MATCH NOTES

- Virginia is 2-1-1 in its last four conference matches.
- UVA is 49-20-12 in the ACC Tournament and 16-0-5 against Wake Forest in the ACC Tournament.
- Virginia has advanced to the semifinals in three of the last four tournaments and the finals in two of those.
- UVA and Wake Forest have met in three of the last four ACC Tournaments, with the Cavaliers going 2-1.
- Virginia's only loss was a 0-0 contest through overtime and ended in six rounds of penalty kicks (4-3).
- The Cavaliers are 6-1-1 when scoring two or more goals in a match this season.
- UVA is 0-3-1 in against ranked opponents this season.
- UVA is coming off a 2-3 overtime loss at No. 13 Duke last Friday (Oct. 29).
- Defender Will Citron scored his second goal of the season and Leo Afonso notched his eighth.
- Daniel Wright registered his second assist as a Cavalier.

NOTABLES

- The Cavaliers have had eight different players score goals this season and 11 players have recorded an assist.
- Leo Afonso leads Virginia with eight goals, scoring five of those in the last six matches. Afonso is second in the ACC in shots per game (3.27) and fourth in goals per game (.53).
- Paul Wiese ranks fourth in the ACC in assists with six.
- Goalkeeper Holden Brown leads the ACC in saves (76) and is fourth in save percentage (.760).
- Three players have recorded a brace for UVA this season: Andreas Ueland (High Point), Kome Ubogu (VCU) and Leo Afonso (Boston College).

FANTASTIC FRESHMEN

- Eight freshmen have made starts for Virginia this season and 29 of UVA's 63 points are from freshmen.
- Paul Wiese and Asparuh Slavov have started all but one game, only missing the Mary Washington contest.
- Kome Ubogu has scored four goals and two assists for 10 points, which is second most on the team.
- Wiese leads the team with six assists and Michael Tscoulias has five points on two goals and one assist.
- Wiese's six assists tie him for fourth in the ACC in assists
- Ubogu scored his first collegiate goal against VCU, Slavov scored his first collegiate goal against Virginia Tech, Tscoulias scored his first collegiate goal against Maryland and Ank Nibogora's first collegiate goal was the game-winner vs. Western Michigan.

AFONSO PROVIDES SPARK

- Sophomore forward Leo Afonso scored three goals in two matches vs. UNCW and Boston College, including his first collegiate brace in the win over Boston College.
- Afonso scored four goals in UVA's two preseason exhibition matches.
- He currently leads UVA with 18 points on eight goals and two assists.

• Afonso is tied for fourth in the ACC in goals scored and ranks second in total shots (49).

UBOGU'S BRACE

- Ubogou had a career night against VCU when he scored his first collegiate goal, recorded his first collegiate brace and added an assist.
- Ubogou entered the match against VCU in the 65th minute and just four minutes later scored the first goal for the Cavaliers on a header off a cross from sophomore Chris Scheipe to tie the game 1-1.
- Two minutes later Ubogou had his second career goal when freshman Ank Nibogora played the ball forward and Ubogou tapped the ball just past the diving VCU keeper to give UVA the lead.
- Ubogou assisted Tsicoulias' goal in the 81st minute.

DEFENDERS DO IT ALL

- Two of the top scorers for the Cavaliers come from the defensive line.
- Andreas Ueland is tied for fourth on the team with five points on two goals and one assist.
- Paul Wiese has six assists, to be third on the team with six points.
- Keeper Holden Brown leads the ACC in total saves (76) and goalie minutes played (1638).

AGAINST WAKE FOREST

- This will be the 61st meeting between Virginia and Wake Forest.
- UVA holds a 39-13-8 lead in the all-time series and is 23-11-6 under head coach George Gelnovatch.
- The Cavaliers have won the last three contests between the teams, with two of those coming in the ACC Tournament.
- Last season, the teams met in the ACC Quarterfinals. Virginia won 2-0 to advance to the ACC Semifinals.
- Cabrel Happi Kamseu scored both goals for Virginia.
- UVA and Wake Forest have met in three of the last four ACC Tournaments, with the Cavaliers going 2-1.
- Virginia's only loss was a 0-0 contest through overtime and ended in six rounds of penalty kicks (4-3).

ABOUT WAKE FOREST

- Wake Forest won six of its last seven games to close out the regular season.
- Most recently, the Demon Deacons defeated Syracuse 2-0 on Friday (Oct. 29).
- Wake Forest is third in the ACC in assists per game (2.44) and sixth in scoring offense (2.06).
- Kyle Holcomb leads WF with 20 points on eight goals and four assists. Holcomb is fourth in the ACC in goals per game (0.53) and shot accuracy (.543) and sixth in points per game (1.33).
- Omar Hernandez, Jake Swallen and Roald Mitchell each have four goals.

NCAA ISSUES RED CARD CORRECTION FOR DANIEL WRIGHT

Virginia will have Daniel Wright available for Friday's match after a misidentification occurred on the second yellow awarded to him at the end of the first half against Maryland, forcing Virginia to play a man down in the

second half.

- Per the NCAA "It is clear that a player misidentification occurred involving UVA #23, Daniel Wright. Mr. Wright was issued a caution at 14:18. He was issued a second caution at 43:58 accompanied by the mandatory red card. The foul at 43:58 was actually committed by UVA #22 Michael Tsicoulias. The second caution and red card assessed against No. 23 Daniel Wright are rescinded and Mr. Wright is eligible to participate in Virginia's next game."

TEAM CAPTAINS

Head coach George Gelnovatch announced that junior Andreas Ueland and sophomore Leo Afonso will serve as team captains in 2021. Ueland was named to the ACC Preseason Watch List and is one of two players remaining from the 2019 Virginia College Cup squad.

ROSTER MAKEUP

- Virginia returns 17 letterwinners from a year ago and welcomes a recruiting class of 13 to Charlottesville for 2021.
- Virginia returns five of its six top goal scorers from a year ago including junior Kevin Ogudugu who led the team with seven points (3g, 1a).
- The 19 UVA goals last season were scored by 12 different players, nine of those goal scorers are back in 2021.
