>> THE OPENING FACEOFF

- Duke, 10-2 on the year, sits at No. 2 in the national polls following the 17-12 setback at Notre Dame. Faceoff is set for 12 p.m., on ACC Network at Koskinen Stadium.
- Virginia sits at No. 3 in the USILA poll and No. 2 in the Inside Lacrosse rankings with an 8-2 record and 2-1 mark in ACC play after a 19-12 win at North Carolina. The Cavaliers feature the nation's top-ranked scoring offense, averaging 18.20 goals per game.
- The attack unit of Andrew McAdorey, Brennan O'Neill and Dyson Williams have paced the Blue Devils. The trio is averaging 8.2 goals and 12 points per game and has 51 percent of the team's 280 points. Duke has gotten goals from 22 different players this season.
- Duke's defense has been solid overall, holding teams to just .285 shooting and to 10.75 goals per game. The Blue Devils are allowing just 10.5 goals per game over the past six outings.
- Graduate student transfer William Helm is solid in the cage, averaging 10.9 saves per game and sporting a .520 save percentage.
- Junior faceoff specialist Jake Naso features a .631 win percentage at the dot to rank fifth nationally. He ranks second in faceoffs taken (317). Petey LaSalla is 168-of-290 (.579) in restarts for Virginia.

>> DUKE VS. VIRGINIA GAME NOTES

ABOUT VIRGINIA

- Virginia is coming off a commanding 19-12 victory at No. 10 North Carolina last week. The Cavaliers are 3-0 on the road and averaging 17.33 goals per game in true road contests.
- The Cavaliers sport the nation's top-ranked offense, averaging 18.20 goals per game. Xander Dickson is the top scorer with 39 goals and 10 assists, while Connor Shellenberger has 48 points in his nine games. Payton Cormier rounds out the attack trio with 44 points.
- On the defensive side of the ball, Virginia is allowing 12.5 goals per game to rank 48th among Division I programs. Cade Saustad draws the top matchup and leads the team with 20 caused turnovers.
- Petey LaSalla anchors the faceoff duties, winning 168-of-290 (.579) restarts this season. He is averaging nine ground balls per game and has eight goals. In goal, Matthew Nunes has played all but 31 minutes. He sports an 11.88 goals against average and a .504 save percentage.

SHELLENBERGER VS DUKE

- Connor Shellenberger ranks third among active players with a 4.72 points per game average. The Blue Devils have been able to slow the stellar attackman down in the three previous games, holding him to just two goals and four assists (2021: 1g, 1a, 2022: 1g, 2023: 3a). All three of his assists in the first meeting this season came on extra man.
- He has been held to two or fewer points in a game six times in his career with two of those coming against Duke.

SERIES HISTORY

- Duke and Virginia meet for the 88th time. The Cavaliers have a 51-36 edge in the all-time series, but the Blue Devils have won 24 of the previous 26 contests. Duke has not lost to Virginia in Durham since 2003.
- Duke head coach John Danowski has fared well against the Cavaliers in his career, going 21-2 at Duke and 24-4 all-time.

WHAT GIVES

- Saturday's contest between Duke and Virginia features a host of interesting matchups, including the Cavaliers' high-octane offense against a tough Blue Devil defense.
- Both squads enter the contest with high-powered offenses. Duke is averaging 15.25 goals per game, while Virginia is at 18.20. The Cavaliers have scored at least 15 goals in eight of their 10 games.
- Defensively, Duke sports a 10.75 goals against average, while Virginia is at 12.50. The Blue Devils have held six of their 12 opponents to single digits this season and six of the past seven foes under their scoring average. Five Duke opponents have shot better than 30 percent in a game this season.

MCADOREY, O'NEILL, WILLIAMS ON ATTACK

- Sophomore Andrew McAdorey made the move to attack this season, joining Brennan O'Neill and Dyson Williams. The St. Anthony's product played midfield in high school for the Friars, often playing the part of facilitator. He has stepped right in this season, recording 23 goals and 18 assists in 12 games. He is one of 15 players to record at least six assists in a game this season.
- The trio accounts for 51 percent of Duke's points this year (144-of-280). They have scored at least half of the team's points in eight of the 12 games. Against Syracuse, the trio had nine of the 19 points with midfielders accounting for the other 10. Versus UNC, they had 11 of the 23 points, 11 of 28 against Air Force, and six of 18 at Notre Dame.

DON'T LET WILLIAMS GET HIS HANDS FREE

- Senior Dyson Williams has some of the best and quickest hands in college lacrosse. In 2023, Williams leads the Blue Devils with a .481 shooting percentage with 39 goals on 81 shots. In his past six outings, he has 18 goals on 35 shots (.514). He has shot at least .500 in seven of the 12 outings.
- The Oshawa, Ontario native led the NCAA in shooting percentage last season at .551 percent. He scored 43 goals on 78 shots and put 61 of his 78 shots on the season on goal. He posted a perfect 1.000 shooting percentage in eight of his 17 games last season and only shot below .500 three times.

SOCK TRICKS

- Dyson Williams recorded his second career sock trick - six goals - against High Point with seven goals. He is one of 12 players to have at least seven goals in a game this season.

COMING IN CLUTCH

■ Junior Brennan O'Neill stepped up in a big way against Denver, scoring the game-tying and game-winning goals in the overtime thriller. He had a hand in Duke's final three goals as the Blue Devils outscored the Pioneers 3-1 in the final three minutes of the overall game.

■ Jake Naso also had a monster fourth quarter against Denver, winning seven of the eight faceoffs, including the final one in regulation and drawing the penalty. He won the overtime faceoff at Syracuse, forcing the Orange into a violation. He was 3-2 in the fourth versus the Orange. At Virginia he was 3-of-5 in the final stanza to help Duke seal the 16-14 win.

■ Over the course of Naso's two-plus seasons at the faceoff dot, he is 52-30 (.634) in the fourth quarter in games decided by two or fewer goals. He is 5-0 in faceoffs in overtime with Duke going 4-1 in those contests.

NASO STELLAR AT THE X

■ Since the Robert Morris game in 2021, Jake Naso has gone on to become Duke's top draw man. The St. Anthony's product took 80 percent (361-of-449) of the team's faceoffs in his rookie season and upped his percentage to 91 percent this season.

■ Naso was the lone freshman to rank in the top 30 in faceoff percentage nationally, while his 227 wins are the most by a rookie in Duke lacrosse history.

■ Now a junior, Naso has won 668 faceoffs to lead all Division I juniors. He is seventh among active Division I players in victories at the dot and at his current pace will break the Duke record of 816 by Brendan Fowler. Only 10 players in Division I history have amassed 800 faceoff victories and Fowler is the only other Blue Devil to reach 600.

WILL FRISOLI FOUND HIS FOOTING IN 2022

■ Senior longstick midfielder Will Frisoli has picked up right where he left off in 2022, picking up 28 ground balls and registering six caused turnovers in 12 games. He has eight more ground balls than he had in 15 games in 2022. Frisoli currently ranks third among Duke non-faceoff specialists in GBs.

■ Frisoli found his footing over the final five games of the 2022 campaign. The Westwood, Mass., native collected eight caused turnovers and 10 ground balls in that stretch after having just three and nine in the 10 games prior.

■ Frisoli's 11 caused turnovers in 2022 were nine more than he had in his previous 14 games his first two seasons. He ranked third among Duke LSMs last season in ground balls.

CARPENTER HAS THE SCOOP

■ Preseason All-America and All-ACC choice Tyler Carpenter is outstanding off the ground and on defense for the Blue Devils. He had 67 ground balls and 17 caused turnovers in 17 games in 2022.

■ Carpenter has picked up at least five ground balls in 19 career games, including at Penn, Syracuse and Virginia. His career total sits at 201. He has 57 caused turnovers in his 54 games. He currently is third among non-faceoff specialists in the ACC in ground balls per game at 3.25. Duke's Wilson Stephenson leads the category at 3.50.

ROPE UNIT PRODUCTION

■ Duke has good depth at its rope unit this season. Jack Gray and Jake Caputo are the short-stick middle leaders, while rookie Aidan Maguire and senior Charlie O'Connor add good size, athleticism and a lacrosse IQ to the group. The Blue Devils are versatile up top with the poles as Tyler Carpenter and Wilson Stephenson have and can bounce between LSM and close defense. Will Frisoli and Henry Bard continue to put in good work at LSM and on the faceoff wings. They also are instrumental in Duke's 89 percent clearing rate.

■ Against North Carolina, the Blue Devils held the Tar Heel midfield to one goal.

■ Duke got great offensive production from the group against Penn, scoring two goals and adding an assist, while also picking up seven ground balls in the winning effort.

■ Will Frisoli has two goals, including one at Virginia on a long clear. Aidan Maguire notched his first score vs. North Carolina. O'Connor, leaning on his offensive midfield experience, also has five points. The Blue Devils held Air Force to a season-low 17-percent shooting.

WILSON STEPHENSON'S JOURNEY

■ Wilson Stephenson has had an incredible journey during his time at Duke, battling many ups and downs. He played in 16 games as a freshman as an LSM, picking up 15 ground balls and eight caused turnovers. In his 16th career game the Greenwich, Conn., native suffered a devastating leg injury in the NCAA quarterfinal game against Notre Dame in 2019. After nearly two weeks in the hospital and eight surgeries, Stephenson was released from the hospital.

■ Stephenson immediately started his journey back to playing lacrosse, which he vowed would happen. He returned to campus in the fall of 2019 and worked his way towards walking and building strength and after a few more surgeries, he returned to the lacrosse field in the fall of 2020 for Duke practices.

■ Stephenson made his amazing return official when he stepped on the field to play against Mercer, Feb. 13, 2021 - a span of 637 days between games. He earned his first career start three days later against High Point, picking up two ground balls.

■ Stephenson collected his first career awards, picking up USA Lacrosse Magazine Division I Player of the Week, ACC Co-Defensive Player of the Week and USILA Team of the Week recognition after having a career day in the win over Penn. He picked up six ground balls, caused four turnovers and scored a goal, while holding Sam Handley to just one goal and two assists. His efforts this season earned him a spot on the Tewaaraton Award Watch List.

O'NEILL AND WILLIAMS HIT BENCHMARK

■ With two goals against Bellarmine, junior Brennan O'Neill became the fastest and the 22nd Blue Devil to reach 100 career goals. Senior Dyson Williams followed suit as the 23rd to hit the mark with his seven goals against High Point. O'Neill is at 134 for his career, while Williams owns 130. O'Neill, playing 46 games, is averaging 2.91 goals per game to rank seventh among active players. Only nine players in NCAA Division I history have averaged at least 2.87 goals per game since 2000. Zack Greer averaged 3.07 goals per game in his Duke career. With 130 goals in 52 games, Williams is averaging 2.50 goals per game.

THE MAC ATTACK

■ Midfielder Andrew McAdorey had one of the best freshman campaigns in Duke history. The Long Island native had 23 goals and 16 assists for 39 points to rank fifth on the team in scoring. His 39 points are the most by a Duke freshman midfielder. He scored at least one point in all but one game as Virginia kept him scoreless.

■ McAdorey's 0.94 assists per game were tied for 13th among all freshmen nationally in 2022, while he ranked second among freshmen midfielders in points per game (2.29).

■ The sophomore has not missed a beat since making the move to attack. He is averaging 3.42 points per game and has five-plus points in four of the 12 outings. His 18 assists are two more than his total from his rookie season, while his six assists against Loyola are the most for a Blue Devil since Michael Sowers had six in 2021.

- Senior attackman Dyson Williams is keeping the No. 51 in the family. His father, Shawn Williams, made the number famous in lacrosse circles and Dyson's brother, Tucker, also wore the number before he died of cancer at age eight in 2014. His younger sister, Dylana, who is a sophomore on the Pitt women's lacrosse team also wears No. 51.
- Dylana was named to the ACC Women's Lacrosse All-Freshman squad in 2022, while their father, Shawn was announced as the General Manager and Head Coach of the newest National Lacrosse League franchise - Las Vegas Desert Dogs - over the summer.
- Dyson and his father played a game together in 2017 when they both donned uniforms for the Brooklin Redmen and combined for 10 points. Shawn scored 842 goals in a distinguished box lacrosse league. He was inducted into the National Lacrosse League Hall of Fame in 2021 as a first ballot nominee.

CARPENTER - A LIFELONG BLUE DEVIL

- Tyler Carpenter has been a Blue Devil his entire life after the family moved to Durham when his mom, Jolene Nagel, was hired as the Duke volleyball coach. Nagel was hired in 1999 and has 683 wins as a volleyball head coach, 480 of which have come at Duke.
- Tyler's brother CJ Carpenter also played for the Blue Devils from 2016-2020.
- Carpenter's father, Sam Carpenter, played lacrosse at Middlebury and professionally with the Denver Rifles. He served as the head coach of Denver University from 1986-88 and was an assistant coach for the U.S. U-19 team in 2002-03. Sam Carpenter currently is a Senior Assistant Director in the Office of Admissions at Duke.

- He etched his name at the top of the Division I men's lacrosse wins list in 2017, beating Jacksonville for his 376th career victory. Dom Starsia held the previous record of 375.
- The Blue Devils' leader has 234 wins at Duke, 192 at Hofstra and 27 in his first stop at LIU Post.
- Danowski, a winner of three NCAA titles, is one of three active Division I coaches to own multiple NCAA titles. He is second among the group with three, while Bill Tierney of Denver leads the way with seven.
