OPENING DRAW

GAME OVERVIEW

- · Virginia returns to Klöckner Stadium to host Harvard (0-0) on Saturday (Feb. 18). Opening faceoff is set for 4 p.m.
- $\cdot\,$ William Foshee (play-by-play) will have the call on ACC Network Extra (ACCNX).
- The Cavaliers are ranked No. 1 in all three polls, USILA, Inside Lacrosse and Nike/USA Lacrosse Magazine.

THE SERIES VS. HARVARD

- Virginia leads the all-time series against Harvard, 3-0.
- The series began in 1954, when UVA defeated the Crimson 19-14 in Charlottesville. The two teams also played the following year (1955) with Virginia once again coming out on top, 18-10.
- The last time the Cavaliers and Harvard met was in the quarterfinals of the 1996 NCAA Tournament at Johns Hopkins. After defeating Harvard, 23-12, UVA went on to fall to Princeton, 13-12, in overtime of the championship game.

LAST TIME OUT

- Last Saturday (Feb. 11), Virginia opened its season with a 17-13 win over Michigan at Klöckner Stadium. The meeting marked the first-ever between the two teams.
- The Hoos never trailed in Saturday's contest. After goalie **David Roselle** made a critical save early in the fourth quarter to preserve UVA's 13-12 lead, UVA outscored the Wolverines, 4-1, the rest of the way.
- Payton Cormier (5g, 2a), Connor Shellenberger (3g, 3a) and Thomas McConvey (3g, 2a) led the Cavaliers' effort on offense. Starting goalie Matthew Nunes (15 saves) finished one save shy of tying his career high.
- Virginia's man-down unit killed all four of Michigan's extra-man opportunities and the Cavaliers went 16-for-16 on clears.

NUMBERS TO KNOW

Virginia enters 2023 with seven NCAA championships. UVA's seven NCAA titles are third most by any program since the NCAA Tournament's inception in 1971.

Virginia returns nine starters in 2023. The Cavaliers' only departure from last year's starting lineup is attackman Matt Moore, who was drafted No. 4 overall in the 2022 PLL Draft by the Archers.

Midfielder **Thomas McConvey**, a transfer from Vermont, has registered at least one point in all 53 career games. His 53-game point streak leads all collegiate players nationally.

THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA

UNIQUELY UVA

The University of Virginia is an institution rich with history and tradition. Here is some of the terminology that contributes to UVA's culture.

Grounds: The term used by students, faculty and alumni to refer to the University dating as far back as Thomas Jefferson. "Campus" is never used.

First Year, Second Year, Third Year, Fourth Year: Instead of freshman, sophomore, junior, senior. Why you may ask? To be a "senior" implies that a person has reached the final phase of learning, a feat that Thomas Jefferson believed to be impossible, arguing instead that education is a life-long process.

Commonwealth: Virginia is one of four constituent states of the United States of America that officially uses the name "Commonwealth" instead of the word state in all references. The other three commonwealths are Kentucky, Massachusetts and Pennsylvania.

UNIVERSITY NICKNAMES

Virginia's athletics teams have been accompanied by a somewhat confusing array of nicknames. The most prominent and widely accepted of these monikers are "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos."

Although the terms "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are used almost interchangeably to refer to University teams and players, "Cavaliers" is more often used by the media, while "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are frequently used by Virginia students and fans.

Legend has it that Washington & Lee baseball fans dubbed the Virginia players "Wahoos" during the fiercely contested rivalry that existed between the two in-state schools in the 1890s. By 1940, "Wahoos" was in general use around Grounds to denote University students or events relating to them. The abbreviated "Hoos" sprang up later in student newspapers and has gained growing popularity in recent years.

THE CAVALIER MASCOT

The costumed Cavalier with a large character head debuted during Virginia's 1984 football season and has remained the official mascot of the University.

UNIVERSITY COLORS

Orange and blue were adopted as the University of Virginia's official athletic colors at a mass student meeting in 1888. UVA athletic teams had previously worn silver gray and cardinal red, but those colors did not stand out on muddy football fields, prompting a student movement to change them.

One of the students attending the mass meeting was Allen Potts, a star athlete who played on Virginia's first football team in 1888. Potts showed up at the meeting wearing a navy blue-and-orange scarf that he had acquired during a summer boating expedition at Oxford University. Orange and blue were chosen as the official athletic colors after one of Potts' fellow students pulled the scarf off Potts' neck and, waving it to the crowd, yelled, "How will this do?" UVA later served as the inspiration for schools like Auburn and Florida when they selected school colors.

WAH-HOO-WAH

The origin of "Wah-hoo-wah" is uncertain. The cheer was used to root on Virginia teams as early as 1890 and may have been borrowed from Dartmouth College, whose athletics teams were once known as the Indians.

Legend attributes the yell to Natalie Floyd Otey, who sang the ballad "Where'er You Are, There Shall My Love Be" at Charlottesville's Levy Opera House in 1893. The predominantly student audience noticed that Otey warbled the first three words of the song between each of the stanzas and decided to join in the refrain. By evening's end, goes the legend, the crowd had corrupted "Where'er You Are" into "Wah-hoo-wah."

The Levy Opera House stands at the corner of High Street and Park Street and has since been renovated into an office building.

SEASON OVERVIEW

- \cdot The 2023 season marks the 95th season for the Virginia men's lacrosse program, which boasts an all-time record of 681-378-5.
- · This season, the Cavaliers will host eight regular season games at Klöckner Stadium, including three ACC contests and a rematch of the 2021 NCAA Championship game against Maryland.
- Virginia returns nine starters from its 2022 roster, including Tewaaraton Award finalist Connor Shellenberger, 2022 ACC Defensive Player of the Year Cole Kastner and 2022 ACC Freshman of the Year Matthew Nunes.

2022 SEASON RECAP

- · Virginia finished its 2022 season with an overall record of 12-4, marking the Cavaliers' sixth consecutive winning season.
- · UVA earned a share of the program's 19th ACC title, alongside Notre Dame, after finishing with a 5-1 record in league play.
- Connor Shellenberger was named one of five Tewarraton Finalists, UVA's 11th finalist in program history.
- Cole Kastner (Defensive Player of the Year) and Matthew Nunes (Freshman of the Year) earned ACC postseason awards.

THE CAVALIERS AT KLÖCKNER STADIUM

- · Virginia is currently on a 10-game win streak in games held at Klöckner Stadium, a streak that began in 2021.
- Virginia owns a 167-43 (.795) all-time record at Klöckner Stadium, including a 1-0 record in 2023, and has won
- 21 of its last 25 games played at the historic edifice.
- The Cavaliers' average margin of victory in their last 25 games at Klöckner Stadium is 5.28.
- Virginia is 41-11 (.788) all-time at Klöckner Stadium under head coach Lars Tiffany.
- UVA is also 13-3 all-time at Klöckner Stadium in the NCAA Tournament.
- · Lacrosse debuted in Klöckner Stadium in 1993.

- UVA has been ranked No. 1 in the nation in 72 all-time polls, including in the most recent edition of the poll.
- The USILA Poll began in 1973.

CONNOR SHELLENBERGER IS ELITE

- **Connor Shellenberger**, who is in his third season at UVA, is arguably the mostaccomplished active player in college lacrosse.
- \cdot In addition to being a two-time USILA first team All-American (2021-22),
- Shellenberger became UVA's 11th Tewaaraton Award finalist last season. • This year, Shellenberger was crowned a first team preseason All-American by the
- USILA, Inside Lacrosse and USA Lacrosse Magazine, and the top returning player in 2023 by Inside Lacrosse.
- \cdot This offseason, Shellenberger was invited to try out for a spot on the U.S. National Team for the 2023 World Championships.
- In 2022, he led UVA in points (76) and assists (44) and finished second in goals (32).
- In 2021, Shellenberger was sensational in the NCAA Tournament, guiding the Hoos to the program's seventh NCAA championship and was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player.
- In 35 career appearances, Shellenberger has posted at least one point in 34 contests and has recorded multiple assists in 27 career games.

MORE ON THE UVA AND THE TEWAARATON AWARD

- In addition to Shellenberger in 2022, UVA's other Tewaaraton Award finalists include: Steele Stanwick (2011-12), Ken Clausen (2010), Danny Glading (2009), Ben Rubeor (2007-08), Kyle Dixon (2006), Matt Ward (2006), Chris Rotelli (2003) and Conor Gill (2002).
- Stanwick (2011), Ward (2006) and Rotelli (2003) were recipients of the award.
- Virginia, Maryland and Syracuse are the only schools in the nation to have three Tewaaraton Award winners. Only Duke (13) and Syracuse (12) have had more finalists than UVA (11).

GOING STREAKING

- Newcomer Thomas McConvey, a transfer in the midfield from the University of Vermont, is currently riding a 53-game point streak, which began on Feb. 1, 2019.
- McConvey has registered at least one point in every game of his career
- His 53-game point streak leads the nation among all active players.
- During his streak, McConvey has amassed 130 goals and 49 assists.

SALLADE NAMED ACC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- With three ground balls and two caused turnovers in UVA's season opener against Michigan, **Grayson Sallade** was named the ACC's Defensive Player of the Week on Feb. 14.
- The weekly award was Sallade's first of his career.
- Sallade and the UVA defense held the Wolverines to just one goal in the fourth quarter and scoreless on all four of their extra-man opportunities.
- As a member of Virginia's faceoff unit, Sallade helped the Cavaliers finish 18-for-32 at the center X.

CAVALIERS EXCELLING ON THE FIELD & IN THE CLASSROOM

- \cdot On Feb. 15, Virginia men's lacrosse announced it achieved a 3.610 team GPA in the Fall of 2022.
- The Cavaliers' 3.610 team GPA led all UVA men's athletic programs for the semester.
- \cdot It also marked a 10% increase from the team's GPA in the fall of 2021.

VIRGINIA'S EIGHT PRESEASON ALL-AMERICANS

LAST SEASON, VIRGINIA WAS UNDEFEATED WHEN

- \cdot In 2022, the Cavaliers finished 12-0 when leading their opponents after three quarters.
- UVA combined to out-score its opponents 203-138 in the first three periods of
