



FIELD HOCKEY

TEAM NOTES

- Friday's game against No. 11 Saint Joseph's is Virginia's third-straight contest against a ranked opponent
- The Cavaliers opened the season with a 2-1 win against No. 5 Penn State but fell 3-1 on Tuesday night against No. 14 Liberty
- Virginia trailed Penn State 1-0 at halftime and Liberty 2-0 at the break
- Virginia has three different goal scorers on their three goals this season across three different class years: grad student **Laura Janssen**, sophomore **Daniela Mendez-Trendler** and freshman **Minnie Pollock**
- Virginia has scored all three of its goals in the second half
- Virginia has taken 16 of its 31 shots in the fourth quarter
- Junior **Noa Boterman** logged two defensive saves. She had one defensive save last season giving her three for her career
- Junior goalkeeper **Tyler Kennedy** started the first two games for the Cavaliers, getting the win and taking the loss against Liberty
- Freshman goalkeeper **Nilou Lempers** subbed into the Liberty game, playing the fourth quarter. She made one save in 15 minutes in her collegiate debut

ACC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- **Laura Janssen** was named the ACC Offensive Player of the Week in the first honors of the season (Aug. 29) for scoring the game-tying goal and assisting on the game-winning goal against Penn State
- It was Janssen's first career ACC Player of the Week honor

CAPTAINS

- **Meghen Hengerer** is in her second season as a team captain
- **Laura Janssen** and **Noa Boterman** are also captains this year, the first time for both

PRESEASON POLLS

- Virginia is picked to finish second in the ACC, receiving three of seven first-place votes
- The Cavaliers are No. 6 in the NFHCA Preseason Poll

PRESEASON ALL-ACC

- Sophomore midfielder **Daniela Mendez-Trendler** was named to the 10-player Preseason All-ACC team
- She earned All-ACC First Team honors last year with eight goals and 19 points and was a third-team All-American

CAVALIER SEASON PREVIEW

- Virginia was 13-8 last season, advancing to the ACC Championship match and earning an at-large bid to the NCAA Championship field
- Head coach Michele Madison is beginning her 18th season at Virginia and 35th overall as a head coach. She comes into the year ranked third among active DI coaches in total victories with 444
- Virginia has made 13 NCAA tournament appearances under Madison, with three trips to the Final Four. Her teams have made the tournament in six of the last seven seasons, only missing it during the 2020-21 COVID-19 Pandemic season
- The Cavaliers have made the ACC Championship game each of the last two years. Virginia will be hosting the ACC Championship Oct. 31-Nov. 3 at Turf Field
- Virginia and Penn State have played one another opening weekend in an alternating home-and-home series every year since 2009 except the COVID-19 2020-21 season
- The Cavaliers open the season with three straight games against top-15 opponents
- 12 of Virginia's 16 regular-season opponents are ranked in the preseason top-20, playing three teams in the top five
- The Cavaliers return five of their top six goal scorers from last season
- The returners accounted for 85.7 percent of Virginia's goals last season
- Striker **Laura Janssen** returns as a grad student. She led the team last year with 12 goals. The two-time All-Region honoree has 33 career goals and 71 career points in her four seasons with the Cavaliers
- Midfielder **Adele Iacobucci** is also back for her fifth year. The four-year starter was named to the All-ACC Second Team last year and is a three-time All-Region First Team honoree. She has started 76 of 83 games over the last four years
- Midfielder **Daniela Mendez-Trendler** looks to build on her stellar freshman season. She was a first-team All-ACC honoree and a third-team All-American. She ranked second on the team in goals (8) and points (19) last season
- Juniors **Jans Croon** and **Emily Field** will anchor UVA's backline defense. Croon has started 40 games in the last two seasons while Field has played significant minutes with 16 starts since his freshman year
- Freshman **Mia Abello** is expected to make an immediate impact. The defender has been on the US Women's National Team roster since her senior year of high school

RANKINGS

- The Cavaliers moved back into the top-10 in the first poll of the regular season
- Virginia started the season at No. 12 in the NFHCA Coaches Poll. UVA was No. 13 in the final poll of 2021
- Virginia has been ranked in the top 25 every single week since the 2012 preseason poll
- Virginia is No. 1 in strength of schedule this season, having played all but two of the teams in the final regular-season top-10 (Michigan and Princeton)
- After playing Iowa, UVA will have played all but two of the top-13 teams
- There is only one team on Virginia's schedule that has not been ranked this season: today's opponent Kent State. James Madison and Temple were both unranked when Virginia faced them but both moved into the rankings after. Miami was also unranked when played, but were ranked before and after

OWL & HOOS

- Temple is coached by UVA alumna **Michelle Vittese** (2008-10, 2012). She was a three-time All-American at Virginia and helped lead the team to the 2009 and 2010 Final Fours. She is in her second season as the head coach for the Owls
- Temple's assistant coach is UVA alumna **Carissa Vittese** (2010-13). She was a two-time All-Region honoree at UVA and a member of the 2010 Final Four team. This is her third season as an assistant coach for the Owls
- **Michele Madison** began her head coaching career at Temple, leading the Owl to three NCAA tournament berths in her four seasons and the A-10 title in her final year. She went 56-28-6 in her four seasons

THIS WEEKEND'S MATCH-UP

- UVA played both teams last year in Charlottesville, topping Temple 1-0 and Saint Joseph's 3-2
- UVA is 5-1 all-time against Saint Joseph's and has won the last three meetings
- The series record is tied 2-2 against Temple with UVA having won the last two meetings
- Virginia has three players who grew up within 40 miles of Philadelphia: **Lauren Kenah, Madison Orsi and Adele Iacobucci**
- The Cavaliers have one more Pennsylvania native in **Emma Watchilla**

NFCA PRESEASON WATCH LIST

- **Mia Abello, Daniela Mendez-Trendler, Adele Iacobucci, Laura Jansen and Madison Orsi** were all named to the NFCA Preseason Watch list

SENIOR WOMEN'S NATIONAL TEAMS

- **Mia Abello** is on the 2023-24 USWNT roster. She was also named to the team in 2022-23 while she was still in high school (The Kinkaid School, Houston, Texas), but she has yet to earn an international cap with the senior women's national team
- **Jans Croon** is a member of the US Women's National Hockey5s Team, helping to lead the squad to a gold medal and the 2023 Pan Am Cup and earn a spot in the Hockey5s World Cup that will be held in Oman in January 2024
- **Lauren Kenah** is on the US Women's National Indoor Team and suited up for the squad at the 2023 Women's World Cup in February, 2023 in Pretoria, South Africa

JUNIOR NATIONAL TEAMS

- **Jans Croon, Mia Abello, Madison Orsi and Daniela Mendez-Trendler** are members of the US U21 team that won gold at the 2023 Junior Pan American Championships in Barbados in April
- All four have been named to the roster for the 2023 FIH Hockey Women's Junior World Cup, being held in December in Santiago, Chile

HEAD COACH MICHELE MADISON

- Head coach **Michele Madison** is in her 18th season at Virginia and her 35th overall as a head coach
- She ranks third among active DI coaches in wins with 445 (most of any active ACC coach). She ranks eighth overall on the all-time win list
- Madison was inducted into the National Field Hockey Coaches Association Hall of Fame in 2013 and was named the 2017 ACC Coach of the Year
- Madison is one of only two active Division I head coaches to be a part of two United States Olympic staffs, having worked as a manager with the 1988 Olympic Team in Seoul and served as the head goalkeeper coach with the 1996 squad in Atlanta

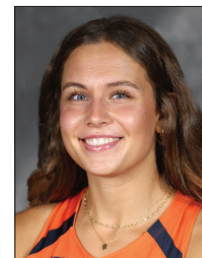

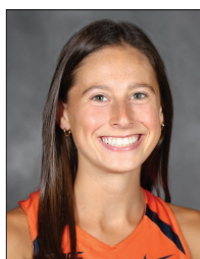
