## OPENING DRAW

### GAME OVERVIEW

- Virginia hosts Michigan at Klöckner Stadium in its 2023 opener on Saturday (Feb. 11) at 12 p.m. Saturday's season opener is set to be broadcast on ACC Network.
- The Cavaliers are ranked No. 1 in both the Inside Lacrosse and Nike/USA Lacrosse Magazine preseason media polls and No. 2 in the USILA coaches poll.

### SEASON OVERVIEW

- The 2023 season marks the 95<sup>th</sup> season for the Virginia men's lacrosse program, which boasts an all-time record of 680-378-5.
- This season, the Cavaliers will host eight regular season games at Klöckner Stadium, including three ACC contests and a rematch of the 2021 NCAA Championship game against Maryland.
- Virginia returns nine starters from its 2022 roster, including Tewaaraton Award finalist **Connor Shellenberger**, 2022 ACC Defensive Player of the Year **Cole Kastner** and 2022 ACC Freshman of the Year **Matthew Nunes**.

### THE SERIES VS. MICHIGAN

- Saturday's contest marks the first-ever meeting between Virginia and Michigan, which started its men's lacrosse program at the Division-I level in 2012.
- During his tenure as head coach at Brown University, Lars Tiffany defeated Michigan twice by a score of 22-9 and 22-8 in 2015 and 2016, respectively.
- In addition to the Wolverines, UVA will also challenge Big Ten foes, Ohio State (Feb. 25), Johns Hopkins (March 7) and Maryland (March 18) this season.

## NUMBERS TO KNOW

Virginia enters 2023 with seven NCAA championships. UVA's seven NCAA titles are third most by any program since the NCAA Tournament's inception in 1971.

Virginia returns nine starters in 2023. The Cavaliers' only departure from last year's starting lineup is attackman Matt Moore, who was drafted No. 4 overall in the 2022 PLL Draft by the Archers.

52

Midfielder Thomas McConvey, a transfer from Vermont, begins the 2023 season on a 52-game point streak. McConvey's 52-game point streak leads the nation among all active players. He has registered at least one point in every single game of his career.

## THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA

### UNIQUELY UVA

The University of Virginia is an institution rich with history and tradition. Here is some of the terminology that contributes to UVA's culture.

**Grounds:** The term used by students, faculty and alumni to refer to the University dating as far back as Thomas Jefferson. "Campus" is never used.

**First Year, Second Year, Third Year, Fourth Year:** Instead of freshman, sophomore, junior, senior. Why you may ask? To be a "senior" implies that a person has reached the final phase of learning, a feat that Thomas Jefferson believed to be impossible, arguing instead that education is a life-long process.

**Commonwealth:** Virginia is one of four constituent states of the United States of America that officially uses the name "Commonwealth" instead of the word state in all references. The other three commonwealths are Kentucky, Massachusetts and Pennsylvania.

### UNIVERSITY NICKNAMES

Virginia's athletics teams have been accompanied by a somewhat confusing array of nicknames. The most prominent and widely accepted of these monikers are "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos."

Although the terms "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are used almost interchangeably to refer to University teams and players, "Cavaliers" is more often used by the media, while "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are frequently used by Virginia students and fans.

Legend has it that Washington & Lee baseball fans dubbed the Virginia players "Wahoos" during the fiercely contested rivalry that existed between the two in-state schools in the 1890s. By 1940, "Wahoos" was in general use around Grounds to denote University students or events relating to them. The abbreviated "Hoos" sprang up later in student newspapers and has gained growing popularity in recent years.

### THE CAVALIER MASCOT

The costumed Cavalier with a large character head debuted during Virginia's 1984 football season and has remained the official mascot of the University.

### UNIVERSITY COLORS

Orange and blue were adopted as the University of Virginia's official athletic colors at a mass student meeting in 1888. UVA athletic teams had previously worn silver gray and cardinal red, but those colors did not stand out on muddy football fields, prompting a student movement to change them.

One of the students attending the mass meeting was Allen Potts, a star athlete who played on Virginia's first football team in 1888. Potts showed up at the meeting wearing a navy blue-and-orange scarf that he had acquired during a summer boating expedition at Oxford University. Orange and blue were chosen as the official athletic colors after one of Potts' fellow students pulled the scarf off Potts' neck and, waving it to the crowd, yelled, "How will this do?" UVA later served as the inspiration for schools like Auburn and Florida when they selected school colors.

### WAH-HOO-WAH

The origin of "Wah-hoo-wah" is uncertain. The cheer was used to root on Virginia teams as early as 1890 and may have been borrowed from Dartmouth College, whose athletics teams were once known as the Indians.

Legend attributes the yell to Natalie Floyd Otey, who sang the ballad "Where'er You Are, There Shall My Love Be" at Charlottesville's Levy Opera House in 1893. The predominantly student audience noticed that Otey warbled the first three words of the song between each of the stanzas and decided to join in the refrain. By evening's end, goes the legend, the crowd had corrupted "Where'er You Are" into "Wah-hoo-wah."

The Levy Opera House stands at the corner of High Street and Park Street and has since been renovated into an office building.

**2022 SEASON RECAP**

- Virginia finished its 2022 season with an overall record of 12-4, marking the Cavaliers' sixth consecutive winning season.
- UVA earned a share of the program's 19th ACC title, alongside Notre Dame, after finishing with a 5-1 record in league play.
- **Connor Shellenberger** was named one of five Tewarraton Finalists, UVA's 11th finalist in program history.
- **Cole Kastner** (Defensive Player of the Year) and **Matthew Nunes** (Freshman of the Year) earned ACC postseason awards.

**THE CAVALIERS AT KLÖCKNER STADIUM**

- Virginia will open its 2023 season on a nine-game win streak in games held at Klöckner Stadium.
- Virginia owns a 166-43 (.794) all-time record at Klöckner Stadium, including an 8-0 record in 2022, and has won 21 of its last 25 games played at the historic edifice.
- The Cavaliers' average margin of victory in their last 25 games at Klöckner Stadium is 5.36.
- Virginia is 40-11 (.784) all-time at Klöckner Stadium under head coach Lars Tiffany.
- UVA is also 13-3 all-time at Klöckner Stadium in the NCAA Tournament.
- Lacrosse debuted in Klöckner Stadium in 1993.

**2022 TEWAARATON AWARD FINALIST CONNOR SHELLENBERGER**

- On May 12, 2022, **Connor Shellenberger** was named one of five Tewaaraton Award finalists.
- Shellenberger's recognition as a finalist marks the 11<sup>th</sup> instance in program history.
- Other UVA finalists include: Steele Stanwick (2011-12), Ken Clausen (2010), Danny Glading (2009), Ben Rubeor (2007-08), Kyle Dixon (2006), Matt Ward (2006), Chris Rotelli (2003) and Conor Gill (2002).
- Stanwick (2011), Ward (2006) and Rotelli (2003) were recipients of the award.
- Virginia, Maryland and Syracuse are the only schools in the nation to have three recipients of the award. Only Duke (13) and Syracuse (12) have had more finalists than UVA (11).

**CONNOR SHELLENBERGER IS ELITE**

- **Connor Shellenberger**, who returns for his third season at UVA in 2023, was crowned a First Team Preseason All-American by USILA, Inside Lacrosse and USA Lacrosse Magazine.
- He was also tabbed Inside Lacrosse's No. 1 overall player returning in 2023.
- This offseason, Shellenberger tried out for a spot on the U.S. National Team for the 2023 World Championships.
- He led UVA in points (76) and assists (44) and finished second in goals (32).
- Shellenberger is a two-time First Team USILA All-American was named the Most Outstanding Player of the 2021 NCAA Tournament.
- He finished the 2022 season fifth in the nation in assists (2.75/gm) and 11th in points (4.75/gm).
- In UVA's NCAA Tournament First Round game at eighth-seeded Brown last season, Shellenberger tied his career of eight points (4g, 4a).
- In 34 career appearances, Shellenberger has posted at least one point in 33 contests and has recorded multiple assists in 26 career games.
- Shellenberger had a streak of at least five points in 12 consecutive games, over the course of 383 calendar days and ended on April 2, 2022 at Richmond.

**HOOS IN THE NATIONAL STATISTICAL RANKINGS IN 2022**

- Last season, Virginia finished second in the nation in ground balls (38.12/gm), third in points (24.31/gm) and scoring offense (15.50/gm), fifth in assists (8.81/gm) and man-up offense (.500), and sixth in opponent clear percentage (.789) and shot percentage (.331).
- In addition to Shellenberger (see above), **Cole Kastner** was sixth nationally in caused turnovers (2.00/gm). **Petey LaSalla** finished eighth in faceoff win percentage (.597) and 18<sup>th</sup> in ground balls (7.06/gm), and **Payton Cormier** was 11th in goals (3.12/gm).

**UVA'S EIGHT PRESEASON ALL-AMERICANS**

- Eight Cavaliers in **Connor Shellenberger** (1st), **Thomas McConvey** (2nd), **Cole Kastner** (2nd), **Payton Cormier** (3rd), **Jeff Conner** (HM), **Petey LaSalla** (HM), **Grayson Sallade** (HM) and **Cade Saustad** (HM) were named Preseason All-Americans by Inside Lacrosse.
- UVA's eight honorees led all Division-I programs nationally.

**LAST SEASON, VIRGINIA WAS UNDEFEATED WHEN...**

- In 2022, the Cavaliers finished 12-0 when leading their opponents after three quarters.
- UVA combined to out-score its opponents 203-138 in the first three periods of 2022, which is an average lead of 4.1 goals entering the fourth period.
- Last season, the Cavaliers went 10-0 when leading at halftime and 1-0 when tied at the half.
- In 2022, Virginia was 12-0 when dishing out more assists than its opponent. In the Cavaliers' 12 wins last season, UVA had 118 assists compared to its opponents' 55.

**REIGNING ACC CHAMPIONS**

- With its 21-15 win at Syracuse last season, Virginia earned a share of its 19<sup>th</sup> ACC championship, including two (2019 & 2022) under **Lars Tiffany**.
- The Cavaliers won 11 titles (1962, 1964, 1969, 1970, 1971, 1975, 1980, 1983, 1984, 1985 and 1986) prior the ACC establishing a tournament from 1989-2019 to determine the champion.
- Virginia has won seven ACC Tournament championships: 1997, 1999, 2000, 2003, 2006, 2010 and 2019.
- In the last ACC Tournament, which was held in 2019 at Klöckner Stadium, UVA defeated Notre Dame 10-4 in the championship game.
- From 1989-2019, Virginia won 14 regular-season titles (1990, 1993, 1994, 1995, 1997, 1999, 2000, 2002, 2003, 2006, 2009, 2010, 2012 and 2019), more than any other ACC School.

**VIRGINIA IN THE POLLS**

- No. 2 Virginia has been ranked in the top 5 of the USILA Coaches poll in 312 weeks all-time.
- UVA has been ranked in the top 10 in 466 polls all-time, including in the most recent edition of the poll.
- UVA has been ranked No. 1 in the nation in 71 all-time polls.
- The USILA Poll began in 1973.

**ON THE HORIZON**

- The Cavaliers returns to Klöckner Stadium on Saturday (Feb. 18) to host Harvard (0-0).
- Opening faceoff is set for 4 p.m. on ACC Network Extra (ACCNX).

**VIRGINIA IS A GROUND BALL MACHINE**

- In 2022, UVA finished top 2 in the nation in ground balls per game (38.12) for the sixth consecutive season.
- UVA is the only school in the nation to finish in the top-5 nationally in ground balls per game 13 times over the last 14 seasons.

## PETEY LASALLA: THE NATION'S DEADLIEST FACEOFF SPECIALIST

- With 781 career faceoff wins, **Petey LaSalla** is currently third among all active Division-I players.
- LaSalla is the only player in all of college lacrosse with at least 781 career wins at the center-X and 27 career goals.
- With 11 career assists, he's also is the only player in the nation with at least 781 career faceoff victories and 38 career points.
- Virginia is 19-3 (.864) all-time when LaSalla scores a goal, including 6-0 in 2022, and 24-5 (.828) all-time when registering at least one point.
- LaSalla set a career high with three points on two goals and one assist in Virginia's ACC-championship clinching game at Syracuse last season.
- LaSalla won the first eight faceoffs of the game in UVA's 19-8 route over Johns Hopkins (March 5, 2022), and finished the contest 9-of-10, setting his single-game career high in faceoff win percentage. LaSalla tied that career best mark (9-of-10) at Richmond (April 2, 2022) before exiting the game with an upper-extremity injury.

- Last season, he recorded 14 multi-goal games, including nine hat tricks.

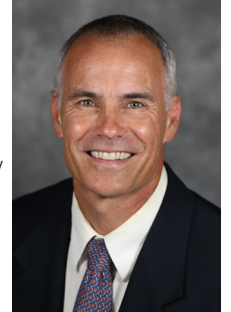

Lars Tiffany was named Virginia's 17<sup>th</sup> head coach on June 21, 2016. He is currently in his seventh season at UVA and 19th season overall as head coach. Tiffany is Virginia's only head coach to win back-to-back national championships (2019 & 2021). Tiffany begins the 2023 season with 67 wins as UVA head coach, good for No. 3 all-time in program history behind only Jim "Ace" Adams (137) and Dom Starsia (274).

He was Co-MVP of the Brown squad that captured its first-ever NCAA playoff victory in 1990 (12-9 vs. UMass). Tiffany capped his career by playing in the North-South Senior All-Star game.
