## HUGE NIGHT FOR FOSTER

Myles Foster led all players in the game Wednesday at Seton Hall with 18 points and 15 rebounds, both career highs for the forward. Foster posted his first career double-double, and the first opening night double-double for a Hawk since the 2017 opener against Bucknell when Micah Seaborn had 21 points and 10 rebounds.

## COLLINS STARTS AS A TRUE FRESHMAN

True freshman Jack Collins became the fourth true freshman to start a season opener under King Rice on Wednesday at Seton Hall. He joins teammate Myles Ruth (12/15/20 vs. Hofstra) and Justin Robinson and Zac Tillman (11/8/13 at Hofstra) in starting their first collegiate game as a true freshman.

## WHAT WAS LOST

Monmouth graduated seven seniors from last season, four fifth-years and three true seniors, a group that accounted for 574 career games at MU. That group featured three All-MAAC performers in George Papas, Walker Miller and Shavar Reynolds, with Papas finishing as the top single-season three-point shooter in program history. Also in that group was the program's all-time games played leader in Marcus McClary, last season's top rebounder in Nikkei Rutty, and veteran point guard Samuel Chaput.

## SCORING PERCENTAGES LOST

Monmouth graduated 84% of its scoring from a season ago, totaling 57.6 points per game amongst the seven graduates. MU returns 16% of last year's points, a total of 11 points per game. That number is third lowest in the NCAA (IUPUI and West Virginia return 9.1 points per game).

## WHAT ENTERS

The Hawks bring in four true freshmen as well as three players that redshirted a season ago to total seven players that are new on the floor this season. True freshmen Andrew Ball, Jack Collins, Amaan Sandhu and Jaret Valencia are joined by redshirts Tadhg Crowley, Jayden Doyle and Sam Fagan.

## ALLEN GOING TO THE RIM

The only member of last year's recruiting class to see action last season, Tahron Allen, posted his first career double-digit scoring game on Wednesday at Seton Hall, finishing with 11 points, all of them at the rim or from the foul line.

## STAFF CHANGES

King Rice enters his 12th season with Rick Callahan by his side, and the staff welcomes two new faces for 2022-23. A familiar coach is back on the MU bench

as Brian Reese, a four-year member of Rice’s original staff in 2011, is back as an assistant coach. Also joining the coaching staff is Clive Bentick as an assistant coach after a long run as an assistant at St. Francis Brooklyn.

**CAA BOUND**

The Hawks are entering their first season as a member of the Colonial Athletic Association, and will be the first team in the league to open CAA play on December 28. This is the second conference change for King Rice, who transitioned the Blue and White from the NEC to the MAAC in 2013.

**COLONIAL PRESEASON POLL**

Monmouth, in its first season in the league, was chosen 10th in the conference’s preseason coaches poll, with MU selected ahead of North Carolina A&T, Hampton and Elon. The Hawks have matched or outperformed their preseason ranking in nine of Rice’s 11 seasons to this point, including winning three MAAC regular season titles despite being picked first just once.

**WINNING 20**

Monmouth won 20 games last season for the third time under King Rice and seventh time as a Division I member. Rice’s two prior 20-win years came in 2015-16 and 2016-17, when the Blue and White won 28 and 27 games. Overall, it was the 16th time in the program’s 66-year history that the Hawks have topped the 20-win plateau.

**RICE SETS PROGRAM WINS RECORD**

With the win on 2/22/22 against Siena, King Rice set the program’s Division I wins record with his 179th victory in his career, all of them coming at Monmouth. That number is second all-time in the history of the program behind Bill Boylan (364).

**ROAD WARRIORS**

Monmouth as third the nation in road victories with 10 true road wins last season, behind only Chattanooga who had 12, as well as Towson, Navy and Murray State with 11.

**TV DEALS**

Monmouth recently reached an agreement for a robust television deal that will feature eight home games airing on SportsNet New York, with five of those to also air on NBC Sports Philadelphia. In addition, MU will play twice on CBS Sports Network as part of the CAA package.

# HEAD COACH KING RICE

North Carolina, 1992 | | 12th Season | | 182-168 Overall | | 0-0 CAA



King Rice has been on the Monmouth sideline for 11 seasons and leads the Hawks into the CAA in his 12th in 2022-23. In February 2022, Rice became the winningest Division I Head Coach in Monmouth Basketball history. He has 182 victories to his credit, as well as a trio of MAAC Coach of the Year honors and three MAAC regular season titles. Rice has set Monmouth records for wins in a season with 28 and consecutive victories with 17. Rice also set a MAAC Record in 2016-17 by winning 18 league games for the first time ever. He has won the John McLendon National Coach of the Year honor, while being named a finalist for the Ben Jobe Award. The 2021-22 Hawks got off to the best start in program history, beginning 10-2 in the first 12 games of the season. Among those 12 wins included signature victories over AAC-member Cincinnati, ACC-foe Pitt and Atlantic 10 opponent Saint Joseph's. Four fifth-year seniors led MU throughout the season under Rice's coaching, with George Papas, Walker Miller and Shavar Reynolds earning spots on All-MAAC teams.

Marcus McClary finished his career as the all-time games played leader in school history, while Papas set the program's single-season three-point record, making 103. Currently, 11 players that played under Rice at Monmouth are playing professional basketball. Rice was awarded with a five-year contract extension in August 2021, following winning his third MAAC regular season title in 2020-21. Rice became the third coach in MAAC history in 2021 to be named the league's Coach of the Year for a third time. He also won his third regular season crown in the pandemic-impacted season, navigating the Hawks through an adversity-filled campaign to finish atop the MAAC. Three MU seniors were named All-MAAC, including Deion Hammond to the First Team, George Papas to the Second Team and Melik Martin to the Third Team. Hammond broke the program's 30-year old record during the season for career made three pointers. The 2019-20 saw Rice lead the Hawks to an 18-win campaign, tied for the third most in a season in his tenure. He had his third player ever named to the All-MAAC First Team in junior guard Deion Hammond, who finished second in the league in scoring, while backcourt mate Ray Salnave was a Second Team selection. Hammond and Salnave both reached the 1,000 career point plateau in their third seasons. MU finished non-league play over .500 in a slate that included wins over Princeton, Albany, Lehigh and eventual Big South regular season champion Radford, and eventually tied for third in the conference and secured a first-round tournament bye for the fourth time in six seasons. A trio of Hawks were also named to the MAAC All-Academic Team under Rice's leadership. Rice orchestrated a momentous turnaround in 2018-19, leading the Hawks to the conference finals while beating three teams in the MAAC Tournament that MU had not yet topped during the regular season. He tutored senior big man Diago Quinn into All-MAAC Third Team honors, while the New York City native graduated as the program's all-time games played leader. Rice coached a pair of players to All-Conference honors in 2017-18, including four-year guard Austin Tilghman, who was named to the Third Team and also became the first guard in school history to register a triple-double, doing so at Yale on December 22. He also mentored Deion Hammond to unanimous All-Rookie Team accolades, with the guard averaging 12 points per contest. In 11 years in West Long Branch, Rice has now graduated all 33 seniors. Following the 2016-17 year, Monmouth men's basketball was one of 35 programs recognized across the nation in men's hoops for its multiyear Academic Progress Rate (APR) and received the NCAA's APR Public Recognition Award. Monmouth was the only school in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference as well as one of just three teams in the state of New Jersey. Rice's team has now earned this recognition in three straight seasons. With his second straight conference Coach of the Year honor in 2016-17, Rice became just the third coach in MAAC history to repeat and the second to do it outright, joining former Iona coach Tim Welsh and ex-LaSalle head man Speedy Morris. Rice secured a second consecutive regular season title and the top seed in the MAAC Tournament, coaching the Hawks to a National Invitation Tournament for the second time. He also earned his second straight NABC District I Coach of the Year accolade, the first MU coach to do so. Rice mentored Justin Robinson to a second straight MAAC Player of the Year and third All-MAAC First Team, as well as being named the Lou Henson National Mid-Major Player of the Year. Robinson graduated as the school's all-time leading scorer at the Division I level and became the second 2,000-point scorer in MU history. He also coached his second MAAC Sixth Man of the Year in three years in guard Austin Tilghman, and a second straight all-league selection for Micah Seaborn, who was named First Team. MU won 17 straight games, including 16 straight to end the regular season, not losing after January 2. He secured a comeback win at Memphis in December, as well as a win over eventual Ivy champion Princeton at home. In 2015-16, leading the Hawks to a program best 28 wins and a top seed in the National Invitation Tournament, as well as wins over five high-major programs. He coached the Hawks to the MAAC regular season title with a 17-3 league mark, collecting MAAC Coach of the Year honors in addition to being named John McLendon National Coach of the Year. Rice picked up ECAC and NABC District I Coach of the Year accolades as well, while being named a finalist for the Ben Jobe Award. Rice posted 17 league victories, including an 11-2 mark at home and a nation-leading 13 road tallies and 17 wins away from home, including neutral site wins. He secured Monmouth's first regular season title in 11 years and the top seed in the conference tournament while knocking off the program's first-ever ranked opponent in No. 17 Notre Dame on Thanksgiving night as well as wins at UCLA, Georgetown and Rutgers and a neutral site victory over Southern California. The Blue and White also notched its first national postseason win since 2006 and the first ever at home, topping Bucknell in the opening round of the NIT. In his fifth season in West Long Branch, Rice mentored MAAC Player of the Year Justin Robinson and league Rookie of the Year Micah Seaborn, both of whom were all-conference selections along with senior Deon Jones. Robinson earned multiple national awards while setting the single-season scoring record under Rice's tutelage.

## THE OCEANFIRST BANK CENTER

Prior to the 2016-17 season, the arena formerly known as The MAC was renamed the OceanFirst Bank Center thanks to a naming rights deal with OceanFirst Bank. MU Basketball enters its eighth season in the building after playing previously in Boylan Gymnasium. Monmouth University ushered in a new era in the school's history with the completion and opening of the long anticipated arena in the Fall of 2009. It not only serves the school's 23 Division I Athletics programs, but is also a key asset for the entire University community. The facility features classroom and seminar space and a conference center that can be used for meetings, or be partitioned and used for study hall, clinics or workshops. The gym, which features a state-of-the-art fitness center, is also the location of the Leon Hess Champions' Hall, Monmouth Athletics Hall of Fame and Varsity Club, which will be used for hospitality for Blue/White Club members. Student lounges and study areas with complete wireless Internet access are also available.

The OceanFirst Bank Center, which is connected to Boylan Gym and the Steadman Natatorium, is 153,200 square feet of space for students and the community to utilize in many different capacities. It's most prominent feature is the 4,000 seat arena, which is the nest for the Monmouth men's and women's basketball programs. The arena also features a six-lane, 200-meter indoor track, which can be used for training and competition all year long. A fitness center with state-of-the-art strength and cardiovascular equipment is also housed here.

The arena provides varsity athletes & coaches with meeting facilities, locker rooms, practice and competition facilities & expanded and upgraded amenities. The University Bookstore was also relocated from the Stafford Student Center, which will improve accessibility for commuting students, and the additional square footage will enable the stocking of a greater variety of merchandise.

In the summer of 2011, with funds raised through private donations, Monmouth's varsity athletics weight room was given a \$200,000 overhaul.

Renovations, which began in June and were funded entirely by the generous donations of Monmouth supporters, included a brand new Mondo floor, replaced HVAC system, new lights and a fresh paint job. The aesthetics of the room were improved with MU branded wall decorations.

## MONMOUTH BASKETBALL MEDIA POLICIES

**In-Season Interview Policy:** Requests for Coach Rice and Monmouth players must be made at least 24 hours in advance. All interviews must be coordinated through the Monmouth Office of Athletics Communications.

**Practice:** Practices are open to accredited members of the media with prior arrangements through the Office of Communications. Shooting of video and still photos is limited and arrangements must be made through Athletics Communications. Monmouth players are unavailable on gamedays until the post-game press conference.

**Post-Game Press Conference:** Post-game press conferences begin approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of each game. A member of the Monmouth Athletics Communications staff will escort Monmouth head coach King Rice and requested players to the media room in the OceanFirst Bank Center. The opposing coach and players (if requested) will also be brought to the media room after Coach Rice.

**Media Credentials:** Arrangements for media credentials for Monmouth home basketball games must be made through the Monmouth Athletics Communications office. Requests by accredited media members should be submitted through Gary Kowal. Credentials must be requested at least 48 hours prior to requested game.
