QUICK KICKS

After four straight weeks at No. 2, the Cavaliers took over the top spot in the rankings this week Virginia's match against Florida State will be its seventh against a top-20 team this season. The Cavaliers are 4-1-1 in games against top-20 opponents this season.

Diana Ordoñez leads UVA in goals (13) and points (29). She has 92 points - 8th all-time at UVA. She is tops in in the ACC in goals, points and leads the nation in game winning goals (6). **Ordoñez** is sixth at UVA in career goals (40) and one shy of tying Morgan Brian for fifth all-time. Ordoñez entered the week ranked fifth in active D1 players in points per game for her career (1.64) and tied for fourth in goals per game (0.71). She has a goal or assist in nine of the last 12 games. She was named ACC Co-Offensive Player of the Week for the second time at the start of the week. Haley Hopkins tied a career high with five points (2G, 1A) at Syracuse - including the game winner and hit the game winner vs. the Irish. She matched that with five points (2G, 1A) against Miami. Alexa Spaanstra came up big for UVA in the last five games with a brace at BC, an assist at Syrause, a goal and assist vs. No. 17 Notre Dame, an asisst vs. UL and a goal and assist vs. Miami. Spaanstra is tied for seventh all-time at UVA in assists and now has 28 assists for her career. **Laurel Ivory** entered the week tied as the NCAA active leader in career shutouts in all divisions (40). **Ivory** has 65 career wins and is four shy of tying the UVA record set by Morgan Stearns (2013-16). Lia Godfrey leads UVA in assists (12) passing her ACC-leading total from 2020. She has a goal or an assist in 11 of the last 14 matches and has a goal and six assists in the last four games. **Godfrey** is currently fourth among active D1 players in assists per game (0.55), fourth in total asists this season (12) and sixth in assists per game (0.71) this season.

THE SERIES WITH FLORIDA STATE

- · Virginia and Florida State meet for the 38th time when the teams face off on Thursday night
- ·The Cavaliers lead the all-time series 21-9-7 and are 6-2-3 in games played at Seminole Stadium
- · Florida State has come on strong in the last 10 years, picking up all nine victories in that time and lead 4-3-3 in the last 11
- ·Virginia won the last meeting in Tallahassee, taking a 1-0 victory in in overtime in the 2019 season
- ·This is the fifth time in the last 10 meetings that Florida State or Virginia has been ranked No. 1 at the time of the match
- · FSU held the top spot in the 2015 regular season meeting (10-25-15) and 2020 NCAA Tournament semifinal (5-13-21)
- · UVA held the top spot in both 2019 regular-season match (10-13-19) and the 2019 ACC Tournament semifinal (11-8-19)

CAVALIERS CLINCH AT LEAST SHARE OF ACC REGULAR-SEASON TITLE

- ·Virginia clinched at least a share of the ACC regular-season title on Sunday when the Cavaliers beat Miami 6-1
- ·The Cavalier win combined with a Florida State loss at Duke pushed Virginia to the top of the ACC standings
- · UVA last won the ACC regular-season title in the 2015 season when the Hoos went 9-1-0 in the ACC that season
- ·Virginia also won the ACC regular-season title in the 2013 season when the Cavaliers went 13-0-0
- · A win or a draw on Thursday night gives the Hoos the regular-season outright a loss results in a shared title with FSU

HOOS SCORE IN BUNCHES DOWN THE STRETCH

- · Virginia has not only been a prolific offense down the stretch, but the Hoos have scored goals in bunches
- ·The flurry of goal scoring began at Boston College when Alexa Spaanstra scored a pair of goals in a three-minute stretch
- · Virginia continued that with five goals in just under 12 minutes in the next outing against Syracuse in a 5-0 win
- ·The Hoos again had an offensive burst against No. 17 Notre Dame with two goals in 37 seconds to notch the 2-1 win
- · Against Miami, the Hoos racked up six goals in a 26 minute span including braces from Haley Hopkins and Diana Ordoñez

SEVERAL HOOS ON FIRE OFFENSIVELY HEADING INTO REGULAR-SEASON FINALE

- · Virginia has several players who have clicked offensively in recent games as the Cavaliers head into the regular-season finale
- · Sophomore midfielder Lia Godfrey has a goal and six assists through a five-game stretch to take the ACC lead in assists (12)
- · Alexa Spaanstra also found a rhythm with four goals and four assists to help a balanced attack as the Hoos surge offensively

- \cdot Diana Ordoñez has four goals and two assists, including a brace against Miamia and game winners vs. BC and Louisville

- · Sophomore Alexis Theoret has settled into her role at midfield as one of the first players off the bench for the Cavaliers
- · Earlier this year, Theoret got her first collegiate assists on game winners vs. No. 2 Duke and at NC State in the same week
- · She finally broke into the scoring column vs. Louisvile, answering the Cards' score with her own goal 1:10 later for a 3-1 lead
- ·Theoret has played 620 minutes this season for the most minutes for any non-starter in the 2021 campaign for UVA
- · In 16 games as a freshman, Theoret tallied 453 minutes and managed two shots in that time

HOOS PICKED TO FINISH THIRD IN ACC PRESEASON POLL

- ·The Cavaliers were picked to finish third in the ACC in a presasson vote of league coaches this season
- · Virginia received one first place vote and tallied 148 points picked behind Florida State and North Carolina
- · Florida State was picked to claim the league title, while North Carolina was picked to finish second
- ·The Cavaliers finished third in the ACC regular-season standings a year ago and advanced to the College Cup

PRESEASON ALL-ACC HONOREES

- · UVA had sophomore midfielder Lia Godfrey and senior forward Alexa Spaanstra named to the preseason All-ACC team
- · Spaanstra was a first team All-ACC selection a year ago and was named an All-Region selection
- · Godfrey earned All-America honors and was the ACC Freshman of the Year last season after leading the league in assists (9)
- ·The preseason All-ACC team was made up of 11 players and featured players from five different teams

IVORY CLIMBING THE RANKS IN THE RECORD BOOK

- · In her fifth season, goalkeeper Laurel Ivory is closing in on the top spots in the history books at UVA
- · Currently, Ivory is second all-time at UVA in shutouts with 40 solo shutouts in her career
- · With 65 wins, Ivory is second all-time in victories as a keeper at UVA she has a 65-16-12 record for her career

CAVALIERS RESPOND WELL AFTER A LOSS UNDER SWANSON

- · Responding after a loss has been a trend for the Cavaliers throughout Steve Swanson's tenure at UVA
- ·Throughout the 22 seasons under Swanson, Virginia holds a 60-8-13 record in matches following a loss

- · UVA head coach Steve Swanson hit a rare milestone vs. NC State (10/25/18), hitting the 400 career win mark
- ·As a head coach, Swanson holds a 448-162-63 record through stops at Dartmouth, Stanford and Virginia
- · Currently only a handful of D1 coaches have hit the 400 win milestone with seven of them currently active
- \cdot Swanson is one of only nine coaches who has recorded 400 wins all at a D1 institution
- · In his coaching career, he has taken all three teams to league titles and the NCAA Tournament

SWANSON GRABS HIS 300TH WIN AS UVA HEAD COACH

- · Head Coach Steve Swanson picked up his 300th wins as the head coach of the Cavaliers vs. Liberty (8/25/19)
- · Currently, Swanson holds a 342-99-52 record as UVA head coach and is 138-48-21 in ACC matches
- · He has 21 consecutive winning seasons at Virginia and 29 overall as a head coach
- · Swanson has taken his teams to 23 consecutive NCAA Tournaments with Virginia's inclusion last season

HOOS CONTINUE STRONG PRESENCE IN PROFESSIONAL RANKS ON NWSL ROSTERS

- · UVA has a strong presence in professional soccer in the U.S. with 11 players appearing on NWSL rosters this season
- · Becky Sauerbrunn now competes with the Portland Thorns after being traded by the Utah Royals
- Orlando features second-year players Courtney Petersen and Phoebe McClernon. Petersen was a first-round pick of the Pride in 2019.
- · Chicago boasts four players in Morgan Gautrat, Danielle Colaprico, Makenzy Doniak and Zoe Morse.
- · Kristen McNabb continues to compete for OL Reign in Seattle, while Brittany Ratcliffe was picked up by North Carolina.

- ·Virginia is one of only three schools to have a player taken in every NWSL Draft

- · Grad transfer Haley Hopkins made an immediate impact for the Hoos with a brace in the season opener vs. Richmond

SEVERAL FORMER HOOS COMPETE WITH USWNT

- Three Cavaliers helped the USWNT claim consecutive FIFA Women's World Cup championships when the US claimed the 2019 title in France
- · Brian and Sauerbrunn were also part of the 2015 FIFA Women's World Cup title in Canada
- Danielle Colaprico, the 2014 ACC Midfielder of the Year, was called up for the USWNT in competition with Portugal and Scotland played in November of 2018

OTHER HOOS WITH US SOCCER ON WORLD STAGE

- Rebecca Jarrett and Alexa Spaanstra represented the US in the Concacaf Cup to help the US qualify for the U20 Women's World Cup before it was canceled.
- · Fellow Cavaliers Diana Ordoñez and Talia Staude were part of the Nike Friendlies with the US Team in prepara tion for the Concacaf Cup along with new freshman Lia Godfrey.

FOUR HOOS REPRESENT THE U.S. IN FRANCE AT 2018 FIFA U20 WOMEN'S WORLD CUP

- Four current members of the UVA women's soccer team represented the U.S. at the 2018 U20 Women's World Cup in France
- · Zoe Morse, Laurel Ivory, Taryn Torres and Alexa Spaanstra all earned spots on the U20 roster in '18
- · Ivory started all three games of pool play for the U.S. team that went 1-1-1 vs. Japan, Paraguay and Spain

OTHER CONNECTIONS

- Current assistant Jaime Frias joined the Hoos after a stint with US Soccer in player development
- · Former head coach Lauren Gregg was head coach of the USWNT from 1997-2000
- Former head coach April Heinrichs coached the USWNT from 2000-2004 and played on the first Women's World Cup Championship team in 1991



ORDONEZ NAMED ACC CO-OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- · Forward Diana Ordoñez was named the ACC Co-Offensive Player of the Week by the league after week five of competition
- · Ordoñez hit the game-winning goal for Virginia in a 1-0 victory over No. 2 Duke in the Thursday night game
- · She then assisted on the game-winning goal in the 90th minute of Virginia's win at NC State on Sunday afternoon

STAUDE NAMED TOP DRAWER SOCCER PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- · Virginia defender Talia Stadue also picked up weekly honors after the Cavaliers' wins over No. 2 Duke and NC State
- · Staude was named the national Player of the Week by Top Drawer Soccer and on the publication's Team of the Week
- · She played the full 90 minutes in both games and helped limit the Blue Devils to three shots on goal in the 1-0 victory
- · Sunday against NC State, she hit the game-winning goal in the 90th minute her first game winner in her UVA career
- · Her 90th minute game-winning goal was the first for UVA since Brianna Westrup vs. Bucknell on August 26, 2018

STAUDE, ZANDI GET INVOLVED IN OFFENSIVE PRODUCTION AT NC STATE

- · Midfielder Sydney Zandi and defender Talia Staude got involved in the offensive production for the Hoos at NC State
- · Sydney Zandi scored the opening goal for the Hoos marking her first goal since the 2019 NCAA Tournament opener vs. Radford
- · Staude then secured the win for the Hoos when she hit the game-winning goal in the 90th minute of play
- · It was Staude's second career goal and the first game-winning goal of her Virginia career

- · UVA returns 17 letterwinners and seven starters from last year's squad that advanced to a 26th straight NCAA Tournament
- · Back are five players who earned post-season honors from the ACC forward **Alexa Spaanstra** earned first team honors, while forwards **Rebecca Jarrett** and **Diana Ordoñez**, and midfielder **Lia Godfrey** were second team honorees. **Samar Guidry** earned All-Freshman team honors along with Godfrey.
- · Godfrey also earned All-America honors to lead a group of players to earn honors from the United Soccer Coaches
- · In addition to Godfrey, Ordoñez and Spaanstra were both All-Region selections by the United Soccer Coaches last season
- · UVA returners contributed 38-of-40 goals scored (95%) a year ago and 31-of-34 assists (91%)
- Among those are the top five goal scorers Ordoñez (12), Spaanstra (10), Jarrett (4), Godfrey (4) and **Claire Constant** (3) and the top assist leaders Godfrey (9), Ordoñez (5), Lizzy Sieracki (4) and Jarrett (3).

HOOS WELCOME SIX FRESHMEN FOR 2021

- ·The Cavaliers brought in six freshmen as part of the 2021 newcomer class to Grounds this fall
- · Among those players were three ranked in the top 200 nationally by Top Drawer Soccer midfielder Madeline Simpson (No. 49), defender Kiki Maki (No. 170) and midfielder Charlotte McClure (No. 186)
- ·Also part of the class is forward Degen Miller who was named the Colorado Gatorade Player of the Year after tallying 43 goals and 16 assists as a senior
- · A pair of goalkeepers round out the freshman crop with Camryn Miller who earned Regional Player of the Year honors and Ally Reynolds who earned Top Drawer Soccer DA Playoff standout recognition

ALL-AMERICAN TRANSFER JOINS CAVALIER PROGRAM

- · In addition to the six freshmen, the Cavaliers also added a grad transfer with two-time All-American forward Haley Hopkins
- · Hopkins comes to the Virginia program with two years of eligibility remaining after graduating from Vanderbilt
- · She finished her career with 34 goals second all-time on the career goal scoring list for in Commodore program history
- · Of her 34 goals, 14 were game-winning goal and she added 12 assists for a total of 80 points in her career
- · Hopkins was named the Southeastern Conference Freshman of the Year in 2018 and earned All-America honors in 2018 and this past season.

IVORY AND CAVALIERS' EXTENDED SHUTOUT STREAK SNAPPED AGAINST GEORGE WASHINGTON

- ·The Hoos entered the 2021 season riding a shutout streak after posting four clean sheets on a run to the NCAA semifinal
- · Laurel Ivory and UVA posted 459:35 scoreless minutes dating back to the NCAA opener against SIUE to close the year
- ·After shut outs in the first three games, the Hoos went 776:41 minutes between goals surrendered
- ·That stretch of 776:41 was the third longest in program history and passed the last stretch of 775:01 set in 2019
- · lvory's streak of 665:06 shutout minutes is fourth all-time at UVA lvory has four of the top eight performances
- ·The fifth-year keeper also holds the second longest shutout streak with 775:01 minutes set in the 2019 season

UNIQUELY UVA

The University of Virginia is an institution rich with history and tradition. Here is some of the terminology that contributes to UVA's culture.

- Grounds: The term used by students, faculty and alumni to refer to the University dating as far back as Thomas Jefferson: "Campus" is never used.
- · First Year, Second Year, Third Year, Fourth Year: Instead of freshman, sophomore, junior, senior. Why you may ask? To be a "senior" implies that a person has reached the final phase of learning, a feat that Thomas Jefferson believed to be impossible, arguing instead that education is a life-long process. This tends to be used less in athletic eligibility references.
- Commonwealth: Virginia is one of four constituent states of the United States of America that officially uses the name "Commonwealth" instead of the word state in all references. The other three commonwealths are Kentucky, Massachusetts and Pennsylvania.

UNIVERSITY NICKNAMES

- Virginia's athletics teams have been accompanied by a somewhat confusing array of nicknames. The most prominent and widely accepted of these monikers are "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos."
- Although the terms "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are used almost interchangeably to refer to University teams and players, "Cavaliers" is more often used by the media, while "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are frequently used by Virginia students and fans.
- Legend has it that Washington & Lee baseball fans dubbed the Virginia players "Wahoos" during the fiercely
 contested rivalry that existed between the two in-state schools in the 1890s. By 1940, "Wahoos" was in
 general use around Grounds to denote University students or events relating to them. The abbreviated "Hoos"
 sprang up later in student newspapers and has gained growing popularity in recent years.

THE CAVALIER MASCOT

•The costumed Cavalier with a large character head debuted during Virginia's 1984 football season and has remained the official mascot of the University.

UNIVERSITY COLORS: ORANGE AND BLUE

- Orange and blue were adopted as the University of Virginia's official athletic colors at a mass student meeting in 1888. UVA athletic teams had previously worn silver gray and cardinal red, but those colors did not stand out on muddy football fields, prompting a student movement to change them.
- One of the students attending the mass meeting was Allen Potts, a star athlete who played on Virginia's first football team in 1888. Potts showed up at the meeting wearing a navy blue-and-orange scarf that he had acquired during a summer boating expedition at Oxford University. Orange and blue were chosen as the official athletic colors after one of Potts' fellow students pulled the scarf off Potts' neck and, waving it to the crowd, yelled, "How will this do?" UVA later served as the inspiration for schools like Auburn and Florida when they selected school colors.

WAHOOWA

- The origin of "Wah-hoo-wah" is uncertain. The cheer was used to root on Virginia teams as early as 1890 and may have been borrowed from Dartmouth College, whose athletics teams were once known as the Indians.
- · Legend attributes the yell to Natalie Floyd Otey, who sang the ballad "Where'er You Are, There Shall My Love Be" at Charlottesville's Levy Opera House in 1893. The predominantly student audience noticed that Otey warbled the first three words of the song between each of the stanzas and decided to join in the refrain. By evening's end, goes the legend, the crowd had corrupted "Where'er You Are" into "Wah-hoo-wah."
