### OPENING DRAW

#### GAME OVERVIEW

- No. 1 Virginia (4-0) travels to No. 11 Johns Hopkins (4-2) for the Cavaliers' first true road contest of 2023 in a clash for the Doyle Smith Cup on Tuesday (March 7). Opening faceoff from Homewood Field is set for 4 p.m. on ESPN+.
- For the fourth consecutive week, the Cavaliers are ranked No. 1 in all three polls, USILA, Inside Lacrosse and Nike/USA Lacrosse Magazine.

#### LAST TIME OUT

- Last Saturday (March 4) at Klöckner Stadium, the Cavaliers scored the first eight goals of the game and later tallied 10 straight scores in UVA's 25-8 rout over Richmond.
- **Xander Dickson** (6g), **Payton Cormier** (3g, 3a), **Petey LaSalla** (19-26 FO) and **Cade Saustad** (6 GBs) led the effort for UVA.
- The Cavaliers collected 53 ground balls in the win, the most by UVA in a single game since scooping 59 against Utah in 2021. After this past weekend's slate of games, Virginia leads the nation in ground balls (41.50/gm).

#### SERIES HISTORY

- The Blue Jays lead the all-time series over UVA, 61-33-1.
- Dating back to 1904, Tuesday's matchup marks the 96th meeting between the UVA and Hopkins. The two teams met at least once every season from 1948-2019.
- Virginia has not faced any opponent more than Hopkins in program history.
- Four of the last 10 meetings have gone to overtime. UVA is 3-1 in such contests.
- In last year's meeting at Klöckner Stadium, Virginia tied for its largest margin of victory (19-8) in the series as **Payton Cormier** (6g), **Connor Shellenberger** (3g, 5a) and **Cole Kastner** (5ct) stood out for the Hoos.

### NUMBERS TO KNOW

Virginia enters 2023 with seven NCAA championships. UVA's seven NCAA titles are third most by any program since the NCAA Tournament's inception in 1971.

Virginia returns nine starters in 2023. The Cavaliers' only departure from last year's starting lineup is attackman Matt Moore, who was drafted No. 4 overall in the 2022 PLL Draft by the Archers.

56

Midfielder **Thomas McConvey**, a transfer from Vermont, has registered at least one point in all 56 career games. His 56-game point streak leads all collegiate players nationally.

## THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA

### UNIQUELY UVA

The University of Virginia is an institution rich with history and tradition. Here is some of the terminology that contributes to UVA's culture.

**Grounds:** The term used by students, faculty and alumni to refer to the University dating as far back as Thomas Jefferson. "Campus" is never used.

**First Year, Second Year, Third Year, Fourth Year:** Instead of freshman, sophomore, junior, senior. Why you may ask? To be a "senior" implies that a person has reached the final phase of learning, a feat that Thomas Jefferson believed to be impossible, arguing instead that education is a life-long process.

**Commonwealth:** Virginia is one of four constituent states of the United States of America that officially uses the name "Commonwealth" instead of the word state in all references. The other three commonwealths are Kentucky, Massachusetts and Pennsylvania.

### UNIVERSITY NICKNAMES

Virginia's athletics teams have been accompanied by a somewhat confusing array of nicknames. The most prominent and widely accepted of these monikers are "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos."

Although the terms "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are used almost interchangeably to refer to University teams and players, "Cavaliers" is more often used by the media, while "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are frequently used by Virginia students and fans.

Legend has it that Washington & Lee baseball fans dubbed the Virginia players "Wahoos" during the fiercely contested rivalry that existed between the two in-state schools in the 1890s. By 1940, "Wahoos" was in general use around Grounds to denote University students or events relating to them. The abbreviated "Hoos" sprang up later in student newspapers and has gained growing popularity in recent years.

### THE CAVALIER MASCOT

The costumed Cavalier with a large character head debuted during Virginia's 1984 football season and has remained the official mascot of the University.

### UNIVERSITY COLORS

Orange and blue were adopted as the University of Virginia's official athletic colors at a mass student meeting in 1888. UVA athletic teams had previously worn silver gray and cardinal red, but those colors did not stand out on muddy football fields, prompting a student movement to change them.

One of the students attending the mass meeting was Allen Potts, a star athlete who played on Virginia's first football team in 1888. Potts showed up at the meeting wearing a navy blue-and-orange scarf that he had acquired during a summer boating expedition at Oxford University. Orange and blue were chosen as the official athletic colors after one of Potts' fellow students pulled the scarf off Potts' neck and, waving it to the crowd, yelled, "How will this do?" UVA later served as the inspiration for schools like Auburn and Florida when they selected school colors.

### WAH-HOO-WAH

The origin of "Wah-hoo-wah" is uncertain. The cheer was used to root on Virginia teams as early as 1890 and may have been borrowed from Dartmouth College, whose athletics teams were once known as the Indians.

Legend attributes the yell to Natalie Floyd Otey, who sang the ballad "Where'er You Are, There Shall My Love Be" at Charlottesville's Levy Opera House in 1893. The predominantly student audience noticed that Otey warbled the first three words of the song between each of the stanzas and decided to join in the refrain. By evening's end, goes the legend, the crowd had corrupted "Where'er You Are" into "Wah-hoo-wah."

The Levy Opera House stands at the corner of High Street and Park Street and has since been renovated into an office building.

**DOYLE SMITH CUP (EST. 2006)**

- Upon the Doyle Smith Cup's inaugural matchup in 2006, Virginia and Johns Hopkins joined together to honor E. Doyle Smith, Jr. for his lifetime of contributions to the lacrosse programs at both schools and on the national level with the annual winner laying claim to the cup.
- Smith served as team manager and statistician for Johns Hopkins under coach Bob Scott from 1963-1968.
- He enrolled at UVA to pursue a doctorate in the fall of 1968, and became the University's first full-time assistant sports information director, a position he held for 31 years until his retirement in 1999, serving as the lacrosse team's publicist for four head coaches—Buddy Beardmore, Glenn Thiel, Jim Adams and Dom Starsia.
- On the national level, Smith was one of the nation's foremost authorities on the sport as his name is synonymous with the game's history and record keeping.
- He is credited with writing the original manuscript that later became the framework for the current NCAA statisticians' manual for men's lacrosse.
- He served as the information director compiling the weekly rankings and statistics for the United States Intercollegiate Lacrosse Association (USILA) from 1973-95 and twice received its Man of the Year Award. The USILA media award bears his name.
- In 2000, he was elected to the US Lacrosse Hall of Fame and is believed to be the only individual inducted who never played or coached the game at some level.
- Smith passed away in June 2004, not long after the 2004 national championship game.
- With last year's 19-8 win at Klöckner Stadium, Virginia retained possession of the Doyle Smith Cup and improved to 9-6 in such contests, dating back to the inaugural matchup in 2006.

**VIRGINIA IN THE POLLS**

- No. 1 Virginia has been ranked in the top 5 of the USILA Coaches poll in 316 weeks all-time.
- UVA has been ranked in the top 10 in 470 polls all-time, including in the most recent edition of the poll.
- UVA has been ranked No. 1 in the nation in 75 all-time polls, including in the most recent edition of the poll.
- The USILA Poll began in 1973.

**CONNOR SHELLENBERGER IS ELITE**

- Connor Shellenberger**, who is in his third season at UVA, is arguably the most-accomplished active player in college lacrosse.
- In addition to being a two-time USILA first team All-American (2021-22), Shellenberger became UVA's 11<sup>th</sup> Tewaaraton Award finalist last season.
- This year, Shellenberger was crowned a first team preseason All-American by the USILA, Inside Lacrosse and USA Lacrosse Magazine, and the top returning player in 2023 by Inside Lacrosse.
- This offseason, Shellenberger was invited to try out for a spot on the U.S. National Team for the 2023 World Championships.
- In 2022, he led UVA in points (76) and assists (44) and finished second in goals (32).
- In 2021, Shellenberger was sensational in the NCAA Tournament, guiding the Hoos to the program's seventh NCAA championship and was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player.
- In 36 career appearances, Shellenberger has posted at least one point in 35 contests and has recorded multiple assists in 28 career games.
- Earlier this season, he recorded a career-high 10 points with three goals and seven assists in UVA's 25-21 win over Harvard (Feb. 18).

**MORE ON THE UVA AND THE TEWAARATON AWARD**

- In addition to Shellenberger in 2022, UVA's other Tewaaraton Award finalists include: Steele Stanwick (2011-12), Ken Clausen (2010), Danny Glading (2009), Ben Rubeor (2007-08), Kyle Dixon (2006), Matt Ward (2006), Chris Rotelli (2003) and Conor Gill (2002).
- Stanwick (2011), Ward (2006) and Rotelli (2003) were recipients of the award.
- Virginia, Maryland and Syracuse are the only schools in the nation to have three Tewaaraton Award winners. Only Duke (13) and Syracuse (12) have had more finalists than UVA (11).

**GOING STREAKING**

- Newcomer **Thomas McConvey**, a transfer in the midfield from the University of Vermont, is currently riding a 56-game point streak, which began on Feb. 1, 2019.
- McConvey has registered at least one point in every game of his career.
- His 56-game point streak leads the nation among all active players.
- During his streak, McConvey has amassed 135 goals and 54 assists.
- Also riding a substantial point streak is UVA attackman **Payton Cormier**, who has recorded at least one point in his last 33 games.
- Cormier's 33-game point streak is currently the sixth longest in the nation. During his streak, which began on March 6, 2021, Cormier has registered 119 points (99g, 20a).

**CAVALIERS EXCELLING ON THE FIELD & IN THE CLASSROOM**

- On Feb. 15, Virginia men's lacrosse announced it achieved a 3.610 team GPA in the Fall of 2022.
- The Cavaliers' 3.610 team GPA led all UVA men's athletic programs for the semester.
- It also marked a 10% increase from the team's GPA in the fall of 2021.

**VIRGINIA'S EIGHT PRESEASON ALL-AMERICANS**

- Eight Cavaliers in **Connor Shellenberger** (1st), **Thomas McConvey** (2nd), **Cole Kastner** (2nd), **Payton Cormier** (3rd), **Jeff Conner** (HM), **Petey LaSalla** (HM), **Grayson Sallade** (HM) and **Cade Saustad** (HM) were named Preseason All-Americans by Inside Lacrosse.
- UVA's eight honorees led all Division-I programs nationally.

**NATION'S NO. 1 RECRUITING CLASS**

- Virginia's first years make up the nation's No. 1 recruiting class, according to Inside Lacrosse.
- Joining the Cavaliers this season are: **Ryan Colsey** (Ridgefield, Conn.), **Mac Eldridge** (Richmond, Va.), **Malachi Jones** (Owings Mills, Md.), **Kyle Morris** (Baltimore, Md.), **Tim Myers** (Charlottesville, Va.), **John Schroter** (Leesburg, Va.), **Truitt Sunderland** (Baltimore, Md.), **Joey Terenzi** (Manhasset, N.Y.) and **Mack Till** (Englewood, Colo.).

**LAST SEASON, VIRGINIA WAS UNDEFEATED WHEN...**

- In 2022, the Cavaliers finished 12-0 when leading their opponents after three quarters.
- UVA combined to out-score its opponents 203-138 in the first three periods of 2022, which is an average lead of 4.1 goals entering the fourth period.
- Last season, the Cavaliers went 10-0 when leading at halftime and 1-0 when tied at the half.
- In 2022, Virginia was 12-0 when dishing out more assists than its opponent. In the Cavaliers' 12 wins last season, UVA had 118 assists compared to its opponents' 55.

**REIGNING ACC CHAMPIONS**

- With its 21-15 win at Syracuse last season, Virginia earned a share of its 19<sup>th</sup> ACC championship, including two (2019 & 2022) under **Lars Tiffany**.
- The Cavaliers won 11 titles (1962, 1964, 1969, 1970, 1971, 1975, 1980, 1983, 1984, 1985 and 1986) prior the ACC establishing a tournament from 1989-2019 to determine the champion.
- Virginia has won seven ACC Tournament championships: 1997, 1999, 2000, 2003, 2006, 2010 and 2019.
- In the last ACC Tournament, which was held in 2019 at Klöckner Stadium, UVA defeated Notre Dame 10-4 in the championship game.
- From 1989-2019, Virginia won 14 regular-season titles (1990, 1993, 1994, 1995, 1997, 1999, 2000, 2002, 2003, 2006, 2009, 2010, 2012 and 2019), more than any other ACC school.

**ON THE HORIZON**

- The Cavaliers return to Klöckner Stadium on Saturday (March 11) to host Towson at 4 p.m. on ACC Network.

**VIRGINIA IS A GROUND BALL MACHINE**

- Since 2009, UVA has finished in the top 3 nationally in ground balls per game in all but one season, and led the nation in ground balls per game eight times.
- UVA is the only school in the nation to finish in the top 5 nationally in ground balls per game 13 times over the last 14 seasons.
- The only school in 2016 to finish with more ground balls per game was UVA head coach Lars Tiffany's Brown team.

**PETEY LASALLA: THE NATION'S DEADLIEST FACEOFF SPECIALIST**

- With **842** career faceoff wins, **Petey LaSalla** is currently second among all active Division-I players. He also ranks in the top-10 all-time in the NCAA Division I record book in both faceoffs won and faceoffs taken. See chart on page 7.
- LaSalla is the only player in all of college lacrosse with at least 842 career wins at the center-X and 33 career goals.
- In addition to his 33 career goals, LaSalla has dished out 11 career assists, making him the only player in the nation with at least 842 career faceoff victories and 44 career points.
- Virginia is 22-3 (.880) all-time when LaSalla scores a goal, including 3-0 in 2023, and 27-5 (.844) all-time when registering at least one point.
- LaSalla recorded two goals in UVA's first three games of 2023.
- LaSalla set a career high with three points on two goals and one assist in Virginia's ACC-championship clinching game at Syracuse last season.
- LaSalla won the first eight faceoffs of the game in UVA's 19-8 route over Johns Hopkins (March 5, 2022), and finished the contest 9-of-10, setting his single-game career high in faceoff win percentage. LaSalla tied that career best mark (9-of-10) at Richmond (April 2, 2022) before exiting the game with an upper-extremity injury.

**CORMIER, SAUSTAD EARN ACC PLAYER-OF-THE-WEEK HONORS**

- For their performance against No. 9 Ohio State, **Payton Cormier** and **Cade Saustad** earned ACC player-of-the-week honors for games played Feb. 20-26, the conference office announced Feb 28.
- Cormier was named ACC Offensive Player of the Week after scoring a career-high seven goals against the Buckeyes. Cormier's seven goals also tied for No. 2 in UVA single-game history and tied for the most by an ACC player in a single game this season.
- Saustad recorded a career-high four caused turnovers and added a pair of ground balls. In addition to holding the Buckeyes to their lowest goal total this season, Saustad limited 2022 second team All-American Jack Myers to just two goals on 10 shots.

**SHELLENBERGER, LASALLA EARN ACC WEEKLY HONORS**

- For their performance against then-No. 18 Harvard, **Connor Shellenberger** and **Petey LaSalla** were named the ACC's Co-Offensive Player of the Week and Co-Defensive Player of the Week, respectively, for games played Feb. 13-19, the conference office announced Feb. 21.
- Shellenberger (3g, 7a) recorded a career-high 10 points, and his seven assists are also a career best. At the time, his 10 points tied for the most nationally by an individual in a single game this season and most by an ACC player this year. Shellenberger's 10-point performance is also tied for eighth all-time in program history and marks just the 17th occasion that a UVA player has registered 10 points or more.
- In a game that set the NCAA record for most combined faceoffs (49), LaSalla dominated the center X, finishing 18-for-29 (.621) against the Crimson. LaSalla also tallied a game-high 10 ground balls and ripped two goals off faceoff wins. LaSalla's second goal of the evening proved to be the game-winning goal in what was one of the highest-scoring games in NCAA men's lacrosse history.

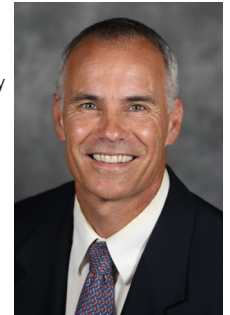
**SALLADE NAMED ACC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

- With three ground balls and two caused turnovers in UVA's season opener against Michigan, **Grayson Sallade** was named the ACC's Defensive Player of the Week on Feb. 14.
- The weekly award was Sallade's first of his career.
- Sallade and the UVA defense held the Wolverines to just one goal in the fourth quarter and scoreless on all four of their extra-man opportunities.
- As a member of Virginia's faceoff unit, Sallade helped the Cavaliers finish 18-for-32 at the center X.

**HEAD COACH LARS TIFFANY**

**OVERVIEW**

Lars Tiffany was named Virginia's 17<sup>th</sup> head coach on June 21, 2016. He is currently in his seventh season at UVA and 19<sup>th</sup> season overall as head coach. Tiffany is Virginia's only head coach to win back-to-back national championships (2019 & 2021). Tiffany begins the 2023 season with 67 wins as UVA head coach, good for No. 3 all-time in program history behind only Jim "Ace" Adams (137) and Dom Starsia (274).

A Biology concentrator, Tiffany played on two Brown teams that advanced to the NCAA Tournament (1987 & 1990). He was Co-MVP of the Brown squad that captured its first-ever NCAA playoff victory in 1990 (12-9 vs. UMass). Tiffany capped his career by playing in the North-South Senior All-Star game.
