- The 47-point win was UVA's largest since a 57-point win (97-40) win over Coppin State in 2018-19
- UVA is 89-10 at JPJ in non-conference action under Tony Bennett
- Bennett registered his 387th career win and 318th at UVA
- UVA is 37-1 when scoring 80 or more under Bennett
- UVA is 107-2, when limiting foes to fewer then 50 points during the Tony Bennett era.
