



FIELD HOCKEY

CAVALIER NOTES

- Virginia moved up one spot in this week's NFCA poll to a season-best No. 6 ranking. The Cavaliers have been ranked in the top-10 since the Week 1 poll
- Virginia is No. 1 in strength of schedule this season
- There is only one team on Virginia's schedule that has not been ranked this season: Kent State. James Madison and Temple were both unranked when Virginia faced them but both moved into the rankings with JMU coming in at No. 21 and Temple at No. 24. Next weekend's home opponent, Miami (Ohio) was ranked No. 24 but has slipped out of the top 25
- Virginia is coming off a 3-2 road win at No. 25 Duke on Friday night. The Cavaliers scored all three goals in the second quarter
- Senior **Laura Janssen** scored her team-leading eighth goal of the year at Duke. The highest-scoring season of her career was her sophomore year (2020-21) when she netted nine goals
- Janssen has scored a goal or had an assist in every game this season except against Temple and Boston College
- Freshman **Daniela Mendez-Trendler**, the reigning ACC Co-Offensive Player of the Week, scored her sixth goal of the year at Duke. Mendez-Trendler has scored four goals in the last three games
- Freshman goalkeeper **Jet Trimborn** had her scoreless streak against conference opponents snapped at 223 minutes when the Blue Devils scored five minutes into the second quarter. It was the first goal she had allowed against an ACC opponent to start her collegiate career. It also snapped her streak of three-straight shutouts that she brought into the contest
- Grad student **Annie McDonough** had two assists in Friday's game. She also had two assists against Syracuse
- The Cavaliers outshot Duke 18-4 after outshooting William & Mary 24-0 last Sunday. In the last two games, Virginia has outshot its opponents 42-4
- Prior to the William & Mary game, the last time Virginia held an opponent to zero shots on game was an Oct. 13, 2019 game at Miami University

- Virginia's three losses this season have been by a single goal. Last season, all nine of UVA's losses were by one goal including a 1-0 loss in overtime to Boston College in the regular season
- In the spring of 2021 (the second half of the split COVID season), UVA went 3-4, with the final three of those losses coming by one goal, including two overtime losses. UVA's last 15 losses have all been by one goal

HOMECOMINGS WEEKEND

- This is Homecomings Weekend for the University and numerous UVA field hockey alumnae will be in attendance at Sunday's game
- Additionally, former UVA field hockey coach and administrator Jane Miller will be presenting the game ball in a pregame recognition

SCOUTING MIAMI

- Miami was ranked as high as No. 24 this season in the NFCA Coaches Poll
- The Redhawks are coming off a shootout loss on Friday night at Mid-American Conference opponent Longwood, falling 2-1 to the Lancers
- Both teams scored their lone goals of the game in the first quarter
- Miami has won the last five MAC regular-season championships and was picked to repeat this year in the preseason coaches poll
- Claudia Negrete Garcia and Paula Peña Martinez are tied for the team lead with nine goals apiece. Macy McHale has nine assists
- Head coach Iñako Puzo spent two years as Virginia's associate head coach (the 2009 and 2010 Final Four teams) with Michele Madison before taking the job at Miami where he has been named the MAC Coach of the Year five times
- Assistant coach Chip Rogers worked in UVA's media relations department before joining Miami's coaching staff
- Virginia leads the all-time series 13-0

• **Danielle Husar** helped the Canadian U21 team win gold at the 2021 Junior Pan Ams to earn a spot in the Junior World Cup. She traveled to South Africa to compete at the FIH Junior World Cup April 1-12 in Potchefstroom, South Africa, approximately 75 miles west-southwest of Johannesburg

• **Jans Croon** and **Daniela Mendez-Trendler** are members of the US U21 team. They helped the team win bronze at the Uniphar 5-Nations Tournament in Dublin in June

• **Meghen Hengerer** is also a member of the US U21 team, but did not travel with the team this summer

• **Lauren Kenah** and **Caroline Nemece** are both members of the US Rise National Team (U18) and played in the series against the Canadian U18 in May in Pennsylvania

• **Lindsay Dickinson** is a member of the US Women's Development Team

HEAD COACH MICHELE MADISON

• Head coach **Michele Madison** is in her 17th season at Virginia and her 34th overall as a head coach

• Madison was inducted into the National Field Hockey Coaches Association Hall of Fame in 2013 and was named the 2017 ACC Coach of the Year

• She has a career record of 439-266-8 (.619 win percentage) and a 225-119 (.650 win percentage) record at UVA

• Her 439 wins are sixth-most among active DI coaches and rank 8th overall

• Madison is one of only two active Division I head coaches to be a part of two United States Olympic staffs, having worked as a manager with the 1988 Olympic Team in Seoul and served as the head goalkeeper coach with the 1996 squad in Atlanta
