OPENING DRAW

GAME OVERVIEW

- · No. 3 Virginia (6-1) opens ACC action at top-ranked Notre Dame (6-0) on Saturday (March 25).
- Opening faceoff from Arlotta Stadium is set for noon as Chris Cotter (play-by-play) and Paul Carcaterra (analyst) will have the call on ESPNU.

LAST TIME OUT

- The Cavaliers suffered their first loss of the season in a 14-13 defeat by then-No. 3 Maryland at Klöckner Stadium last Saturday (March 18).
- Maryland goalie Brian Ruppel made three saves in the overtime period, including his final at point blank range, to help knock off then-No. 1 Virginia.
- Thomas McConvey (4g, 1a), Griffin Schutz (2g, 2a) and Cade Saustad (3gb, 4ct) led the effort for the Hoos.
- The loss broke up UVA's 13-game win streak at home, a streak that began in 2021.

SERIES HISTORY

- · Virginia leads the all-time series over Notre Dame, 9-8, and is currently riding a four-game win streak over the Fighting Irish, dating back to 2019. UVA's four-game win streak is its longest since the series began in 1993.
- At Klöckner Stadium last year, the Cavaliers defeated Notre Dame, 12-8, on March 26. Both teams finished ACC play with a 5-1 record to earn a share of the 2022 ACC title, however it was only UVA that received an at-large bid to the 2022 NCAA Tournament.
- The two teams had a three-year series that ended in 2003, but have met 12 times since, including the 2006 and 2012 NCAA Tournaments as well as 10 ACC regular-season contests from 2014-present.
- After dropping the 2018 ACC championship final to Notre Dame, 17-7, at Klöckner Stadium, UVA got its revenge in a rematch at the 2019 ACC championship, which was also held at Klöckner Stadium. The victory in 2019 was UVA's 18th ACC championship, which it achieved after holding Notre Dame scoreless for 42:12.

NUMBERS TO KNOW

Virginia enters 2023 with seven NCAA championships. UVA's seven NCAA titles are third most by any program since the NCAA Tournament's inception in 1971.

Virginia returns nine starters in 2023. The Cavaliers' only departure from last year's starting lineup is attackman Matt Moore, who was drafted No. 4 overall in the 2022 PLL Draft by the Archers.

Midfielder **Thomas McConvey**, a transfer from Vermont, has registered at least one point in all 59 career games. His 59-game point streak leads **all** collegiate players nationally.

THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA

UNIQUELY UVA

The University of Virginia is an institution rich with history and tradition. Here is some of the terminology that contributes to UVA's culture.

Grounds: The term used by students, faculty and alumni to refer to the University dating as far back as Thomas Jefferson. "Campus" is never used.

First Year, Second Year, Third Year, Fourth Year: Instead of freshman, sophomore, junior, senior. Why you may ask? To be a "senior" implies that a person has reached the final phase of learning, a feat that Thomas Jefferson believed to be impossible, arguing instead that education is a life-long process.

Commonwealth: Virginia is one of four constituent states of the United States of America that officially uses the name "Commonwealth" instead of the word state in all references. The other three commonwealths are Kentucky, Massachusetts and Pennsylvania.

UNIVERSITY NICKNAMES

Virginia's athletics teams have been accompanied by a somewhat confusing array of nicknames. The most prominent and widely accepted of these monikers are "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos."

Although the terms "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are used almost interchangeably to refer to University teams and players, "Cavaliers" is more often used by the media, while "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are frequently used by Virginia students and fans.

Legend has it that Washington & Lee baseball fans dubbed the Virginia players "Wahoos" during the fiercely contested rivalry that existed between the two in-state schools in the 1890s. By 1940, "Wahoos" was in general use around Grounds to denote University students or events relating to them. The abbreviated "Hoos" sprang up later in student newspapers and has gained growing popularity in recent years.

THE CAVALIER MASCOT

The costumed Cavalier with a large character head debuted during Virginia's 1984 football season and has remained the official mascot of the University.

UNIVERSITY COLORS

Orange and blue were adopted as the University of Virginia's official athletic colors at a mass student meeting in 1888. UVA athletic teams had previously worn silver gray and cardinal red, but those colors did not stand out on muddy football fields, prompting a student movement to change them.

One of the students attending the mass meeting was Allen Potts, a star athlete who played on Virginia's first football team in 1888. Potts showed up at the meeting wearing a navy blue-and-orange scarf that he had acquired during a summer boating expedition at Oxford University. Orange and blue were chosen as the official athletic colors after one of Potts' fellow students pulled the scarf off Potts' neck and, waving it to the crowd, yelled, "How will this do?" UVA later served as the inspiration for schools like Auburn and Florida when they selected school colors.

WAH-HOO-WAH

The origin of "Wah-hoo-wah" is uncertain. The cheer was used to root on Virginia teams as early as 1890 and may have been borrowed from Dartmouth College, whose athletics teams were once known as the Indians.

Legend attributes the yell to Natalie Floyd Otey, who sang the ballad "Where'er You Are, There Shall My Love Be" at Charlottesville's Levy Opera House in 1893. The predominantly student audience noticed that Otey warbled the first three words of the song between each of the stanzas and decided to join in the refrain. By evening's end, goes the legend, the crowd had corrupted "Where'er You Are" into "Wah-hoo-wah."

The Levy Opera House stands at the corner of High Street and Park Street and has since been renovated into an office building.

MORE ON THE NOTRE DAME SERIES

- · Four of the meetings between UVA and Notre Dame have come in the NCAA Tournament (1993, 1994, 2006, 2012) and UVA holds a 3-1 record.
- The 2014 ACC matchup marked the first time the series had been played in Notre Dame. The first six games of the series were contested at UVA's Klöckner Stadium.
- · Weather in South Bend forced the 2014 meeting inside at the Loftus Sports Center.
- · The 2012 meeting came in the quarterfinal round of the NCAA Tournament at PPL Park in Chester, Pa.
- · Notre Dame's first victory was an 11-8 win in 2001 at Klöckner Stadium as the Fighting Irish advanced to Championship Weekend that season before falling to Syracuse in the semifinals.
- · The Fighting Irish, ranked sixth at game time, became just the second team ranked fifth or lower to defeat the Cavaliers at Klöckner Stadium.
- · Notre Dame won the most recent NCAA Tournament meeting, a 12-10 triumph over UVA to advance to Championship Weekend in 2012 before falling to Loyola in the semifinals.
- The 2012 meeting was the final game in the illustrious career of UVA's Steele Stanwick. Stanwick, UVA's all-time point leader at the time, closed out his career with two goals and five assists against the Irish.
- · Virginia's 23-4 win in the 1994 Tournament marks its biggest win over a ranked team in program history (Notre Dame was ranked 14th at game time.) The margin of victory also marks UVA's greatest in NCAA Tournament action.
- · 2006 Tewaaraton Trophy winner Matt Ward led UVA with four goals in the 2006 meeting between UVA and Notre Dame, as the Cavaliers won 14-10 in the NCAA First Round on their way to the program's fourth NCAA title.

CAVALIERS, IRISH SHARE TIES WITH KEVIN CORRIGAN

- Notre Dame head coach Kevin Corrigan (Virginia '81) is in his 35th season with the Fighting Irish after spending two seasons as an assistant coach for the Cavaliers under former head coaching legend Jim "Ace" Adams.
- Corrigan played on three Cavalier squads that made the NCAA Tournament from 1979-81.
- · After his playing career, Corrigan went on to become an assistant coach on Adams' staff at UVA from 1987-88 before being named head coach at Notre Dame prior to the 1989 season.
- · Corrigan's father, Gene Corrigan, served as the athletics director at UVA from 1971-80, was the UVA lacrosse head coach from 1959-67 and head men's soccer coach from 1958-65, among other positions.
- · Gene Corrigan left UVA to become Notre Dame's athletics director in 1981 and left in 1987 to become the ACC's third-ever commissioner from 1987-97.
- · Kevin Corrigan is first cousins with former UVA women's basketball head coaching legend Debbie Ryan.

VIRGINIA AGAINST NO. 1 RANKED TEAMS ALL-TIME

- Saturday's meeting at No. 1 Notre Dame marks UVA's 44th all-time meeting against a No. 1 opponent (USILA poll).
- · The Cavaliers are 15-28 in such contests.
- · Virginia has been outscored by No. 1 foes by exactly 100 goals, 538-438.
- UVA's last win over a No. 1 opponent was against Maryland in the 2021 national championship game, a 17-16 showdown at Rentschler Field.
- Virginia and Syracuse were both tied for first in the poll when the two teams met on March 4, 2011. The Orange won the matchup, 12-10.
- Neither the Cavaliers nor Notre Dame have ever gone head-to-head as the No. 1 ranked team.

VIRGINIA IN THE POLLS

- · At No. 3 in this week's USILA Coaches poll, Virginia has been ranked in the top 5 of the poll in 320 weeks all-time.
- · UVA has been ranked No. 1 in the nation in 69 all-time polls.
- The USILA Poll began in 1973 and there have been 532 polls all-time.

CAVALIERS AMONG THE NATION'S STATISTICAL LEADERS

- Virginia currently leads the nation in assists (12.71/gm), ground balls (42.00/gm), points (31.86/gm), scoring offense (19.14/gm) and shot percentage (.393).
 The Cavaliers are also second in the nation in clearing percentage (.938), man-up offense (.625) and scoring margin (6.71).
- Connor Shellenberger is second in the nation in assist (3.71/gm) and sixth in points (5.43/gm). Cade Saustad is fifth in caused turnovers (2.29/gm). Xander Dickson is fourth in goals (3.71/gm), 15th in points (4.71/gm) and third in shot percentage (.553). Patrick McIntosh is second in shot percentage (.571).

THE CAVALIERS AT KLÖCKNER STADIUM

- Virginia saw its 13-game home win streak at Klöckner Stadium come to an end after falling to then-No. 3 Maryland, 14-13, in overtime on March 25, 2023.
- Virginia owns a 170-44 (.794) all-time record at Klöckner Stadium, including a 4-1 record in 2023, and has won 21 of its last 25 games played at the historic edifice.
- The Cavaliers' average margin of victory in their last 25 games at Klöckner Stadium is 5.88 goals.
- · Virginia is 44-12 (.786) all-time at Klöckner Stadium under head coach Lars Tiffany.
- · UVA is also 13-3 all-time at Klöckner Stadium in the NCAA Tournament.
- $\cdot\,$ Lacrosse debuted in Klöckner Stadium in 1993.

CONNOR SHELLENBERGER IS ELITE

- Connor Shellenberger, who is in his third season at UVA, is arguably the mostaccomplished active player in college lacrosse.
- In addition to being a two-time USILA first team All-American (2021-22), Shellenberger became UVA's 11th Tewaaraton Award finalist last season.
- Shellenberger currently leads all active Division-I players in career assists (112), is second in assists per game (2.73) and third in points per game (4.71).
- This year, Shellenberger was crowned a first team preseason All-American by the USILA, Inside Lacrosse and USA Lacrosse Magazine, and the top returning player in 2023 by Inside Lacrosse.
- This offseason, Shellenberger was invited to try out for a spot on the U.S. National Team for the 2023 World Championships.
- \cdot In 2022, he led UVA in points (76) and assists (44) and finished second in goals (32).
- In 2021, Shellenberger was sensational in the NCAA Tournament, guiding the Hoos to the program's seventh NCAA championship and was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player.
- In 41 career appearances, Shellenberger has posted at least one point in 40 contests and has recorded multiple assists in 33 career games.
- Shellenberger has tallied a career-best 10 points on two occasions this season: vs. then-No. 18 Harvard (3g, 7a) and vs. Towson (4g, 6a).

- Virginia, Maryland and Syracuse are the only schools in the nation to have three Tewaaraton Award winners. Only Duke (13) and Syracuse (12) have had more finalists than UVA (11).

GOING STREAKING

- Newcomer **Thomas McConvey**, a transfer in the midfield from the University of Vermont, is currently riding a 59-game point streak, which began on Feb. 1, 2019.
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ McConvey has registered at least one point in every game of his career.
- · His 59-game point streak leads the nation among all active players.
- · During his streak, McConvey has amassed 143 goals and 60 assists.
- Also riding a substantial point streak is UVA attackman Payton Cormier, who has recorded at least one point in his last 34 games.
- Cormier's 33-game point streak is currently the sixth longest in the nation. During his streak, which began on March 6, 2021, Cormier has registered 122 points (102, 20a).

THOMAS McCONVEY: ONE OF THE NATION'S MOST ELITE MIDFIELDERS

- Thomas McConvey (143-60-203) is currently second among all active Division-l players in career goals and fifth in points.
- As of March 20, Villanova's Matt Campbell (204 points) is the only Division-I midfielder with more career points than McConvey.
- Against then-No. 3 Maryland, McConvey registered a season-high five points on four goals and one assist. His fourth goal of the day tied the score [13-13] with 1:18 left in regulation to ultimately force overtime.

CAVALIERS EXCELLING ON THE FIELD & IN THE CLASSROOM

- On Feb. 15, Virginia men's lacrosse announced it achieved a 3.610 team GPA in the Fall of 2022
- The Cavaliers' 3.610 team GPA led all UVA men's athletic programs for the
- · It also marked a 10% increase from the team's GPA in the fall of 2021.

VIRGINIA IS A GROUND BALL MACHINE

- Since 2009, UVA has finished in the top 3 nationally in ground balls per game in all but one season, and led the nation in ground balls per game eight times.
- UVA is the only school in the nation to finish in the top 5 nationally in ground balls per game 13 times over the last 14 seasons.
- The only school in 2016 to finish with more ground balls per game was UVA head coach Lars Tiffany's Brown team.
- · Virginia's 2023 season high in ground balls is 53 vs. Richmond (March 4).

PETEY LASALLA: THE NATION'S DEADLIEST FACEOFF SPECIALIST

- With 895 career faceoff wins, Petey LaSalla is currently second among all active Division-I players. He also ranks in the top-10 all-time in the NCAA Division I record book in both faceoffs won and faceoffs taken.
- · LaSalla is the only player in all of college lacrosse with at least 895 career wins at the center-X and 33 career goals.
- In addition to his 33 career goals, LaSalla has dished out 11 career assists, making him the only player in the nation with at least 895 career faceoff victories and 44 career points.
- Virginia is 22-3 (.880) all-time when LaSalla scores a goal, including 3-0 in 2023, and 27-5 (.844) all-time when registering at least one point.
- · LaSalla recorded two goals in UVA's first three games of 2023.
- LaSalla set a career high with three points on two goals and one assist in Virginia's ACC-championship clinching game at Syracuse last season.
- · LaSalla won the first eight faceoffs of the game in UVA's 19-8 route over Johns Hopkins (March 5, 2022), and finished the contest 9-of-10, setting his single-game career high in faceoff win percentage. LaSalla tied that career best mark (9-of-10) at Richmond (April 2, 2022) before exiting the game with an upper-extremity injury.

SHELLENBERGER, LASALLA EARN ACC WEEKLY HONORS

- For their performance against then-No. 18 Harvard, Connor Shellenberger and Petey LaSalla were named the ACC's Co-Offensive Player of the Week and Co-Defensive Player of the Week, respectively, for games played Feb. 13-19, the conference office announced Feb. 21.
- Shellenberger (3g, 7a) recorded a career-high 10 points, and his seven assists are also a career best. At the time, his 10 points tied for the most nationally by an individual in a single game this season and most by an ACC player this year. Shellenberger's 10-point performance is also tied for eighth all-time in program history and marks just the 17th occasion that a UVA player has registered 10 points or more.
- In a game that set the NCAA record for most combined faceoffs (49), LaSalla dominated the center X, finishing 18-for-29 (.621) against the Crimson. LaSalla also tallied a game-high 10 ground balls and ripped two goals off faceoff wins. LaSalla's second goal of the evening proved to be the game-winning goal in what was one of the highest-scoring games in NCAA men's lacrosse history.

SALLADE NAMED ACC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- With three ground balls and two caused turnovers in UVA's season opener against Michigan, Grayson Sallade was named the ACC's Defensive Player of the Week on Eab. 14
- · The weekly award was Sallade's first of his career.
- Sallade and the UVA defense held the Wolverines to just one goal in the fourth quarter and scoreless on all four of their extra-man opportunities.
- · As a member of Virginia's faceoff unit, Sallade helped the Cavaliers finish 18-for-32 at the center X.

2022 SEASON RECAP

- Virginia finished its 2022 season with an overall record of 12-4, marking the Cavaliers' sixth consecutive winning season.
- $^{\circ}$ UVA earned a share of the program's 19th ACC title, alongside Notre Dame, after finishing with a 5-1 record in
- · league play.
- Connor Shellenberger was named one of five Tewaaraton Finalists, UVA's 11th finalist in program history.
- Cole Kastner (Defensive Player of the Year) and Matthew Nunes (Freshman of the Year) earned ACC postseason honors.
- Payton Cormier (50g) became UVA's fifth-ever 50-goal scorer in a single season and first since Ian Laviano in 2019.

REIGNING ACC CHAMPIONS

- With its 21-15 win at Syracuse last season, Virginia earned a share of its 19th ACC championship, including two (2019 & 2022) under Lars Tiffany.
- The Cavaliers won 11 titles (1962, 1964, 1969, 1970, 1971, 1975, 1980, 1983, 1984, 1985 and 1986) prior the ACC establishing a tournament from 1989-2019 to determine the champion.
- Virginia has won seven ACC Tournament championships: 1997, 1999, 2000, 2003, 2006, 2010 and 2019.
- In the last ACC Tournament, which was held in 2019 at Klöckner Stadium, UVA defeated Notre Dame 10-4 in the championship game.
- From 1989-2019, Virginia won 14 regular-season titles (1990, 1993, 1994, 1995, 1997, 1999, 2000, 2002, 2003, 2006, 2009, 2010, 2012 and 2019), more than any other ACC school.

LAST SEASON, VIRGINIA WAS UNDEFEATED WHEN...

- In 2022, the Cavaliers finished 12-0 when leading their opponents after three quarters
- VIVA combined to out-score its opponents 203-138 in the first three periods of 2022, which is an average lead of 4.1 goals entering the fourth period.
- · Last season, the Cavaliers went 10-0 when leading at halftime and 1-0 when tied at the half
- In 2022, Virginia was 12-0 when dishing out more assists than its opponent. In the Cavaliers' 12 wins last season, UVA had 118 assists compared to its opponents'
