QUICK KICKS

UVA moved to No. 7 nationally in the United Soccer Coaches poll for week five after a draw vs. VCU The Hoos are 7-0-1 on the season and have posted seven straight shutouts entering ACC play. UVA went through the non-conference undefeated and posted seven shutouts in those eight games. The shutout of VCU marks 648:08 minutes since UVA last conceded - the fifth longest streak in UVA history. The fourth-longest streak is 654:32 (9/15/90 through 10/6/90).

Following the draw with VCU, **Cayla White** is now 11-0-1 as a starter in goal for the Cavaliers. **White** is fourth nationally in goals against average (0.17) and has four solo shutouts this season.

Maggie Cagle scored her first goal vs. Oregon State and has a goal and five assists. She has three assists on game-winning goals and hit the game-winning goal against the Beavers.

Maya Carter notched a brace against Oregon State, scoring twice in the final five minutes of the first half to help give the Hoos a 3-0 lead going into the half.

The Hoos had back-to-back ACC Player of the Week selections in weeks three and four with **Haley Hopkins** named Offensive PoW for week three and **Talia Staude** Defensive PoW for week four. The Cavaliers are one of the most prolific offenses early in the 2022 season, tied for third nationally with 27 goals, while the 3.38 goals per game is tied for fifth nationally in goals per game.

Alexa Spaanstra also continues to move up the UVA career record book and sits sixth all-time in assists at UVA with 32 assists following a pair of assists in the win over Memphis.

Hopkins and **Spaanstra** are two of only eight players active in the NCAA with 30 goals and 20 assists for their careers. Hopkins has 49 goals and 22 assists (120 points) while Spaanstra has 31 goals and 32 assists (94 points) to rank second and fourth, respectively, among the eight players.

THE SERIES WITH NORTH CAROLINA

- ·Virginia and North Carolina have met 48 times with the Tar Heels leading the all-time series 39-4-5
- ·The Cavaliers have posted all of their wins on the road or at a neutral site winning three on the road and one at a neutral site
- · Virginia's four wins came in five meetings across the 2011-14 seasons, including two games in ACC Tournament play
- · This meeting will be the fourth straight away from home against UNC for UVA which hasn't hosted UNC since the 2017 season
- ·The Hoos and Tar Heels played in ACC Tournament play in 2019 and 2020 and at UNC in the 2021 regular season last fall
- · A fifth meeting was to have taken place in the 2020 regular season but was canceled due to COVID

LAST TIME OUT AGAINST THE TAR HEELS

- · Virginia and North Carolina played in Chapel Hill last season with the teams playing to a scoreless draw at Dorrance Field
- · In that draw, then UVA keeper Laurel Ivory made five saves on 20 Tar Heel shots in posting the clean sheet
- · Diana Ordoñez and Alexa Spaanstra led the Virginia offense on that afternoon with a combined seven shots for the Hoos
- · Both teams were ranked at the time of the meeting with UVA ranked No. 2 and UNC ranked No. 5 in the polls

HOOS PICKED TO FINISH SECOND IN 2022 ACC PRESEASON POLL

- ·The Cavaliers were picked to finish second in the ACC in a presasson vote of league coaches this season
- ·Virginia received four first place vote and tallied 153 points picked behind Duke who had 156 points
- · Duke had the most points, but the Cavaliers and Tar Heels both received more first-place votes with four each
- ·The Cavaliers won the ACC regular season championship a year ago after being picked to finish third in the preseason poll

PRESEASON ALL-ACC HONOREES

- · UVA had sophomore midfielder Lia Godfrey and senior forward Alexa Spaanstra named to the preseason All-ACC team

- ·The Hoos won't be going to overtime until NCAA Tournament play due to changes in rules, but UVA is no stranger to OT
- · Virginia has gone to extra time in 87 matches during the Steve Swanson era with a 23-12-53 record in those matches
- · In those 53 draws, 15 have come in the postseason with the Cavaliers surviving shootouts in five of those 15 matches

HOOS EARN UNITED SOCCER COACHES TEAM ACADEMIC AWARD FOR 13TH CONSECUTIVE YEAR

- ·The Cavaliers were named a recipient of the Team Academic Award by the United Soccer Coaches for the 2021-22 year
- · It marks the 13th consecutive season for the Hoos to receive the award from the coaches organization
- ·Teams must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 to be named as a recipient of the award each season

HOOS CONTINUE STRONG PRESENCE IN PROFESSIONAL RANKS ON NWSL ROSTERS

- · UVA has a strong presence in professional soccer in the U.S. with 15 players appearing on NWSL rosters this season
- · Becky Sauerbrunn now competes with the Portland Thorns after being traded by the Utah Royals
- · Orlando features third-year player Courtney Petersen. Petersen was a first-round pick of the Pride in 2019.
- · Chicago boasts three players in Morgan Gautrat, Danielle Colaprico and Zoe Morse.
- · Kristen McNabb and Makenzy Doniak now play for San Diego, while Veronica Latsko, Phoebe McClernon and Laurel Ivory are with the OL Reign.
- · Megan Reid was picked up by Angel City FC in the offseason, while Emily Sonnett is with the Washington Spirit.
- · First-round pick Diana Ordoñez plays for NC Courage along with Brittany Ratcliffe.
- · Virginia is one of only three schools to have a player taken in every NWSL Draft

HOOS HAVE A PRESENCE IN TOP DRAWER SOCCER PRESEASON TOP 100

- · Virginia had several players ranked among the top 100 in the presason by Top Drawer Soccer with four making the list
- · Midfielder Lia Godfrey led the list at No. 5 after earning All-America honors for the second straight year in 2021
- · Defender Talia Staude came in at No. 14 on the list, while Alexa Spaanstra came in at No. 18 after earning All-ACC and All-Region honors a year ago
- · Rebecca Jarrett was ranked No. 50 as she returns to the pitch after an ACL tear ended her season early last year

GODFREY NAMED TO HERMANN TROPHY WATCH LIST

- ·The Hoos had a player on the Hermann Trophy Watch list yet again this season when the 61 player list was announced

- \cdot Junior Brianna Jablonowski turned in a career performance for the Hoos and turned the tide in a win over No. 23 Memphis
- \cdot She scored her first collegiate goal in the 43rd minute to get UVA on the board just five minutes after entering the game
- · Jablonowski would go on to add an assist and a second goal down the stretch in the second half to put a stamp on the win
- · In all, the junior tallied the brace and assist in only 19 minutes of play and delivered the game winner on that first goal

HOPKINS GOES ON HOT STREAK STARTING WITH GAME-WINNING GOAL AGAINST NO. 11 GEORGETOWN

- · Forward Haley Hopkins has been on a hot streak since scoring her first goal of the season at No. 11 Georgetown
- · Hopkins has scored seven goals in the last five games including hitting three game-winning goals in that span
- · She tallied a brace for the Hoos in the win over Fairleigh Dickinson, notching all three goals in the first 14 minutes of play
- · Hopkins also hit what proved to be the game-winning goal in the 2-0 victory over JMU as part of that five-game stretch

- · Freshman forward Maggie Cagle made an immediate impact for the Hoos, jumping right into the action from game one
- · Cagle started the first three games of the season and notched four assists through the first three games of the season

- · UVA head coach Steve Swanson hit a rare milestone vs. NC State (10/25/18), hitting the 400 career win mark
- ·As a head coach, Swanson holds a 458-164-65 record through stops at Dartmouth, Stanford and Virginia
- · Currently only a handful of D1 coaches have hit the 400 win milestone with eight of them currently active
- ·The list gained a coach when Merrimack College transitioned to D1 status for this season
- · Swanson is one of only nine coaches who has recorded 400 wins all at a D1 institution

UNIQUELY UVA

The University of Virginia is an institution rich with history and tradition. Here is some of the terminology that contributes to UVA's culture.

- Grounds: The term used by students, faculty and alumni to refer to the University dating as far back as Thomas Jefferson: "Campus" is never used.
- First Year, Second Year, Third Year, Fourth Year: Instead of freshman, sophomore, junior, senior. Why you may
 ask? To be a "senior" implies that a person has reached the final phase of learning, a feat that Thomas
 Jefferson believed to be impossible, arguing instead that education is a life-long process. This tends to be
 used less in athletic eligibility references.
- Commonwealth: Virginia is one of four constituent states of the United States of America that officially uses the name "Commonwealth" instead of the word state in all references. The other three commonwealths are Kentucky, Massachusetts and Pennsylvania.

UNIVERSITY NICKNAMES

- · Virginia's athletics teams have been accompanied by a somewhat confusing array of nicknames. The most prominent and widely accepted of these monikers are "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos."
- Although the terms "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are used almost interchangeably to refer to University teams and players, "Cavaliers" is more often used by the media, while "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are frequently used by Virginia students and fans.
- Legend has it that Washington & Lee baseball fans dubbed the Virginia players "Wahoos" during the fiercely
 contested rivalry that existed between the two in-state schools in the 1890s. By 1940, "Wahoos" was in
 general use around Grounds to denote University students or events relating to them. The abbreviated "Hoos"
 sprang up later in student newspapers and has gained growing popularity in recent years.

THE CAVALIER MASCOT

•The costumed Cavalier with a large character head debuted during Virginia's 1984 football season and has remained the official mascot of the University.

UNIVERSITY COLORS: ORANGE AND BLUE

- Orange and blue were adopted as the University of Virginia's official athletic colors at a mass student meeting in 1888. UVA athletic teams had previously worn silver gray and cardinal red, but those colors did not stand out on muddy football fields, prompting a student movement to change them.
- One of the students attending the mass meeting was Allen Potts, a star athlete who played on Virginia's first football team in 1888. Potts showed up at the meeting wearing a navy blue-and-orange scarf that he had acquired during a summer boating expedition at Oxford University. Orange and blue were chosen as the official athletic colors after one of Potts' fellow students pulled the scarf off Potts' neck and, waving it to the crowd, yelled, "How will this do?" UVA later served as the inspiration for schools like Auburn and Florida when they selected school colors.

WAHOOWA

- The origin of "Wah-hoo-wah" is uncertain. The cheer was used to root on Virginia teams as early as 1890 and may have been borrowed from Dartmouth College, whose athletics teams were once known as the Indians.
- · Legend attributes the yell to Natalie Floyd Otey, who sang the ballad "Where'er You Are, There Shall My Love Be" at Charlottesville's Levy Opera House in 1893. The predominantly student audience noticed that Otey warbled the first three words of the song between each of the stanzas and decided to join in the refrain. By evening's end, goes the legend, the crowd had corrupted "Where'er You Are" into "Wah-hoo-wah."
