

UVA/BYU Postgame Notes

TEAM

- Virginia scored 42 points in the first half the third highest total in school history
- UVA's 35 points in the second quarter were tied for the most in a single game (Colgate, 1970).
- Virginia scored a touchdown on six-straight possessions and all five drives in the second quarter.
- The 115 combined points in the contest were the most ever in a UVA football game.
- Virginia led the contest on three different occasions including at the half and the end of the third quarter.
- The Cavaliers snap a four-game win streak and drop to 0-2 against AP Top-25 opponents this season.
- UVA is 3-3 all-time against BYU and 1-2 in Provo.

PLAYER

- Brennan Armstrong broke the school record for passing yards with an eight-yard completion to Jelani Woods in fourth quarter. He finished the game with 337 yards passing and upped his season total to 3,557, surpassing former teammate Bryce Perkins' mark of 3538 in 2019.
- The 300-yard passing game was Armstrong's ninth of his career, breaking Matt Schaub's record of eight.
- Armstrong threw four touchdown passes and now has 27 this season, one shy of matching Schaub's mark set in 2002.
- Brennan Armstrong's two rushing touchdowns were his sixth and seventh of the season. He now has 12 career rushing touchdowns, tied with Don Majkowski for the eighth most in school history.
- Virginia had been 7-0 when Armstrong rushed for a touchdown. The two-rushing touchdown performance is his fourth of his career and third of the season.
- Brennan Armstrong's first quarter interception snapped a streak of 113 attempts without throwing an interception.
- Dontayvion Wicks, Keytaon Thompson, Ra'Shaun Henry and Billy Kemp have now caught a pass in all nine games this season.
- Jelani Woods caught his sixth touchdown pass of the season, tied for the second most by a tight end in a single season in program history. He's caught a touchdown in six of the eight games he's played in this year. The 40-yard touchdown was the longest reception of his career.
- Devin Darrington's 49-yard rushing touchdown was the longest of his career (both UVA & Harvard). It was also the longest rush by a Cavalier this season.
- Billy Kemp has caught a pass in 24-straight games.
- Dontayvion Wicks recorded his fifth, 100-yard receiving game of the season. Only Germane Crowell (6 in 1997) and Kris Burd (5 in 2011) have five 100-yard receiving games in the same season in UVA history.
- Keytaon Thompson caught his first receiving touchdown of the season and fourth of his career. He finished with nine receptions for 91 yards, his second-straight nine-reception game. He had caught nine or more balls in three of the last four games.
- Linebacker Nick Jackson matched his career-high with 16 tackles, nine of them were unassisted. The 16 tackles were the second most in a single-game by an ACC defender this season.
- Punter Jacob Finn had three punts for a total of 169 yards including a 59-yard blast, his longest of the season. His 46.4 punting average on 29 punts currently stands as the highest single-season total in program history.
