DAVENPORT FIELD AT DISHAROON PARK



HISTORY

- Stadium underwent complete overhaul after the 2001 season, making it a premier college facility.
- Bermuda grass playing surface – known as Ted Davenport Field – was dedicated April 13, 2002, against Wake Forest in honor of Thomas “Ted” Edward Davenport, former Executive Director and Secretary/ Treasurer of Virginia Student Aid Foundation.
- Field was named for Davenport to recognize his dedication to student-athletes and leadership role in fundraising.
- Prior to the 2018 season, Virginia completed an 18.6 million expansion project that extended the concourse from the LF foul pole to the scoreboard in RF, nearly 1,000 new seats, a field level club, new hitting facility and coaches offices.
- On March 2, 2018 the stadium was renamed Davenport Field at Disharoon Park, in honor of Leslie B. Disharoon and Ann Merriwether Disharoon, long time donors and supporters of the program. The renaming was made possible by an anonymous donor.




FAN SUPPORT

- The stadium seats 5,919 (third largest in the ACC) and includes a canopied grandstand with nearly 3,000 chairback seats encircling the playing surface, left field bleacher seats, grass hillside seating down the left-field line, 140 permanent field level seats equipped with a lounge and seven suites for lease by fans and corporate sponsors.
- Disharoon Park welcomed its one millionth fan early in March 2015.
- Virginia has drawn over 1,000,000 fans since 2009, including over 100,000 fans in nine of the last 13 seasons.
- UVA averaged a program-record 3,749 spectators per game in 2014 and has ranked in the top 20 nationally in attendance 11 of the last 13 years
- Disharoon Park provides one of the best home-field advantages in college baseball: UVA is 537-165 (.765) at home since 2004.
- The facility has played host to nine NCAA Regionals (2004, 2006, 2007, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2016) and five NCAA Super Regionals (2010, 2011, 2013, 2014, 2015).

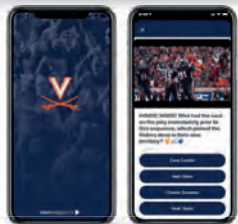
