- No. 1 Virginia (2-0) heads to Naples, Florida on Saturday (Feb. 25) to take on No. 9 Ohio State (3-0) in a top-10
 matchup at the Paradise Coast Sports Complex.
- · Saturday's neutral-site meeting will stream on B1G+ with a paid subscription.
- · Saturday's contest also marks Virginia's first-ever in the state of Florida.

 $\cdot\,$ The Cavaliers are ranked No. 1 in all three polls, USILA, Inside Lacrosse and Nike/USA Lacrosse Magazine.

LAST TIME OUT

- Last Saturday (Feb. 11), Virginia improved to 2-0 on the season after defeating then-No.18 Harvard, 25-21.
- The Hoos never trailed in last Saturday's matchup against the Crimson. The game also set the NCAA record for most faceoff attempts (47).
- Connor Shellenberger (3g, 7a) set a career high with 10 points. His seven assists are also a career best.
- Shellenberger's 10-point performance tied for No. 8 all-time in UVA single-game history.
- Xander Dickson scored a team-high five goals on five shots.

SERIES HISTORY

- Virginia and Ohio State meet for the first time at a neutral site on Feb. 25, 2023 at the Paradise Coast Sports Complex.
- UVA, which leads the all-time series 6-1, suffered an 11-10 loss at Klöckner Stadium the last time the two teams went head-to-head, which was in 2013. There was a 103-minute lightning delay during the game. The Cavaliers had a chance to force overtime, but former OSU goalie Greg Dutton stopped Nick O'Reily's shot from the crease with five seconds remaining.
- UVA has only faced the Buckeyes away from Klöckner Stadium twice, both of which were true away games but in separate venues in Columbus. The Cavaliers' first road game against OSU was in 2000, a 13-7 victory from Jesse Owens Stadium, and an 11-9 win at Ohio Stadium in 2012.

NUMBERS TO KNOW

Virginia enters 2023 with seven NCAA championships. UVA's seven NCAA titles are third most by any program since the NCAA Tournament's inception in 1971.

Virginia returns nine starters in 2023. The Cavaliers' only departure from last year's starting lineup is attackman Matt Moore, who was drafted No. 4 overall in the 2022 PLL Draft by the Archers.

Midfielder **Thomas McConvey**, a transfer from Vermont, has registered at least one point in all 54 career games. His 54-game point streak leads all collegiate players nationally.

THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA

UNIQUELY UVA

The University of Virginia is an institution rich with history and tradition. Here is some of the terminology that contributes to UVA's culture.

Grounds: The term used by students, faculty and alumni to refer to the University dating as far back as Thomas Jefferson. "Campus" is never used.

First Year, Second Year, Third Year, Fourth Year: Instead of freshman, sophomore, junior, senior. Why you may ask? To be a "senior" implies that a person has reached the final phase of learning, a feat that Thomas Jefferson believed to be impossible, arguing instead that education is a life-long process.

Commonwealth: Virginia is one of four constituent states of the United States of America that officially uses the name "Commonwealth" instead of the word state in all references. The other three commonwealths are Kentucky, Massachusetts and Pennsylvania.

UNIVERSITY NICKNAMES

Virginia's athletics teams have been accompanied by a somewhat confusing array of nicknames. The most prominent and widely accepted of these monikers are "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos."

Although the terms "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are used almost interchangeably to refer to University teams and players, "Cavaliers" is more often used by the media, while "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are frequently used by Virginia students and fans.

Legend has it that Washington & Lee baseball fans dubbed the Virginia players "Wahoos" during the fiercely contested rivalry that existed between the two in-state schools in the 1890s. By 1940, "Wahoos" was in general use around Grounds to denote University students or events relating to them. The abbreviated "Hoos" sprang up later in student newspapers and has gained growing popularity in recent years.

THE CAVALIER MASCOT

The costumed Cavalier with a large character head debuted during Virginia's 1984 football season and has remained the official mascot of the University.

UNIVERSITY COLORS

Orange and blue were adopted as the University of Virginia's official athletic colors at a mass student meeting in 1888. UVA athletic teams had previously worn silver gray and cardinal red, but those colors did not stand out on muddy football fields, prompting a student movement to change them.

One of the students attending the mass meeting was Allen Potts, a star athlete who played on Virginia's first football team in 1888. Potts showed up at the meeting wearing a navy blue-and-orange scarf that he had acquired during a summer boating expedition at Oxford University. Orange and blue were chosen as the official athletic colors after one of Potts' fellow students pulled the scarf off Potts' neck and, waving it to the crowd, yelled, "How will this do?" UVA later served as the inspiration for schools like Auburn and Florida when they selected school colors.

WAH-HOO-WAH

The origin of "Wah-hoo-wah" is uncertain. The cheer was used to root on Virginia teams as early as 1890 and may have been borrowed from Dartmouth College, whose athletics teams were once known as the Indians.

Legend attributes the yell to Natalie Floyd Otey, who sang the ballad "Where'er You Are, There Shall My Love Be" at Charlottesville's Levy Opera House in 1893. The predominantly student audience noticed that Otey warbled the first three words of the song between each of the stanzas and decided to join in the refrain. By evening's end, goes the legend, the crowd had corrupted "Where'er You Are" into "Wah-hoo-wah."

The Levy Opera House stands at the corner of High Street and Park Street and has since been renovated into an office building.

• Virginia's largest margin of victory in the series was a 21-0 shutout in 1999, the same year UVA won its second NCAA Championship. The shutout was the program's sixth at the time and first since blanking Virginia Tech 27-0 in 1986. UVA was credited with 83 ground balls, while the Buckeyes managed 42.

SEASON OVERVIEW

- The 2023 season marks the 95th season for the Virginia men's lacrosse program, which boasts an all-time record of **682-378-5**.
- This season, the Cavaliers will host eight regular season games at Klöckner Stadium, including three ACC contests and a rematch of the 2021 NCAA Championship game against Maryland.
- Virginia returns nine starters from its 2022 roster, including Tewaaraton Award finalist **Connor Shellenberger**, 2022 ACC Defensive Player of the Year **Cole Kastner** and 2022 ACC Freshman of the Year **Matthew Nunes**.

2022 SEASON RECAP

- Virginia finished its 2022 season with an overall record of 12-4, marking the Cavaliers' sixth consecutive winning season.
- UVA earned a share of the program's 19th ACC title, alongside Notre Dame, after finishing with a 5-1 record in league play.
- Connor Shellenberger was named one of five Tewarraton Finalists, UVA's 11th finalist in program history.
- Cole Kastner (Defensive Player of the Year) and Matthew Nunes (Freshman of the Year) earned ACC postseason
 awards.

THE CAVALIERS AT KLÖCKNER STADIUM

- Virginia is currently on an 11-game win streak in games held at Klöckner Stadium, a streak that began in 2021.
 Virginia owns a 168-43 (.796) all-time record at Klöckner Stadium, including a 2-0 record in 2023, and has won 21 of its last 25 games played at the historic edifice.
- The Cavaliers' average margin of victory in their last 25 games at Klöckner Stadium is 5.08.
- Virginia is 42-11 (.792) all-time at Klöckner Stadium under head coach Lars Tiffany.
- · UVA is also 13-3 all-time at Klöckner Stadium in the NCAA Tournament.

- The USILA Poll began in 1973.

CONNOR SHELLENBERGER IS ELITE

- **Connor Shellenberger**, who is in his third season at UVA, is arguably the mostaccomplished active player in college lacrosse.
- \cdot In addition to being a two-time USILA first team All-American (2021-22),
- Shellenberger became UVA's 11th Tewaaraton Award finalist last season. • This year, Shellenberger was crowned a first team preseason All-American by the
- USILA, Inside Lacrosse and USA Lacrosse Magazine, and the top returning player in 2023 by Inside Lacrosse.
- \cdot This offseason, Shellenberger was invited to try out for a spot on the U.S. National Team for the 2023 World Championships.
- In 2022, he led UVA in points (76) and assists (44) and finished second in goals (32).
- In 2021, Shellenberger was sensational in the NCAA Tournament, guiding the Hoos to the program's seventh NCAA championship and was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player.
- In 36 career appearances, Shellenberger has posted at least one point in 35 contests and has recorded multiple assists in 28 career games.

MORE ON THE UVA AND THE TEWAARATON AWARD

- In addition to Shellenberger in 2022, UVA's other Tewaaraton Award finalists include: Steele Stanwick (2011-12), Ken Clausen (2010), Danny Glading (2009), Ben Rubeor (2007-08), Kyle Dixon (2006), Matt Ward (2006), Chris Rotelli (2003) and Conor Gill (2002).
- Stanwick (2011), Ward (2006) and Rotelli (2003) were recipients of the award.
- Virginia, Maryland and Syracuse are the only schools in the nation to have three Tewaaraton Award winners. Only Duke (13) and Syracuse (12) have had more finalists than UVA (11).

GOING STREAKING

- Newcomer Thomas McConvey, a transfer in the midfield from the University of Vermont, is currently riding a 54-game point streak, which began on Feb. 1, 2019.
- McConvey has registered at least one point in every game of his career.
- His 54-game point streak leads the nation among all active players.
- During his streak, McConvey has amassed 132 goals and 51 assists.

CAVALIERS EXCELLING ON THE FIELD & IN THE CLASSROOM

- \cdot On Feb. 15, Virginia men's lacrosse announced it achieved a 3.610 team GPA in the Fall of 2022.
- The Cavaliers' 3.610 team GPA led all UVA men's athletic programs for the semester.
- · It also marked a 10% increase from the team's GPA in the fall of 2021.

VIRGINIA'S EIGHT PRESEASON ALL-AMERICANS

- Eight Cavaliers in Connor Shellenberger (1st), Thomas McConvey (2nd), Cole Kastner (2nd), Payton Cormier (3rd), Jeff Conner (HM), Petey LaSalla (HM), Grayson Sallade (HM) and Cade Saustad (HM) were named Preseason All-Americans by Inside Lacrosse.
- · UVA's eight honorees led all Division-I programs nationally.

LAST SEASON, VIRGINIA WAS UNDEFEATED WHEN ...

- In 2022, the Cavaliers finished 12-0 when leading their opponents after three quarters.
- UVA combined to out-score its opponents 203-138 in the first three periods of 2022, which is an average lead of 4.1 goals entering the fourth period.
- Last season, the Cavaliers went 10-0 when leading at halftime and 1-0 when tied at the half.

PETEY LASALLA: THE NATION'S DEADLIEST FACEOFF SPECIALIST

With **813** career faceoff wins, **Petey LaSalla** is currently second among all active Division-I players.

- LaSalla is the only player in all of college lacrosse with at least 813 career wins at the center-X and 31 career goals.
- In addition to his 31 career goals, LaSalla has dished out 11 career assists, making him the only player in the nation with at least 813 career faceoff victories and 42 career points.
- Virginia is 21-3 (.875) all-time when LaSalla scores a goal, including 2-0 in 2023, and 26-5 (.839) all-time when registering at least one point.
- LaSalla set a career high with three points on two goals and one assist in Virginia's ACC-championship clinching game at Syracuse last season.
- LaSalla won the first eight faceoffs of the game in UVA's 19-8 route over Johns Hopkins (March 5, 2022), and finished the contest 9-of-10, setting his single-game career high in faceoff win percentage. LaSalla tied that career best mark (9-of-10) at Richmond (April 2, 2022) before exiting the game with an upper-extremity injury.

SHELLENBERGER, LASALLA EARN ACC WEEKLY HONORS

For their performance against then-No. 18 Harvard, Connor Shellenberger and Petey LaSalla were named the ACC's Co-Offensive Player of the Week and Co-Defensive Player of the Week, respectively, for games played Feb. 13-19, the conference office announced Feb. 21.

 Shellenberger (3g, 7a) recorded a career-high 10 points, and his seven assists are also a career best. At the time, his 10 points tied for the most nationally by an individual in a single game this season and most by an ACC player this year. Shellenberger's 10-point performance is also tied for eighth all-time in program history and marks just the 17th occasion that a UVA player has registered 10 points or more.

 In a game that set the NCAA record for most combined faceoffs (49), LaSalla dominated the center X, finishing 18-for-29 (.621) against the Crimson. LaSalla also tallied a game-high 10 ground balls and ripped two goals off faceoff wins. LaSalla's second goal of the evening proved to be the game-winning goal in what was one of the highest-scoring games in NCAA men's lacrosse history.

SALLADE NAMED ACC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

• With three ground balls and two caused turnovers in UVA's season opener against Michigan, **Grayson Sallade** was named the ACC's Defensive Player of the Week on Feb. 14.

- The weekly award was Sallade's first of his career.
- Sallade and the UVA defense held the Wolverines to just one goal in the fourth guarter and scoreless on all four of their extra-man opportunities.
- As a member of Virginia's faceoff unit, Sallade helped the Cavaliers finish 18-for-32 at the center X.

Lars Tiffany was named Virginia's 17th head coach on June 21, 2016. He is currently in his seventh season at UVA and 19th season overall as head coach. Tiffany is Virginia's only head coach to win back-to-back national championships (2019 & 2021). Tiffany begins the 2023 season with 67 wins as UVA head coach, good for No. 3 all-time in program history behind only Jim "Ace" Adams (137) and Dom Starsia (274).
