

**No. 10 Virginia 76, Wake Forest 67**  
**Saturday, Jan. 21, 2023**  
**Lawrence Joel Veterans Memorial Coliseum**

**Team Notes**

- Head coach Tony Bennett recorded his 400th career win
- Virginia is 154-11 when scoring at least 70 or more points under Tony Bennett
- UVA is 10-0 when scoring 70 or more points in 2022-23
- UVA is 6-2 away from home and 4-2 on the road
- UVA drilled 10 or more 3-pointers for the sixth time (6-0)
- UVA's 15 3-pointers and 34 3-point attempts marked season highs
- Wake went on a 7-0 run to cut the UVA margin to 45-39
- UVA started 0 of 8 from the field before a Ben Vander Plas layup at 16:16
- UVA started 0 of 6 from 3-point range, but buried seven straight in the first half
- UVA's 17-0 run staked the Hoos to a 29-14 lead
- UVA's 22-1 run ignited a 34-15 lead
- UVA went 9 of 20 from 3-point range and led 42-32 at the half

**Series Notes**

- Virginia is 70-71 all-time vs. Wake Forest, including a 17-41 mark in Winston-Salem, in the series that dates to 1910-11.
- UVA has won 11 of the last 12 meetings in the series, including a five-game win streak in Winston-Salem
- The Cavaliers have scored 65 or more points in eight of their last 11 games (7-1) vs. the Demon Deacons
- Tony Bennett is 11-5 vs. Wake Forest as head coach at Virginia

**Player Notes**

- Double Figure Scorers: Armaan Franklin (25), Kihei Clark (12), Isaac McKneely (11)
- Franklin added a career-high 10 rebounds for his first career double-double
- Franklin recorded his eighth 20-point game at UVA (5th in 2022-23 and 11th career)
- Franklin has an eight-game double figure streak and 47 career game with 10+ points
- Franklin scored 18 of his 25 points in the first half
- Franklin attempted a career-high 13 3-pointers
- Franklin matched a career-high with five 3-pointers
- McKneely reached double figures for the fourth time
- Ryan Dunn had career highs in rebounds (8) and minutes (30)
- Clark reached double figures for the 62nd time
- Clark (4,840 minutes) passed Duke's Chris Duhon (4,813 from 2001-04) for second on the ACC's career minutes played list
- Clark (1,290 points) passed Cory Alexander (1,286 from 1992-95) for 28th on the list.
- Beekman had a game-high six assists
- UVA started Clark, Beekman, Franklin, Gardner and Vander Plas for the third straight game
