Team Notes

- The Cavaliers end their season with a 21-14 record
- UVA is 9-6 in nonconference action
- UVA is 11-7 at home
- Bennett's UVA NCAA/NIT postseason record fell to 17-9 and 4-2 in NIT action
- UVA shot 46.4 percent in the second half (13 of 28) and outscored the Bonnies 34-31
- UVA shot 28 percent in the first half (7-25) and trailed 21-17
- St. Bonaventure went 9 of 9 from the free throw line and committed just seven turnovers
- UVA led 50-45 with 2:59 left in the contest
- St. Bonaventure owned an 11-0 advantage in fast break points

NIT Notes

- The Cavaliers are 19-12 all-time in 14 NIT appearances, including a pair of championships in 1980 and 1992
- UVA is 2-5 all-time in the NIT quarterfinals
- The Cavaliers are 11-5 at home in the NIT
- Bennett is 4-3 all-time in the NIT, including a 68-57 loss at St. Mary's as head coach at Washington State in 2009

- Double Figure Scorers: Armaan Franklin (17), Jayden Gardner (14)
- Franklin matched a career high with five 3-pointers
- Gardner reached double figures for the 29th time (103rd career)
- Franklin reached double figures for the 21st time (35th career)
- Beekman (6 assists) passed Kihei Clark (2019-20) for seventh on UVA's single season assist list with 181
- Kadin Shedrick (2 blocks) passed Jay Huff (2020-21) for sixth on UVA's single-season blocked shots list with 67
- Shedrick had a team-high nine rebounds
