Virginia Cavaliers (2-0, 0-0 ACC) vs. Wake Forest Demon Deacons (2-0, 0-0 ACC) Sunday, Nov. 13, 2 p.m., John Paul Jones Arena

- Wake Forest and Virginia are playing the first ACC game of the 2022-23 campaign of any team. There isn't another ACC contest until Dec. 7 between Boston College and Virginia Tech. UVA's next conference contest is Wednesday, Dec. 21 at Duke
- The Wake Forest/Virginia contest features the conference debuts of two of the league's four new head coaches: Amaka Agugua-Hamilton and Wake Forest's Megan Gebbia. Florida State (Brooke Wyckoff) and Syracuse (Felisha Legette-Jack) also have new head coaches this season
- This is the earliest the Cavaliers have ever played a conference game. The previous earliest was a Nov. 21 contest against Georgia Tech in 1982
- The Cavaliers opened the season with an 85-59 victory against George Washington on Monday. Virginia trailed by six with 9:18 left in the third quarter but outscored the Colonials 31-9 in the fourth
- Virginia improved to 2-0 in the Coach Mox era with a 101-49 victory against UMBC on Thursday
- Senior guard London Clarkson pushed the team over the century mark with a layup with 52 seconds remaining in the game
- It was the 36th 100-point game in program history and the first since scoring 103 against Central Connecticut State on Nov. 12, 2017
- The Cavaliers scored 80 points in back-to-back games for the first time since the 2014-15 season when UVA had 100 vs. Delaware State on Dec. 6 and followed that up with 91 vs. Longwood on Dec. 16
- Virginia had five players score double in each of the first two games. Two players, Camryn Taylor and Sam Brunelle, did so in both games. Eight of Virginia's 11 players have scored in double figures in a game this season
- On Monday, all nine players who dressed for the George Washington game scored in the game. On Wednesday, all 11 players on the roster scored and had at least one rebound and one assist against UMBC
- Virginia is averaging 93.0 points per game with a +40.5 scoring differential. Virginia has averaged fewer than 60 points per game in three of the last four seasons and has finished last in the ACC in scoring in each of the last two seasons. The Cavaliers haven't averaged more than 65 points per game since 2014-15. The last time the Cavaliers averaged 70 points per game for a season was 2013-14

HEAD COACH AMAKA AGUGUA- HAMILTON "COACH MOX"

- Amaka Agugua-Hamilton (Uh-mah-kuh Uh-goo-gwa) comes to Virginia after serving as the head coach at Missouri State the past three seasons. She is a native of Herndon, Va.
- During Agugua-Hamilton's three years heading up the Lady Bears program, Missouri State went 74-15 including a 46-6 record in Missouri Valley Conference play. Her teams won two MVC regular-season titles (2020, 2021) and have played in the past two NCAA Tournaments (2021, 2022), including a Sweet 16 trip in 2020-21. In her inaugural season, Missouri State appeared headed to the NCAA Tournament with a 26-4 record when the postseason was canceled due to the pandemic.
- Agugua-Hamilton has twice won MVC Coach of the Year honors, was named the Women's Basketball Coaches Association Spalding Maggie Dixon Rookie Coach of the Year in 2020, and was one of 10 finalists for WBCA National Coach of the Year in 2021. This season, Agugua-Hamilton became just the fourth head coach in Division I history to reach 60 victories in less than 70 games to begin their career at the Division I level.
- She made her USA Basketball coaching debut in the summer of 2022, serving as a court coach for the Women's U18 National Team trials.
- The 2021-22 Missouri State team went 25-8 and was a No. 11 seed in the NCAA Championships. The Lady Bears defeated Florida State 61-50 in the tournament's inaugural First Four before bowing out against No. 6 Ohio State in the first round of the tournament.
- The victory against the Seminoles was one of nine she had against Power Five opponents during her three seasons at MSU. That list includes wins versus USC, Virginia Tech, Missouri (three), Maryland, Minnesota and Oklahoma
- Agugua-Hamilton has two previous coaching stops in the Commonwealth. She was an assistant coach at VCU for the 2007-08 and 2008-09 seasons when the Rams went 52-15. She was on the staff at Old Dominion in 2011-12 and 2012-13.
- She was an assistant coach at Michigan State for six years prior to her head coaching stint at Missouri State, helping the Spartans to four seasons with at least 21 wins, four NCAA Tournaments, one WNIT bid, and the 2014 Big Ten regular-season title.
- In 2020-21, Missouri State finished with a 23-3 record, advancing to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament. MSU extended its ranking streak in the Coaches Poll to 35 consecutive appearances and finished 14th, its highest ranking since 2001. Missouri State matched the program's best-ever NCAA Tournament seed with a No. 5, defeating UC Davis and Wright State in the postseason before falling to No. 1 overall seed Stanford in the Sweet 16 to end a 19-game win streak.
- Agugua-Hamilton played at Hofstra and is the Pride's career field goal percentage leader at .551 and graduated with the top three single-season field goal percentage marks in school history. A four-year team captain, she was a second-team All-Colonial Athletic Association pick in 2004, and helped Hofstra to a WNIT berth in 2006, the school's first-ever postseason appearance.

VIRGINIA NOTES (CONTINUED)

- The Cavaliers had 53 rebounds against GW, their first time with 50 rebounds since the 2019-20 season when they had 50 rebounds at Old Dominion (11/24/19)
- Virginia grabbed 65 rebounds against UMBC, their first time with 60 or more rebounds in a decade since grabbing 63 at Alabama on Dec. 21, 2012
- Three of the Cavaliers' newcomers made their debuts against George Washington. Freshman Yonta Vaughn grabbed six rebounds while dishing out four assists. Fellow freshman Cady Pauley hit a three-pointer. Notre Dame transfer Sam Brunelle scored 10 points with five rebounds
- Alexia Smith, a transfer from Minnesota, made her Cavalier debut against UMBC, grabbing a career-best nine rebounds
- Senior Camryn Taylor is averaging 18.5 points and 10.0 rebounds per game in the first two games of the season.
 Taylor was the Cavaliers' leading scorer last season but only played in 12 games, taking a personal leave of absence from the team after Jan. 13 game against NC State
- Grad student transfer Sam Brunelle had 13 points in the first half of the UMBC game, finishing with 21. She is averaging 15.5 points per game
- Brunelle is 4-of-9 from three-point range and shooting 54.2 percent overall (13-of-24)
- Guard Kaydan Lawson, who scored a career-high 18 points on Monday against GW, is averaging 8.0 rebounds per game

HIGH SCHOOL ACCOLADES

- The Cavaliers have two McDonlad's All-Americans on the team in Mir McLean and Sam Brunelle. UVA has only had two other McDonald's All-Americans in the program's history, Monica Wright (2006) and China Crosby (2009)
- The Cavaliers have three Gatorade State Players of the Year in Brunelle (VA), McLean (MD) and McKenna Dale (Conn.)

SIGNING DAY

- Amaka Agugua-Hamilton announced the signing of two top-50 recruits on National Signing Day
- Kymora Johnson is a point guard and a five-star recruit who plays at St. Anne's-Belfield, a private high school located a mile from John Paul Jones Arena. The 2022 Gatorade Virginia Player of the Year is the No. 24 recruit in the class
- Olivia McGhee is from Louisa County, approximately 40 miles from Grounds, but is playing her senior season at IMG Academy. The guard is the No. 45 recruit in the class
- With these signings and the transfer of Sam Brunelle from Notre Dame, the Cavaliers will have three players on next year's roster who grew up within 50 miles of the University
- The recruiting class is ranked No. 13 by ESPN.com

SEASON PREVIEW

- The Cavaliers open their 2022-23 campaign with three home games during the opening week, hosting UMBC on Thursday at 7 p.m. before playing their ACC opener on Sunday, Nov. 13 at 2 p.m. against Wake Forest
- Amaka Agugua-Hamilton ("Coach Mox") takes over as the head coach of the Cavaliers af-ter leading Missouri State for the last three seasons. She was an assistant coach at Michigan State for six years prior to taking over at Missouri State. Coach Mox is a native of Virginia, growing up in Herndon, Va. She earned her master's degree at VCU where she began her coaching career as an assistant coach. She also served as an assistant at Old Dominion in Norfolk, Va., from 2011-13
- During Agugua-Hamilton's three years heading up the Lady Bears program, Missouri State went 74-15, including a 46-6 record in Missouri Valley Conference play. Her teams won two MVC regular-season titles (2020, 2021) and have played in the past two NCAA Tournaments (2021, 2022), including a Sweet 16 trip in 2020-21. The 2021-22 Missouri State team went 25-8 and was a No. 11 seed in the NCAA Championships. The Lady Bears defeated Florida State 61-50 in the tournament's inaugural First Four before bowing out against No. 6 Ohio State in the first round of the tournament
- The victory against the Seminoles was one of nine she had against Power Five opponents during her three seasons at MSU. That list includes wins versus USC, Virginia Tech, Missouri (three), Maryland, Minnesota and Oklahoma.
- Coach Mox brought her entire coaching staff with herfrom Missouri State (three assistant coaches and a strength coach), including Tori Jankoska who played for her at Michigan State and graduated as the Spartans all-time leading scorer. Mox also has two former Missouri State Bears on her office staff, Abby Hipp the director of scouting and player development and Mariah White, the director of recruiting operations

- The Cavaliers return four of five members of their starting lineup and their first two off the bench from last year's team. In all, seven members of the 2021-22 team are back for the 2022-23 campaign. In all, UVA has seven players returning
- The team added two transfers: junior guard Alexia Smith from Minnesota (a 2022-23 Vir-ginia opponent) and grad student Samantha Brunelle from Notre Dame. Brunelle earned her undergrad at Notre Dame in three years. With her COVID year, she has two years of eligi-bility remainin
- Brunelle was named to the Katrina McClain Award preseason watch list for the third straight year. The accolade recognizes the top power forward in the country
- There are also two freshmen on the team, including Yonta Vaughn from Bishop McNama-ra High in Maryland. Vaughn was ranked No. 72 overall in last year's recruiting class and was the No. 15 point guard prospect
- Freshman Cady Pauley was ranked No. 10 in the nation in scoring her senior season, fin-ishing her career with 3,074 career points, ranking eighth all-time in Missouri girls' basket-ball history
- Senior forward Camryn Taylor was a breakout star for the Cavaliers last season, leading the team in scoring and rebounding. In her very first game with the Cavaliers, she scored a dazzling 27 points at James Madison. Taylor stepped away from the team for personal rea-sons in mid-January after playing only 12 games. She rejoined the team in the spring and looks to be a key element of this year's team, giving UVA a strong post presence
- Another breakout star returning from last year's team was fellow Marquette transfer, senior guard Taylor Valladay.
 Valladay averaged 6.7 points per game in the non-conference sea-son and then finished the regular season averaging 15.8 points per game in the final five contests heading into the ACC Tournament
- Junior forward Mir McLean, a mid-season transfer last year from UConn, made an imme-diate impact on the team, averaging 11.4 points and 8.3 rebounds per game. The latter stat would have ranked her fifth in the conference had she had enough minutes to qualify for rankings
- The Cavaliers played a preseason exhibition game last Thursday against NCAA II Pitt-Johnstown, winning 92-45. Taylor and Valladay each had 20-point performances, contributing 22 and 21 points. Taylor also had 10 rebounds in 24 minutes on the court. Valladay was 7-of-10 shooting and 7-of-8 from the free-throw line




