 Notre Dame
- · Spaanstra started the scoring for the Hoos with a goal in the 82nd minute for her sixth goal of the season
- · She followed it up with an assist on what proved to be the game-winning goal 37 seconds later connecting with Hopkins
- · Spaanstra played the full 90 minutes in the win over the Irish and kept the Hoos as one of two unbeaten teams in ACC play

ORDOÑEZ BREAKING INTO THE RECORD BOOK IN YEAR THREE AS A HOO

- · Diana Ordoñez is climbing up the UVA offensive record books, breaking into the top 10 in goals scored in her third season
- · Currently, the junior forward has 38 goals which is sixth all-time passing midfielder Alexis Shaffer (2013-16)
- \cdot Ordoñez is 10th in UVA history in career points as she currently holds 87 points for her career
- · She is also in the top 10 in: career game-winning goals (T6th 13) and career multiple-goal games (T4 9)

SPAANSTRA ALSO CLIMBING IN THE OFFENSIVE RECORDS

- $\cdot \text{Alexa Spaanstra is another Cavalier making her way up the career record books at Virginia with Ivory and Ordoñez}$
- $\cdot Spaanstra\ moved\ into\ sole\ possession\ of\ ninth\ in\ career\ assists\ at\ UVA\ against\ Louisvilleand\ currently\ has\ 27\ for\ her\ career$
- \cdot She also is tied for eighth all-time at UVA in game-winning assists with nine matching a mark held by Tracy DiMillo
- · Spaanstra has 83 career points and is closing in on the top 10 all-time in career points for the Cavaliers

UNIQUELY UVA

The University of Virginia is an institution rich with history and tradition. Here is some of the terminology that contributes to UVA's culture.

- Grounds: The term used by students, faculty and alumni to refer to the University dating as far back as Thomas Jefferson: "Campus" is never used.
- · First Year, Second Year, Third Year, Fourth Year: Instead of freshman, sophomore, junior, senior. Why you may ask? To be a "senior" implies that a person has reached the final phase of learning, a feat that Thomas Jefferson believed to be impossible, arguing instead that education is a life-long process. This tends to be used less in athletic eligibility references.
- Commonwealth: Virginia is one of four constituent states of the United States of America that officially uses the name "Commonwealth" instead of the word state in all references. The other three commonwealths are Kentucky, Massachusetts and Pennsylvania.

UNIVERSITY NICKNAMES

- Virginia's athletics teams have been accompanied by a somewhat confusing array of nicknames. The most prominent and widely accepted of these monikers are "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos."
- Although the terms "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are used almost interchangeably to refer to University teams and players, "Cavaliers" is more often used by the media, while "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are frequently used by Virginia students and fans.
- Legend has it that Washington & Lee baseball fans dubbed the Virginia players "Wahoos" during the fiercely
 contested rivalry that existed between the two in-state schools in the 1890s. By 1940, "Wahoos" was in
 general use around Grounds to denote University students or events relating to them. The abbreviated "Hoos"
 sprang up later in student newspapers and has gained growing popularity in recent years.

THE CAVALIER MASCOT

•The costumed Cavalier with a large character head debuted during Virginia's 1984 football season and has remained the official mascot of the University.

UNIVERSITY COLORS: ORANGE AND BLUE

- Orange and blue were adopted as the University of Virginia's official athletic colors at a mass student meeting in 1888. UVA athletic teams had previously worn silver gray and cardinal red, but those colors did not stand out on muddy football fields, prompting a student movement to change them.
- One of the students attending the mass meeting was Allen Potts, a star athlete who played on Virginia's first football team in 1888. Potts showed up at the meeting wearing a navy blue-and-orange scarf that he had acquired during a summer boating expedition at Oxford University. Orange and blue were chosen as the official athletic colors after one of Potts' fellow students pulled the scarf off Potts' neck and, waving it to the crowd, yelled, "How will this do?" UVA later served as the inspiration for schools like Auburn and Florida when they selected school colors.

WAHOOWA

- The origin of "Wah-hoo-wah" is uncertain. The cheer was used to root on Virginia teams as early as 1890 and may have been borrowed from Dartmouth College, whose athletics teams were once known as the Indians.
- · Legend attributes the yell to Natalie Floyd Otey, who sang the ballad "Where'er You Are, There Shall My Love Be" at Charlottesville's Levy Opera House in 1893. The predominantly student audience noticed that Otey warbled the first three words of the song between each of the stanzas and decided to join in the refrain. By evening's end, goes the legend, the crowd had corrupted "Where'er You Are" into "Wah-hoo-wah."
