

**Virginia 75, Clemson 65**  
**Tuesday, Jan. 4, 2022**

**Team Notes**

- Virginia improved to 9-5, 3-1 ACC
- The Cavaliers evened their road record at 2-2
- UVA is 4-1 when scoring 70 or more points
- UVA is 140-11 when scoring at least 70 or more points under Tony Bennett
- UVA shot 54.3 from the field and drilled 21 of 24 free throws
- The game featured 15 lead changes
- All eight Cavaliers who played scored in the win
- UVA outrebounded Clemson 28-23
- UVA held a 34-22 advantage in points in the paint
- Clemson led 37-36 at halftime
- Virginia went on a 10-0 run to gain 30-23 lead
- UVA shot 61.9 percent and was 9-of-9 from the free throw line in the first half

**Series Notes**

- UVA is 80-53 all-time vs. Clemson, including a 27-35 road mark, in a series that dates back to 1935-36
- The Cavaliers own a six-game winning streak against the Tigers in South Carolina
- UVA is 14-3 in its last 17 meetings against the Tigers
- Head coach Tony Bennett is 14-4 all-time vs. Clemson

**Player Notes**

- Double Figure Scorers: Jayden Gardner (23), Armaan Franklin (13)
- Gardner had his third 20-point game at UVA (36 career)
- Kadin Shedrick (4 blocks) had his 10<sup>th</sup> multi-block game
- Francisco Caffaro matched a season high with eight points off the bench
- Kody Stattmann had five points off the bench (most since 8 vs. Coppin State on Nov. 19, 2021)
