GAME OVERVIEW

- In its 42nd NCAA Tournament appearance, No. 2 seed Virginia (12-3) takes on seventh-seeded Georgetown (13-3) in the NCAA Tournament Quarterfinals on Saturday (May 20). Opening faceoff from Tom & Mary Casey Stadium in Albany, New York is set for noon.
- Chris Cotter (play-by-play) and Paul Carcaterra (analyst) will have the call on ESPN.

VIRGINIA IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

- Saturday's game marks Virginia's 42nd all-time appearance in the NCAA Tournament and 93rd NCAA Tournament game.
- Only Johns Hopkins (48) and Maryland (45) have been to the tournament more times than UVA.
- The Cavaliers are 58-34 (.630) all-time in NCAA Tournament games and have won 10 of their last 11 tournament contests, dating back to 2019.
- Only Johns Hopkins (72), Maryland (70) and Syracuse (65) have more NCAA Tournament wins than Virginia.

SERIES HISTORY

- Virginia leads the all-time series, 5-0, over the Hoyas.
- Three of UVA's wins in the series have come in the NCAA Tournament, including the most recent meeting in 2021.
- All three prior NCAA Tournament meetings between the Cavaliers and Georgetown (2003, 2006 & 2021) have come in the Quarterfinals round, and UVA went on to win the national championship all three times.
- In 2021, the then-fourth seeded Cavaliers advanced to Championship Weekend after UVA scored nine straight goals in the first half to knock off then-No. 5 seed Georgetown, 14-3. UVA's three goals allowed tied its NCAA Tournament single-game best.
- Connor Shellenberger** scored six goals and dished out one assist against the Hoyas.
- Shellenberger's six goals tied UVA's NCAA single-game record for most goals. He matched Doug Knight's 1995 game against Brown and Mikey Herring's 2019 game against Robert Morris.

THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA

UNIQUELY UVA

The University of Virginia is an institution rich with history and tradition. Here is some of the terminology that contributes to UVA's culture.

Grounds: The term used by students, faculty and alumni to refer to the University dating as far back as Thomas Jefferson. "Campus" is never used.

First Year, Second Year, Third Year, Fourth Year: Instead of freshman, sophomore, junior, senior. Why you may ask? To be a "senior" implies that a person has reached the final phase of learning, a feat that Thomas Jefferson believed to be impossible, arguing instead that education is a life-long process.

Commonwealth: Virginia is one of four constituent states of the United States of America that officially uses the name "Commonwealth" instead of the word state in all references. The other three commonwealths are Kentucky, Massachusetts and Pennsylvania.

UNIVERSITY NICKNAMES

Virginia's athletics teams have been accompanied by a somewhat confusing array of nicknames. The most prominent and widely accepted of these monikers are "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos."

Although the terms "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are used almost interchangeably to refer to University teams and players, "Cavaliers" is more often used by the media, while "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are frequently used by Virginia students and fans.

Legend has it that Washington & Lee baseball fans dubbed the Virginia players "Wahoos" during the fiercely contested rivalry that existed between the two in-state schools in the 1890s. By 1940, "Wahoos" was in general use around Grounds to denote University students or events relating to them. The abbreviated "Hoos" sprang up later in student newspapers and has gained growing popularity in recent years.

THE CAVALIER MASCOT

The costumed Cavalier with a large character head debuted during Virginia's 1984 football season and has remained the official mascot of the University.

UNIVERSITY COLORS

Orange and blue were adopted as the University of Virginia's official athletic colors at a mass student meeting in 1888. UVA athletic teams had previously worn silver gray and cardinal red, but those colors did not stand out on muddy football fields, prompting a student movement to change them.

One of the students attending the mass meeting was Allen Potts, a star athlete who played on Virginia's first football team in 1888. Potts showed up at the meeting wearing a navy blue-and-orange scarf that he had acquired during a summer boating expedition at Oxford University. Orange and blue were chosen as the official athletic colors after one of Potts' fellow students pulled the scarf off Potts' neck and, waving it to the crowd, yelled, "How will this do?" UVA later served as the inspiration for schools like Auburn and Florida when they selected school colors.

WAH-HOO-WAH

The origin of "Wah-hoo-wah" is uncertain. The cheer was used to root on Virginia teams as early as 1890 and may have been borrowed from Dartmouth College, whose athletics teams were once known as the Indians.

Legend attributes the yell to Natalie Floyd Otey, who sang the ballad "Where'er You Are, There Shall My Love Be" at Charlottesville's Levy Opera House in 1893. The predominantly student audience noticed that Otey warbled the first three words of the song between each of the stanzas and decided to join in the refrain. By evening's end, goes the legend, the crowd had corrupted "Where'er You Are" into "Wah-hoo-wah."

The Levy Opera House stands at the corner of High Street and Park Street and has since been renovated into an office building.

MORE ON THE GEORGETOWN SERIES

- The UVA defense held Georgetown's Jake Carraway scoreless. He had the nation's longest active goal-scoring streak entering the game at 44 games.
- In the 2006 meeting, the Cavaliers exploded for nine goals in the third quarter to ultimately secure the largest win in series history. Ben Rubeor scored five goals and Matt Ward set UVA series records with five assists and eight points. Kip Turner also recorded a dozen saves before the Cavaliers advanced to Lincoln Financial Field for Championship Weekend.
- In the 2003 quarterfinals, John Christmas scored three goals and Tillman Johnson made 15 saves as the Cavaliers held for the inaugural victory, 12-7, despite winning just seven of 30 faceoffs.

LAST TIME OUT

- After a lightning delay halted play in between the first and second quarters, Virginia pulled away with ease, defeating Richmond 17-8 in the first round of the NCAA Tournament last Saturday (May 13) at Klöckner Stadium.
- Payton Cormier** (6g) and **Connor Shellenberger** (2g, 4a) recorded six points each and **Petey LaSalla** won 18 of his 27 attempts at the faceoff X.
- Cormier's six goals tied for the most in a single NCAA Tournament game in school history.
- Xander Dickson's** (2g, 1a) first score of the day saw him shatter Virginia's single-season goals record as the fifth-year attackman surpassed Doug Knight's 1996 record of 56 goals.
- Defensively, **Cade Saustad** held Richmond attackman Dalton Young (2g, 2a), the Atlantic 10's Offensive Player of the Year, to just four points. **Matthew Nunes** (12-3) earned his second NCAA Tournament victory of his career in net after turning away nine Spider shots on goal.

CAVALIERS AMONG THE NATION'S STATISTICAL LEADERS

- Virginia currently leads the nation in assists (11.87/gm), ground balls (40.33/gm), points (29.47/gm), scoring offense (17.60/gm) and shot percentage (.382). The Cavaliers are second in scoring margin (5.67/gm), fifth in man-up offense (.571) and seventh in clearing percentage (.904).
- Connor Shellenberger** is currently second in assists (3.36/gm) and 10th in points (4.86/gm). **Xander Dickson** is fourth in goals (3.87/gm), fifth in points (5.13/gm) and second in shot percentage (.569). **Payton Cormier** is fifth in goals (3.77/gm), 19th in points (4.62/gm) and fourth in shot percentage (.505). **Cade Saustad** is seventh in caused turnovers (2.13/gm) and **Petey LaSalla** is 16th in ground balls (8.07/gm).

CAVALIERS ON THE VERGE OF SETTING PROGRAM'S SINGLE-SEASON ASSIST RECORDS

- With 178 assists on the season, Virginia needs just seven assists to break the UVA single-season assists record (184), which was set by the 2006 national-champion Cavaliers.
- This year's Cavaliers team has led the nation in assists per game for the vast majority of the year and is currently averaging 11.87 assists per game.

NINE CAVALIERS NAMED INSIDE LACROSSE ALL-AMERICANS

- Thomas McConvey** (1st), **Connor Shellenberger** (2nd), **Xander Dickson** (2nd), **Cade Saustad** (3rd), **Grayson Sallade** (3rd), **Evan Zinn** (HM), **Payton Cormier** (HM), **Petey LaSalla** (HM) and **Cole Kastner** (HM) were named All-Americans by Inside Lacrosse on May 17.
- Virginia's nine selections led all Division I programs nationally.
- The announcement also marked the first instance of McConvey garnering first-team honors.
- Voting by participating media members was completed after conference tournaments and before the NCAA First Round.

VIRGINIA IN THE POLLS

- At No. 2 in the most recent edition of USILA Coaches poll, Virginia has been ranked in the top 5 of the poll in 326 weeks all-time, including all 13 polls in 2023.
- UVA has been ranked No. 1 in the nation in 70 all-time polls.
- Virginia has been ranked in 517 polls all-time.
- The USILA Poll began in 1973 and there have been 538 polls all-time.
- From 1973-89, the USILA ranked the top-15 teams before expanding the poll to 20 teams for the 1990 season.

THE CAVALIERS AT KLÖCKNER STADIUM

- Virginia owns a 173-45 (.794) all-time record at Klöckner Stadium, including a 7-2 record in 2023, and has won 20 of its last 25 games played at the historic edifice.
- The Cavaliers' average margin of victory in their last 25 games at Klöckner Stadium is 5.68 goals.
- Virginia is 47-13 (.783) all-time at Klöckner Stadium under head coach Lars Tiffany.
- UVA is also 14-3 all-time at Klöckner Stadium in NCAA Tournament contests and 20-3 all-time in the month of May, including 5-0 under Tiffany.
- Lacrosse debuted in Klöckner Stadium in 1993.

VIRGINIA KNOWS HOW TO RESPOND AFTER A LOSS

- Coming of a 15-14 loss at No. 2 Duke (April 15), the Cavaliers took down No. 13 Syracuse (April 22), 19-12. The win over the Orange marked UVA's 19th consecutive victory in games immediately following a loss (within the same season).
- The Cavaliers have not suffered back-to-back defeats since 2017, **Lars Tiffany's** first year as UVA head coach.
- During Tiffany's tenure as Cavalier head coach, Virginia 23-2 (.920) in games following a loss.

THREE CAVALIERS SELECTED IN 2023 PLL DRAFT

- Thomas McConvey** (Waterdogs/RD 1, PK 8), **Xander Dickson** (Atlas/RD 2, PK 3) and **Petey LaSalla** (Whipsnakes/RD 2, PK 6) were all selected in the first two rounds of the 2023 Premier League College Draft.
- Virginia is the only school in the nation with at least one first round selection in each of the first five PLL Drafts. The Cavaliers also have the most first round picks among any collegiate program in PLL history with six since the league's inaugural draft in 2019.
- Evan Zinn** (Chaos), **Jeff Conner** (Waterdogs) and **Cade Saustad** (Cannons) were also claimed from the league's player pool.
- As of May 16, a total of 14 current and former Cavaliers are currently listed on PLL training camp rosters.

ON THE HORIZON

- The winner of Virginia and Georgetown will face the winner of No. 3 seed Notre Dame and No. 6 seed Johns Hopkins in the semifinals in Philadelphia, Pa. at Lincoln Financial Field on Saturday, May 27. Opening faceoff will commence at either noon for 2:30 p.m. on ESPN2.
- The Fighting Irish and Blue Jays are set to square off in Annapolis, Md. at Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium on Sunday (May 21) at 2:30 p.m.
- The NCAA championship game is set for 1 p.m. on ESPN on Memorial Day (May 27).

CAVALIERS EXCELLING ON THE FIELD & IN THE CLASSROOM

- On Feb. 15, Virginia men's lacrosse announced it achieved a 3.610 team GPA in the Fall of 2022.
- The Cavaliers' 3.610 team GPA led all UVA men's athletic programs for the semester.
- It also marked a 10% increase from the team's GPA in the fall of 2021.

SHELLENBERGER NAMED TEWAARATON AWARD FINALIST

- For the second consecutive year, UVA attackman **Connor Shellenberger** was named one of five Tewaaraton Award Finalists, the Tewaaraton Foundation announced May 11.
- Joining Shellenberger on the list are Pat Kavanagh (Notre Dame), Brennan O'Neill (Duke), CJ Kirst (Cornell) and Tucker Dordevic (Georgetown). The five finalists are invited to Washington, D.C., for the Foundation's annual ceremony on June 1 where the winner will be announced.
- The announcement marked Virginia's 12th finalist in school history. Only Duke (14) and Syracuse (12) have also had at least a dozen finalists in its program's history.
- Shellenberger joins Ben Rubeor (2007-08) and Steele Stanwick (2011-12) as UVA's only two-time finalists. Chris Rotelli (2003), Matt Ward (2006) and Stanwick (2011) were winners of the trophy.

CONNOR SHELLENBERGER IS ELITE

- **Connor Shellenberger**, who is in his third season at UVA, is arguably the most-accomplished active player in college lacrosse.
- In addition to becoming UVA's third two-time Tewaaraton Award finalist this year, Shellenberger is a two-time USILA first team All-American (2021-22).
- Shellenberger currently leads all active Division-I players in career assists (133), is second in assists per game (2.77) and fourth in points per game (4.65).
- This offseason, Shellenberger was invited to try out for a spot on the U.S. National Team for the 2023 World Championships.
- In 2022, he led UVA in points (76) and assists (44) & finished second in goals (32).
- In 2021, Shellenberger was sensational in the NCAA Tournament, guiding the Hoos to the program's seventh NCAA championship and was crowned the tournament's Most Outstanding Player.
- In 48 career appearances, Shellenberger has posted at least one point in 47 contests and has recorded multiple assists in 40 career games, including 27 games with at least three assists.
- Shellenberger has tallied a career-best 10 points on two occasions this season: vs. then-No. 18 Harvard (3g, 7a) and vs. Towson (4g, 6a).

- **Thomas McConvey**, a transfer in the midfield from the University of Vermont, is currently riding a 67-game point streak, which began on Feb. 1, 2019.
- McConvey has registered at least one point in every game of his career.
- His 67-game point streak leads the nation among all active players.
- During his streak, McConvey has amassed 154 goals and 68 assists.
- Also riding a substantial point streak is UVA attackman **Payton Cormier**, who has recorded at least one point in his last 42 games.

MATTHEW NUNES HEATING UP IN NET

- After registering a sub-.500 save percentage prior to the Cavaliers' opening ACC play, UVA goalie **Matthew Nunes** finished the 2023 regular season with a .551 save percentage, the best among all ACC goalies in conference play.
- Nunes also finished ACC action with a 11.95 goals-against average, just 0.2 goals allowed per game more than ACC Goalie and Defensive Player of the Year Liam Entenmann (Notre Dame).
- The Woodlands, Texas native claimed two wins over No. 1 Notre Dame and turned in a career-best 19 saves against the Fighting Irish in UVA's 12-8 win at Klöckner Stadium on April 30.

PETEY LASALLA: THE NATION'S DEADLIEST FACEOFF SPECIALIST

- With **1,021** career faceoff wins, **Petey LaSalla** is currently second among all active Division-I players.
- He also ranks in the top 10 all-time in the NCAA Division I record book in both career faceoffs won and faceoffs taken.
- LaSalla is the only player in all of college lacrosse with at least 1,021 career wins at the center X and 37 career goals.
- With **511** career ground balls, LaSalla is currently third among all active Division I players.
- In addition to his 37 career goals, LaSalla has dished out 11 career assists, making him the only player in the nation with at least 989 career faceoff victories and 48 career points.
- Virginia is 25-3 (.893) all-time when LaSalla scores a goal, including 6-0 in 2023, and 30-5 (.857) all-time when registering at least one point.
- LaSalla recorded two goals in UVA's first three games of 2023 and two at then-No. 10 North Carolina (April 7).
- Of Virginia's 15 contests so far this season, LaSalla has finished above 50 percent at the faceoff X 12 times.
- LaSalla set a career high with three points on two goals and one assist in Virginia's ACC-championship clinching game at Syracuse last season.
- LaSalla won the first eight faceoffs of the game in UVA's 19-8 rout over Johns Hopkins (March 5, 2022), and finished the contest 9-of-10, setting his single-game career high in faceoff win percentage. LaSalla tied that career best mark (9-of-10) at Richmond (April 2, 2022) before exiting the game with an upper-extremity injury.

PETEY LASALLA IN THE NCAA DIVISION-I RECORD BOOK

- In 75 career games, **Petey LaSalla** is the NCAA Division-I record holder in career faceoff attempts (1,720).
- With his 11th faceoff attempt in Virginia's 20-11 win at Lafayette (April 25), LaSalla shattered TD Ierlan's previous record of 1,657, which he set in 2021.
- He is also currently sixth all-time in DI history in career faceoff wins (1,003).

PETEY LASALLA AT THE FACEOFF X IN OVERTIME

- For his career, **Petey LaSalla** is 6-for-7 at the faceoff X in six overtime games, including 2-for-2 in the Cavaliers' 13-12 double overtime win over Duke in the 2019 NCAA Tournament semifinals.
- LaSalla won his first six overtime faceoffs before losing the first one of his career in UVA's 2023 contest against Maryland.
- Virginia is 4-2 all-time in overtime when LaSalla takes a faceoff, but has dropped its last two overtime games.

SEASON OVERVIEW

- The 2023 season marks the 95th for the Virginia men's lacrosse program, which boasts an all-time record of **691-381-5**.
- This season, the Cavaliers host eight regular season games at Klöckner Stadium, including three ACC contests and a rematch of the 2021 NCAA Championship game against Maryland (March 18).
- Virginia returns nine starters from its 2022 roster, including Tewaaraton Award finalist **Connor Shellenberger**, 2022 ACC Defensive Player of the Year **Cole Kastner** and 2022 ACC Freshman of the Year **Matthew Nunes**.

2022 SEASON RECAP

- Virginia finished its 2022 season with an overall record of 12-4, marking the Cavaliers' sixth consecutive winning season.
- UVA earned a share of the program's 19th ACC title, alongside Notre Dame, after finishing with a 5-1 record in league play.
- **Connor Shellenberger** was named one of five Tewaaraton Finalists, UVA's 11th finalist in program history.
- **Cole Kastner** (Defensive Player of the Year) and **Matthew Nunes** (Freshman of the Year) earned ACC postseason honors.
- **Payton Cormier** (50g) became UVA's fifth-ever 50-goal scorer in a single season and first since Ian Laviano in 2019.

REIGNING ACC CHAMPIONS

- With its 21-15 win at Syracuse last season, Virginia earned a share of its 19th ACC championship, including two (2019 & 2022) under **Lars Tiffany**.
- The Cavaliers won 11 titles (1962, 1964, 1969, 1970, 1971, 1975, 1980, 1983, 1984, 1985 and 1986) prior to the ACC establishing a tournament from 1989-2019 to determine the champion.
- Virginia has won seven ACC Tournament championships: 1997, 1999, 2000, 2003, 2006, 2010 and 2019.
- In the last ACC Tournament, which was held in 2019 at Klöckner Stadium, UVA defeated Notre Dame 10-4 in the championship game.
- From 1989-2019, Virginia won 14 regular-season titles (1990, 1993, 1994, 1995, 1997, 1999, 2000, 2002, 2003, 2006, 2009, 2010, 2012 and 2019), more than any other ACC school.

LAST SEASON, VIRGINIA WAS UNDEFEATED WHEN...

- In 2022, the Cavaliers finished 12-0 when leading their opponents after three quarters.
- UVA combined to out-score its opponents 203-138 in the first three periods of 2022, which is an average lead of 4.1 goals entering the fourth period.
- Last season, the Cavaliers went 10-0 when leading at halftime and 1-0 when tied at the half.
- In 2022, Virginia was 12-0 when dishing out more assists than its opponent. In the Cavaliers' 12 wins last season, UVA had 118 assists compared to its opponents' 55.

- Eight Cavaliers in **Connor Shellenberger** (1st), **Thomas McConvey** (2nd), **Cole Kastner** (2nd), **Payton Cormier** (3rd), **Jeff Conner** (HM), **Petey LaSalla** (HM), **Grayson Sallade** (HM) and **Cade Saustad** (HM) were named Preseason All-Americans by Inside Lacrosse.
- UVA's eight honorees led all Division-I programs nationally.

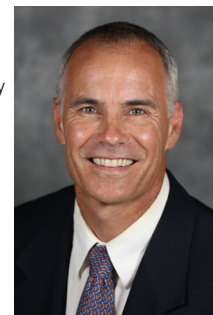

OVERVIEW

Lars Tiffany was named Virginia's 17th head coach on June 21, 2016. He is currently in his seventh season at UVA and 19th season overall as head coach. Tiffany is Virginia's only head coach to win back-to-back national championships (2019 & 2021). Tiffany begins the 2023 season with 67 wins as UVA head coach, good for No. 3 all-time in program history behind only Jim "Ace" Adams (137) and Dom Starsia (274).

DICKSON GARNERS HIS SECOND ACC WEEKLY HONOR

- For the second time this season, **Xander Dickson** was named ACC Offensive Player of the Week, the conference office announced Tuesday (April 25).
- Dickson tied his career highs in both goals (7) and points (9) in UVA's 19-12 win over Syracuse at Klöckner Stadium last Saturday (April 22).
- His seven goals also tied for No. 2 all-time in UVA single game history and marked the fourth time this season Dickson has scored at least six goals.
- The reigning ACC Offensive Player of the Week proceeded to total four goals and four assists, his ninth 5+ point performance of the year, at Lafayette on Tuesday (April 30).

CORMIER NAMED TEWAARATON AWARD WATCH LIST FIRST ROUND ADDITION

- UVA attackman **Payton Cormier** was named one of nine Tewaaron Award Watch List first round additions, the Tewaaron Foundation announced on March 9.
- In six of his seven appearances so far this season, Cormier has scored at least three goals, including a career high of seven against then-No. 9 Ohio State (Feb. 25).
- The Ontario native joined teammates **Connor Shellenberger**, **Petey LaSalla** and **Cole Kastner** as candidates for the award. Shellenberger, LaSalla and Kastner were named to the Foundation's initial Watch List on Feb. 10.

SHELLENBERGER, KASTNER SWEEP ACC WEEKLY HONORS

- **Connor Shellenberger** (2g, 5a) and **Cole Kastner** (1gb) were named the ACC's Offensive and Defensive Players of the Week, respectively, on March 28. The duo led the Cavaliers in their 15-10 win at No. 1 Notre Dame (March 25).
- It marked the second time that Shellenberger and Kastner swept ACC weekly honors for UVA with first coming in 2021 after the Cavaliers' win over Johns Hopkins.
- Shellenberger's five assists against the Irish are the most by a Notre Dame individual opponent in Arlotta Stadium history.
- Kastner held Notre Dame star attackman Pat Kavanagh, who entered the game fifth in the nation in points per game, to just two goals and two assists in addition to a pair of turnovers. Kastner anchored a UVA defense that held Irish offense, which entered the game second in the country in scoring, to their lowest goal total in a single game since the Cavaliers defeated Notre Dame 12-8 at Klöckner Stadium last year.

DICKSON GARNERS ACC WEEKLY HONORS

- For his performance at then-No. 11 Johns Hopkins and against Towson, **Xander Dickson** was named the ACC's Offensive Player of the Week for games played March 6-12, the ACC announced on March 14.
- Dickson tallied a team-best 10 goals, scoring on 62.5 percent of his shots, and added two assists in UVA's pair of wins on the week.
- Dickson's six goals at Hopkins marked his second straight outing with six scores, while his four goals and two assists against Towson marked his third consecutive game with six points.

CORMIER, SAUSTAD EARN ACC PLAYER-OF-THE-WEEK HONORS

- For their performance against No. 9 Ohio State, **Payton Cormier** and **Cade Saustad** earned ACC player-of-the-week honors for games played Feb. 20-26, the conference office announced Feb 28.
- Cormier was named ACC Offensive Player of the Week after scoring a career-high seven goals against the Buckeyes. Cormier's seven goals also tied for No. 2 in UVA single-game history and tied for the most by an ACC player in a single game this season.
- Saustad recorded a career-high four caused turnovers and added a pair of ground balls. In addition to holding the Buckeyes to their lowest goal total this season, Saustad limited 2022 second team All-American Jack Myers to just two goals on 10 shots.

SHELLENBERGER, LASALLA EARN ACC WEEKLY HONORS

- For their performance against then-No. 18 Harvard, **Connor Shellenberger** and **Petey LaSalla** were named the ACC's Co-Offensive Player of the Week and Co-Defensive Player of the Week, respectively, for games played Feb. 13-19, the conference office announced Feb. 21.
- Shellenberger (3g, 7a) recorded a career-high 10 points, and his seven assists are also a career best. At the time, his 10 points tied for the most nationally by an individual in a single game this season and most by an ACC player this year. Shellenberger's 10-point performance is also tied for eighth all-time in program history and marks just the 17th occasion that a UVA player has registered 10 points or more.
- In a game that set the NCAA record for most combined faceoffs (49), LaSalla dominated the center X, finishing 18-for-29 (.621) against the Crimson. LaSalla also tallied a game-high 10 ground balls and ripped two goals off faceoff wins. LaSalla's second goal of the evening proved to be the game-winning goal in what was one of the highest-scoring games in NCAA men's lacrosse history.

SALLADE NAMED ACC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- With three ground balls and two caused turnovers in UVA's season opener against Michigan, **Grayson Sallade** was named the ACC's Defensive Player of the Week on Feb. 14.
- The weekly award was Sallade's first of his career.
- Sallade and the UVA defense held the Wolverines to just one goal in the fourth quarter and scoreless on all four of their extra-man opportunities.
- As a member of Virginia's faceoff unit, Sallade helped the Cavaliers finish 18-for-32 at the center X.

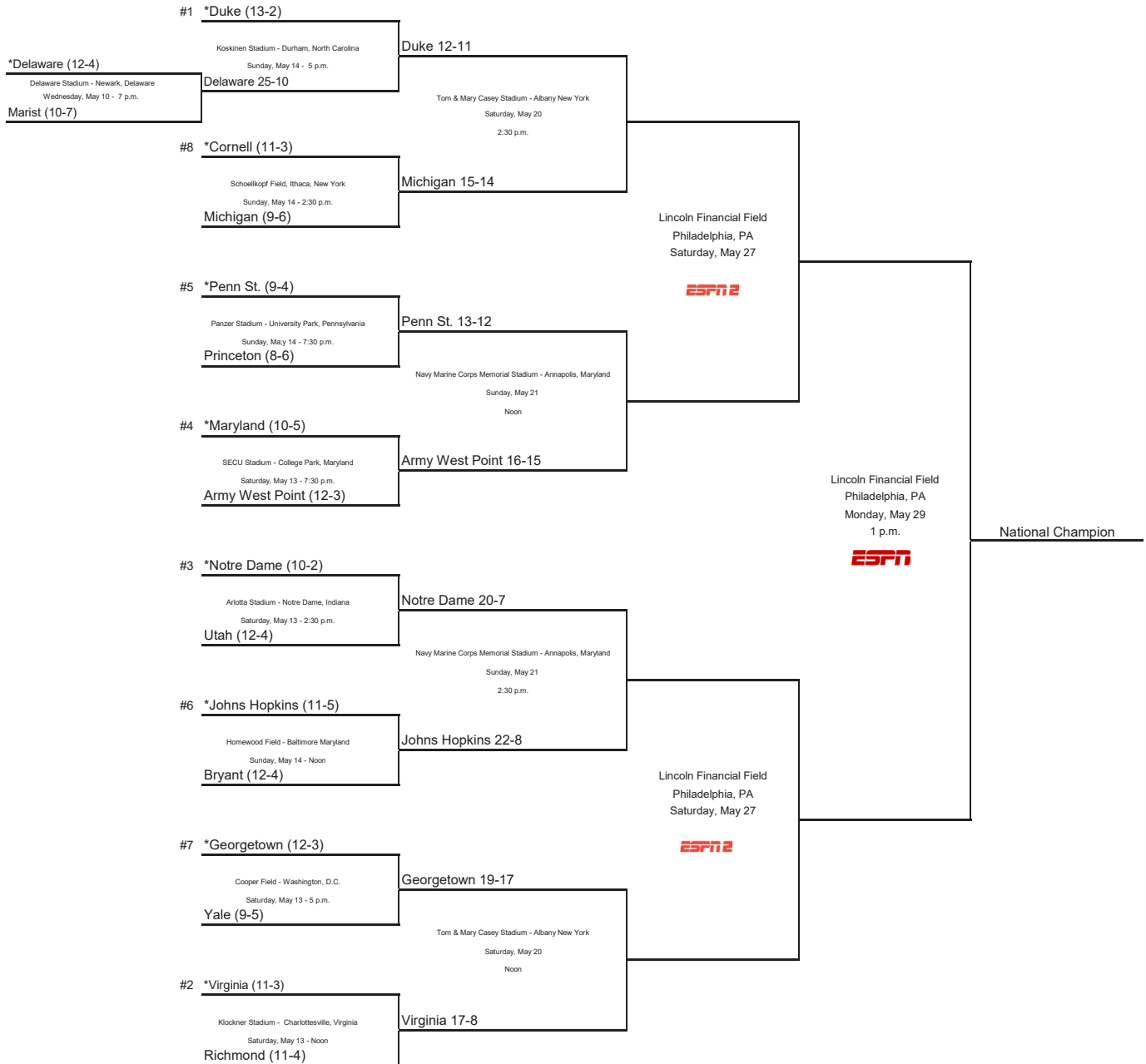
