OPENING DRAW

GAME OVERVIEW

- · No. 3 Virginia (10-3, 3-2 ACC) concludes its 2023 regular season on Sunday (April 30), when the Cavaliers host No. 1 Notre Dame (9-1, 3-1 ACC).
- · Opening faceoff from Klöckner Stadium is set for 2 p.m. on ACC Network. Virginia will honor 13 student-athletes prior to the start of Sunday's game for Senior Day.
- The two teams squared off earlier this season at Notre Dame (March 25) with the Cavaliers prevailing, 15-10. Like Sunday's upcoming contest, Virginia was ranked No. 3, while the Irish claimed the top spot in the USILA coaches poll.

LAST TIME OUT

- The Cavaliers tallied their fifth win of the season away from Klöckner Stadium with their 20-11 victory at Lafayette Tuesday night (April 25).
- UVA's 10th overall win of the season saw Petey LaSalla set the NCAA Division-I faceoff attempts record. LaSalla has now taken 1,669 career faceoffs in 73 career games played.
- · Eleven different Cavaliers registered a goal, including Xander Dickson who scored a game-high four goals and tied for a game-high four assists. With three goals and two assists, Connor Shellenberger notched his 16th career hat
- · In net, Matthew Nunes earned the win after posting 13 saves, including seven in the first period.

SERIES HISTORY

- · Virginia leads the all-time series over Notre Dame, 10-8, and is currently riding a five-game win streak over the Fighting Irish, dating back to 2019.
- \cdot UVA's five-game win streak is its longest since the series began in 1993.
- \cdot Sunday's regular-season finale marks the second time this year in which the two teams will go head-to-head with the Cavaliers being ranked No. 3 and Notre Dame coveting the nation's top spot in the USILA coaches poll.

NUMBERS TO KNOW

Virginia is the only program in the nation with three players in Xander Dickson (5.31), Connor Shellenberger (4.83) and Payton Cormier (4.82) averaging at least 4.82 points per game.

Virginia's seven NCAA titles are third most by any program since the NCAA Tournament's inception in 1971.

UVA will honor 13 of its student-athletes for Senior Day prior to opening faceoff: Connor Shellenberger, Danny Parker, Will Cory, Drew Brennfleck, Quentin Matsui, Scott Bower, John Izlar, Peter Garno, Mike Bienkowski, Mitch Whalen, Jake Giulieri, David Roselle & Thomas McConvey.

THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA

UNIQUELY UVA

The University of Virginia is an institution rich with history and tradition. Here is some of the terminology that contributes to UVA's culture.

Grounds: The term used by students, faculty and alumni to refer to the University dating as far back as Thomas Jefferson. "Campus" is never used.

First Year, Second Year, Third Year, Fourth Year: Instead of freshman, sophomore, junior, senior. Why you may ask? To be a "senior" implies that a person has reached the final phase of learning, a feat that Thomas Jefferson believed to be impossible, arguing instead that education is a life-long process.

Commonwealth: Virginia is one of four constituent states of the United States of America that officially uses the name "Commonwealth" instead of the word state in all references. The other three commonwealths are Kentucky, Massachusetts and Pennsylvania.

UNIVERSITY NICKNAMES

Virginia's athletics teams have been accompanied by a somewhat confusing array of nicknames. The most prominent and widely accepted of these monikers are "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos."

Although the terms "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are used almost interchangeably to refer to University teams and players, "Cavaliers" is more often used by the media, while "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are frequently used by Virginia students and fans.

Legend has it that Washington & Lee baseball fans dubbed the Virginia players "Wahoos" during the fiercely contested rivalry that existed between the two in-state schools in the 1890s. By 1940, "Wahoos" was in general use around Grounds to denote University students or events relating to them. The abbreviated "Hoos" sprang up later in student newspapers and has gained growing popularity in recent years.

THE CAVALIER MASCOT

The costumed Cavalier with a large character head debuted during Virginia's 1984 football season and has remained the official mascot of the University.

UNIVERSITY COLORS

Orange and blue were adopted as the University of Virginia's official athletic colors at a mass student meeting in 1888. UVA athletic teams had previously worn silver gray and cardinal red, but those colors did not stand out on muddy football fields, prompting a student movement to change them.

One of the students attending the mass meeting was Allen Potts, a star athlete who played on Virginia's first football team in 1888. Potts showed up at the meeting wearing a navy blue-and-orange scarf that he had acquired during a summer boating expedition at Oxford University. Orange and blue were chosen as the official athletic colors after one of Potts' fellow students pulled the scarf off Potts' neck and, waving it to the crowd, yelled, "How will this do?" UVA later served as the inspiration for schools like Auburn and Florida when they selected school colors.

WAH-HOO-WAH

The origin of "Wah-hoo-wah" is uncertain. The cheer was used to root on Virginia teams as early as 1890 and may have been borrowed from Dartmouth College, whose athletics teams were once known as the Indians.

Legend attributes the yell to Natalie Floyd Otey, who sang the ballad "Where'er You Are, There Shall My Love Be" at Charlottesville's Levy Opera House in 1893. The predominantly student audience noticed that Otey warbled the first three words of the song between each of the stanzas and decided to join in the refrain. By evening's end, goes the legend, the crowd had corrupted "Where'er You Are" into "Wah-hoo-wah."

The Levy Opera House stands at the corner of High Street and Park Street and has since been renovated into an office building.

MORE ON THE NOTRE DAME SERIES

- · UVA knocked off No. 1 Notre Dame, 15-10, at Arlotta Stadium earlier this season (March 25).
- Xander Dickson (6g, 1a), Connor Shellenberger (2g, 5a) and Payton Cormier (2g, 2a) combined for 18 points. Shellenberger's five assists were good for the most by a UND individual opponent in Arlotta Stadium history.
- The win was also UVA's 16th all-time over a No. 1 foe and first since defeating Maryland, 17-16, in the 2021 national championship game.
- · At Klöckner Stadium last year, the Cavaliers defeated Notre Dame, 12-8, on March 26. Both teams finished ACC play with a 5-1 record to earn a share of the 2022 ACC title, however UVA was the only ACC program to earn a berth in the NCAA Tournament.
- · After falling to the Irish, 17-7, in the 2018 ACC championship final at Klöckner Stadium, UVA got its revenge, 10-4, in a rematch at the 2019 ACC title game, which was once again held at Klöckner Stadium.
- The 2019 ACC title was UVA's 18th, which it achieved after holding Notre Dame scoreless for 42:12 of game time.
- · Former goalie Miles Thompson got the nod in net and earned his first career win after making 13 saves. Offensively, Payton Cormier scored five goals and former UVA player Regan Quinn ripped four goals.

HONORING THE 2003 NCAA CHAMPION CAVALIERS

- · At halftime of Sunday's contest, Virginia will honor its 2003 ACC and NCAA championship team on the field to commemorate the 20-year anniversary of the program's third NCAA title and fifth national championship
- · Led by head coach Dom Starsia and captains Ned Bowen, Chris Rotelli, A.J. Shannon and Trey Whitty, the Cavaliers finished 15-2 overall to set the program's single-season wins record.
- · Rotelli was named UVA's first-ever Tewaaraton Award recipient, the most prestigious award in all of college
- · Goalie Tillman Johnson put on one of the most memorable performances in Championship Weekend history. He was named UVA's third NCAA Tournament Most Outstanding Player.
- · After falling to Johns Hopkins and Maryland in back-to-back regular-season games, the two-seeded Cavaliers earned their redemption in the NCAA Tournament at M&T Bank Stadium in Baltimore, Md. Behind Johnson's career high of 18 saves, UVA dominated the Terrapins, 14-4, in the semifinals before defeating No. 1 $\,$ Hopkins, 9-7, in the championship game.

CAVALIERS AMONG THE NATION'S STATISTICAL LEADERS

- Virginia currently leads the nation in assists (12.08/gm), ground balls (40.92/gm), points (30.08/15), scoring offense (18.08/gm) and shot percentage (.385). The Cavaliers are third in scoring margin (5.54/gm), fourth in clearing percentage (.914), and fifth in man-up offense (.559).
- Connor Shellenberger is currently second in assists (3.33/gm) and 15th in points (4.83/gm). Payton Cormier is fifth in goals (3.91/gm), 16th in points (4.82/gm) and fourth in shot percentage (.512). Xander Dickson is fourth in goals (4.00/gm) and points (5.31/gm), and second in shot percentage (.571). Petey LaSalla is 14th in ground balls (8.08/gm) and Cade Saustad is eighth in caused turnovers (2.15/gm).

CORMIER, SHELLENBERGER NAMED TEWAARATON AWARD NOMINEES

- UVA attackmen Payton Cormier and Connor Shellenberger were named two of 25 total Tewaaraton Award Nominees, the Tewaaraton Foundation announced April 20.
- The list will be trimmed to five finalists on May 11. Virginia was one of seven programs nationally to have multiple nominees.
- The ACC boasted eight nominees, which led all conferences nationally.

MORE ON VIRGINIA AND THE TEWAARATON AWARD

- In addition to Shellenberger in 2022, UVA's other Tewaaraton Award finalists include: Steele Stanwick (2011-12), Ken Clausen (2010), Danny Glading (2009), Ben Rubeor (2007-08), Kyle Dixon (2006), Matt Ward (2006), Chris Rotelli (2003) and Conor Gill (2002).
- · Stanwick (2011), Ward (2006) and Rotelli (2003) were recipients of the award.
- Virginia, Maryland and Syracuse are the only schools in the nation to have three Tewaaraton Award winners. Only Duke (13) and Syracuse (12) have had more finalists than UVA (11).

DICKSON GARNERS HIS SECOND ACC WEEKLY HONOR

- For the second time this season, **Xander Dickson** was named ACC Offensive Player of the Week, the conference office announced Tuesday (April 25).
- Dickson tied his career highs in both goals (7) and points (9) in UVA's 19-12 win over Syracuse at Klöckner Stadium last Saturday (April 22).
- His seven goals also tied for No. 2 all-time in UVA single game history and marked the fourth time this season Dickson has scored at least six goals.
- The reigning ACC Offensive Player of the Week proceeded to total four goals and four assists, his ninth 5+ point performance of the year, at Lafayette on Tuesday (April 30).

VIRGINIA IN THE POLLS

- At No. 3 in this week's USILA Coaches poll, Virginia has been ranked in the top 5 of the poll in 325 weeks all-time, including all 12 polls in 2023.
- · UVA has been ranked No. 1 in the nation in 70 all-time polls.
- · Virginia has been ranked in 516 polls all-time.
- The USILA Poll began in 1973 and there have been 537 polls all-time.
- From 1973-89, the USILA ranked the top-15 teams before expanding the poll to 20 teams for the 1990 season.

THE CAVALIERS AT KLÖCKNER STADIUM

- Virginia owns a 171-45 (.792) all-time record at Klöckner Stadium, including a 5-2 record in 2023, and has won 20 of its last 25 games played at the historic edifice.
- The Cavaliers' average margin of victory in their last 25 games at Klöckner Stadium is 5.56 goals.
- Virginia is 45-13 (.776) all-time at Klöckner Stadium under head coach Lars Tiffany.
- UVA is also 13-3 all-time at Klöckner Stadium in NCAA Tournament contests.
- Lacrosse debuted in Klöckner Stadium in 1993.

VIRGINIA KNOWS HOW TO RESPOND AFTER A LOSS

- Coming of a 15-14 loss at No. 2 Duke (April 15), the Cavaliers took down No. 13 Syracuse (April 22), 19-12. The win over the Orange marked UVA's 19th consecutive victory in games immediately following a loss (within the same season).
- The Cavaliers have not suffered back-to-back defeats since 2017, Lars Tiffany's first year as UVA head coach.
- During Tiffany's tenure as Cavalier head coach, Virginia 23-2 (.920) in games following a loss.

- One of the nation's top goal scorers, Dickson currently leads UVA in both goals (52) and points (69) on the season.
- Dickson has registered at least one goal in all 13 games this year and has scored at least six goals in four different games this season (7 vs. Syracuse, 6 at Notre Dame, 6 at Johns Hopkins and 6 vs. Richmond).

CONNOR SHELLENBERGER IS ELITE

- Connor Shellenberger, who is in his third season at UVA, is arguably the mostaccomplished active player in college lacrosse.
- In addition to being a two-time USILA first team All-American (2021-22), Shellenberger became UVA's 11th Tewaaraton Award finalist last season.
- Shellenberger currently leads all active Division-I players in career assists (126), is second in assists per game (2.74) and fourth in points per game (4.63).
- This year, Shellenberger was crowned a first team preseason All-American by the USILA, Inside Lacrosse and USA Lacrosse Magazine, and the top returning player in 2023 by Inside Lacrosse.
- This offseason, Shellenberger was invited to try out for a spot on the U.S. National Team for the 2023 World Championships.
- Team for the 2023 World Championships.

 In 2022, he led UVA in points (76) and assists (44) and finished second in goals (32).
- In 2021, Shellenberger was sensational in the NCAA Tournament, guiding the Hoos to the program's seventh NCAA championship and was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player.
- In 46 career appearances, Shellenberger has posted at least one point in 45 contests and has recorded multiple assists in 38 career games, including 25 games with at least three assists.
- Shellenberger has tallied a career-best 10 points on two occasions this season: vs. then-No. 18 Harvard (3g, 7a) and vs. Towson (4g, 6a).

- Thomas McConvey, a transfer in the midfield from the University of Vermont, is currently riding a 65-game point streak, which began on Feb. 1, 2019.
- · McConvey has registered at least one point in every game of his career.
- His 65-game point streak leads the nation among all active players.
- During his streak, McConvey has amassed 150 goals and 67 assists.
- Also riding a substantial point streak is UVA attackman Payton Cormier, who has recorded at least one point in his last 40 games.
- Cormier's 40-game point streak is currently the seventh longest in the nation.

 During his streak, which began on March 6, 2021, Cormier has registered 124 goals and 24 assists.
- Cormier is also riding a 16-game goal streak, which began April 16, 2022 and is currently tied for the 13th-longest goal streak in the nation. During his streak, Cormier has score 59 goals.

THOMAS McCONVEY: ONE OF THE NATION'S MOST ELITE MIDFIELDERS

- Thomas McConvey (150-67-217) is currently tied for fourth among all active Division-I players in career goals and No. 5 outright in points.
- McConvey and longtime friend and fellow Canadian **Payton Cormier** are currently tied with 150 career goals each.
- As of April 28, McConvey and Villanova's Matt Campbell are the only active Division I midfielders with at least 150 career goals.
- Against then-No. 3 Maryland, McConvey registered a season-high five points on four goals and one assist. His fourth goal of the day tied the score [13-13] with 1:18 left in regulation to ultimately force overtime.

PAYTON CORMIER: ONE UVA'S BEST-EVER GOAL SCORERS

- With four goals at then-No. 2 Duke (April 15), Payton Cormier became UVA's No. 2 all-time goal scorer.
- Cormier has led UVA in goals in the last two seasons, and with 50 goals in 2022, became UVA's fifth-ever 50-goal scorer in a single season and first since 2019.
- \cdot His 2.98 career goals-per-game average currently stands at No. 1 all-time in program history.
- This season, Cormier has recorded multiple goals in all 10 appearances, including nine hat tricks.

PETEY LASALLA: THE NATION'S DEADLIEST FACEOFF SPECIALIST

- With **989** career faceoff wins, **Petey LaSalla** is currently second among all active Division-I players. He also ranks in the top 10 all-time in the NCAA Division I record book in both career faceoffs won and faceoffs taken.
- · LaSalla is the only player in all of college lacrosse with at least 989 career wins at the center X and 37 career goals.
- With 495 career ground balls, LaSalla is currently third among all active Division I players.
- In addition to his 37 career goals, LaSalla has dished out 11 career assists, making him the only player in the nation with at least 989 career faceoff victories and 48 career points.
- Virginia is 25-3 (.893) all-time when LaSalla scores a goal, including 6-0 in 2023, and 30-5 (.857) all-time when registering at least one point.
- LaSalla recorded two goals in UVA's first three games of 2023 and two at then-No. 10 North Carolina (April 7).
- In Virginia's 13 contests so far this season, LaSalla has recorded at least a 50 percent faceoff win percentage in 11 games.
- LaSalla set a career high with three points on two goals and one assist in Virginia's ACC-championship clinching game at Syracuse last season.
- LaSalla won the first eight faceoffs of the game in UVA's 19-8 rout over Johns
 Hopkins (March 5, 2022), and finished the contest 9-of-10, setting his single-game
 career high in faceoff win percentage. LaSalla tied that career best mark (9-of-10) at
 Richmond (April 2, 2022) before exiting the game with an upper-extremity injury.

- The 2023 season marks the 95th for the Virginia men's lacrosse program, which boasts an all-time record of 689-381-5.

- UVA attackman **Payton Cormier** was named one of nine Tewaaraton Award Watch List first round additions, the Tewaaraton Foundation announced on March 9.
- In six of his seven appearances so far this season, Cormier has scored at least three goals, including a career high of seven against then-No. 9 Ohio State (Feb. 25).
- The Ontario native joined teammates **Connor Shellenberger**, **Petey LaSalla** and **Cole Kastner** as candidates for the award. Shellenberger, LaSalla and Kastner were named to the Foundation's initial Watch List on Feb. 10.

SHELLENBERGER, KASTNER SWEEP ACC WEEKLY HONORS

- Connor Shellenberger (2g, 5a) and Cole Kastner (1gb) were named the ACC's Offensive and Defensive Players of the Week, respectively, on March 28. The duo led the Cavaliers in their 15-10 win at No. 1 Notre Dame (March 25).

- Shellenberger's five assists against the Irish are the most by a Notre Dame individual opponent in Arlotta Stadium history.
- Kastner held Notre Dame star attackman Pat Kavanagh, who entered the game fifth in the nation in points per game, to just two goals and two assists in addition to a pair of turnovers. Kastner anchored a UVA defense that held Irish offense, which entered the game second in the country in scoring, to their lowest goal total in a single game since the Cavaliers defeated Notre Dame 12-8 at Klöckner Stadium last year.
