### THE GAME

- ▶ Syracuse travels for the first time this season to face No. 2 Virginia. Syracuse will have faced the nation's No. 1 and No. 2 teams in the same week after playing No. 1 Maryland on Sunday.
- ▶ The game will be broadcast on ACCN with Chris Cotter (PxP), Paul Carcaterra '97 (analyst) and Quint Kessenich (analyst) on the call. Brian Higgins '04 (PxP) and Kyle Fetterly '09 (analyst) will broadcast the action on TK99/105, Cuse.com and the TuneIn App, while WAER will also carry the game.

### THE VIRGINIA SERIES

- ▶ Syracuse and UVA square off for the first of two times this season and 39th time in total.
- ▶ Syracuse swept the two meetings last year to break a tie, and now own the all-time series lead 20-18.
- ▶ Last year's multi-goal wins (10, 2) were outliers in a series that entered last season knotted at 18-18 with both teams having scored an identical number of goals. Heading into this season's matchup Orange have now scored 499 goals, UVA has netted 487.
- ▶ The game has been decided by one goal on 17 occasions - including five of the last-seven meetings. Seven of those one-goal games went to overtime.
- ▶ This is Syracuse's second-straight trip to Charlottesville, having last played there in April of last year. UVA will make its way to the Dome later this season.
- ▶ **Jakob Phaup** has been the key of late for Syracuse. In last year's two meetings, he won 46-of-60 faceoffs (including 24-of-27 at Klockner) and picked up 17 ground balls to control possessions for SU.
- ▶ **Bobby Gavin** spent last season at a member of the Cavaliers NCAA title squad, playing in eight games before transferring to Syracuse this winter.

### ORANGE IN BOUNCE-BACK GAMES

- ▶ The Orange are 74-26 in games following a loss during a season (this record does not include the season opener following season-ending losses) in their last-100 tries.
- ▶ Since the team won its first NCAA Championship in 1983, 'Cuse has only had 14 "losing streaks" (two or more consecutive losses) in 40 seasons.

### 5-SPOT

- ▶ **Tucker Dordevic** has tied his career high with five goals in back-to-back games, which coincide with his first two collegiate starts on attack.
- ▶ He is the first Syracuse player to score 5+ goals in back-to-back games since 2015. The last player to do so was attackman Dylan Donahue, who scored five goals in a 19-7 win over No. 4 Duke (3/22/15) and followed it up with a seven-goal performance in a 13-12, double overtime loss at then No. 2 Notre Dame (3/28/15).
- ▶ Donahue finished that season with a team-high 50 goals and was second on the team with 71 points. Only Kevin Rice (84) had more that season. Donahue's 50 goals were the seventh-most by a Syracuse player in a single season ever.

### A GAUNTLET LIES AHEAD

- ▶ Syracuse will play the top-two teams in the USILA Poll in the span of seven days after hosting Maryland on Sunday and then hitting the road to face Virginia this Saturday.
- ▶ Every opponent except one (UAlbany) left on the Orange's 2022 schedule is at least receiving votes in this week's USILA Poll.

### STRONG IN LEAGUE

- ▶ Since joining the ACC, Syracuse has the second-best record in regular season league games (18-13) and also has two ACC Tournament titles. Duke holds a 19-12 record in that time to lead all teams. Notre Dame (16-15), North Carolina (16-15) and Virginia (8-23) make up the remaining records.

### PHAUP COMING ON

- ▶ **Jakob Phaup** enters 2022 as one of the nation's most experienced faceoff men, having taken 625 faceoffs in his career.
- ▶ Only Petey LaSalla (997) and Zach Tucci (815) have more in the ACC, with Phaup ranking 12th nationally in most faceoffs taken among active players. His 375 wins ranks 11th.
- ▶ He won .652 percent of his faceoffs thus far in 2022, a mark that ranks sixth nationally.

### A WIN AGAINST VIRGINIA WOULD...

- ▶ Give Gary Gait a 1-0 record in ACC play as a men's lacrosse coach. Gait was 73-23 in league play as a women's coach.
- ▶ Be the program's 926th victory, second all-time behind Johns Hopkins.
- ▶ Be a third-straight victory against Virginia, extending the all-time series to a three-game advantage in favor of SU (21-18). That would be Syracuse's largest advantage in the series ever, and neither team has ever had more than a four-game advantage in the series.

## LAST TIME THEY MET

### Syracuse 13, Virginia 11

April 24, 2021 // Charlottesville, Va.

A wire-to-wire victory by the Syracuse men's lacrosse team snapped a three-game ACC losing skid, taking down No. 5 Virginia 13-11.

Jakob Phaup dominated at the X, winning 24-of-27 restarts to give 'Cuse a massive possession advantage, while Owen Hiltz (3-2) led the Orange in scoring. Owen Seebold (2-2) notched four points in his first collegiate start, and Jamie Trimboli posted a hat trick.

The 'Cuse defense was again phenomenal, holding the Cavaliers to their second-lowest offensive total, behind the earlier matchup this year when SU held Virginia to 10 goals in the Dome. Drake Porter made nine big saves in net and Brett Kennedy's three caused turnovers and career-high eight ground balls helped the Orange.

Syracuse struck early, scoring the game's first two goals off the sticks of Trimboli and Lucas Quinn. The 'Hoos evened things up with two minutes left in the first, but Hiltz notched his first of the day in the waning seconds of the first period to give the Orange a 3-2 lead after one. That goal ignited a five-goal run, with Trimboli, Quinn, Seebold and Hiltz (twice) scoring in the stretch.

A pair of goals from Xander Dickson pulled the Cavaliers within three, but Stephen Rehffuss capped the run with a late goal before the half, giving Syracuse an 8-4 lead at the break.

Virginia scored four of the first-five goals of the second half to pull within one at 9-8, but Syracuse's resiliency showed again, Seebold, Hiltz, Curry and Trimboli scored four in a row to open a 13-8 lead.

The Cavaliers continued to chip away late, but never got within two.

Syracuse will look for their third top-five win of the year next week, when the team travels to Notre Dame. Faceoff is scheduled for Noon on ESPNU.

EFFICIENT ORANGE

- Syracuse had one of its most efficient offensive performances on record in their season-opening 28-5 win over Holy Cross.
- Syracuse notched 19 goals in the first half, which is the most in program history.
- The 23-goal margin of victory is the largest margin of victory in Carrier Dome history.
- Perhaps even more impressive was the efficiency the offense scored with. Syracuse scored 28 goals on 49 shots (57.1 shot percentage). That's the highest shooting percentage on record in Syracuse lacrosse history. It was the first time 'Cuse shot better than 50-percent since April 5, 2017 at Hobart, when the Orange notched 17 goals on 31 shots (.548).
- Of the 10 players who took multiple shots on Saturday, nine shot over 50-percent. Only **Liam Ferris** (who went 2-of-5) was below the marker.

THE GARY ERA

- Lacrosse legend **Gary Gait** returns to the program that he helped win three NCAA titles as a player, to be the fifth Roy D. Simmons Jr. Head Men's Lacrosse Coach at Syracuse University in program history this spring.
- The Hall of Fame player led the Orange women's team to the NCAA Championship game in 2021.
- He's won everywhere he's been. His career includes 10 NCAA titles as a player and assistant coach, three NLL titles, three MLL Championships, three Mann Cups, a Heritage Cup and an ILF World Championship.

BLUE JAYS AND MAROONS

- For the first time on record, only one member of the Orange's on-field coaching staff is a Syracuse alum. This is the fewest 'Cuse alums on staff since the program began hiring full-time assistants.
- **Pat March** was the first non-Syracuse grad in a full-time on the coaching staff since BJ Ohara was hired as an assistant coach in 2002, when he joined the program in the fall of 2019. March is a Roanoke alum, and started his 10 year coaching career there.
- Johns Hopkins grad and legendary player **Dave Pietramala** was tabbed as the Orange's defensive coordinator this past fall.
- **TD Ierlan**, who played at Yale, Denver and Albany in his career, joins the team as the volunteer assistant.
- **Roy Simmons III** is the longest tenured member of the staff, remaining in his director of operations role.

HALLS OF FAME

- **Gary Gait**, **Casey Powell** and **Pat McCabe** were all members of the inaugural Pro Lacrosse Hall of Fame class, which was announced on Feb. 15.
- The Hall of Fame, which is managed by the Premier Lacrosse League, announced an 11-man class consisting of a player for each of the 10 starting field positions (3 A, 3 M, 3 D, 1 G) and a specialist.
- Syracuse was the only school to have multiple alumni selected in the inaugural class, which is fitting as the Orange also own the records for most professional lacrosse draft picks of all time and most first round selections.
- All three are already members of the National Lacrosse Hall of Fame for their collegiate play. Gait is now a member of the National Lacrosse Hall of Fame, NLL Hall of Fame, Pro Lacrosse Hall of Fame and Greater Syracuse Sports Hall of Fame.

TEN BELOW

- Syracuse has won 66-straight games when holding opponents to under 10 goals in a game.
- 46 of those 66 games have come since the start of the 2015 season, including a high of 11 in 2016.
- The last time Syracuse failed to win when keeping its foe to single digits was on April 28, 2012, when the Orange fell at Notre Dame, 8-6.

HILTZ HAS RECORD WORTHY ROOKIE SEASON

- **Owen Hiltz's** freshman season was one for the record books.
- He wrapped up his first season on campus ranked eighth in points (48), goals (29) and assists (19) among rookies in program history, despite playing just 13 games. In the last-30 years, only four freshman have posted more than 40 points at Syracuse - Mikey Powell (70, 2001), Casey Powell (67, 1995) and Mike Leveille (41, 2005). All three went on to win national player of the year honors. Hiltz's 13 games tied Leveille for the fewest of the four.
- Mikey Powell and Leveille were the only two players to have more goals than Hiltz as a freshman this century. The eventual Tewaaron Award winners notched 30.
- Larry Storrier scored 42 goals in 1976 to set the Orange record. Casey Powell's 39 in 1995 was the next-highest tally.
- John Zулberti (1986) owns Syracuse's freshman assists (41) and points (74) records. Mike Powell (40/70) is second in both of those categories.

## THE LOUD HOUSE IS BACK

- ▶ For the first time in 24 months, the Syracuse lacrosse program welcomed fans back to the Dome without a capacity restriction.
- ▶ Last season, only four of the Orange's nine games had fans of any kind. Three offered limited student attendance, while one had limited allotment for parents/families.
- ▶ 7,314 fans attended the Orange's most recent game vs. Maryland, 4,000 more than any other game to date this season in the country.
- ▶ Syracuse has led the nation in attendance nearly yearly over the last-40 years since the construction of the Dome. Should trends continue, this would be the first season since 2018 that Syracuse can complete without attendance interruptions. In 2019, the Orange's home game against Duke was moved to Cicero-North Syracuse High School due to attendance conflicts with the building, playing just one true home game after March 16. 2020 was shortened due to COVID after just four games and 2021 had no attendance larger than 650 due to building capacity restrictions for public health reasons. Prior to this season, only Brendan Curry, Owen Seebold, Brett Kennedy, Lucas Quinn, Tucker Dordevic, Nick DiPietro, Dami Oladunmoye, Jacob Buttermore, Brett Barlow, Grant Murphy and Jake Phaup have experienced playing in the building for a 'normal' season.

## THE BEST CONFERENCE IN AMERICA

- ▶ The ACC claimed five of the eight NCAA Tournament at-large berths and the league's five total selections were the most of any conference in 2021.
- ▶ All-five ACC teams are currently ranked inside of the top-13 in the USILA Poll.
- ▶ The Big Ten (2), BIG EAST (2), and Patriot League (2) were the other multi-bid leagues in the NCAA Tournament last season.

## STATE CHAMPS

- ▶ Syracuse has five games scheduled against in-state competition this season.
- ▶ Historically, Syracuse has dominated New York. Owing a combined 418-161-10 record against teams from New York.

## NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

- ▶ Since joining the ACC, the Orange is 55-16 versus non-conference opponents, including a 51-11 mark in regular-season, non-league contests.

## EXTRA, EXTRA

- ▶ Syracuse owns an all-time overtime record of 39-23-4.
- ▶ Syracuse has not played an overtime game since March of 2019.
- ▶ SU has won 17 of its last 26 overtime games dating back to 2006.
- ▶ 'Cuse snapped a five-game winning streak in games that needed extra time in their loss to Virginia in 2019 before rebounding and defeating Duke in OT later in the year.
- ▶ Syracuse had previously won seven-straight overtime games at the Dome before that game.

## POLL POINTS

- ▶ Syracuse is ranked No. 9 in the USILA Poll this week.
- ▶ Overall, Syracuse has been ranked in 261 of the 265 USILA polls that have been released since 2000 and 476 of the 506 polls since the USILA began its national rankings in 1973.
- ▶ The Orange appeared in 274 straight USILA polls from April 10, 1978 to April 30, 2007.

## AN UPGRADED HOME VENUE

- ▶ Home to the Orange since the 1981 season, the Dome got a face lift this offseason.
- ▶ The bulk of \$118 million in renovations to the facility which hosts SU football, basketball and lacrosse, were done this offseason. They include: a new fixed roof, upgraded lighting and sound and a gigantic center-hung video screen, among other amenities.
- ▶ The venue has been Syracuse's home for all 11 NCAA titles and 'Cuse has finished first or second nationally in attendance every season since the NCAA has begun tracking it.
- ▶ In total, 1,484,843 fans have watched 299 lacrosse games in the Dome, or an average of 4,966 fans per contest. SU is 255-44 in the Dome all time.

## LACROSSE LEGENDS DAY

- ▶ Gary Gait became the first Syracuse lacrosse player to have his jersey retired and Roy Simmons Jr. was the sixth member enshrined into Syracuse Athletics' Ring of Honor vs. Maryland.
- ▶ Simmons Jr. joins Jim Brown, Floyd Little, Ernie Davis, Jim Boeheim and Pearl Washington in the Ring of Honor in the Dome. The six are honored for their incredible contributions to Syracuse University that transcend the sport.
- ▶ Gait, the greatest player of all time, becomes the first men's lacrosse player to have his jersey retired. The four-time All-American, three-time NCAA Champion and two-time National Player of the Year, will be honored prior to the game. While his jersey will hang in the rafters forever, the legendary No. 22 won't be coming out of circulation, as Syracuse is honoring his jersey, not retiring the number.
- ▶ Later in the day, Katie Rowan was celebrated at the SU women's game vs. Stony Brook, becoming the first women's lacrosse player and second woman at Syracuse to have her jersey retired. Rowan is Syracuse lacrosse's all-time leader in points (396).

## DOME-INATION

- ▶ Syracuse is 255-44 (.858) in the Carrier Dome since it began playing the majority of its home games there in 1981.
- ▶ 'Cuse has won 38 of its last-50 home games.

## A SECOND CENTURY OF SU LACROSSE

- ▶ While the Syracuse men's lacrosse team celebrated their centennial season in 2016 - the 100th anniversary of the 1916 squad that first brought lacrosse to Syracuse, the 2022 season is the 103rd season of the sport being played at SU.
- ▶ Due to no games being played in 1917 and the program being suspended from 1943-45 due to WWII, this will be season 103.

**TOUGH ON THE RIDE**

- ▶ For the third year in a row, the Orange attackmen and middies are tenacious on the ride. For the second time in three years, **Griffin Cook** is tied for the team lead in caused turnovers (2). In 2021, **Owen Hiltz** (6), was fourth on the team in the category. Defenseman **Grant Murphy** (16) led the team.
- ▶ Through five games the year prior (and his first five starts on attack), Griffin Cook had seven caused turnovers before the season was canceled. Since caused turnovers officially became an NCAA statistic in 2010, Cook is just the fourth attackman in program history to have more than six caused turnovers in an entire season.
- ▶ Cook had the most caused turnovers by an attackman in the country in the shortened 2020 campaign, but played mostly through the midfield in 2021 and 2022 thus far.

**IN THE CLEAR**

- ▶ Syracuse struggled in the clearing game in 2021, clearing at only 83.1 percent. That number ranked 47th nationally and is last in the ACC. Historically, Syracuse has been one of the nation's best team in the clear.
- ▶ The Orange turned that around for the first two games of 2022, where they rank eighth nationally, clearing at 93.3-percent (42-of-45).
- ▶ According to research done by the Virginia Athletic Media Relations Office, there have been 51 seasons (excluding the 2020 shortened season) in which a Division I team has cleared the ball at 90 percent or better, including five by SU.

**RARE CHANGE ATOP**

- ▶ Syracuse is one of two programs to win 900+ games in program history, with Johns Hopkins being the other.
- ▶ Besides all the wins and tradition of success, the most remarkable item of the more than 100 years of Syracuse lacrosse is that the program has only had five head coaches. Laurie Cox (1916-1930), Roy Simmons Sr. (1931-1970), Roy Simmons Jr. (1971-1998) and John Desko (1999-21) and now Gary Gait (2022-pres.) have been the only bench bosses in the storied tradition of the program.

**OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN**

- ▶ **Brendan Curry, Tucker Dordevic, Owen Seebold** and **Brett Kennedy** were selected as the Orange's team captains this season.
- ▶ Curry is the second three-time team captain in program history.
- ▶ Curry is also 1-of-31 players to serve as a captain in multiple seasons at SU.
- ▶ Curry's dad Todd was a two-time captain as well, making he and Brendan the first father-son combination to be two-time Syracuse lacrosse captains.

**'CUSE WINS 900th GAME**

- ▶ Syracuse became the second program in NCAA Division I lacrosse history to win 900 games in 2018.
- ▶ Johns Hopkins (1,000), **Syracuse (925)**, Maryland (857), Navy (815) and Army (813) are the only five programs with 800 or more wins.
- ▶ There are six other programs in the 700 win club, Johns Hopkins (1,000), Maryland (857), Navy (815), Army (813), Hobart (791) and Cornell (774).

**CARDIAC 'CUSE NO MORE?**

- ▶ The Syracuse lacrosse program was always worth the price of admission, playing in a one-goal thriller almost every other time out from 2016-2019, but have only played in one 1-goal game since the conclusion of the 2019 campaign.
- ▶ Still, 27 of Syracuse's last-69 games have been decided by one goal heading into Saturday's game.
- ▶ Overall 'Cuse has been widely successful in those matchups as well, winning 16 of the 27 games.
- ▶ The Orange set the program record with 11 one-goal games in 2017, but has only played in one since the start of the 2020 season.

## THE CALVARY IS COMING

- ▶ Syracuse's 2022 recruiting class, which signed NLI's this fall, stacks up as one of the best in the nation.
- ▶ Joey Spallina (No. 1) headlines the class. It also features fellow *Inside Lacrosse* five stars Carter Kempney (Midfield), Finlay Thompson (Attack) and Billy Dwan (Defense)
- ▶ Four-star prospects Riley Figueiras (Defense), Dylan Sageder (LSM), Chuck Kuczynski (Defense), Jimmy McCool (Goalie), Michael Leo (Attack) and Vincent Trujillo (Midfield) also signed NLIs, among other talented recruits.

## LEAGUE DOMINANCE

- ▶ The Orange has won nine conference titles in the last 11 seasons, including five regular season titles (2010, 2011, 2013, 2017, 2018) and four conference tournament titles (2012, 2013, 2015, 2016).
- ▶ Syracuse collected its second-straight ACC regular season championship in 2018. Virginia took home the regular season crown in 2019. No conference champion was crowned in 2020 due to the COVID-19 Pandemic.

## NUMBERS GAME

- ▶ Two members of this year's roster have dads who played varsity lacrosse for the Orange, with both wearing the number their father wore - Owen Seebold (14) and Brendan Curry (16).
- ▶ Curry switched to #16 for the 2019 season after it was occupied by another family legacy the season prior. Ryan Simmons was in his final season wearing the number that had been worn by his father, grandfather and great-grandfather at Syracuse.
- ▶ Beyond the family legacy, Syracuse has a tradition of putting thought into assigning numbers. Director of Operations Roy Simmons III handles the task, typically.
- ▶ Jerry Staats now occupies the #45 that Brendan Bomberry left in 2019. Randy Staats previously wore the number. Jerry attended The Hill Academy like Bomberry. The Hill Academy alums don the jersey in memory of former Hill Academy player Jamieson Kuhlmann, who passed away in 2008 on the field.

## BROTHERLY LOVE

- ▶ The team currently has one sets of brothers on the roster.
- ▶ Preseason All-American Brett Kennedy's younger brother Jack joined the program for the 2018-19 school year.

## PRESEASON ALL-AMERICA HONORS

- ▶ Four members of the Orange garnered All-America accolades in *Inside Lacrosse's* Preseason All-America media voting, the most of any program.
- ▶ Brendan Curry, Brett Kennedy, Tucker Dordevic and Owen Hiltz were all honored in the voting.
- ▶ Dordevic earned third-team honors, while the other three were honorable mentions.

## SEEBOLD RAISES FUNDS

- ▶ Orange junior midfielder Owen Seebold asked for a unique birthday gift in 2019.
- ▶ Seebold's father - Bob - who played on Syracuse's first NCAA Championship team was diagnosed with Multiple Sclerosis when Owen was in high school.
- ▶ In lieu of gifts for Seebold's 21st birthday, he asked family and friends to donate to Hope for a Cure - an organization dedicated to finding a cure for M.S.
- ▶ Seebold's promotion of the charity through his Facebook page and a feature on the ACC Network Extra broadcast generated over \$8,000 in donations to the charity.

## 'CUSE PICKED LAST IN ACC

- ▶ The Orange were picked to finish last in the ACC, in what is a loaded conference that features four of the top-five teams in the preseason poll.
- ▶ Defending champion Virginia (23) was picked to win, followed by Duke (17), Notre Dame (16), North Carolina (12) and Syracuse (7) round out the poll in succession.
- ▶ Brendan Curry and Tucker Dordevic were all honored as Preseason All-ACC selections by the coaches.

## EVERYONE'S FAVORITE TEAMMATE

- ▶ In a partnership with Team IMPACT, Syracuse has added a teammate last year that is everyone's favorite.
- ▶ Gaven Bort, a 5-year-old suffering from Cystic Fibrosis officially "signed" with the Orange in the fall of 2019 and has been part of the team ever since.
- ▶ He has elected to wear No. 27 because his favorite teammate was Luke Strang.
- ▶ Strang, Nick DiPietro and Tucker Dordevic facilitated the partnership with the organization. Bort was on the sidelines at Orange home games last season and occasionally attends practices and team events.

## GOAL SONGS ARE BACK

- ▶ Fans at the Dome heard an eclectic mix of musical selections following Orange goals this season. That's because players have picked their own celebratory music.
- ▶ Each player was asked to pick one song and that'll play immediately following that player's goal.

## CHEF CURRY

- ▶ Many people picked up new hobbies during quarantine, including midfielder Brendan Curry.
- ▶ Curry has taken his cooking prowess to Instagram, starting @the.hangrychef where he posts photos of his creations that he cooks.

## ATTENDANCE LEADERS ONCE AGAIN

- ▶ Syracuse currently leads the nation in average (4,896) and total (9,792) attendance so far in 2022.
- ▶ SU has finished first or second in lacrosse attendance in every season since the NCAA began tracking it (with the exception of the 2021 season where COVID protocols limited fans across the country).
- ▶ Since the Carrier Dome opened in 1981, 1,484,843 fans have seen the Orange play in a total of 299 games.
- ▶ Two of the nation's top-four attended games in 2019 were in the Carrier Dome, as is the highest attended game thus far in 2022.

Widely considered to be the greatest player in lacrosse history, Gary Gait has been hired as the Roy D. Simmons Jr. Head Men's Lacrosse Coach at Syracuse.

Gait becomes the fifth head coach for the 107th year of Syracuse men's lacrosse, replacing Hall of Fame head coach John Desko, who announced his retirement on Monday. He takes the job after a 14-year stint as the head coach of the Orange's women's lacrosse program.

Gait's remarkable playing career features a winning theme at every level. A three-time NCAA Champion, Gait led Syracuse's most dominant stretch in program history, losing just one game in three seasons from 1988-90. He is a two-time recipient of the Lt. Raymond J. Enners Award, presented annually to the nation's most outstanding player, and was the NCAA Championship Most Outstanding Player on a team considered to be the greatest ever assembled in college lacrosse.

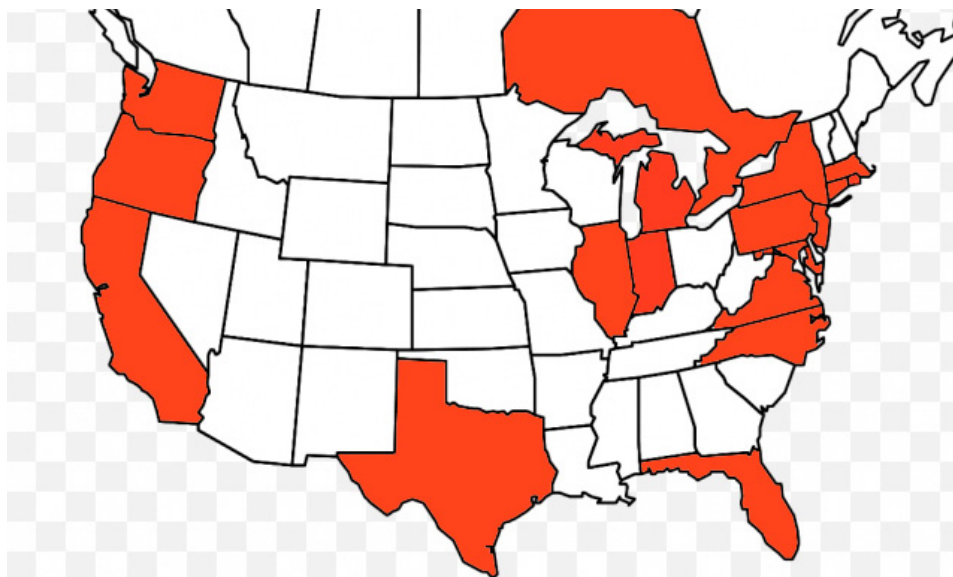
